BELONG TO ME FILLY TOPS AT KEENELAND

The top price at yesterday's fourth session of the 13day Keeneland September Yearling Sale in Lexington, Kentucky was brought by hip number 1100, a filly by Belong to Me out of the Seattle Slew mare Lassie Connection. The dark bay yearling was purchased for \$600,000 by Frank Mansell and, in a familiar refrain at these sales, was consigned by Lane's End, agent. "I'm really not that surprised at the price that she brought," said Lane's End owner William Farish. "She is a very nice filly and with the pedigree that she has, I thought that she would bring a good price. That family has been a foundation mare for our farm, without doubt. It keeps producing stallion after stallion after stallion." Of his farm's September success, Farish added, "It's been beyond our wildest expectations. But I think the market shows that there is plenty of money out there for the good-looking horses with solid pedigrees. I think it will keep going, too. I think it will be strong right through the weekend. There are still a lot of people here and they are looking for horses." The second highest price of the day was also for a filly. Hip number 1266, a daughter of Honour and Glory--Trust in Me (Procida) brought a final bid of \$550,000 from B. Wayne Hughes. The dark bay was consigned by Blackburn Farm, agent for Longleaf Pine Farm. The sale's fifth session will begin today at 10 a.m.

KID TAKES ON FOUR IN WOODWARD

Leading Horse of the Year candidate Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo) faces four rivals in his attempt to win a fourth straight graded event in Saturday's GI Woodward S. at Belmont Park. The four-year-old colt, already booked to stand at Lane's End for a fee of \$100,000 next season, is coming off victories in the June 11 GII Brooklyn, July 4 GII Suburban and Aug. 6 GI Whitney. "I've never had one like Lemon Drop Kid, he's exceptional," said Hall of Fame trainer Scotty Schulhofer. "He's the easiest and best horse I've trained. It's going to be tough to replace him." California invader Skimming (Nurevey) will seek his second straight Grade I victory Saturday. The four-year-old Bobby Frankel trainee won the Aug. 26 GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar in his last trip to the post. "We thought he could be a nice horse, but we didn't realize he could do what he did," Frankel admitted. "I'm hoping it wasn't just Del Mar, but it might have been." In addition to the Classic, Skimming captured the Aug. 6 GIII San Diego over the Del Mar strip. "He's trained well at Belmont. He's just got to come out of there and do his running," Frankel added. Behrens (Pleasant Colony), second to Dubai Millennium (GB) in the G1 Dubai World Cup in March, hasn't won since taking the Feb. 26 Gl Gulfstream Park H. Most recently, the six-year-old multi-millionaire has finished second to Lemon Drop Kid in the Suburban and third to that rival after a troubled trip in the Whitney. "That was yesterday and the Woodward is Saturday," trainer H. James Bond said of the Whitney. "He's been doing great since the Whitney."

GODOLPHIN SEEKS THIRD LEGER Kayf Tara (GB) carried the famous Godolphin silks under the wire first in the last two runnings of the G1 Irish St Leger, but with the recent retirement of that talented runner. hopes for a Dubai three-peat in Saturday's renewal of the race at The Curragh rest with Mutafaweq (Silver Hawk). The four-year-old is no Leger novice, winning last year's English St Leger by two lengths before being named high weighted three-year-old at over 14 furlongs. The field of eight also includes the Aga Khan's Kativkha (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}). The four-year-old Irish-bred filly won the Ballycullen S. over this course and distance in August. Michael Tabor will be represented by two runners on Saturday--Lermontov (Alleged), second in last year's G1 Racing Post Trophy and Rostropovich (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), owned in partnership with Susan Magnier, who ran seventh in last Saturday's English St Leger. GEIGER COUNTER EUTHANIZED Arrowfield stallion Geiger Counter (Mr. Prospector), the sire of multiple group winners Gold Guru (Aus) and Nuclear Debate, was euthanized yesterday at the age of 18. He was suffering from cancer of the stomach. Geiger Counter was standing at Chatswood Stud in Victoria for a fee of A\$16.500 this season and had covered around 50 mares. He is sire of 42 stakes winners with progeny earnings of more than A\$37 million standing in dual hemispheres since 1992. Three-yearold champion of 1998, Gold Guru was Geiger Counter's best Australian representative, winning the G1 AJC Australian Derby, the G1 Ranvet S. and the G1 VRC Australian Guineas. He is also the sire of South African champion Rarotonga Treaty (Aus) and stakes winners Minegold (Aus), Close Your Eyes (Aus), Stella Artois (Aus), Morphy (NZ) and Smytzer's Trish (Aus). Among his American graded stakes winners are Meter Maid and Could Be. "He has been a great horse, but he was having trouble and was losing weight and vets recommended we euthanize," said Arrowfield Stud chairman John Messara. "We stopped shuttling him several years ago and he was covering a reduced book this year as he was 18."

FILLY FOR PASEANA Two-time champion older mare Paseana (Arg) (Ahmad {Arg}--Pasiflin {Arg}, by Flintham) has produced her first foal, a filly by Lode, at Dr. Ignacio Pavlovsky Sr.'s Haras San Ignacio de Loyola in Argentina. The 13-year-old Paseana has a history of troubled foalings and the healthy filly represents two years of effort by Dr. Diego I Ayerza. An Eclipse champion in 1992 and 1993, Paseana won the 1992 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff as well as nine other Grade I races.

VINERY STALLIONS TO ENGLAND Two Vinery stallions will return to England to stand the 2001 season. Cheveley Park Stud in Newmarket has agreed to stand Loup Sauvage (Riverman--Louveterie, by Nureyev) next year for a fee of £5,000. The six-year-old stallion captured the 1998 G1 Prix D'Ispahan, was second in the 1997 G1 Dubai Poule d'essai de Poulains and G1 Dubai Champion S. and was third in the 1997 G1 Irish Derby and 1998 G1 Dubai World Cup. He stood his first season at stud at Vinery in 1999. He stood last season for a fee of \$10,000. "Loup Sauvage is an exciting stallion to be associated with," said Cheveley Park managing director Chris Richardson. "Not only was he a very talented racehorse, but also, being from the Never Bend line, he fills a void left by the likes of Mill Reef and Shirley Heights (GB)." Kern Lillingston Association and Warrender Associates have purchased Mister Baileys (GB) (Robellino--Thimblerigger {GB}, by Sharpen Up {GB}) and the nine-year-old stallion will stand the 2001 season at Chris Harper's Whitsbury Manor Stud in Hampshire. The 1994 English 2000 Guineas winner will be re-syndicated in 2001. "We are sure he will be very well received by European breeders and we have great expectations for a very successful future standing in the country where he belongs," said Lincoln Collins, a partner in Kern Lillingston. Mister Baileys's first crop of foals are three-year-olds and include stakes winner Cool Ashlee. He stood at Vinery last season for \$7,500.

In spite a lacklustre last-place finish in yesterday's Shannon S. at Syndney's Rosehill racetrack, Might And Power (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ})'s connections will press on with a G1 George Main S. start at Randwick on Sept. 23. Nine lengths behind the winning Al Mansour (Aus), the dual horse of the year's performance didn't worry jockey Jim Cassidy. "His action was much better than his last start and he is getting fitter," Cassidy said, adding that trainer Jack Denham wanted the former front-runner settled back in the field. "Give him one more run, which he'll need, then the run after that you'll see him do something." Owner Nick Moraitis said: "I haven't come this far to turn back now. He didn't shirk his task and racing back in the field isn't what he's used to, but it's the way he's had to be ridden."

A DIRECT EXPRESS TAKES HILL STAKES

Injury-plagued Pasta Express (Aus) (Rigoletto {Aus}) cemented his G1 Metropolitan H. credentials with a neck win in yesterday's G2 Hill S. at Rosehill. Overcoming a fractured fetlock at two and suffering a hairline fracture to his cannon bone as an early four-year-old, the John Anderson-bred gelding rewarded his patient trainer, Paul Cave, who is traditionally a pointer to Melbourne spring carnival winners. Sitting one from the lead, Pasta Express got up to fend off a fast-finishing Pravda (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) with Padfoot Charlie (Aus) (Chimes Square {Aus}) landing third with a powerful charge from the rear. Pasta Express, now six, has nine wins including a last start G2 Chelmsford S. win, the highlight of Cave's training career. The A\$600,000 Metropolitan H. is at Randwick on Oct. 7 after which Cave will decide whether to take Pasta Express to Melbourne for the Caulfield and Melbourne Cups.

UNWORLDLY PROVES STAR QUALITY

Unworldly (Aus) (Quest For Fame {GB}) added the G2 Tea Rose S. to a record that stands at four wins from five starts yesterday at Rosehill and owners Jack and Bob Ingham hope she'll balance their score. The pair have 36 Group 1 wins since trainer John Hawkes took over Crown Lodge about five years ago, but only five of those have come from fillies. The daughter of the Danehill mare Spirit (Aus), Unworldly is widely regarded as this season's potential star and she was sent out the odds-on favourite after winning the G3 Furious S. in her last outing. Beating a speedy Dynamic Love (Aus) (Brave Warrior {Aus}) by three-quarters of a length with Lady Mulan (NZ) (Bigstone) the best of eight others, five lengths back, Unworldly clocked: 34.17 for her last 600m. In each of her wins, she has hardly been extended, but Hawkes has typically downplayed the filly's prospects. "There's no doubt she's a very nice filly who finds the line well. But she hasn't run against top company yet. She isn't beating much in Sydney," Hawkes said. He remains non-commital over whether she will start in the G1 Epsom H. at Randwick on Oct. 2 after she received just 47kg for the race, with the G1 Flight S. for fillies over the same trip on the same day.

INAFLURY RETIRED

Inaflury (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) has been retired after suffering a leg injury in a track accident at Caulfield. She started just once this campaign for new trainer Jim Conlon, when fifth in the Memsie S. The five-year-old mare's last win was 1999's John Feehan S. at Moonee Valley on Sept. 11, before her Caulfield Cup third. Conlan said Inaflury, winner of the G1 Thousand Guineas at three, split her off hind heel after kicking out at a fence.

SUNLINE EARLY FAVORITE

Sunline (NZ) (Desert Sun {USA}) is the early 1-4 favourite for Saturday's G2 John F Feehan S. at Moonee Valley chasing her 20th win at her 27th outing. Trainer Trevor McKee required stitches to his hand after the mare, notorious for her short temper, bit him. The five-year-old worked solo Thursday over 1200m at Flemington, running 1:20, with her last 600m in :39.4.
