GIANT SEEKS CHAMPION STATUS

The fifth leg in the Emirates Racing Series will showcase **Giant's Causeway** (Storm Cat) in the G1 Esat Digifone Irish Champion at Leopardstown this afternoon. The mid-week depression caused by the announcement that Montjeu (Ire) would miss this race was lifted with the inclusion of the Ballydoyle star. Although the two horses are vastly contrasting racehorses, they hold special places in the public's heart. Aidan O'Brien's colt was only hinting at what was to come when he took last year's G1 Prix de la Salamandre at Longchamp, crowning an unbeaten two-year-old campaign. However, he had his detractors when he found one better in both the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 6 and G1 Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh May 27. He answered criticism in the best possible way, taking four Group 1 races--the St. James' Palace S. June 20, Eclipse S. July 8, Sussex S. Aug. 2 and International S. Aug. 22--within 63 days. The colt always offered his rivals a close look at victory before snatching it back from them when it mattered. Having beaten Valentino (GB), Dansili (GB) and Kalanisi (Ire) twice, by no more than a length, he clearly revels in a scrap. This may be in the mind of Frankie Dettori and company as they attempt to get past the favorite today. Tactics nearly paid off for Pat Eddery on Kalanisi (Ire) at York, as he brought his challenge out of range of the winner's sight, but even he had to acquiesce in the end. **Best Of The Bests** (Machievellian) looked impressive when storming away with the G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano Aug. 15 and is an obvious danger as he attempts to give Godolphin their third consecutive Irish Champion S. Although he may not have achieved as much as Swain (GB) and Daylami (Ire) so far, he is considered to be their best three-year-old by Dettori, and so must be respected. While **Indian Danehill** is a Group 1 winner, having taken the Prix Ganay Apr. 30, he may need to improve to prevail here, and the same applies to **Greek Dance**. He claimed the scalp of **Sumitas** in the G1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis July 30, winning by 2 1/2 lengths. As the latter has already run well overseas this year, finishing second to Dubai Millennium (GB) in the G1 Prince Of Wales' S. June 21, he must be respected as the first German-trained horse to run on these shores. *Field p3*

AN INTERNATIONAL MAN O'WAR

Godolphin's **Fantastic Light** (Rahy) leads three European raiders in the GI Man O'War S. at Belmont today as the Fall Championship Meeting gets underway. The bay colt opened this season with a three-length score in the G3 Dubai Sheema Classic in March before finishing second in the G1 Coronation Cup in June. Fifth behind **Giant's Causeway** in the G1 Coral-Eclipse July 8, he rebounded with a good second to Montjeu (Ire) in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot July 29. The elite company which he has kept is reflected in his even-money status on the morning line. "We selected him to come out [to the U.S.] because we think he is an ideal candidate for American racing," said Simon Crisford, Godolphin's racing manager. "He does well on fast ground and likes to quicken off a fast pace." **Fantastic Light** will be ridden for the first time by Jerry Bailey. Trainer Bobby Frankel will send **Timbrooa** (GB) (Salse) postward for the first time. Winner of the 10-furlong G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica in Italy May 14, the four-year-old had his last outing in France, finishing fifth in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois over a mile at Deauville Aug. 13. He should be better suited today's 11-furlong distance. The American contingent is headed by **John's Call** (Lord At War {Arg}), the venerable nine-year-old who scored his first career Grade I in the Sword Dancer at Saratoga Aug. 12. A former steeplechaser, he scored by 9 1/4 lengths over **Aly's Alley** (Alwuhush) over a very soft course that day at the Spa. The latter, who missed by a head in the 1998 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, has found a new life going long on the grass and will attempt to make all the running. Prior to his second to John's Call, he was caught late by Down the Aisle in the GI United Nation's H. at Monmouth July 1.

Noverre felt the fury of Bad As I Wanna Be (Ire) last time in the G1 Prix Morny Aug. 20, being beaten seven lengths into third. Despite critics' reluctance to rate the winner there, the form now looks increasingly impressive. This colt had shown himself to be a fine two-year-old in winning the Listed Prix La Fleche at Maisons-Laffitte June 14 and the G3 July S. at Newmarket July 13. Here he stepped up in class and trip for his most important success yet. Settled near the back of the field early, he needed a gap when it was time to deliver his challenge, which was not immediately there. As he leaned on Chianti, Cd Europe and Ghayth were having their own tussle up front, but when he saw daylight he quickened gradually, sweeping past the front rank with 150 yards to race to put the field away comfortably in a few strides. Diana Cooper, racing manager to Godolphin France, said, "He was a very nice winner indeed. He probably didn't appreciate the ground at Deauville, but Bad As I Wanna Be was unbeatable that day. He came out of that race well, and he enjoyed the seven furlongs today--he's bred to take the extra furlong without any problems." Ricky Bowman, assistant to trainer David Loder, added, "When he first ran we thought he was all speed, but now that he's gone up to seven he can be dropped out and then use his turn of speed, which he did very well here. I think he'll have another race or two this season, and he may end up going to the Breeders' Cup Juvenile." William Hill quote him at 25-1 for next year's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, ironically alongside Bad As I Wanna Be.

St Leger Preview cont.

Sir Michael Stoute has won every domestic Classic, yet the St. Leger still evades him. This may be mystifying when studying the representatives of Freemason Lodge here over the years. No less than Shergar (GB), Untold (GB), Hellenic (GB), Saddler's Hall (Ire) and Shernazar (Ire), have all tried and failed to end the hoodoo. The latter is the sire of Dalampour, one of two horses he has to go to war with this year, and it would be fitting were he to bounce back from his third place in the G2 Great Voltigeur S. Aug. 22 to win this. The Great Voltigeur is seen as the most comprehensive guide to the season's final Classic, having produced subsequent St Leger winners Snurge (Ire), Bob's Return (Ire), Mutafaweq and Silver Patriarch (Ire) in the last decade. Pat Downes, The Aga Khan's stud manager, said of Dalampour, "I think York just did not go well for him--it did not suit him to make the pace. Here they certainly should go quicker, and the extra two furlongs will suit him well. With a strong pace, he will drop his head in behind a few and I would hope that we will see a different result, but it is a very competitive St Leger." He will have to improve to reverse placings with stablemate Air Marshall, who unleashed a devastating turn-off-foot there to win in style off a relatively slow pace. He appeared to have progressed since being denied by the late run of Millenary previously in the G3 Gordon S. Aug. 1, when jockey Johnny Murtagh seemed to ease his mount before the line. John Reid takes Murtagh's place on board the favourite here, and he will be hoping that the talented colt can give him a quick follow-up after Nedawi (GB), who gave him his first success in this in 1998.

Tout Charmant, winner of the GI Del Mar Oaks last season, started the year off with a victory in the Gill Wilshire at Hollywood in May and came back with a third to Astra and Happyannoit (NZ) in the GI Gamely over the same course June 4. The Ron McAnally-trainee was a solid second to Tranquility Lake in the Gill Palomar Aug. 16 on the Del Mar turf in her last out and merits top billing here. Her Stonerside entrymate **Caffe Latte** opened 2000 impressively with back-to-back scores, including the GI Santa Barbara H. in April, but has faltered in her last two, finishing seventh in the Palomar. **Alexine**, a Group 1 winner in her native Argentina, made a strong impression when capturing a Del Mar money allowance Aug. 17 and should handle the step up in competition.

Having looked a filly with a bright future when winning the G3 Queen Mary S. impressively, **Romantic Myth** appeared disappointing next time when trailing in sixth behind **Superstar Leo** in the Weatherbys Super Sprint at Newbury July 22. However, it transpired that she had injured herself in running, and she put up a much improved effort last time when fourth, beaten just over 2 1/2 lengths by **Enthused** in the G2 Lowther S. Aug. 24. **Superstar Leo** was trounced by **Minardi**, losing by five lengths in the G1 Heinz 57 Phoenix S. Aug. 13, but that form looks particularly smart and she must be respected here. **Nerys Dutfield's** pride and joy **Misty Eyed** showed a devastating turn of foot to win both the Listed Dragon S. July 9 and the G3 Molecomb Aug. 4. On the latter occasion she beat several useful horses, and her finishing speed may be decisive here. **Zilch** nearly got the better of **Bannister (GB)** when second by a neck in the G2 Gimcrack S. Aug. 23 last time, and this drop back to five furlongs may bring out the best in him.

We were convinced that we had put together the best collection of yearlings ever seen at Doncaster and the huge number of buyers that have been active this week thoroughly endorsed that conviction. The quality of yearlings at the sale has steadily improved over the last few years and our record average of 14,020 guineas is a great testament to the professionalism of our vendors, to whom we are indebted for showing such confidence in DBS. The extremely high clearance rate of 96 percent also illustrates the strength of the market from start to finish. It was again particularly notable that the sale was dominated by British buyers, including a huge number of trainers from every corner of the country, but we were also very happy to welcome some new and notable overseas faces for the first time headed by the likes of leading German trainer Andreas Wohler." In fact, last night's top lot, the only Indian Ridge (Ire) in the catalogue, heads to Italy. The well-related colt, offered from Kirtlington Stud, was bought for 58,000gns by trainer Fabio Brogi via agent Marco Bozzi. "He will race for the Scuderia Allevamento La Nuova Sabarra, who won this year's G1 Italian Oaks with Timi (GB)," said Bozzi. Underbidder was agent Will Edmeades, accompanied by James Stafford, manager of the Thurloe Thoroughbreds syndicates. Oxfordshire-based trainer Henry Candy will train the second top lot, a 42,000gns Pursuit Of Love (GB) filly offered by Catridge Farm Stud, agent for Wheelersland Stud. Talking of Montjeu, Kinane said: "It is a little bit worrying that he has had a scare, but John [Hammond] has decided to keep him in France, with the Arc as his ultimate aim, and I definitely respect that--he knows the horse better than anyone else.
