RIBOLETTA'S ROUSING RUFFIAN

Aaron and Marie Jones' Riboletta (Brz) (Roi Normand) took her show on the road and came away with a sparkling triumph which made her a millionaire in the GI Ruffian H. at Belmont Park vesterday. Already confirmed as the West Coast's top distaffer, the bay mare dusted her Ruffian rivals with ease and laid claims to national superiority with her fifth straight trip to the winner's circle. "She had some questions to answer today and she did it rather easily," said winning jockey Chris McCarron. "Every time I ride this mare, I look forward more and more to taking on Beautiful Pleasure and Heritage of Gold." Riboletta started her skein with a seven-length score in the GII Hawthorne H. at Hollywood May 7 before annexing the GI Milady May 28 and the GI Vanity June 25, the latter by 5 1/2 lengths. Given a brief freshening, she returned to take the GII Clement L. Hirsch at Del Mar Aug. 12 by "only" 1 1/2 lengths after her saddle slipped slightly. The Belmont bettors respected her record by sending her off as the even-money favorite here. Away smoothly from post three, she went up and vied with Country Hideaway (Seeking the Gold) through easy fractions of :23 4/5 and :47. Taking command as they turned for home, Riboletta shrugged off a bid from Lu Ravi (A.P. Indy) and shifted into another gear, opening up at will under scant urging from her pilot. "I didn't even touch her in the stretch," McCarron said. "I just waved the whip at her and she took off." Her conditioner, Eduardo Inda, agreed with that assessment. "I thought the race set up perfectly," Inda remarked. "We've always know she has a lot of early speed. Lu Ravi has speed too, but not the speed of Riboletta. She changed her leads and just exploded after that. It's just like she does in California." The GI Beldame (Belmont, Oct. 14, \$750,000, 9f) is the next likely target for the Brazilian bombshell, where she is could run into Beautiful Pleasure. "The Beldame should be a good race, but I'll still have to talk to the owners before anything is definite," Inda continued. She is not nominated to the Breeders' Cup, but has more than earned the supplementary fee and would certainly take a lot of beating at Churchill Downs. Fellow Californian Gourmet Girl (Cee's Tizzy), second to Riboletta in the Hirsch, filled the same spot here as well. "I thought she ran very well," said her triner, Pico Perdomo. "It's unfortunate we had to run into a mare like Riboletta."

KID KING IN WOODWARD

Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo) survived a compelling stretch-long battle with Behrens (Pleasant Colony) to register a narrow victory in yesterday's GI Woodward S. at Belmont Park, his second consecutive Grade I win. Undefeated since a third-place finish in the GI Pimlico Special in May, the four-year-old won the GII Brooklyn H. by 7 1/2 June 11, the GII Suburban H. by 2 1/2 and the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga by two lengths. The lead changed hands three times in the opening two furlongs as first Ecton Park (Forty Niner), followed by Behrens up the inside and Pacific Classic winner Skimming (Nurevey) alternated on the front end. Jockey Jerry Bailey sent Behrens to the lead along the wood entering the far turn, but was joined midway on the turn by a four-wide Lemon Drop Kid as Skimming began a steady retreat. Like Ali and Frazier, the two slugged it out to the wire, neither giving an ounce of ground and Lemon Drop Kid prevailed in the end by the narrowest of margins. Gander (Cormorant) closed well on the outside to finish a clear third. "Once he gets his head in front, you're going to have a hard time getting by him," commented winning conditioner Scotty Schulhofer. "This horse does everything he has to in order to win. It's been a combination of maturity, blinkers and (jockey) Edgar Prado." Prado, who replaced Jose Santos in the irons this past April, was impressed not only with the effort from his horse, but also the runner up. "I've got to give credit to Behrens," Prado said. "He was real tough to get by and he's an old warrior. My horse just won't let anyone pass once he's in front." The winner has now won a Grade I race at Belmont Park in each of his three years on the racetrack, the GI Futurity in 1998, and the Belmont S. last year. Lemon Drop Kid will make one final appearance in the Big Apple in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup Oct. 14, before making his last start in the Breeders' Cup Classic Nov. 4. And as for year-end honors, Schulhofer added, "In my mind, he's Horse of the Year, but he'll do whatever it takes to get it. If he's got to win two more races, then he will." BALLADO COLT MAKES A MILLION The number of seven-figure horses sold at this year's Keeneland September Yearling Sales rose yesterday to 28 when Eugene Melnyk went to \$1.1 million for a colt by Saint Ballado. Hip number 1992, the first foal from Stephanie's Road (Strawberry Road (Aus)), was consigned to the sale by Taylor Made Sales Agency and was the fourth horse purchased for \$1 million or more by the native of Barbados. Melnyk also accounted for the second-highest priced lot of the session when he purchased hip 1963 for \$600,000, a colt by Unbridled's Song--Sensational Eyes (Roman Majesty), also from the consignment of Taylor Made. Madeleine Paulson was the successful bidder on the top filly of the afternoon, a filly consigned to the sale by her Brookside Farms with Lane's End as agent. By Theatrical (Ire) out of the unaced mare Capre (Seattle Slew), Mrs. Paulson topped the bidding at \$275,000. Keeneland reported 304 horses sold for gross receipts of \$14,835,000 and an average of \$48,801, down slightly from 1999. The overall average for the first six days of the sale remains ahead by 32 percent. The sale continues this morning at 10 a.m. (Statistics, p8)

Australia's Melbourne Cup in November now beckons for the five men from North Devon who form The Owl Society, owners of Arctic Owl, who finally secured his first G1 success, forcing Yavana's Pace into a second straight runner-up finish in this race. The winner of the G2 Prix Kergolay and G3 Jockey Club Cup in 1998 and the G3 Bonusprint Henry II S. in 1999, Arctic Owl had failed to score this year until winning the Shergar Cup Classic over a mile and a half at Ascot Aug. 12 on his last start. Settled towards the rear of the field as Lermontov (Alleged) led from Yavana's Pace and Little Rock (GB) (Warning {GB}), Arctic Owl moved smoothly through to join Yavana's Pace in the lead at the quartermile marker. From there onwards, the two geldings had the race between them, with Arctic Owl edging clear at the furlong marker to go and score comfortably. His trainer James Fanshawe was being represented by his first winner in Ireland and said, "The horse deserved this and I was very pleased to see the rain. These older horses are fun to train. The Melbourne Cup is a big possibility now. The owners are keen to go, but it's a long way to go and one hell of a risk." Frankie Dettori said of the favourite Mutafaweg, who failed to guicken on the yielding ground in the straight, "He needs very good ground, but didn't find it here."

Tobougg mastered the front-running second favourite Honours List to make the steep climb from maiden to Group 1 company look easy, continuing the overwhelming success trainer Mick Channon has had with his twoyear-olds so far this year. Tobougg looked special on his debut in his maiden at York at the end of August, making up for a tardy start by sweeping by his rivals for a comfortable success, but entered this race as an unknown quantity compared to the achievements of the favoured G1 Prix Morny hero Bad As I Wanna Be (Ire) (Common Grounds {GB})., whose victory in the Deauville event put him to the top of the juvenile ratings. Honours List led straightaway as Tobougg was settled in third, while jockey Gerald Mosse struggled to keep hold of Bad As I Wanna Be. Asked to get down to work by jockey Craig Williams, Tobougg responded to sweep by Honours List with a furlong and a half remaining, before being pushed clear under hands and heels to win comfortably. "This horse is a real machine, and by far the best at home of Mick Channon's two-year-olds," Williams said. "He is still tender and a little baby, so he will improve for this, and the sky is the limit." Diana Cooper, representing the owner, said that she did not know where he would go next, although he is in the G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket Oct. 14, and the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster Oct. 21. Gerald Mosse, last on the favourite, said, "I don't understand what happened, as I tried to ride him like last time, but he would not do it. He faded very quickly, and that was not his true race."

Captain Steve, eighth in the Kentucky Derby and fourth in the Preakness, got a breather following his Pimlico effort and has been a different horse since. Shipped to Prairie Meadows, the chestnut came from just off the pace to register a 1 3/4-length victory in the July 3 lowa Derby and followed that triumph 20 days later with an impressive 2 1/2-length success over Pacific Classic runner up Tiznow in the GI Swaps at Hollywood Park. Second by three parts of a length in the GI Haskell Aug. 6, the Mike Pegram colorbearer was the third choice facing his elders for the first time. Captain Steve raced with the pace along the rail and took command after the opening four furlongs. Headed by favored Golden Missile at the three-eighths pole, the "Captain" responded to heavy urging from jockey Shane Sellers to regain the lead and held gamely for the win. "I thought of running him in New York, but it was only one turn and then I saw this race with Cat Thief and Golden Missile," said winning trainer Bob Baffert. "I thought 'let's find out what he's really made of'. He's turned into a man."

Forbidden Apple finished strongly in winning his first black-type event and giving his trainer-jockey combination a second straight victory in this race. An impressive winner of a Saratoga allowance July 29, the dark bay shipped down to Monmouth for the Bob Harding S. Aug. 27, where he was forced wide en route to a fourthplace finish. Back on home turf here, the homebred tracked Altibr through solid fractions over the soft turf and rallied three wide off the turn. Seizing the lead at the stretch call, the longest shot on the board maintained a clear advantage over a resurgent Val's Prince. "When I looked at the race this morning, I was a little worried," commented winning jockey Jose Santos. "There were a lot of speed horses entered in here. But they all scratched out. That set things up better for him. The only question mark seemed to be if he was going to like the soft going. At the 3/8ths-pole we were going pretty easy. He didn't switch leads, but that didn't worry me too much because he was running all the way to the end." White Heart (GB) (Green Desert), favored at 6-5, did not handle the going and finished fourth.

Caller One, off since July, continued his domination of the three-year-old sprint ranks with this easy victory. Now four-for-five on the year, with just a fifth in the one-mile GIII Derby Trial in May marring his record, the bay confirmed himself as a solid threat for the Gi Breeders' Cup Sprint. Having announced himself with a 10-length romp in the Hansel S. over this track in March, he took the GIII Lafayette at Keeneland, then shipped to California following his Churchill sojourn and defeated Dixie Union and Swept Overboard in the Laz Barrera H. at Hollywood May 29. Off two months, Caller One shipped to Calder and romped by five lengths in the Carry Back S. July 15 over a sloppy track. Assuming his customary position at the head of affairs, he carried a 1 1/2-length lead into the stretch and widened that advantage down the lane under a hand ride. "Now that I've been on his back, I see how [talented] he is," said winning rider Kent Desormeaux. "He is multi-talented. Jim [trainer Chapman] had him perfect today. He wouldn't have blown out a match coming into the winner's circle. He's truly a brilliant, brilliant sprinter." Jim Chapman confirmed the Breeders' Cup Sprint (Churchill Downs, Nov. 4) as his charge's next target. "He's a smart horse, and he can overcome problems," Chapman said. "He's going back to Hollywood and then we'll go on to the Breeders' Cup."

BOOKS 1 & 2: UP HOW FAR?

It's difficult to gauge how much this sale is really up, judging from the critical first four days. The tale of the tape says 976 yearlings sold (a seven-percent drop from last year) for just about \$220.8-million, up 29 percent, and averaged \$226,229, a titanic 39-percent jump. And I know we're never supposed to use that phrase, "Take out ..." since you never really can, or should, take it out. Still, I can't get away from those 45 Lane's End Tuesday yearlings, which brought \$45 million, or 20 percent of the gross receipts for the first four days.

So, what would it look like if we did "take it out?" A total of 931 yearlings would have sold for \$175-million (up three percent from last year), and averaged about \$188,000, which would have been an 11-percent gain.

The truth must lie somewhere in between, because there were sure a lot of consignors who were not hopping around gleefully after the first two books. Though only one percent higher than last year, the 26-percent buy-back rate, the internet auction aside, does tend to confirm something alot of sellers said, including on Tuesday--tough going. Yes, said one leading consignor, if you have the one they want, the sky's the limit; if you don't, you're in trouble. Those seven \$3-million plus yearlings on Tuesday represented just over one percent of book one sales; book one buy-backs were 27 percent. One percent, twenty-seven percent. And breeders buy stud fees based on the one percent. How representative can it be?

Yet the breeders are falling over themselves chasing these stud fees, and they will chase every bit as hard after the next round of raises, moaning about stud fees all the while. This is an old refrain, but a true one--the job of the stallion manager is not to make money for breeders. His or her job is to generate revenue through the sale of seasons. They don't owe the breeders the time of day; the breeder is perfectly entitled to say no, and go somewhere else. Meaning, if three years from now they are bemoaning their shrinking profit margins, they, the breeders, will have only themselves to blame.

The Big Three

The top three stallions on average in Books 1 & 2 were the same three that topped the averages before the September sale--Storm Cat, Mr. Prospector, and A.P. Indy--though not in the same order. Storm Cat's 16 yearlings averaged \$1.4-million, which propelled his average, through the end of Book 2, to \$1,278,250, with 24 sold. Mr. Prospector ended Book 2 with an average just over \$20,000 lower, his 15 yearlings averaging \$1,257,000. A.P. Indy had 17 average \$848,235 in the first two books, and therefore averaged \$921,522 for his 23 sold overall.

Young Guns...

Honour and Glory, who was up to 16 individual winners before the sale started, topped the averages for sires with first two-year-olds in the first two books, as his seven sold averaged an impressive \$290,000. In those two books, Unbridled's Song had 19 (of 27 offered, 70 percent) average \$203,125, while Hennessy sold 28 of 34, and averaged \$190,464. Unbridled's Song did better in the summer, however, so cumulatively he had 30 yearlings average \$307,533, while Hennessy's cumulative figures read 41 sold, averaging \$234,634. Both had right at 71-72 percent sell.

Among first-year sires, Pulpit blew them away. He had 16 of 17 average \$408,250 in books 1-2. Overall, 23 sold of 25 offered (92 percent) and averaged \$458,130. Very impressive. After Spinning World had a bad Tuesday, both Siphon (10 averaged \$187,500), and the surprising Editor's Note (six averaged \$177,500) out-averaged Spinning World (19, of 29 offered--66 percent--averaged \$159,737) in books 1-2. Atticus (eight sold, out of 16 offered, averaging \$153,375) and Benny the Dip (seven sold of eight offered, averaging \$152,429--boy, did he come to life) were close behind. But cumulatively, Spinning World (26, \$182,115) edged Siphon (19, \$177,105) for a distant second to Pulpit. Boston Harbor (33, \$158,121), Benny the Dip (seven, \$152,429), Atticus (12, \$146,917), Louis Quatorze (10, \$128,800), Editor's Note (13, \$116,923), and Langfuhr (17, \$106,100) all broke the \$100,000 average barrier in what looks a pretty salty group of first-crop sires, even considering they are in that ever-popular 'first-year sires' category.


