COOLMORE VERSUS GODOLPHIN, PART TWO

The middle day of the Tattersalls Houghton Yearling Sales produced more fireworks and featured yet another major bidding duel between the main combatants from Monday's opening session. Coolmore Stud, the most powerful stud operation in the world and Godolphin, the Maktoum-family entity led by Sheikh Mohammed, went toe to toe for lot 105, a colt by Coolmore stallion Sadler's Wells. The colt was consigned to the sale by Bloomsbury Stud as agent for Newmarket's Plantation Stud, which is selling home-bred colts for the first time following the death of owner Lord Howard de Walden. The bay, named Sorcerous (GB), is a half brother to dual Group 1 winner and champion Grand Lodge and was knocked down for a final bid of 2,000,000gns. John Magnier, the Coolmore boss, was once again the successful purchaser when Sheikh Mohammed declined to go above 2 million. While the price may have been somewhat below the European record 3.4 million guineas set Tuesday evening, it still topped the highest price paid for a yearling in Europe last year and was the sixth-highest price ever achieved for a yearling in Europe. Demi O'Byrne of the Coolmore team said, "He is a very nice individual from a lovely family. We thought he might cost this much." The colt will go into training with Aidan O'Brien in Ireland for the Michael Tabor/Sue Magnier partnership and there will be a further chance to buy into the family when another Grand Lodge half-brother, a Zafonic foal, is offered at the Tattersalls December Sales. O'Byrne also signed the next lot for Coolmore as well, a colt by Gone West and the first produce of 1996 G1 Oaks winner Lady Carla (GB), consigned by Wafic Said through Watership Down Stud. Magnier saw off Ahmed Salman of The Thoroughbred Corporation who had earlier gone to 875,000gns for Lot 99, a Barathea (Ire) colt consigned by Barbara Facchino's Barouche Stud. Sheikh Mohammed was the underbidder for the handsome colt out of Karlafsha (Top Ville {Ire}). Salman, who will put the colt into training with John Dunlop in Britain, said, "I thought he was the best horse in the sale. He reminds me of my Derby winner Oath." (Houghton Sale cont. p2)

MINARDI IN THE MIDDLE

It is the time of year to be jostling for position in the ante-post lists for next season's Classics and a major pushing match is set to ensue today with the wraps coming off a number of useful individuals. Minardi (Boundary) was given a a five-length beating, albeit off a slow pace, by Rumpold (GB) in an Ascot maiden July 29. In hindsight, trainer Aidan O'Brien said it may have been unwise to run in that race and he was proved correct when Minardi slammed subsequent G2 Flying Childers winner Superstar Leo (Ire) by five lengths in the G1 Heinz 57 Phoenix S. at Leopardstown Aug. 13. That was some performance and Minardi will justifiably start as the likely favourite. Bad As I Wanna Be (Common Grounds (GB)) upset some more fancied rivals when an impressive winner of the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville Aug. 20. On the evidence of that form, he was favoured to follow up in the G1 Prix de la Salamandre on unsuitable ground at Longchamp Sept. 16. He did not help his cause by pulling hard and finished last of four to Tobougg (Ire). He can be afforded one more chance. Endless Summer (Zafonic) is highly regarded by connections and followed up his maiden win at Newbury July 21 with a fine success in the G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood Aug. 3. His latest outing saw him finish second to Bad As I Wanna Be in the Prix Morny and his overall form puts him in with a solid chance. Bannister (Inchinor {GB}) showed he possesses plenty of ability when winning the G2 Gimcrack S. at York Aug. 23. He is sure to give a good account of himself and has place claims at least.

Middle Market Also Strong

Whereas the upper echelons of the auction action at the first session were dominated by two buyers, others made their presence felt yesterday. Shadwell Estate Company, owned by Sheikh Hamdan al Maktoum, bought two yearlings, lot 83, a Sadler's Wells colt out of Greek Moon (Ire) for 400,000gns and lot 90, a Green Desert colt for 300,000gns. Agent John Warren went to 400,000gns for lot 136, an Indian Ridge (Ire) colt out of the Irish 1,000 Guineas winner Nicer (Ire) (Pennine Walk {Ire}) who continued an excellent sale for vendor Watership Down Stud. The median enjoyed a very healthy 25-percent increase to 150,000gns.

The "Figs"

Record figures were again realized during the second session, with the average coming in at well over 200,000gns for the second-session running (223,338gns), up 35 percent compared to the previous year. Jimmy George, the Tattersalls marketing manager, commented, "Before this week, we have never had a session averaging over 200,000gns."

Sale Wraps Today

The sale concludes today with a session at 5:30 p.m. Some of the highlights could include hip 194, a full brother to Godolphin's G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano winner Best of the Bests; hip 166, a Mark of Esteem (Ire) half brother to Colorspin (Fr), the dam of champions Opera House (GB) and Kayf Tara (GB); and hip 164, a Sadler's Wells filly out of a 1/2 to champions High Estate (Ire) and King's Theatre (Ire).

THE EVERY-OTHER-YEAR SURGE

In 1996, the Houghton sale jumped 50 percent in average from 80,940gns to 122,427. In 1997, they added almost 100 horses and the average dropped back to 106,073gns. They knocked the number back down (224 offered) in 1998, and the average surged 61 percent to 171,357gns. Then last year it dropped back slightly again to 161,232gns.

The every-other-year surge is continuing this year. Though the number offered and sold has dropped again, like Kentucky in July, it works at Houghton. They probably wouldn't want the sale to get any smaller than this, but the numbers, with three-quarters of the sale in the books, are decidedly impressive. Though only 107 have sold (down 31 percent from 156 at this stage last year), the average has shot up another 44 percent, to 234,402gns. The gross is down 1 percent, at 25,081,000 gns. (25,403,000gns last year at this stage), but there's no other way to describe this sale than strong, strong, strong.

The Coolmore team, represented by Demi O'Byrne, was on the warpath yesterday. They bought nine in the session, including the 2 million guineas session topper (the ninth yearling to bring over \$3-million this month). For the sale thus far, Demi has signed for 13, totalling just under 8.9-million gns--35 percent of the gross. There was plenty of action, too, from John Ferguson and several other Arab buying entities, including Shadwell, Gainsborough, and Charlie Gordon-Watson.

Sadler's Wells continues to dominate the sire list. He's now had 19 sell, including the two saletoppers. They have totalled 8,974,000 gns (36 percent of the gross), and averaged 472,315 gns--about \$720,000. But the 88 yearlings by all other sires have still averaged 183,148 gns--just about \$280,000. Not bad.

The three leading first-year sires are Coolmore's Entrepreneur (five averaged 196,000gns) and Desert King (4 for 141,250), and Darley's Singspiel (1 so far, for 140,000). Sinsgpiel has three selling tonight, Entrepreneur two. Desert King is finished for the sale. Among what looks a strong group of sires with their first two-year-olds, Spectrum (2 for 160,000) just heads Mark of Esteem (3 averaged 149,000, two more tonight). Halling (3 avg 91,667, two tonight), Pennekamp (1 for 85,000), and King's Theatre (1 for 110,000) have also had yearlings sell so far.

NYRA TRACKS SUBJECT OF INVESTIGATION

New York state troopers were at Belmont Park, Aqueduct and Saratoga Racecourse Tuesday to collect information as they investigate an allegation of money laundering. The raid was conducted under the auspices of the Attorney General's Organized Crime Task Force and resulted in the confiscation of betting and other financial documents, a source told the New York Post. Sources told the newspaper that some employees at Belmont Park are under suspicion of exchanging traceable money obtained by illegal means for untraceable money, in the form of wagering tickets. While the investigation is taking place at NYRAoperated racetracks, NYRA President Terry Meyocks was quick to point out that his corporation is not under investigation. "In connection with an ongoing investigation, NYRA is assisting federal authorities and providing it with certain documents that it needs. NYRA is not the target of any investigation, federal or state," he said yesterday. "Integrity is our major goal. We won't let the actions of anybody get in the way of that."

GOLD CASE COLT TOPS CBS SALE A colt by Gold Case (Forty Niner) brought a final bid of C\$150,000 to top Tuesday's Canadian Breeders Sales's Yearling Sale at the Woodbine Sales Pavilion in Toronto. Hip number 125, out of the stakes-winning mare Honolulu Gold (Alwuhush), was consigned by Adena Springs, agent, and was purchased by Jimmy Gladwell III. The toppriced filly of the session was hip number 120, a daughter of Tejano Run--Grumble and Grunt (Brave Shot {GB}). Consigned by Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency, agent, the dark bay was purchased for C\$100,000 by Mike Doyle, agent. The sale continues today with a session of breeding stock and horses in training. The results of that portion of the sale will appear in Saturday's edition of the TDN.
