DEFRERE COLT TOPS AT KEENELAND

Wednesday's 10th session of the Keeneland September Yearling Sales was topped by hip number 3537, a colt by second-crop sire Defrere. The bay is the first foal from the unraced mare Roleo (Devil's Bag), whose dam Fold The Flag is out of the late Up The Flagpole, the dam of multiple Champion Flagbird, Grade I stakes winners Runup The Colors and Prospectors Delite and Top Account. Consigned to the sale by Carmichael Sales as agent for Aberdeen Partnership, the colt was purchased for \$180,000 by John Oxley. The gross is ahead by 22.8 percent while the average is up by 28.2 percent through 10 days. The sale continues today at 10 a.m.

OKAWANGO "OK" IN ROCHETTE

Okawango (Kingmambo), an impressive three-length winner of a Class B maiden over a mile at Longchamp Sept. 3, confirmed the promise of that debut success to record a first pattern win in the G3 Prix la Rochette yesterday on only his second racecourse appearance. Jockey Olivier Doleuze had the son of Kingmambo settled in third in the early stages as his stable companion French Tune (Fr) (Green Tune) disputed the lead with the British-trained challenger Lucayan Chief (With Approval). He travelled smoothly throughout and made effortless progress into a challenging position at the distance as Lucayan Chief held the outright lead. Doleuze asked the main question inside the final furlong and the partnership went to the front with 150 yards remaining. Okawango was not seriously threatened thereafter and kept on in good style for a decisive win. Vahorimix (Linamix {Fr}) tracked the eventual winner for most of the race and put in his best work in the closing stages to deprive the game Lucayan Chief of second in the dying strides. The winner will now point to the G1 Grand Criterium, again over a mile, at Longchamp Oct. 8.

ALMUTAWAKEL RETIRED G1 Dubai World Cup winner Almutawakel (GB) (Machiavellian--Elfaslah {Ire}, by Green Desert) has been retired and will stand at Sheikh Hamdan al Maktoum's Derrinstown Stud in County Kildare, Ireland next season. His fee will be 6,000 Irish guineas, October 1 terms. Racing in the colours of Godolphin, Almutawakel captured the G1 Prix Jean Prat and was second in the G1 Grand Prix de Paris at three before shipping to Dubai. When successful at Nad al Sheba in March 1999, he beat a strong international field which included Daylami (Ire), High-Rise (Ire), Malek (Chi), Silver Charm and Victory Gallop. Trained in Europe by Saeed bin Suroor, he was second in the GI Woodward H., third in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park and fifth in the Breeders' Cup Classic before being transferred to the care of trainer Mark Hennig. The bay horse did not find his best form this season, but finished second in the GI Oaklawn H. in April. His career earnings amounted to \$3,643,268. A son of Machiavellian, also sire of Best Of The Bests and Vettori, Almutawakel is out of a half-sister to G1 winner White Muzzle (GB), runner-up in both the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. "We are delighted to be standing Almutawakel," said Hubie de Burgh, general manager of Derrinstown. "He is a very good looking horse and a great opportunity for breeders to get into a well-bred horse at a fraction of the price of either of his sire or his maternal sire Green Desert."

STUD FEE SET FOR CHESTER HOUSE

GI Arlington Million winner Chester House (Mr. Prospector--Toussaud, by El Gran Senor), recently retired with a hairline fracture of his scapula, will stand the 2001 breeding season at Juddmonte Farms near Lexington for a fee of \$25,000, it was announced yesterday. The 1/2 brother to multiple Grade I winner Honest Lady made a splash in his American debut when a hard-closing fourth in the Breeders' Cup Classic last November, and was a good second in the GI Eddie Read at Del Mar, before registering his first U.S. victory in the Million Aug. 19. The winner of the Group 3 Brigadier Gerard in England, the five-year-old retired with six wins from 21 starts and earnings of \$1,944,545.

Kelly Kip Back On Track:

Millionaire sprinter Kelly Kip (Kipper Kelly), sidelined for four months as the result of a second hock infection, recorded his third workout since his return to training, getting four furlongs in the Belmont slop yesterday in :47 around the dogs. "It's good to have him around the barn," said Hall-of-Fame trainer Allen Jerkens. "He was well within himself this morning. I'm not sure where or when he'll return again." The six-year-old missed most of the 1999 season due to a hock infection which proved nearly fatal. He is unraced since a second-place finish in the GII Bold Ruler H. at Aqueduct Apr. 15.

Pletcher Pair to Meet Saturday:

Stablemates More Than Ready (Southern Halo) and Trippi (End Sweep) will likely face off Saturday in the Gl Vosburgh H. at Belmont Park. More Than Ready is coming into the race off his first Grade I victory in the King's Bishop at Saratoga Aug. 26 and is undefeated at distances less than one mile, while Trippi disappointed when third in the GIII Amsterdam at the Spa Aug. 4, but won the GII Tom Fool and GII Riva Ridge at Saturday's seven-furlong distance. "I'd rather not run them against each other, but it's looking more and more like that's what's going to happen," said trainer Todd Pletcher. The Vosburgh has never produced the winner of the Breeders' Cup Sprint.

IRB Makes Significant Schedule Changes:

During a Tuesday meeting, the Illinois Racing Board decided on major changes for the Chicago racing land-scape in 2001. Arlington International was awarded dates from June 11 to Oct. 30, while Hawthorne received a split meeting from May 1 through June 10 and Oct. 31 through Dec. 31. Sportsman's Park will operate from Mar. 1 through April 30, stripping the track of its simulcast rights to the Kentucky Oaks and Derby in early May. The decrease in days is attributable to a substantial decline in on-track betting when the track was reopened this past March after being converted to a combination Thoroughbred/auto racing facility. Sportsman's meeting ran this year from Mar. 1 through May 13.

TATTERSALLS CONCLUDES ON HIGH NOTE

The Tattersalls (Ireland) September Yearling Sale at Fairyhouse concluded yesterday with substantial increases. Trade was down on the first day, but overall the sale showed solid gains on 1999, with the gross of IR5,090,100 up 24 percent on the last year's IR4,118,300, while the average rose by 17 percent from IR9,091 guineas to IR10,671 guineas. The median rose by 14 percent from IR7,350 to IR8,400 guineas. This year's clearance rate was 94 percent compared to 92 percent last year. Top price on the second day was IR41,000 guineas paid by English-based owner-breeder Dwayne Woods for lot 504, a chestnut colt by Tagula (Ire) out of the winning mare Sauvignon (Ire) (Alzao {USA}), a half sister to the G3 Prix du Muguet winner Schwepperusschian (Ire). Owned and bred by Mrs P Grubb, the colt was consigned by Big Acre Stud. Second most expensive yearling was Lot 361, a bay filly by Barathea (Ire) out of the multiple winner Daniela Samuel (USA) (No Robbery {USA}). Owned and bred by Mrs J Costelloe, the filly was consigned by J K Thoroughbreds and bought by Irish trainer Edward Lynam. She is a halfsister to the top-rated Italian miler of 1995, Prince Arthur (Ire) (Fairy King {USA}), whose wins included the G1 Premio Parioli (Italian 2000 Guineas). Two yearlings shared the third-highest price of IR35,000 guineas. One came right at the outset when BBA Italia purchased Lot 277, a chestnut colt by Spectrum (Ire). He comes from the family of the multiple G1 winner and leading sire Riverman (USA). Also selling for IR35,000 guineas was Lot 475, a bay filly from the first crop of Revoque (Ire).
