ALL THE RAGE

It was the first time she was truly tested. Running her unbeaten streak to four, 1-5 Raging Fever (Storm Cat) fought off the furious late charge of 5-1 shot Dancinginmydreams (Seeking the Gold) to take yesterday's GI Matron S. at Belmont Park by a head. "I saw the other filly coming on at the end," jockey Jerry Bailey said. "We got to midstretch and I was trying to get my filly to pick it up some more, but she thought the race was over. That's something I'll have to be mindful of next time." The dark bay filly had never before been challenged. She broke her maiden by six lengths May 25, added an 11-length victory in the Astoria S. July 2 and toyed with her rivals in her latest try, capturing the GII Adirondack S. by 9 1/4 lengths at Saratoga Aug. 14. Looking for her first Grade I win in the Matron, the Edward Evans homebred battled 8-1 Major Wager (Valid Wager) through a half in :46 3/5, but opened up after six furlongs and held a seven-length advantage as they came down the stretch. Dancinginmydreams was better than 15 lengths out of it as they hit the halfmile pole. She made up half the ground as they raced around the far turn and almost erased the rest in the stretch, but despite closing with every stride, she fell about a jump short at the wire. "This was only her second start and I think, with more races, she'll get more competitive," trainer Shug McGaughey said of the runner-up, who rallied to win her debut at Saratoga Aug. 31 and will make her next appearance in the GI Frizette S. at Belmont Park Oct. 14. Winning trainer Mark Hennig could bring his filly back for that race, or may head to Keeneland for the GII Walmac Int'l Alcibiades S. Oct. 15. "There are advantages to running in the Frizette and the Alcibiades," Hennig said. "I'd like to run her out of her own stall [at Belmont], but a two-turn race [at Keeneland] could help her, too." "ROMA" BURNS FUTURITY FAVORITE

The photo finish camera gave the nod to City Zip (Carson City); the stewards saw it a different way. Sent off the 7-5 favorite in yesterday's GI Futurity S. at Belmont Park, City Zip had the lead at the top of the lane. He looked sure to relinguish it as 17-1 Roma Burns (Rubiano) came flying in the final furlong, but veered out when jockey Jose Santos switched to the left-handed stick and bumped the late-closing longshot, then crossed the wire a nose in front for what would have been his fifth straight graded-stakes score. It was not to be, however, as the stewards took a look at the tape and reversed the order of finish. "I think the stewards made the right call," said a gracious Linda Rice, trainer of City Zip, who had reeled off victories in the July 3 GIII Tremont S., July 27 GII Sanford S., Aug. 16 GII Saratoga Special and Sept. 2 GI Hopeful. He will head next to the GI Champagne S. at Belmont Oct. 14. Roma Burns, winner of the Prince George Park S. at Laurel in his latest try, is now officially three-for-three and could return for the Champagne as well. "My colt has improved so much and he'll only get better as the distances get longer," jockey Rick Wilson said.

The sale topper at last year's Tattersalls Houghton Yearling Sales, Beckett made a winning debut in a Leopardstown maiden June 14, but was then beaten a half length and a head in the G3 King Of Kings EBF Futurity S. here Aug. 26. Rated only third of the four Ballydoyle runners in this contest, with unbeaten stable companion Darwin (Ire) (Danehill) sent off the 4-9 favourite, he turned opinion on its head with an emphatic success, earning a quote of 20-1 from most bookmakers for next year's G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas. Smartly into his stride, he raced in fifth early, moved over to the far rail with three furlongs to run and began to motor. He soon grabbed the lead from Down To The Woods and went clear of King's County, who tended to wander around in the closing stages. Winning trainer Aidan O'Brien, who saddled all four stakes winners on yesterday's card at The Curragh, said, "He's a smashing colt. He'll get a mile really well and will be a Guineas horse next spring." Asked about the favourite Darwin and his other runner Bonard, O'Brien said, "Both their jockeys said that they just weren't able to handle the ground. You can expect different results on fast ground." The Sporting Life on-line reported that Darwin was found to be "lame behind" by the Turf Club veterinarian after the race.

Having taken her second consecutive G3 Preis der Badsichen Sparkassen Aug. 25, where Aboard was fourth and Icemoon seventh, Elle Danzig came back here to take her most important prize this year. Champion filly in 1998 when winner of the G1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis at Munich, she captured the G1 Premio Roma at Rome last November, but has taken her time returning to form this season. The five-year-old put an unplaced effort in the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. at Sandown May 30 behind her with an authorative display in this, stretching clear of her rivals for a convincing win.

The winner of the Listed Davenport Hotel Eyrefield S. last November on her second start, Chiang Mai won a conditions race here Apr. 9, then finished eighth in the G1 Entenmann's Irish 1000 Guineas May 28. Away since, she was nevertheless sent off favourite here. Racing in fourth as stable companion Apollo Victoria (Fr) (Sadler's Wells) set the early pace, she moved up to join Happy Change and Chimes At Midnight in the lead over a quarter mile out and the trio engaged in a battle royal up to the line, with Chiang Mai gaining the upper hand in the final strides. Amazingly, the runner-up was having his third start in eight days; he was sixth in Saturday's G1 Jefferson Smurfit Memorial Irish St Leger. Winning trainer Aidan O'Brien said, "She's been ready to run for over a month, but we've been waiting for this easier ground, which she prefers. She'll improve a lot from this run and we'll look for another Group race for her, but it's also possible that she'll stay in training next year."

FUSAICHI PEGASUS ON BELMONT WORK TAB Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector), unraced since finishing second in the Preakness S., worked seven furlongs in 1:28 1/5 over the Belmont Park main track yesterday. "I thought he worked well," trainer Neil Drysdale said. "He looked happy and was just cruising along." Drysdale added that the three-year-old could make his return in the GII Jerome H. at Belmont Saturday. "It's a possibility," he said. "It depends on the weather and how the horse comes out of the work. I don't have a set plan with him. The only plan we have is to get him to the Breeders' Cup."

KEENELAND LAUNCHES INTERNET AUCTION Keeneland successfully executed the Thoroughbred industry's first-ever Internet auction Saturday, selling four horses on-line for a total of \$109,500. There were more than 200 buyers and agents registered to bid and 75 yearlings listed for sale. Keeneland President Nick Nicholson said, "First and foremost, it worked. The Internet auction demonstrates that you can blend the tried and proven elements of Keeneland's live auction with emerging technology to provide an expanded service to our customers." Added Internet Sales Administrator Stephen Koch, "The most important thing was to demonstrate that we have an effective Internet system. The entire industry was watching us and that is why we are so ecstatic that the system proved so effective. I received a lot of positive feedback from buyers and sellers." The next Internet session will be held Sept. 20, with a third set for Sept. 25.

MIGHT AND POWER RETIRED After discussing the horse's future with trainer Jack Denham, owner Nick Moraitis announced yesterday that multiple Australian Horse of the Year Might And Power (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) has been retired. "It was a devastating decision to have to make," said Moraitis, "The last thing we wanted was to see him break down like a lot of other champion horses. It was best for the horse to be put into greener pastures." The seven-year-old gelding, who suffered a bowed tendon in November, 1998, returned from a 22-month absence to run last in the Tramway H. Sept. 2 before a similar lacklustre performance in the Shannon S. last Thursday. Might And Power retires with 15 wins, seven of those Grade 1s, including the Caulfield and Melbourne Cup double in 1997 and his record-breaking win in the 1998 W.S. Cox Plate. He will be retired to Denham's son Alan's property at Dooralong, near Wyong on the New South Wales Central Coast.

MARIA'S MON COLT TOPS KEENELAND

SUNDAY A chestnut colt by freshman sire Maria's Mon out of Blues On Parade (Cure the Blues) brought a final bid of \$325,000 to top Sunday's session of the 2000 Keeneland September Yearling Sales in Lexington. Consigned by Forbush Farm, agent for Dr. David and Jean Darby, the February foal was purchased by Bob and Beverly Lewis, making them the leading buyers at the session. He is from the family of champion turf horse Itsallgreektome, who won the GI Hollywood Derby and GI Hollywood Turf Cup and finished second in both the GI Breeders' Cup Turf and GI Breeders' Cup Mile; and of graded-stakes winner Big Stanley. Yesterday's leading consignor was Taylor Made Sales Agency. While yesterday's average was off six percent, the median rose slightly, from \$26,500 to \$27,000. Through seven sessions, the sale has seen a 28-percent increase in average and a nine-percent increase in median over last year. The 11-day marathon continues through Sept. 23, with bidding beginning at 10 a.m. daily.

BAILEYS BACK TO BRITAIN Mister Baileys (GB) (Robellino {USA}--Thimblerigger {GB}, by Sharpen Up {GB}), the hero of the 1994 G1 2000 Guineas, will return from the United States to stand at Chris Harper's Whitsbury Manor Stud in Hampshire. He was due to stand at the National Stud at the outset of his stud career, but a life-threatening bout of grass sickness and his subsequent sale to U.S. interests saw him take up duties at Vinery Stud in Versailles, Kentucky, in 1996. Part-owner Luke Lillingston has bought out U.S. interests in the nine-year-old stallion, the sire of the promising two-year-old Rumpold (GB), five-length conqueror of Phoenix S. winner Minardi (USA) in an Ascot maiden July 29, as well as American stakes winner Cool Ashlee (USA). Harper said, "He is a very exciting addition to our team. I followed his career as we have his dam here--she has now been pensioned--and he was bred by a friend in Dorset. When he won the Guineas he broke the track record which still stands and he ran a fantastic race in the Derby for a horse who had no designs on staying a mile and a half. And he has made a fantastic start at stud--he has only had about half a dozen run in Europe and they have all shown promise. He is a very exciting horse and I am sure he will be popular." He will stand alongside Cadeaux Genereux, Compton Place and Magic Ring.

IRON FILLY VERSUS IRON GIANT A clash of multiple Group 1 winners is shaping up for this Saturday's G1 Oueen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot as trainer Clive Brittain has pronounced his three-time Group 1 heroine Crimplene (Ire) (Lion Cavern {USA}) a definite starter in the one-mile event. She is likely to lock horns with Giant's Causeway (USA) (Storm Cat {USA}), who will be aunning for his fourth consecutive Group 1 success and seventh overall. Crimplene followed her victory at The Curragh with 2 1/2-length win in the Coronation Cup at Ascot before besting Ela Athena by 1 3/4 lengths in the 10-furlong Nassau S. at Goodwood Aug. 5. Shipped on only eight days rest to contest the Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville Aug. 13 at a mile, she could muster only a fourth-place finish, but that is an effort best ignored, according to trainer Clive Brittain. "She did get a little stirred up in France and it is possible that running a mile and a quarter for the first time previously might just have emptied her. She had a week off after France but has come back into her work very strongly. Crimplene is a definite runner and in very good form," Brittain told PA Sporting Life.
