CAUSEWAY CELEBRE

Looking for his fifth straight Group 1 win, Giant's Causeway (Storm Cat) was sent off the 11-8 on favourite in the Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown yesterday afteroon and resumed normal service to take his most valuable prize vet, beating Greek Dance (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) by a half length. His success was a case of bringing together the best aspects of history with the modern. The Ballydoyle star becomes the first three-year-old to win five consecutive Group 1 races since the great Nijinsky in 1970, who also emanated from Ballydoyle, and he also put himself into the picture for the Emirates World Series. Now he shares the mantle as leader in that championship with the now-retired Dubai Millennium (GB), the brilliant Montjeu (Ire), Arlington Million winner Chester House and German champion Samum (Ger), with 12 points. Deputizing for Montjeu here, who instead runs in France today, Giant's Causeway had missed work last week, as the plan was to run next in the Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot Sept. 23. Yet he overcame that factor to win again at the highest level. As Apollo Victoria (Fr) (Sadler's Wells) roared off in front to make it a true test, the favourite was settled in second with Best Of The Bests (Ire) (Machiavellian) shading him on the outer. The crucial move came before the sharp turn into the short straight, as Giant's Causeway drove to the lead on the inside of the pacemaker. Jockey Frankie Dettori, aboard Best Of The Bests, attempted to get first run the other side of him and two furlongs out briefly took a lead, but the "iron horse" was in his element and he battled back, gradually shaking off the willing efforts of that rival as he powered towards the line. The winner was more than a length clear as Greek Dance arrived with a flourish under Johnny Murtagh. Owner Michael Tabor said, "I'm just over the moon--he's a very special horse. You think the end is going to come, but he keeps pulling out more-he's the iron horse. He obviously didn't see Greek Dance, because if he had he would have pulled away, and I just can't imagine having a tougher horse. I like to take one race at a time. The long-term target is the Breeders' Cup Classic, but obviously he'll need a race or two prior to that." Aidan O'Brien added, "He's a brilliant horse, and I'd say we're only at the tip of the iceberg with him. He's a possible for the Queen Elizabeth II S. now, and then the Breeders' Cup--he finds racing so easy." (Irish Champion S. chart, p2)

THERE'S NO TRIPPING THE LIGHT FANTASTIC

Fantastic Light (Rahy), the 3-5 favorite making his U.S. debut in the GI Man o'War S. at Belmont Park yesterday afternoon, found not a straw in his path as he rallied to win by a length over Ela Athena (GB) (Ezzoud {Ire}). "I decided to go outside down the backstretch and I felt the field was at his mercy the entire time." winning jockey Jerry Bailey said. "He finished up strong, and I don't think he was wound up very tight for this race. He'll only get better." The winner of the G3 Dubai Sheema Classic in March, Fantastic Light came back in June to be second by a neck behind Daliapour (Ire) in the June 9 G1 Coronation Cup. After finishing fifth to Giant's Causeway in the G1 Coral-Eclipse S. July 8, he was again second, this time to Montjeu (Ire) in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. Facing much less lofty company this time, the bay settled off soft early fractions, came with a three-wide sweep on the far turn and drove past Ela Athena in the final furlong. "We knew this horse was legitimate and would be very competitive," Tom Albertrani, assistant trainer to Saeed bin Suroor, said. "We'll run him in the Turf Classic [at Belmont, Oct. 7] next."

St. Leger cont.

Millenary (GB), sent off the 11-4 favourite, got the better of market rival Air Marshall (Ire), at 7-2, in a thrilling tussle at the end of Britain's final Classic of the year. Having won the G3 Chester Vase May 9, he was tried in the G1 Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby, June 4), but could finish only eighth there. Given a rest, he returned to beat Air Marshall in the G3 Gordon S. at Goodwood Aug. 1, when that horse had been eased slightly before the line. That form was confirmed fair and square over the extra two furlongs here, as Millenary responded to a bold ride from Richard Quinn to take the glory. Held up in mid-division as Rostropovich (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) assumed the early lead, he settled well to hold his position. Dalampour (Shernazar {Ire}) dragged his rider to the front of affairs, with Quinn still comfortably tucked away on the favorite and Air Marshall just in behind. Quinn decided to make his move 2 1/2 furlongs out and, as Dalampour had nothing more to give--the bit had slipped through his mouth--Air Marshall loomed the main danger. He got alongside the winner inside the final 150 yards, but he could not pass him: Millenary gave more the greater threat he felt. Forging away again inside the final 50 yards, he ran out a deserved winner, giving John Dunlop his third St Leger success. Matthew Jones, son of owner Neil, who was away in the United States, spoke of his delight, saying, "It was incredible and we're very happy--we always had a lot of big hopes for the horse, and it has been a wonderful day." Trainer John Dunlop added, "He's gone through the process and really done nothing wrong. You're hoping all the time, as he hadn't run beyond a mile and a half and he hadn't run against some of these contenders here, so you never know. I'm a great supporter of the St Leger, as I think it's a wonderful race. Today was a fascinating contest, and a very close race, and so it proved--it was very exciting. You need these days now and again, and more often than not. Long live the St Leger as a three-year-olds only race, over this distance." Said Quinn, "He was always travelling well, and if anything I ended up in front a bit too soon and he's idled, but I've picked him back up and he's rallied." Sir Michael Stoute said of Air Marshall's performance, "It was a great run--he was given a great ride and just got outbattled. He ran out of petrol and came to the end of his tether. They were two brave horses, but we were second again."

Caffe Latte ended her European stint with a Listed win in France last June, then finished 1999 in the U.S., notching seconds in the GII San Clemente H. over this course and in the GI Yellow Ribbon Invitational H. at Santa Anita before running a solid fourth in the inaugural GI Breeders' Cup "Disturf." After a five-month vacation, she started 2000 with wins in an optional claimer Apr. 6 and in the GII Santa Barbara H. Apr. 23, but failed to fire in the June 4 GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. and was given another break. Her return was not promising, however, as she finished a lackluster seventh in the Palomar H. Aug. 16. Favored here because she was coupled with the consistent Tout Charmant as the Stonerside Stable entry, the bay bided her time near the back of the pack for a mile, but came with a three-wide sweep on the final bend and finished full of run to catch her stablemate late in the lane and edge clear. "The whole key to this filly is that she needed the prep, but the real key was Brice Blanc," trainer Bob Baffert, who won this race with Tuzla (Fr) last year, said. "I believe he's one of the best turf riders around. He sits back and stays cool...that's the way she likes to run. She has one big kick and you just have to wait and wait and wait." Jockey Chris McCarron, aboard the runner-up, complained, "She ran too good to get beat. We had a perfect trip. She sailed out when I asked her and I couldn't believe somebody ran by her."

When the real Secret Status (A.P. Indv) didn't show up, this race was left wide open for an upset and New York-bred Critical Eye obliged. After posting back-toback allowance wins, one on turf and one in the slop, the bay filly finished an even fourth in the Gl Alabama S. at Saratoga last time out Aug. 19. Ignored here despite that promising showing, the longshot sat sixth as Plenty Of Light set a solid pace, made her move while three wide on the turn to join the leader and proved gamest in the drive, but just barely. "She has a tendency to wait or hang, but as long as someone runs with her, she'll keep going," winning trainer Scott Schwatz said, adding, "We might run her back here on New York Showcase Day in the Ticonderoga [Oct. 21] or we may just stop on her. She's developed into something special." Secret Status, sent off the 4-5 favorite after running second in the Alabama, trailed early and was never in the hunt, finishing sixth. "I spoke with [Pat Dayl and he said she just wasn't there," trainer Neil Howard said. "She had trained well leading up to the race. She still is a real nice filly and we don't want to get down on her after just one race. This horse could be due a rest after a race like this."

Superstar Leo is all speed, and that is what is required to win this race. She was too fast for anything at Royal Ascot in the G3 Norfolk S. June 21 and again in the Weatherbys Super Sprint July 22. Next time she finished five lengths runner-up to Minardi in the G1 Heinz 57 Pheonix S. Leopardstown Aug. 13, emerging with credit nonetheless after having had the worst of the draw. Here she returned to winning ways in style with a furiously fast display to make all and take her most important prize to date. Bouncing from the stalls, she quickly put daylight between herself and the chasing group, consisting of Joplin (Nureyev) and The Trader (Ire) (Selkirk), Romantic Myth (GB) (Mind Games {GB}) found the gaps on the far side and looked a danger, but it was short-lasted as the leader turned on the pressure again from the front. Maintaining her relentless gallop all the way to the line, she remained comfortably clear of the fast-finishing Misty Eyed. Trainer William Haggas will have to part company with the filly at the end of the season as her owners, Lael Stable, will send her to race in the United States next year. He said, "In the Heinz, we rode her wrong, and she had a bad draw--over five furlongs I'd take [Minardi] on any time. We will be very upset to lose her, but she'll do Mr. and Mrs. Jackson proud. She won't run in Britain again; if she is okay she possibly might run in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp [Oct. 1], as there's no point in running in anything other than a Group 1, and that's the only one." Ekraar, having failed in his attempt at Classic company when fourth in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas at Longchamp, May 14), has finally started to show just how good he is. Given time to come to himself after that test, he returned with a facile success in a Newbury conditions event in July, then stepped up to take the G3 Rose Of Lancaster S. at Haydock Aug. 12. Here he was produced by Marcus Tregoning to outclass his rivals for his third stakes success. Settled in second early as Gold Academy (Ire) (Royal Academy) bowled along in front, he was moved into the centre of the track by Richard Hills in search of better ground entering the straight. From there he took command before extending his advantage over his struggling rivals; never in danger, he strode clear under hands-and-heels riding for an impressive success. The winner may now go for the G1 Dubai Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 14, or G1 Prix de l'Arc Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 1. Tregoning said, "He's improved throughout the year and I'm delighted with him. He has shown he can now go on any ground. I know Sheikh Hamdan is very keen for him to have a crack at the Champion S., so we'll see. He is still in the Arc, but a lot can happen between now and then."

He loves these wet conditions and he just dominated today." The Craiglee was delayed for 20 minutes after multiple stakes-winning mare Ad Alta (NZ) (Kenfair {NZ}) died following an apparent heart attack while cantering around to the barriers. Jockey Leath Innes said the Group 1 winning four-year-old was trotting normally when she slowed and suddenly dropped.

EASY WIN FOR HIRE

G2 Theo Marks S. winner Hire (Aus) (Canny Lad {Aus}) is likely to incur a weight penalty for the G1 Epsom H. next month following his success at Sydney's Rosehill vesterday. Connections have warned they'll send the gelding to Melbourne if they feel TRB handicapper Mark Webbey is too heavy-handed. Runner-up in the Warwick S. Aug. 19, the classy four-year-old has Group wins including the G2 Royal Sovereign S. to his credit, but has yet to capture a Group 1. In a race where many of spring's main star contenders were resuming, favored Hire overcame a tardy beginning and won easily by 1 1/4 lengths from highly rated Landsighting (Aus) (Greig {NZ}) with Shogun Lodge (Aus) (Grand Lodge {USA}) a further 3/4 of a length away third. Hire's options include the Epsom, Sydney's major spring mile event at Randwick Oct. 2, with the weight-for-age G1 George Main S. at the same track on Sept. 23. With the weights for Epsom to be released today, trainer John Hawkes said he believes Hire is entitled to no more than 54kilograms, but Webbey says he "couldn't have been more impressive" and could get as much as 55.5 kilograms.
