#### MORE RECORDS FOR KEENELAND?

It is annually considered the world's biggest yearling auction, but this year the Keeneland September Yearling Sale is in fact bigger than ever. A record 4,650 horses have been catalogued for the sale, which is set to begin today and runs for 13 days through Saturday, Sept. 23. Sessions will begin at 10 a.m. each morning. With sales continuing to surge throughout the year 2000, many are expecting this year's sale to top last September's record gross of \$233,020,800 and average of \$77,390. New sale standards were also set at the Keeneland July Sale and at Saratoga, giving every indication that the feverish sales pace will reach new heights. New this year will be a series of online auctions at www.keeneland.com. The three sessions, set for Sept. 16, 20 and 25, include horses that did not attract their reserve price tags during the live sessions.

#### Optimism Abounds...

The optimism has resonated to consignors, farms and buyers worldwide. Bill Farish of Lane's End said, "We have very high expectations for the September Sale. The business is strong, and we've got our biggest group of horses ever [230]. The industry is really strong right now, so there's a lot of optimism. The purses are increasing all the time, and there are a lot of new buyers. It's really a great time to be in the business." Lane's End was one of the top consignors (by gross sales) during the 1999 September Sale. Behind only Taylor Made Sales Agency, Eaton Sales and Mill Ridge Farm, the farm sold 85 horses for a total of \$12,404,800.

#### More Is Better...

The 2000 Keeneland September catalogue includes more entries and will undoubtedly last longer than it ever has before. Some of the leading sires represented in the September Sale include Mr. Prospector, A.P. Indy, Broad Brush, Danehill, Deputy Minister, Gone West, Kingmambo, Saint Ballado, Seattle Slew, Seeking the Gold, Storm Cat, Theatrical and Unbridled. Mr. Prospector, who had seven yearlings fetch an average price of \$1,477,142 back in July, will have nine sons and daughters in the September auction. Also represented in the sale will be offspring from some promising young sires, including Boston Harbor, Forest Wildcat, Hennessy, Pulpit, Siphon (Brz), and Unbridled's Song. Recent graduates of Keeneland's September Sale are 1999 champions Anees, Chilukki and Victory Gallop.

#### **RIVIERA'S ATTO REVERIE**

Edmund A. Gann's Riviera (Fr) (Kris {GB}) was a bit mulish about loading into the gate and proved equally stubborn down the stretch as he fought off the stiff challenge of Arkadian Hero (Trempolino) by the narrowest of margins in the GI Atto Mile at Woodbine yesterday. The six-year-old chestnut had never been worse than second in eight U.S. starts and had gone off as the favorite in each of those efforts. Returning from a sixmonth layoff, he was beaten a neck by Conserve in the GII Firecracker Breeders' Cup at Churchill July 4, then was awarded victory via DQ in the restricted Wickerr H. at Del Mar Aug. 4. He was sent off as the fifth choice here in the presence of top West Coast miler Ladies Din (Din's Dancer) and Godolphin's Muhtathir (GB) (Elmaamul), winner of the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville Aug. 13. Reluctant to enter his outside post, Riviera edged inside after the stalls opened and was allowed to settle into stride by jockey John Velazquez, who had just returned after suffering a broken collarbone at Saratoga. Six wide as the field turned for home, he struck the front in midstretch and was joined by the late-charging Arkadian Hero, but refused to be passed and got his nose down on the line. "Once he got into the gate, he was fine," Velazquez said. "It was a perfect trip. When I pulled him out at the 5/16 pole, he really responded. Bobby [trainer Frankel] told me not to worry about being a little wide. I followed the Godolphin horse [Muhtathir] and when he went, I went. Once he got to the lead, he started waiting. When the other horse came to him, it made him fire back." The GI Breeders' Cup Mile [Churchill, Nov. 4] may be next for Riviera. "He'll go back to Hollywood," said Frankel. "He's Breeders' Cup eligible and I hope we'll go there. I've won three million dollar races in three weeks (after Chester House-GI Arlington Million and Skimming-GI Pacific Classic]. It's fun. It's a lot of fun. I don't smile much, but this keeps me smiling." Arkadian Hero dwelt at the start and seemingly lost all chance, but rallied gamely in the stretch. "He lost the race leaving the gate," said jockey Jamie Spencer. "Obviously, he's the best horse." Atto Mile chart p2

Gaviola, giving away from six to 10 pounds as the highweight, took command in the stretch en route to her first Grade I victory, her sixth straight visit to the winner's circle. After opening 2000 with a third in the GIII Sweetest Chant at Gulfstream, the gray filly rattled off her next five, including Saratoga's GII Lake Placid H. Aug. 21 in front-running fashion. Content to let Good Game (Fly Till Dawn) cut out the early fractions, the crowd's choice sat just off that filly until the far turn. As they entered the stretch, Gaviola took over, opened a clear lead and was not threatened by French invader Flawly, who closed stoutly from the back of the pack for the place spot. "I thought I would be on the lead, but would let someone else go early if they wanted to," said winning jockey Jerry Bailey. "She was a little eager in the Lake Placid, but had no problem rating today. The pace was moderate down the backstretch and she made her way into the race. She just took off at the top of the stretch." A trip to Kentucky may be next for the nation's top sophomore turf filly, according to winning trainer Billy Turner. "If she comes out okay, we'll go to the Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup [GI, Keeneland, 10/8]," he said. "Right now, I would have to say that to get us to the Breeders' Cup, they would have to put a hook around me and drag me there. But times change."

Volvoreta, at odds of 11-2, gained her most important success to date by taking the honours from Reve d'Oscar and recording the fastest-ever winning time in this race in the process. She looked very impressive when taking the G3 Prix Penelope at Saint-Cloud Apr. 12 from that horse, on that occasion handing her a sixlength thrashing. She took her unbeaten record into the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes (French Oaks, June 4), but lost it when finishing three lengths behind Egyptband. Here she returned to winning ways to reverse that form and confirm the result of the Prix Penelope. She now can stake her claim as the best middle-distance filly in Europe after leaving G1 Epsom Oaks winner Love Divine (GB) (Diesis {GB}) and Sadler's Flag (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) trailing in her wake. She also gave Argentinian trainer Carlos Lerner a career-best success. Held up in the rear early as Green Image (Fr) (Green Tune (Fr)) fulfilled her role as pacemaker, she was settled and travelling easily. Love Divine assumed the lead in the straight with two furlongs remaining, but she failed to go away from Volvoreta and Egyptband, who were finishing with a flourish, while Reve d'Oscar was also making up ground. As they drove to the line, Michael Kinane's mount had all the answers and was too strong for the runner-up, taking the prize with something in hand. Said the winning trainer, "This is just fantastic for a small trainer like me. My first-ever Group 1 race, on such a day, in the Prix Vermeille, is a big thrill. We gave her a rest after the Prix de Diane, where she had a quarter crack going into the race, and had it not been the Diane, she would not have run that day. That is why she shortened her stride after making the running and had to settle for second. She proved her great quality here, with a strong pace and a great ride from Michael Kinane. The Vermeille was her primary target and now that she has won it we can think about something else. We will decide soon on the Arc, but it is very possible." Kinane added, "She's done it very well, and there was loads of pace which suited her. She picked up nicely and she's a very sweet filly. She has a chance in the Arc--a filly that can finish like that always has a chance." Volvoreta bested the previous mark, set by Magic Night (Fr) in 1991, by 1 1/2 seconds; that filly went on to be second to Suave Dancer in the Arc.

A year ago, Montjeu and Michael Kinane began their partnership with a win in the G2 Prix Niel. John Hammond's colt had to work hard in the final quarter of a mile in that test to catch the bold Bienamado, which he did in a flying finish. Here, albeit in far lesser company, he put on an altogether different performance, showing what a year's racing and training can do for a horse of his calibre. He was kept in last place as Stop By (Ire) (Be My Guest) cut out a suitable pace until Kinane thought it right to let him do his job. This happened with under 200 yards remaining, as Commander Collins could give no more, and Crillon was running at the one pace only. With a shake of the reins, Montjeu disposed of them all in a few strides. Now he will defend his crown in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 1 as the odds-on favourite. Said Kinane, "John [Hammond] said that he missed a bit of work, and the decision not to run in the Irish Champion S. was probably the right one as he was probably 85 percent today. He'll progress nicely from here to the Arc--I was happy with him. This year I've felt that he's a better horse, as he has a lot more pace. His maturity has come through this year--he's an exceptional horse. Everything has to run smoothly from now until the Arc, but if it does I'll be looking forward to him." Hammond added, "He had a minor ankle problem, but that is behind us now and we are happy to have this race behind us. He did exactly what we wanted by winning this race easily and all we have to do now is keep our fingers crossed and hope that he stays healthy up to the Arc and is able to run his race."

The winner of five stakes races now, and two Derbies, he looks an outstanding prospect for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 1. After wrestling the June 10 G1 Epsom Derby from Sakhee in the final furlong, he was stunningly impressive next time in the G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh July 2. That day he had nine lengths to spare over the runner-up, but instead of capitalizing on his brilliance by making hay then, the decision was made to rest him for a campaign geared solely towards the Arc. The colt tracked stablemate Raypour (Ire) (Barathea {Ire}) until easing to the front with a furlong and a half remaining, then barely turned on the pressure to win by eight lengths, proving the decision to give him a break categorically right. The only worry for connections may be that he did not have a proper race after his layoff. His Highness The Aga Khan said, "The race went according to plan. Sinndar needs a consistent, even pace, and this is what he had here. Sinndar won over very heavy going last year at two, he handled the course perfectly today and whatever the conditions in three weeks' time, it should not be a problem to him." John Oxx added, "This horse has never stopped improving all year and I have to say that I should be amazed at his performance today, but I am not. He is a pretty fit horse now and we will not have to do too much with him until the race, just keep him happy and fresh and cross our fingers. He handled the course well, but I had no worries about that as a horse who handles Epsom can handle any course." The winning time was a 10th of a second faster than that of Volvoreta's in the Prix Vermeille, which itself was a race record.

Walkslikeaduck belied his name here, striding clear in deep stretch to set a new stakes record and equal the course record. The dark bay colt broke his maiden over the Hollywood main in May and tried the turf two starts later, winning a Hollywood allowance by three lengths July 15. He finished a troubled third in his last out, beaten just a length, to Designed for Luck (Rahy) and Schotis (Freedom Cry {GB}) in the restricted Relaunch S. over this course Aug. 18. Stepping up to graded company here, he settled in midpack as Purely Cozzene whipped through fractions of :22 4/5 and :45 1/5, but advanced along the inside through the far turn and challenged the pacesetter from the outside. They raced in tandem to midstretch, where Walkslikeaduck kicked clear in winning his first black-type event. Purely Cozzene held well for second, while the lone filly, Euro invader New Story, delivered a strong late punch for the show spot. "I'm very happy, happy for the owners," said winning trainer Patrick Gallagher, his first major stakes success at Del Mar. "The other day when he ran in the Relaunch, we thought if he'd win or run good we'd run in the Derby. Eddie [jockey Delahoussaye] thought he had enough trouble [that day] maybe cost him the race, so that was a big factor in making the decision to try our luck here. He's come around a lot since that race. Today was 'D-Day,' Delahoussaye and the Duck." Delahoussay was winning his fourth Del Mar Derby. "I knew my horse would come with his late kick, and the script was perfect," he said.

Outclassed when 10th in the GI Beverly D. in her latest effort Aug. 19, the dark bay was getting her favorite jockey back in the irons for the Canadian H. The four-year-old filly showed good speed to take command of the race early on and led past every pole to score a relatively easy victory.
