MONTJEU IN SEARCH OF REPEAT TRIOMPHE

Turning the clock back twelve months, it was Montjeu (Sadler's Wells) who was the horse looking to seal his reputation in the 1999 Arc de Triomphe. Having taken the G1 French and Irish Derbies, he showed there was real substance to him as he ruthlessly reeled in El Condor Pasa up the straight to record the victory. It is fair to say that today's Longchamp feature is awaited with the same mixture of expectation and trepidation that is always felt when the greats enter their real test. If the Michael Tabor colorbearer was good last year, this year he has been almost impossible to stop; he has become increasingly merciless in his disposing of rivals without ever having to draw on all his reserves. First there was his 1 1/2-length success in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 28, followed by a five-length score in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud July 2. The bay followed with an imperious display in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 29, never coming out of a canter to win by 1 3/4 lengths, and in his most recent effort made light work of the G2 Prix Foy here Sept. 10, winning by 1 1/2 lengths. In all, he has left eight Group 1 winners trailing in his wake so far this year, and he comes into this with a suitably dominant attitude. Sinndar (Grand Lodge), on the other hand, is more or less at the same stage his chief rival was last year, having taken his own two Derbies, at Epsom June 10, and The Curragh July 16. He was a nine-length winner of the latter, and returned to show the benefit of a summer breather by beating Crimson Quest (Ire) by eight lengths without turning a hair in the G2 Prix Niel at Longchamp Sept. 10. Montjeu did not have an older antagonist of his own caliber to deal with last October, despite the merit of El Condor Pasa, something Sinndar's connections will be all too aware of. However, that is the fascination of watching these two go head-to-head here. Nevertheless, that is to take nothing away from the excitement that the presence of the German-trained Samum will generate. He has stormed his way through the G1 BMW Deutsches Derby at Hamburg July 2, and the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden at Baden-Baden Sept. 3, defeating, among others, Catella (Ger), Fruits Of Love, Daliapour (Ire), and Holding Court (GB). Fillies do not have a strong record in this race, but few have entered with the potential of Volvoreta. Last time she returned to form with a sixlength victory in the G1 Prix Vermeille here Sept. 10. (Arc Field p2)

HIS TIME TIZ NOW

Tiznow (Cee's Tizzy) drew off impressively in the GI Super Derby at Louisiana Downs yesterday, setting a new track record of 1:59 4/5 and affirming himself as one of the nation's top three-year-olds in the process. Favored off a second in the GI Pacific Classic, the Calbred hopped slightly at the start, but settled smoothly into stride and led the field into the first turn on a long rein from jockey Chris McCarron. Heading into the backstretch, Commendable (Gone West) ranged up alongside, and the pair raced in tandem through three-quarters in 1:10 3/5. At that point, Tiznow lengthened his stride, quickly opened daylight on his rivals and was ridden out to the line by McCarron for the victory. After breaking his maiden by 8 1/2 lengths May 31, Tiznow tried stakes company and came away with a victory over Dixie Union in the GIII Affirmed H. at Hollywood Park July 1. Second to Captain Steve in the GI Swaps preceded a tilt at his elders in the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar Aug. 26, where he finished second to Skimming. "He's got a good, natural turn of foot to him, so he was able to get his position very easily," McCarron analyzed. "Once he made the lead, he started pricking his ears. Once he relaxed the way he did, I felt very confident." Tiznow is not nominated to the Breeders' Cup and trainer Jay Robbins said any decision to supplement to the Cup would be left up to the owners.

Trainer Mick Channon has produced an array of serious juvenile talent all year, picking up prizes on these shores, and in Ireland, as well as on his home ground. It was this kind of fearless opportunism that saw Ascension take the G3 Prix du Calvados at Deauville Aug. 27. The way she quickened that day to put the race beyond doubt was unforgettable, and the unbeaten filly has been prepared with this race in mind since. She has to cope with Sir Michael Stoute's Karasta, who followed up an impressive success in a Newmarket maiden to take the G3 May Hill S. at Doncaster Sept. 7. After that effort, she was quoted as low as 6-1 favourite for next year's G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket, the impression being that as she is a large filly, she can only improve on her efforts this year. There was a lot to like about the way Green Minstrel won the G3 Prix d'Aumale at Chantilly Sept. 11, having taken a Deauville conditions race the previous month when well backed. She was a comfortable winner from Winter Solstice by threequarters-of-a-length last time, and any improvement from that will see her go close here. Prove created quite an impression when winning her maiden here earlier in the month and she is pitched in at the deep end here, but she may have the quality to cope.

The Highclere Thoroughbred Syndicate have decided to route their star filly Petrushka here, and the decision can pay dividends. The relative disappointment of her runs when third in the G1 1000 Guineas S. at Newmarket May 7, and fourth in the G1 Epsom Oaks June 9 were put behind her with two impressive displays in mid-summer. The first of those, in the G1 Irish Oaks at The Curragh July 16, saw her bounce back to winning ways and the sort of form that connections always belived she was capable of. The second was a resounding success over Love Divine, her Oaks conqueror, in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks at York Aug. 23. That performance put her up with some of the best middledistance performers around. Love Divine followed that performance with a fourth in the G1 Prix Vermeille here Aug. 10, unable to hold off the late rattle of Volvoreta (GB) and Reve D'Oscar, who was second that day. She must hold the greatest danger to Sir Michael Stoute's filly and she has already won at this level in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary here May 21. Timi has raced at the highest level in her country this year, tallying the G1 Oaks d'Italia at Milan May 21, and was a half-length second to Xua when second in the G2 Peremio Regina Elena (Italian 1000 Guineas). It will be interesting to see how she figures in this company.

Although two-year-olds are allowed to take on the older horses here, not many have been chanced, understandably, in this supremely tough five-furlong test. Magic Ring (Ire) tried in 1991, and was a highly creditable third, but he was a particularly precocious type. Two juveniles step forward this year in a bold bid, and both are extremely fast and forward. Criquette Head's Iron Mask followed up success in the Listed Prix de la Vallee d'Auge at Deauville Aug. 15 with the G3 Prix d'Arenberg at Chantilly Aug. 30. He has never been out of the first two, including when he was second in the G2 Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte July 29. Joining him in the challenge is William Haggas' Superstar Leo, who was impressive when winning the G2 Flying Childers S. at Doncaster Sept. 9. Previously she had chased home subsequent G1 Middle Park S. winner Minardi in the G1 Independent Heinz 57 Pheonix S. at Leopardstown Aug. 13. John Oxx's Namid has progressed all season, putting in his best performance when winning the G3 Flying Five at Leopardstown Sept. 9, where Watching was fifth. Previous to that, he had hinted at his capability of winning a race like this when fourth in the G1 Nunthorpe S. at York Aug. 24. That day Pipalong finished a head in front of Richard Hannon's horse in third before going on to win the G1 Sprint Cup at Haydock Sept. 2 from Sampower Star. That was a desrved first Group 1 success, and she will be suited by the return to five furlongs here, although she would prefer it softer.

Last October Tajoun took this race, crowning an impressive season of consistency at the highest level, where he was in the first two in six stakes races. His return this year in the Listed Prix Right Royal at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 11 was successful, but he has failed to win in his next two starts. Fourth to Amilynx (Fr) in the G3 Prix Barbeville here Apr. 30, he then overcame a substantial absence to finish a length third to Orchestra Stall (GB) in the G3 Prix Gladiateur here Sept. 5. Although he will need to improve on those efforts, he is back on his favoured stomping ground here and must be respected. Enzeli regained the winning thread last time in the G3 Doncaster Cup Sept. 7, giving seven pounds and a neck beating to Churlish Charm (GB). Royal Rebel is a consistent, tough colt, and he has taken the G2 Goodwood Cup Aug. 3 and G3 Lonsdale S. at York Aug. 22 this year, enduring two tough battles in the process. If he is in the van at the finish here, he will be extremely hard to beat.

She had been training well and had run a respectable fourth in the Listed Caffrey's Premium Ale Foundation S. at Goodwood Sept. 20, but after reassessing the situation, her connections decided to abort the comeback. O'Rourke said, "She had a slight mishap after her last race and, although she has seemingly recovered from it, she is unlikely to race again. She will be returned to the broodmare band at Dalham Hall Stud." No decision has been made on who Zomaradah will be bred to. She finishes her career with six wins from her 13 starts and earnings of \$658,827.
