CHAMPIONS TO HARAS DE BONNEVAL

European champion miler **Sendawar (Ire)** (Priolo--Sendana {Fr}, by Darshaan {GB}), who was retired last month, and 1988 Irish champion **Kahyasi (Ire)** (Ile de Bourbon--Kadissya, by Blushing Groom {Fr}) will head to stud in France for the 2001 breeding season, standing at the Aga Khan's Haras de Bonneval in Normandy. The Aga Khan has decided to give French breeding a boost by reopening his stallion operation in the country. First or second in nine of his 10 career starts, the four-year-old Sendawar captured the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp, G1 St. James's Palace S. and G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) last season and added a victory in the G1 Prix d'Ispahan this year. Kahyasi was hero of both the Irish and Epsom Derbies in 1988. Among the Group winners he has sired are Vereva (Ire) and Zainta (Ire), back-to-back winners of the G1 Prix de Diane in 1997-98.

FILLY TOPS KEENELAND DAY 11

The 13-day Keeneland September Yearling Sale marched on yesterday in Lexington, Kentucky with a daughter of Allen's Prospect--Fleet Road (Magisterial) bringing top price of \$170,000. The bay yearling, who sold as hip number 4076, was consigned by Lane's End, agent for Brookside Farms, and was purchased by Wakefield Farm. The top-priced colt of the session was hip number 3837, a son of Alydeed--Mimi Kat (Storm Cat). He was consigned by Runnymede Farm, Inc., agent, and was purchased for \$125,000 by Billy Fuccillo. The sale's penultimate session begins today at 10 a.m.

Mount Abu, winner of two Listed races earlier this year, finished sixth to Josr Algarhoud (Ire) in the G3 Prix de la Porte Maillot at Longchamp June 25 and then was third to Three Points (GB) in the G3 Prix de Meautry at Deauville Aug. 27. With the benefit of his favoured underfoot conditions, he scored his first Group win with a battling display to deny the Irish-trained raider One Won One. The bay was positioned a tracking second in the early stages as Claranet (GB) (Arazi) set off at a fast pace. Jimmy Fortune asked Mount Abu to make his bid from the quarter-mile marker, as Claranet began to fade, and he went to the front approaching the final furlong only to be tackled by One Won One and Last Resort. The three tussled in game fashion all the way to the wire with Mount Abu holding on well in the closing stages. "He likes cut in the ground but that was a bit too much today and they went a hell of a pace too," said winning trainer John Gosden. "He was left in front too early and the race was not run to his liking. Having said that I'm delighted he won and with better ground he could run better. He could go for either the G1 Prix de la Foret [at Longchamp Oct. 15] or the G2 Challenge S. [at Newmarket Oct. 14] but probably France as the food is better in Paris."

MIGHTY RETURNS *Mighty* (Lord at War {Arg}), a leading Kentucky Derby contender before being sidelined by injury this past spring, returns to action today at Belmont Park. The three-year-old colt won the GII Louisiana Derby at Fair Grounds in March, but suffered a strained carpal tunnel behind his right knee while running seventh in the Apr. 15 GI Toyota Blue Grass at Keeneland. He has been away from the races since then. *Mighty* will face six rivals in today's seventh race at Belmont, a 1 1/16-mile allowance contest for three-year-olds and older.

In her first start for Al Goldberg, the Kentucky-bred ran fourth of five in the Aug. 19 Silver Spoon S. at Delaware. Unhurried throughout here, the filly rated behind moderate fractions and showed a game late dash to clinch the victory by a nose at 4-1. The filly is a half sister to Excellent Meeting (General Meeting, MGISW, \$1,402,396) and Crown Meeting (General Meeting, MSP, \$330,552). Lifetime Record: SW, 6-3-1-0, \$149,086.

Two for five on the Belmont turf, Aldo has been racing in graded-stakes company, where he finished second in Saratoga's GII National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame H. Aug. 7. Seventh last time out in the GIII Saranac H. Sept. 3, the colt returned to his favorite course for this start. In back of the seven-horse field with a half mile to run, he made a gradual move from last place to be just off the lead entering the straight, out-raced his rivals and nabbed the narrow win.

DONCASTER AUTUMN SALE PREVIEW The European sales season is about to hit top gear, with most eyes trained on next week's Tattersalls Houghton Yearling Sale at Park Paddocks in Newmarket. DISTANT MUSIC POINTS TO DUBAI CHAMPION

Three-year-old Distant Music (USA) (Distant View {USA}), who came back after a disappointing eighth-place finish in the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas to take the G3 White Rose Park S. at Doncaster Sept. 7, could make his first start beyond a mile in the 1 1/4-mile G1 Dubai Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 14. The colt was originally scheduled to contest this weekend's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot, but Teddy Beckett, racing manager for owner Khalid Abdullah, told *PA Sport*, "He had a long layoff after the Guineas and we didn't want to rush him back again after the Doncaster race. But [trainer Barry Hills] is very happy with the horse and all being well, we will be thinking about the Champion S. now." He added, "The good news is that the horse, subject to Prince Khalid's approval, will be staying in training next season."

TOTE EXTENDS £2 MINIMUM

The Tote will extend its minimum of £2 per bet to include more types of wagers at most courses beginning Oct. 2, the *Sporting Life* on-line reports. The minimum, already in place for Win, Place, Exacta and Scoop6 bets, will now encompass Jackpot, Placepot and Trifecta wagers. "Bookmakers generally have a much higher minimum and research we have undertaken among our customers suggests that this change, while upsetting to some in the short term, is merely a reflection of the changing value of money," Tote PR Director Rob Hartnett told *Sporting Life*.

Jockey James Spencer, considered a potential star of the future, was handed a 17-day suspension for misuse of the whip during his ride aboard Tedstale (USA) in yesterday's Tote Placepot Nursery S. at Warwick, *PA Sport* reports. Spencer incurred the heavy penalty because he had already been suspended 15 days for whip infractions during the past 12 months. The jockey will miss all flat racing from Sept. 26 through Oct. 10, and will take another four days next March. He is also required to attend the British Racing School Sept. 28 for lessons on the use of the whip.
