RECORD HOUGHTON SALE ENDS

This year's Tattersalls Houghton Sale, which ended last night in Newmarket, England, broke nearly all records, despite the absence of a seven-figure lot during an extraordinary third and final session which produced a hefty median of 200,000gns. Trade was extremely strong again, even without a headline-grabbing lot, with the session average going over 200,000 for the third consecutive day. The Houghton ended with the average up 45 percent over 1999 and the median up 21 percent. Edmond Mahony, the Tattersalls Chairman, said, "Results from the earlier sales around the world had given cause for optimism but the level of trade we have witnessed over the last three days has exceeded all expectations. The catalogue was quite exceptional with some rare jewels on paper, and the individuals more than matched their pedigrees but we did not truly expect to see the average price break the 200,000-guineas barrier for the first time and to do so by such a margin is remarkable. The overall quality of the yearlings at the sale has been remarked on time after time by buyers and it has been wonderful to see the vendors rewarded so spectacularly." A son of first-season sire Singspiel (Ire) and half brother to Persian Punch (Persian Heights) and Island Magic (Indian Ridge), brought 800,000gns to top yesterday's session of the sale. The battle for Lot 173 went to John Ferguson, sitting alongside Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum, with Rudiger Alles of German International the underbidder. Singspiel raced in Sheikh Mohammed's colour and stands at his Darley Stud in Newmarket. Ferguson said of the colt, "He will race for Godolphin next year. He was an outstanding-looking colt by an extremely promising stallion." Breeder Jan Steinmann of Granham Farm, who used Voute Sales to offer the colt, had a very good day, taking the stallion's 1998 fee of £25,000 into account. The good-looking Nureyev colt, Lot 196, consigned from Timmy Hyde's Camas Park Stud, went for 760,000gns to Coolmore's John Magnier, after it looked like Adrian Nicoll of the BBA (Ireland), with trainer John Gosden next to him, had won the day. A Singspiel filly was in demand by Prince Ahmed Salman's The Thoroughbred Corporation. Salman called the tune for Lot 177 at 400,000gns after a brief flurry of Godolphin interest. Dick Mulhall, the prince's racing manager, said, "The Prince said that we had bought a few colts and it was time to get some fillies."

Minardi was backed from 13-8 in the morning into odds of 6-5 on, and he duly justified that confidence with a convincing display of speed and power. Minardi defeated Superstar Leo by five lengths in the Aug. 13 G1 Independent Heinz 57 Pheonix S. and, when that horse went on to win the G2 Flying Childers S., the portents were good. He missed the kick slightly here, but did not lose a great deal of ground, as stablemate Joplin (Nureyev) took off in front. Michael Kinane was able to get him covered up in midfield tracking Bad As I Wanna Be (Ire) (Common Grounds {GB}). As Joplin folded, Pat Eddery on Bad As I Wanna Be, and Kinane on Minardi looked the threat. Eddery's mount failed to match the favourite's relentless quickening, but Jimmy Fortune had brought Endless Summer through in his slipstream. Minardi was gone, however, making the race his in the final 200 yards. An impressed Kinane said, "He's a good colt, and he has a look. He's a lovely laid-back, free-flowing horse, and there's plenty to come from him. He never overdoes anything through a race, and he covers great ground, although quicker ground would be much more to his benefit." Ladbrokes and William Hill are taking no chances, offering him at 6-1 for the Classic run here next May. Trainer Aidan O'Brien may have more immediate plans for him, however, "We'll see how he comes out of the race but he certainly has to be a possible for the G1 Dewhurst S. (Oct. 14). Michael taught him a lot out there today and he said that he was always feeling confident. He has come on a lot since he won the Pheonix S. at Leopardstown."

THE NEW HOUGHTON RECORD

They've just about got the formula narrowed down at Tatts: cut the book down to between 200-250, go Tuesday and Thursday nights on either side of an all-day Wednesday session, make sure about one of every six yearlings sold is by Sadler's Wells, and make sure Sheikh Mohammed and John Magnier and Michael Tabor show up.

Seriously, though, this Old Firm is to be congratulated, really, on the new record average for a European yearling sale, 141 sold for 32,978,000gns, and an average of 233,886gns--just over \$350,000 at prevailing rates. There's an interesting twist in the figures which means the sale may have actually been even better than that. I finally had Jimmy George explain to me the difference between 'bought by Vendor' and 'not-sold'. Under their new commission charge of 2 1/2 percent for reported buy-backs--set up to encourage reporting of buy-backs--both Vendor and Not-Sold qualify. 'Not Sold' means it didn't meet the reserve in the stand. 'Vendor' means it was signed for as a buy-back, but not on the rostrum. Either way, the vendor pays 2 1/2 percent commission, AND the horse is reported as a not-sold. This means, for the first time, there is a chance of getting some sort of realistic buy-back rate, while the buy-backs also stay eligible for the rich sales races. Got the picture? There'll be a test tomorrow.

What it meant to the rest of us is that Tattersalls reported 181 through the ring, 141 listed sales, 78 percent sold. Looks a realistic figure. But it's also true that, when the sale is compared with previous years when this reporting technique was not in place, it's entirely possible the sales' true gross were actually somewhat lower (perhaps as much as 20 percent lower) than what was being reported. That's why I say this year's sale might have been even better than it looks.

There were two 10-million pound men. Sadler's Wells had 22 sell, including the two sale toppers, for a total gross of 10,099,000gns. That's 16 percent of the sale's yearlings, and they brought 31 percent of the sale's gross. His average was 459,045gns--almost exactly \$700,000. And Demi O'Byrne signed for 16 yearlings, for a total of 9,990,000gns--had he

known, I'm sure he would have thrown in an extra bid. If you add in John Ferguson's 11 purchases for Godolphin, totaling 4,815,000gns, the two titans of the marketplace bought 27 yearlings (one of every five sold), for a total of 14,805,000gns--45 percent of the sale's gross. But of course you also have to add in the various other Maktoum buying groups, and so on.

Singspiel had an 800,000gns colt (John Ferguson) and a 400,000gns filly last night, to end up with four yearlings, which averaged an impressive 346,250gns--over \$528,000. The Coolmore duo of Entrepreneur (seven, averaged 165,000gns-- \$251,000) and Desert King (four, averaged 141,250--about \$215,000) were the other major first-year European sires represented.
