THE GOLDEN YEARS

Golden Snake (Danzig) was retired last year after a busy season that saw him win the G1 Prix Jean Prat. He was sent to Newmarket's National Stud to take up stallion duties, but reemerged with a fourth-place finish to Montjeu in the May 28 G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh. While only fifth in the G3 La Coupe at Maisons-Laffitte Sept. 13, Golden Snake found his best stride again yesterday with a narrow victory over Yavana's Pace (Ire) (Accordion {Ire}) in the G1 Deutsche Post Euro Express Preis von Europa in Cologne, Germany. The runner-up filled the same berth in the G1 Irish St Leger at The Curragh only eight days ago. Evening Storm (Ire) (Acatenango {Ger}) made the running as Golden Snake was positioned in midfield. Yavana's Pace seized the initiative once into the straight and quickly asserted a three-length advantage, but Golden Snake finished with a tremendous rattle inside the final furlong and collared Yavana's Pace on the line.

NO SINKING ATLANTIS

Four unbeaten colts lined up for yesterday's G2 Serpentine Gallery Royal Lodge S. at Ascot, but only Atlantis Prince (GB) (Tagula {Ire}) was still perfect at the end of the day. The colt added the Sept. 8 Listed Stardom S. at Goodwood to wins at Epsom and Newmarket and was looking for his first group win yesterday. Going straight to the front from the start, he still had the call a furlong and a half out where Hill Country (Ire) (Danehill) made good progress on the outside, while Turnberry Isle (Ire) (Deputy Minister) was switched away from the rail and looked a serious threat. The latter closed to within a half length, but Atlantis Prince was always in command and stayed on well to win with more in hand then the official margin suggests. Winning trainer Sean Woods said, "You never know how two-year-olds are going to handle conditions like this, but it was loose when he won at Goodwood and he handled that OK. This colt is a true professional, he just does the business and has never taken anything out of himself in his four races. And he's got all the gears of a good horse. If the ground conditions stay like this, I'd like to run him in the [G1] Grand Criterium at Longchamp [Oct. 8], but I'll have to talk to the owner Edward St George." Bookmakers Ladbrokes quote Atlantis Price at odds of 25-1 for next season's G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas.

Heavy track conditions forced the Godolphin team to scratch its main hope Bertolini, but mudlover Sampower Star proved a very worthy substitute. Winner of the G3 Duke of York S. on the soft last year, he captured the G3 Prix de Saint-Georges at Longchamp May 14 on the heavy, his only win in five previous starts this campaign. Behind deep cover along the rail early as Monkston Point (Ire) (Fayruz {GB}) led from Trinculo, Sampower Star was always travelling well and jockey Frankie Dettori had a double handful a furlong and a half out, but seemed to have no chance of finding an opening, with Tayseer keeping him boxed in. But when Tayseer switched to the outside Dettori went with him, found a perfect split between Tayseer and the leader Trinculo well inside the final furlong and Sampower Star quickened into the lead in a few strides and swept home for a clever victory. Winning trainer Saeed bin Suroor said, "The rain changed the going a lot and we were lucky that it suited Sampower Star. It's always difficult to find room and time your run in a six-furlong race, but Frankie (Dettori) did it perfectly. We'll see how the horse comes out of the race, but we'll now look at next weekend's [G1] Prix de l'Abbaye at Longchamp [Oct. 1]."

Muntej followed his five-length maiden win over this course in July with an allowance victory at this distance, but had his win streak broken with fourth-place effort in the 1 1/2-miles GII Niagara Breeders' Cup S. Sept. 3. The colt was allowed to settle off the pace, came four wide into the stretch to take command at midstretch and drew off to the wire. "He was very relaxed today and settled in behind horses nicely and when I asked him to punch, he kicked on," jockey Robert Landry said of the winner. "I made the lead maybe a little earlier than I wanted to but he got it done. He's a good horse." Trainer Roger Attfield enjoyed a one-two finish in the race when pacesetting Free Vacation held on to the runner-up position. "I was hoping we were going to be one-two, but I didn't know in which order," Attfield commented. "It's a nice situation to be in." Sam-Son Farm's Quiet Resolve (Affirmed) was scratched due to the soft turf conditions.

The consistent Devine Wind has gone from \$40,000 maiden winner to graded-stakes glory in the course of six starts this season. The dark bay was victorious in fact in each of his first three trips to the post, culminating with a two-length victory in his first turf try at Hollywood Park July 9. Fourth in a Del Mar allowance Aug. 6, Devine Wind was most recently second in the H F Brubaker H. "where the surf meets the turf" Aug. 25. Kept within striking distance through the opening half mile, the four-year-old was allowed to take up the running three wide around the final turn. Devine Wind and jockey Garrett Gomez hit the front with a furlong to run and inched away to the victory.

During his European campaign, Ciro just missed winning the G1 Grand Criterium last October, won the G1 Prix Lupin in May and finished third in the G1 Irish Derby in July. In his North American debut, the chestnut drove to a one-length tally over King Cugat in the Aug. 19 GI Secretariat S. Favored to go twofor-two in the U.S., Ciro raced off the pace along the rail, moved out six wide for the drive and motored down rivals in the stretch to win under a hand ride. "I wanted him to show me he could stay the mile and a half on soft ground," said winning trainer Christophe Clement, who was saddling Ciro for the first time vesterday, "He won very impressively. He had some trouble in the race. He was boxed in at the threeeighths pole, but Jose [Santos] took him wide for a clear run. We will try to map out a plan to get to the Breeders' Cup. The [Oct. 7 Gl] Turf Classic might be too quick, but there are other options." Santos added, "This horse is something special. He was totally relaxed out there. I asked him to run at the three-eighths pole and he just took off. I never asked him in the stretch."

Second in the 1997 GI Canadian International, the seven-year-old did not make a single start in 1998, won two of his three starts last year, but has had something of a breakthrough year in 2000. The 1/2-length winner of the GIII Bougainvillea H. at Hialeah in his seasonal debut, the gray was third in the GII Hialeah Turf Cup and GII Brooklyn H. on the main, before annexing the GI United Nations H. at Monmouth in his last trip postward July 1. Eighth after the opening mile, jockey Robby Albarado switched the Bill Mott trainee to the outside for the stretch run and caught a very game Crowd Pleaser in the waning strides for the victory.


