SIPHON FILLY TOPS DAY 8 AT KEENELAND

A filly from the first crop by South American import Siphon (Brz) out of Miss Represented (Sovereign Dancer) topped vesterday's eighth session of the 2000 Keeneland September Yearling Sales in Lexington. Consigned by Lakland LLC, agent, the chestnut was purchased for \$190,000 by Bruce Headley. Her sire, a Group 1 winner in his native country, proved even tougher in the U.S., accounting for the GI Santa Anita H. and GI Hollywood Gold Cup; he was also runner-up in the G1 Dubai World Cup. Another first-crop stallion, Pulpit, was responsible for the session's top colt. The bay, from the Walnut Green consignment, was bought for \$150,000 by James K. Chapman. He is out of My Imagination (Easy Goer), who is herself a half sister to champion and 11-time Grade I winner Serena's Song. The session average was up better than 10 percent from last year, while the median rose 16.7 percent. Through the first eight days, the gross has increased 23 percent, the average is up 27.6 percent and the median is up 6.3 percent. The 13-day Keeneland September Sale continues this morning at 10.

Demi O'Byrne and John Ferguson have played leading roles in the spectacular trade at Keeneland's September Sale and it's a safe bet that they will also be fighting over the choicest youngsters at Tattersalls' Houghton Sales later this month. Their enthusiasm will have been fired by the Group 1 victories of two of their 1999 Houghton buys. Beckett, a Fairy King colt bought by O'Byrne for a sale-topping 1,700,000gns, was a stylish winner of the Aga Khan Studs National S., and Tobougg, a 230,000gns purchase by Ferguson, was similarly impressive in the Prix de la Salamandre.

Tobougg's win represented a well-deserved breakthrough for his sire Barathea, who will be best remembered for his victory in the 1994 GI Breeders' Cup Mile. After that win, he was immediately retired to Rathbarry Stud in Ireland, where he proved highly popular at a fee of Ir16,000gns. Expectations were boosted higher still when John Ferguson bid IR950,000gns--the highest price for a filly at Europe's 1997 yearling sales--for one of Barathea's daughters at Goffs. That filly, Ajhiba, became a Listed winner, but it wasn't long before the critics got to work.

For example, Barathea featured in the *Racing Post's* 1999 Christmas quiz, when readers were asked to identify a stallion who was "still without a winner above Group 3 level and covered 147 mares in 1999," a clue being that his 2000 fee would be Ir25,000gns.

While the facts were strictly as stated, Barathea was unlucky not to have had a Group 1 success or two from his first two crops. His son Enrique had failed by only a neck to win the 1999 2000 Guineas after being left with five lengths to make up when forced to check at a crucial stage. "Had things gone his way, he may well have won," was Raceform's comment.

Five months later, juvenile Barathea Guest was controversially demoted to second after beating recent GI Secretariat S. winner Ciro by a neck in the Grand Criterium. This year, he was third to King's Best and Giant's Causeway in the 2000 Guineas after inflicting the first defeat on Distant Music in the G3 Greenham S.

The question now is whether Tobougg can succeed where Enrique and Barathea Guest failed so honorably. He is one of the leading fancies for next year's 2000 Guineas and there is every reason to expect this colt, now unbeaten in two starts, will continue improving.

Barathea's Timeform rating jumped from 107 at two to 124 at three, when he followed up his second to Zafonic in the 2000 Guineas with a victory in the Irish equivalent.

Tobougg's dam, Lacovia, also improved from two to three. She had claims to being the best middle-distance three-year-old filly of 1986 when she produced excellent acceleration to take the G1 Prix Saint-Alary by four lengths and the G1 Prix de Diane by two.

Tobougg is a reminder that a particular mating should not be automatically rejected if it fails to work the first time. Lacovia's first visit to Barathea resulted in Come On George, a disappointing gelding whose price fell from 150,000gns as a yearling to 15,000gns at three. In fact Tobougg is comfortably better than any of Lacovia's nine previous foals.

Tobougg is another good winner whose pedigree features the top-class half-brothers Sir Gaylord and Secretariat. Appropriately, his second dam, the Secretariat mare Hope For All, is a half-sister to Miswaki, the Prix de la Salamandre winner of 1980.

Tobougg and Enrique were both sired by Barathea from mares by Raise a Native line stallions, as was his 1999 Group 3 winner La Sylphide. This looks to be an avenue well worth pursuing. Barathea has also done well with mares from the Mill Reef line, siring the Group 3 winners Barafamy, Barathea Guest and Red Sea.

MINER'S MARK TO FLORIDA Miner's Mark (Mr.

Prospector), who was retired to Lane's End near Versailles, Kentucky in 1995, has been relocated to Dunhill Stud near Ocala, Florida for the 2001 season. The first foal from undefeated champion Personal Ensign (Private Account), the 10-year-old compiled a record of six wins, four seconds and two thirds from 18 starts for earnings of \$967,170. He captured the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, GII Jim Dandy S. and GIII Colin S. in 1993. From his three crops to race, the stallion has sired the winners of more than \$2.4 million. Miner's Mark stood for a fee of \$12,500 this year, but his stud fee for next season has not yet been announced.

Kentucky Cup Crowd Sets Record:

A total of 11,090 fans came through the gates at Turfway Park for Saturday's \$1.15 million Kentucky Cup Day of Champions and Infield Festival, a record for the event which was inaugurated in 1994. Both total and on-track handle were up 10 percent over last year, with \$1,439,888 wagered on site and \$8,016,906 handled from all sources. The card was simulcast to 1.002 outlets.

Improvement Plan for Sportsman's Park:

The National Jockey Club is undertaking a multi-million dollar improvement plan which will include the renovation of the grandstand and clubhouse facilities at Sportsman's Park. "Our intention will not only be to restore the convenience and 'up close and personal' feeling that our patrons loved for so long," National Jockey Club Chief Operating Officer Edward T. Duffy said. "We are going to go beyond what existed prior to the conversion of Sportsman's Park into an all-purpose sports and concert facility and make it an aesthetically pleasing state-of-the-art facility for both our live racing and simulcast fans." After the overhaul, which is expected to be completed by opening day 2001, the track will have more seating, more TV monitors and a new escalator, and an improved infield tote board. The crash fence in front of the stands will be eliminated.
