KEENELAND SETS NEW RECORD

In just the fifth day of the 13-day auction, the Keeneland September Yearling Sale has grossed \$238,142,500, surpassing the record set over the course of 11 days last year of \$233,020,800. Spurred by a \$950,000 Saint Ballado colt, the session average was a solid \$65,778, up from last year's average of \$58,650. Consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency, Hip 1443 was purchased by Eugene Melnyk. The session topper, a Canadian-bred colt, represented a pinhooking score, having been purchased as a weanling for \$62,000 by Phillip F. McCarthy at the Keeneland November sale. A son of the stakes-placed Jeannie the Meanie (Rare Performer), he is a half brother to stakes winner L. B. on Tour (Tour d'Or). Highest-priced filly on the day was Hip 1573, a bay by Spinning World from the consignment of Ashview Farm. Purchased by Jared Co. LLC, she is closely related to champion Peintre Celebre (Nureyev), as her dam, Scivolina (Slew o'Gold), is a half sister to the Arc winner's dam Peinture Bleue (Alydar). Taylor Made led all consignors with receipts totalling \$6,530,000. Currently, the 2000 sale average is \$192,361, a 37 percent increase over the \$140,367 average at this point last year. The median price was slightly down yesterday--\$38,000 to \$40,000 last year--but overall remains well ahead of 1999's numbers, with the current median for 2000 at \$95,000 as compared to \$73,500 last year. With eight days remaining, the sale continues today at 10:00 a.m.

CINQ POUR SALAMANDRE

A small but select field of five will go postward in the G1 Prix de la Salamandre Dinard Grand Hotel Barriere at Longchamp this afternoon. Invariably won by one of the season's crack juveniles, this prize has been taken by some outstanding thoroughbreds in its time en route to larger things, both on the racecourse and at stud. In the '70s, it was won by Blushing Groom (Fr) and Irish River (Fr), two formidable stallions of recent times. The next decade saw Miswaki, Miesque and Machiavellian take this prize. In the '90s, the race seemed to have fallen into a state of grace with winners such as Hector Protector, Arazi, Zafonic, Pennekamp, Xaar, Aljabr and Giant's Causeway. **Bad As I Wanna Be (Ire)** (Common Grounds {GB}) will look to enhance his reputation after demolishing a competitive field by six lengths in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville Aug. 20. He is still on offer at 25-1 with William Hill for the 2000 Guineas. That seems to stem from the fact that he raced up the stands' rail, where the ground was considered to be faster. However, his trainer is of the opinion that he prefers softer conditions, and Gerald Mosse, who rode him that day, said that he could have broken the track record with slightly more pressure. Add to that the fact that the third that day, Noverre, has since given weight away and a beating to the G2 Champagne S. field at Doncaster last Friday, and you have a colt of considerable ability. "He's a lovely horse, and it's a day we're looking forward to," said trainer Brian Meehan. "Last time [in the Morny] there was definitely some sort of advantage on the stands' rail, but he's gone away, and recorded a fast time. The one I fear most is **Wooden Doll** (Woodman)." That horse was recorded a smooth success in the Listed Prix Yacowlef at Deauville Aug. 1 on her first start, and if she has improved she will surely figure here. With the withdrawal of Listed Acomb S. (York Aug. 22) winner Hemingway (Ire), trainer Aidan O'Brien relies on **Honours List** (Danehill) and **King Charlemagne** (Nureyev) here. The former has already won the G3 Railway S. at The Curragh, while the latter took his Leopardstown maiden impressively last Saturday. *Field, more previews, p4*

A maiden after two juvenile starts, Danger Over started the season with a conditions race win at Maisons-Laffitte Mar. 21, and followed up with victory in the Listed Prix Djebel at the same course Apr. 14. He then secured the runner up spot in both the G3 Prix de Ris-Orangis at Deauville July 11 and in the G3 Prix de Meautry at the same picturesque track Aug. 27. He had the beating of most of his opponents on form and as a result was sent off as the 4-5 favourite. He did not let his supporters down as he won with something in hand from the fast-finishing Khasayl to record his first Group win. Danger Over was positioned in a close second as Terroir (Ire) (Fairy King) led. Thierry Thulliez asked for Danger Over's effort from the quarter mile marker and momentum carried them to the lead soon after. Thulliez kept his mount up to required amount of work inside the final eighth and the pair held on well as Khasayl closed close home. Khasayl was reserved in rear for the most part of the race, but ran on well to be closest at the finish. Jezebel's cross-Channel sojourn was not in vain, proving best of the remainder in third.

Arctic Owl has always promised to win a race of this stature, without ever producing the goods when it mattered. In 1998 he was at the top of his game when taking the G2 Prix Kergorlay at Deauville and the G3 Jockey Club Cup at Newmarket. Since then he has collected one stakes race, last year's G3 Henry S. at Sandown over an extended two miles, while showing that he has the pace for a mile and a half. This was evident in perhaps his best run to date, when a length runner-up to Craigsteel (GB) in the G2 Princess Of Wales' S. at Newmarket last July. He advertised his wellbeing last time when denying the supremely tough Murghem (Ire) by a head in the Shergar Cup Classic at Ascot Aug. 12 over twelve furlongs, and he may find this distance ideal. Katiykha is an interesting contender, having taken the Listed Ballycullen S. here Aug. 26, and the Listed Victor McCalmont Memorial S. at Gowran Park June 7. The former was over this trip, and although she is taking a considerable step up in company here, she created a favourable impression that day. Mark Johnston's Yavana's Pace chased home Kayf Tara (GB) when runner-up in this last year, and if anything the seven-year-old is even better this season. He was only beaten 1 1/2 lengths by stablemate Fruits Of Love in the G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot June 23 over a mile and a half, and a strict reading of that form puts him up with some of the best older horses in Europe. One of the horses that finished behind him that day was Mutafaweq, who has since gone on to win the G1 Deutschland-Preis at Dusseldorf July 23. He was disappointing when unplaced in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden Sept. 3 behind Samum (Ger), but if he is back to his best he should figure here. The four-year-old bay will seek to add another Leger to his resume, following last year's Doncaster triumph.

Riboletta, who has dominated her West Coast foes, carries a four-race win streak on her first trip to Belmont. The five-year-old mare won the GI Milady Breeders' Cup H. in May, the GI Vanity H. in June and the GII C L Hirsch H. in August. Lu Ravi hasn't been beaten since finishing second to Heritage of Gold in the GI Apple Blossom in April. The five-year-old bay defeated champion Silverbulletday by a head to take the July 4 GII Molly Pitcher Breeders' Cup H. before winning the July 23 GIII Delaware H. in her most recent start. She has hit the board in all 14 of her starts at this distance. Country Hideaway has been beaten only once in five Belmont starts. She was most recently a late-closing second in the Aug. 20 GI Ballerina H. Houdini's Honey, who began her career in England, has been first or second in four U.S. outings. The filly stormed home an impressive 8 1/2-length come-from-behind winner in a July 22 Belmont allowance in her last start.

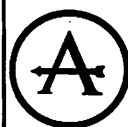

Altibr, second in last year's G2 Budweiser International S., was gamely closing the gap on the impressive Hap in the Aug. 26 GII Fourstardave and came up just 3/4-length shy of the win. **White Heart** rallied determinedly to get up for a neck win in the May 29 GI Whittingham H. and was flying late to finish fourth behind Silic (Fr) and Ladies Din in the June 18 GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile. **Sardaukar**, Group 1-placed in France in 1999, was second at this distance in the July 4 GII American H. at Hollywood before winning an Aug. 5 Del Mar optional claimer last time out.

The very consistent **Caller One** has lost only one of five starts this season. Aside from a fifth-place showing in the one-mile GIII Derby Trial in April, the bay sophomore was a 10-length winner of Turfway's Hansel, a four-length winner of Keeneland's GIII Lafayette and an easy winner of Hollywood's May 29 Laz Barrera S. and Calder's July 15 Carry Back S. **Millencolin** began his 2000 campaign with a Churchill allowance win at this distance in June and he returned to sprinting to finish a game third behind More Than Ready in the GI King's Bishop at Saratoga last time out Aug. 26. **Personal First** comes into this race off back-to-back wins at the distance. He was a 7 1/2-length victor in Ellis Park allowance company before finishing three lengths the best in the Aug. 4 GIII Amsterdam at Saratoga.

Hurricane Floyd was fourth in the G2 Gimcrack S. at York Aug. 23 behind Bannister (GB), but connections may have been disappointed, such was the pre-race confidence there. In that event, he was denied a run at a crucial stage, and he was beaten by only a length and a half. Previous to that he had brushed that winner aside in a Newmarket maiden, where Eminence (Ire) was third. As that horse reappeared to run Hemingway (Ire) to a length and a quarter in the Listed Acomb S. at York Aug. 22, a reproduction of that form may be enough to take this. He faces **Bouncing Bowdler**, a winner of the Listed Roses S. at the same meeting (Aug. 24), and Mark Johnston's colt is progressing all the time. If her speed lasts over this extended six furlongs, **Misty Eyed** would merit respect as the winner of the G3 Molecomb S. at Goodwood Aug. 4, where she beat Bouncing Bowdler by a length and a quarter. 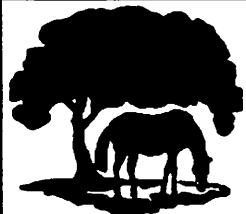

Named Pelcam, the bay colt was presented by Soc. Allevamento Besnate and fetched L185,000,000 from Bullard, acting on behalf of Ettore Landi, who will send the colt to Newmarket trainer Chris Wall. The top-priced filly, at L120,000,000, was Agricola Patrizia's Fame And Fortune, a daughter of In The Wings (GB) out of Fourth Of July (GB). The buyer was Allevamento Nuova Sbarra.
