MONTJEU'S ARC DEFENSE HEADS FESTIVAL

With only 10 horses set to go postward for tomorrow's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp, the smallest field since 1946 will be assembled. Heading them is **Montjeu (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), the current 2-1 on favourite with William Hill to follow up last year's success in this race. No horse has won two Arcs since Alleged in 1977-78. Owner Michael Tabor reported yesterday that trainer John Hammond was very happy with the horse, and jockey Michael Kinane added, "It's going to be difficult, and Sinndar is a very good horse, but a strong pace will suit and the best horse will win." **Sinndar (Ire)** (Grand Lodge) is quoted at 5-2 with the same firm, while **Samum (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}) is still 10-1. **Volvoreta (GB)** (Suave Dancer) has dropped from 14-1 to 12-1, while **Egyptband** (Dixieland Band) is 14-1. Surprisingly, no British-trained runners will take part in the contest for the first time since 1963. However, a strong British presence is assured in the rest of the supporting card on Sunday, especially in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac, which has attracted 10 entries, including Group 3 winners **Karasta (Ire)** (Lake Coniston {Ire}) and **Ascension (Ire)** (Night Shift). Twelve will run in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp, including the two-year-olds **Superstar Leo (Ire)** (College Chapel {GB}) and **Iron Mask** (Danzig). The G1 Prix de l'Opera includes G1 Irish and Yorkshire Oaks winner **Petrushka (Ire)** (Unfuwain) and G1 Epsom Oaks winner **Love Divine (GB)** (Diesis {GB}) in its field of 14. The nine declared for the G1 Prix du Cadran, moved from the Saturday, include last year's winner **Tajoun (Fr)** (General Holme).

SEXTET FOR SUPER DERBY

A field of six three-year-olds will meet in today's G1 Super Derby at Louisiana Downs, headed by **Tiznow** (Cee's Tizzy) and **Commendable** (Gone West). Tiznow, a son of 1987 Super Derby third Cee's Tizzy, started his career in April and has progressed rapidly since, winning the GIII Affirmed H. before finishing second to Captain Steve in the GI Swaps S. July 23 at Hollywood Park. The dark colt tried his elders in his last start, chasing Skimming throughout when second in the GI Pacific Classic over 10 furlongs at Del Mar. He will be making his first start outside of his native California, a source of concern to trainer Jay Robbins. "He's a little nervous here," said Robbins. "Normally, he's quiet at home." He breezed a bullet seven panels in 1:25 4/5, handily, at Santa Anita Sept. 21. Classic winner **Commendable** has not visited the winner's circle since his GI Belmont S. triumph June 10, but held well for the show spot in the GI Travers S. at this distance Aug. 26. The third shipper in the field is the consistent **Mass Market** (Marquetry), who is six-for-nine lifetime. A four-length winner of the West Virginia Derby, the chestnut colt was a troubled third over a sloppy strip in the GIII Pennsylvania Derby at Philly Park Sept. 4 in his most recent outing. The home defense is spearheaded by **Chris's Bad Boy** (Marquetry), a 6 1/2-length winner of the Prelude S. over this track Sept. 9. The chestnut breezed seven panels in 1:27 1/5 Sept. 23. "He's doing fine," said trainer Troy Young. "He came out of his work really well and he has been aggressive on the racetrack the last two days, so I think he's ready to go."

GOFFS ARC SALE SET FOR TODAY The average of FF500,000 generated by the Goffs Arc Sale makes it the best sale of its kind in Europe. Fillies in or out of training, destined for a career at stud, last year realized an average of FF725,000. Over the last few years, the sale has produced such major winners as Elmhurst (GI Breeders' Cup Sprint), Urban Sea (G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe), Aube Indienne (Fr) (G1 Yellow Ribbon S.) and Vert Amante (Fr) (G1 Prix Ganay). This year's one-day Arc sale will take place this evening at the Saint-Cloud Goffs sales complex, with bidding beginning at 6:30 p.m., after the running of the last race at nearby Longchamp. The catalogue features 79 horses in training, including several Group and Listed performers, and starts off with the 14-horse dispersal of the John D. Martin horses. Highlighting the Martin dispersal are: two-year-old filly **Allright Now (Fr)** (Cardoun {Fr}), a winner of three races who was second in a Listed stakes; top chaser **Boca Boca (Ire)** (Mandalus {GB}), second in The Nakayama Grand Jump in Tokyo; and four-year-old **Miss Bedouine (Fr)** (Bering {GB}), a winning full sister to Group 2 winner Miss Berbere. Other offerings at the sale sure to attract attention are: Italian filly **Super Tassa (Ire)** (Lahib), a Group 3 winner in France this year who will run in the G2 Prix de Royallieu in the afternoon and go through the ring as hip 18 tonight; **Peneia (Nureyev)**, a three-parts sister to GI Breeders' Cup Mile winner Spinning World; three-year-old **Kathmandu (Fr)** (Kaldounevees {Fr}), a Listed winner this season who was fourth in the G2 Prix Niel last time out; **Mayaro (Fr)** (Saumarez), a multiple Listed-winning four-year-old; **Vatirisk (Fr)** (Linamix {Fr}), a three-year-old colt who made all to win the valuable Prix Sea Bird this past Wednesday; and **Skatesheba (Fr)** (Green Tune), a promising two-year-old filly who captured her second start and will contest the G3 Prix de Condé this afternoon at Longchamp.

King Charlemagne was due to run in the G1 Prix de la Salamandre at Longchamp Sept. 16, but was pulled out because of a stone bruise, so it is clear that he is considered a colt of some ability in a stable brimming with talent. He had been beaten in a highly competitive race at York in August before getting his first win in a Leopardstown maiden shortly after. Here he stepped up in class and, despite drifting from 5-2 favoritism to 11-2, gave trainer Aidan O'Brien his third success of the meeting and put himself in the picture for next year's Classics. Michael Kinane held on to him early as stablemate Cashel Palace (Ire) (Lure) made the running, and he was travelling well while Patsy's Double pulled for his head just in behind. As that horse and Grandera moved up either side of him before the furlong marker, he was temporarily swamped, but Kinane issued encouragement from the saddle and he started to get back into the race. Patsy's Double and Richard Quinn drove towards the line, but they could not shake off the winner, who showed determination to get in front in the final strides to grab the spoils. Quoted as low as 20-1 for next year's G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas with Victor Chandler, his standing was put into perspective by owner Michael Tabor, who said, "He'd be up there with the best, but he wouldn't be the best, and that's why he is in a Group 3 and not a Group 1. He's a good horse and we hope that next year he can go on to better things."

Lady Of Chad was at her destructive best at Deauville Aug. 30 when beating Danzigaway by four lengths in the G2 Prix d'Astarte, but must bounce back from her last run, when last of 11 to Muhtathir (GB) in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois, to figure. The filly was unplaced in Classic company this year in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) and G1 Prix de Diane Hermes (French Oaks), but at this time last year she was winning the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac at Longchamp, which saw her awarded the position as joint-top rated juvenile filly in the International Classifications. Her connections may have most to fear from **Alshakr** and **Danceabout**, who were first and third respectively in the G2 Falmouth S. here on the July Course July 12. Although the winner has not been seen out since, that last effort was her first race since May 14, when she finished third in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches, with Lady Of Chad trailing in behind her.

Although **Sadler's Flag** was sixth last time in the G1 Prix Vermeille here Sept. 10, she had shown the utmost consistency in her races previous to that, not being out of the first three in her eight outings. She ran Interlude (GB) to a short neck in the G2 Prix de Pomone at Deauville July 30 and won the G3 Prix de Royaumont Chantilly June 3. **Inaaq** represents the Godolphin team here and although she has only raced once, when winning a Newmarket maiden in July, she warrants respect. Her sire was successful in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe here in 1995, and she showed the same characteristics first time out, staying on strongly at the end. **Chiang Mai** returned from a lengthy absence to win the G3 Blandford S. at The Curragh Sept. 17 and on that form she is entitled to respect.

Adilabad has been brought along steadily by Sir Michael Stoute this year, not being asked too great a question thus far in his racing. He lost his unbeaten record when fifth in the G3 Craven S. at Newmarket Apr. 20, where he was ridden from the front. After a rest and less aggressive tactics he returned to winning ways when accounting for Summoner (GB) in the Listed Thoroughbred S. at Goodwood Aug. 5, and he followed that up by taking the competitive victory in the G3 Winter Hill S. at Windsor Aug. 26. That day he had **Albarahin** a half-length back in second, but that horse came back to take the Listed Foundation S. at Goodwood ten days ago. They may have too much for **Sobieski**, whose best effort to date came when winning the G2 Prix Eugene Adam at Deauville July 14. He was ridden from behind last time in the G2 Prix Niel here Sept. 10 and never looked like landing a blow on **Sindar** (Ire), but this will be a less daunting task.

Epitre has developed into a promising stayer, winning the Listed Prix de Reux at Deauville Aug. 6, and G3 Prix Lutece here Sept. 3 on his last two outings. On the latter occasion, he showed an exceptional turn of foot and an impressive style of racing, which may prove decisive here. Riddlesdown won a highly competitive handicap earlier in the season under top weight before easily taking a Haydock conditions race Sept. 3. Gold Round was 11th in the G1 Epsom Oaks June 9, but has not been seen out since. If she can return to the sort of form that saw her take the G3 Prix Cleopatre at Saint-Cloud May 12, and if she is suited by the step up in trip, she could be a danger.

We've had a little trouble with him, and patience is paying its rewards now. He'll make a lovely four-year-old."
