GOFFS ORBY OPENS TODAY

The Goffs Orby Sale kicks off today at the Kildare Paddocks in Co. Kildare, Ireland with almost 400 choice lots up for grabs. After the high prices achieved at the Tattersalls Houghton Sales, and following on the heels of the G1 Prix de l'Opera victory of Goffs Orby graduate Petrushka (Ire), the feeling is that the bull market will continue on the Emerald Isle. The top lot could be number 314, a full sister to 1997 champion three-year-old Desert King (Ire). The daughter of Danehill out of Sabaah (Nureyev) is from the Irish National Stud consignment; her champion brother won the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas and G1 Irish Derby in 1997. Another likely to attract attention is number 28, a colt by Danzig out of two-time Canadian champion Alywow (Alysheba), whose half sister by Mr. Prospector realized 1.2 million Irish guineas at this sale last year. Kilcarn Stud sends in lot 102, a bay colt by Spectrum (Ire) out of the top class race mare Danse Royale (Ire) (Caerleon). Danse Royale is herself a daughter of champion Flame Of Tara (Ire) and therefore a half sister to the great Salsabil (Ire), winner of the G1 Irish Derby, G1 Epsom Oaks, G1 English 1000 Guineas and G1 Prix Vermeille in 1990. Camas Park Stud, which offers 22 lots, has a chance of being top vendor. Perhaps the best of their consignment are lot 4, a son of Woodman out of Vilkaia (Nureyev), who was champion sprinter in Europe in 1985 and has produced stakes winner Legend of Russia (GB); and lot 366, a filly by Danehill out of Summerosa (Woodman). Champion sire Sadler's Wells has 13 in the sale, including lot 126, a bay filly out of Final Farewell, who is herself a half sister to the dam of Danehill. Other elite stallions represented in the catalogue are Alzao, Baratha (Ire), Bering (GB), Bluebird, Darshaan (GB), Doyoun (Ire), In The Wings (GB), Kris (GB), Linamix (Fr), Machiavellian and Zafonic. Yearlings by promising young sires such as Charnwood Forest (Ire), Desert King (Ire), Entrepreneur (GB), Revoque (Ire), Singspiel (Ire) and Spinning World, as well as offspring by a number of American-based stallions including Broad Brush, Cozzene, Hennessy, Kingmambo, Miswaki, Nureyev and Storm Bird, are also on offer. Bidding for the opening session of the Orby Sale begins at noon; Wednesday's second session of the two-day auction starts at 11 a.m. The Goffs Challenge Sale, featuring lots 401-661, will be held Thursday, Oct. 5 beginning at 10 a.m.

For the second time, Grand Lodge recorded a dual hemisphere Group 1 double, with Sinndar (Ire) taking the Arc and Shogun Lodge recording a narrow win here. Jockey Glen Boss, standing in for suspended Damien Oliver, rode the perfect rails ride aboard the four-year-old to rally from sixth to first. "It was a magic ride by Glen today. He rode the horse exactly how I asked and we got the right result," said trainer Bob Thomsen. Boss added, "The plan was to ride him cold. I had a lapful of horse topping the rise. I knew he would give me four or five [lengths] when I let him go." Tie The Knot (Aus) (Nassipour) was unplaced, with jockey Darren Beadman providing connections with a detailed explanation of the horse's tendency to hang, but trainer Guy Walter said he was not disappointed. "He was held up in the straight and he was only two or three lengths from the winner. This was a race in which he needed luck and he didn't get a lot of luck," said Walter.

"This is the best horse you have had since Hussar's Command," jockey Justin Sheehan told country trainer Bede Murray after partnering Universal Prince in a barrier trial in April. Murray, who trained Hussar's Command to win the G1 Doomben Cup in 1984, retorted, "You've obviously been on the grog," but Sheehan was proven correct when Universal Prince captured this event. "Justin couldn't get on the phone quick enough to tell me how good Universal Prince was, and he'd just got beaten in a trial," Murray said of the A\$80,000 Inglis Easter graduate. "It took me a little longer to warm to him." Sheehan added, "Bede thought I was full of booze when I rang him. But I knew right from day one Universal Prince was a bloody good horse." The colt will head to Melbourne next Sunday where his main aim is the Victoria Derby. "I can't wait 'til he gets over 2500 meters at Flemington," Sheehan said. "What is going to beat him? He can quicken like nothing else."

Unwordly recorded an impressive win here, with owner Jack Ingham naming her potentially the best filly he'll ever own and jockey Larry Cassidy drawing comparisons with mighty mare Sunline (NZ), who won this race in 1998. Unbeaten at her last two starts, the three-year-old settled third from last. Cassidy made his move approaching the turn and the crowd's odds-on choice scooted away inside the 200 meters to win going away. Ingham's massive Woodlands Stud and Crown Lodge operation has enjoyed a purple patch in recent years under the leadership of trainer John Hawkes, with 45 Group 1 victories including 10 gathered by turf superstar Octagonal (NZ), but filly success at the highest level has been relatively lean. Now Unwordly is poised to even the score. "She is a lovely filly and she was always special, right from the start, but she hasn't beaten all that much," said Hawkes, who opted to stay away from the track for the race. His son Wayne said, "There is no talk of the Cox Plate in our camp. All that has come from the press." Cassidy added, "She is a very exciting filly to ride, extremely easy, you just have to keep out of trouble. I let her ramble up the rise and let her go. She is a different type of filly to Sunline, who was a real speed filly when she won the Flight S., and it is hard to compare them because of what Sunline has gone and done since. But at the same stage, certainly there is nothing between them."

The champion older mare in Canada last year, Magic Code had taken the last two editions of this race. On the board in every start this season, the ultra-consistent performer beat Fleet Pacific in the King County H. at Emerald Downs June 24, then finished second to that filly in four straight, most recently missing by a length in the Sept. 10 Belle Roberts H. at the Washington track. Finally avoiding her arch rival in this test, the chestnut was odds-on to get back to the winner's circle. She emerged from midpack to take the lead as they raced down the stretch and drove to a decisive score.

ALL'S WELL WITH ARC WINNER After the heroics of Sunday, John Oxx reported G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner **Sinndar (Ire)** (Grand Lodge), as well as G1 Prix de l'Abbaye winner **Namid (GB)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) and Saturday's G2 Prix Royalieu winner **Mouramara (Ire)** (Kahyasi {Ire}), in fine order, but the trainer stressed that there are no firm plans for the trio. "They came back late [Sunday] night, but they travelled well and have all eaten up so it is a bonus that they are all right," Hammond said. "Everything went well for the whole weekend--it is great when it all works out. No decision has been made yet [on Sinndar], and there are obviously plenty of considerations other than those of the trainer. The G1 Prix Royal-Oak [at Longchamp, Oct. 22] may be a possibility for Mouramara if the ground was not too heavy for her--she is a good filly, and we will have to see."

I believe Sinndar had European three-year-old honors wrapped up before his oh-so-impressive win in the Arc, despite formidable opposition from Giant's Causeway, but the handicappers are going to find it less easy to nominate Europe's champion three-year-old filly.

The French Oaks winner Egyptband strengthened her claims by reducing Sinndar's winning margin to one-and-a-half lengths in the Arc and, for a second time, showed herself to be three lengths superior to Volvoretta, winner of the G1 Prix Vermeille. Then, in the very next race, the Irish Oaks winner Petrushka again proved herself to be the best of the English fillies by recording her third Group 1 success of the season in the Prix de l'Opera.

I suspect the handicappers will side with Egyptband, but Petrushka is clearly a very, very good filly. She is another example of the expertise of the John Warren-Harry Herbert team which has made the Highclere Thoroughbred Racing syndicates such a success, and she represents another fine advertisement for Ballymacoll bloodlines, even though she was bred by Airlie Stud.

The last Ballymacoll stud book in my possession is the 1999 edition, which contained 34 mares, including an impressive number of Group and Listed winners. But the stud book underlined a perennial problem facing any breeding operation, even one with Ballymacoll's history of producing important winners such as Pilsudski, Troy, Spectrum, Sun Princess and Fastness. The list of Ballymacoll's 19 yearlings included 14 fillies, and fillies also accounted for 12 of Ballymacoll's 17 weanlings.

Obviously, if numbers are to be kept manageable at this 300-acre stud, quite a few of these young fillies will eventually have to be culled. The possibility exists that they will one day do extremely well for other breeders, as has already happened twice this year. Millenary, recent winner of the G1 St Leger, is out of Ballerina, a filly sold by Ballymacoll for 130,000gns in 1994, and Petrushka is out of Ballet Shoes, who was sold for 42,000gns at Tattersalls a year earlier.

The Ballet theme in these two mares' names is an indication that they come from the same family. Ballerina is out of Dancing Shadow, while Ballet Shoes is out of River Dancer, a very smart daughter of Dancing Shadow.

Petrushka has won Group races this year over seven furlongs, 1 1/4 miles and 1 1/2 miles, so she is unusually versatile by European standards. She can thank her sire Unfuwain and her broodmare sire Ela-Mana-Mou for her stamina, and she probably has River Dancer to thank for her speed. Although she stayed a mile well enough to finish third in the French 1000 Guineas, River Dancer showed a lot of speed at two, winning the Listed Prix Yacowlef over five furlongs and finishing second, a nose ahead of the great Miesque, in the G1 Prix Morny over six.

Ela-Mana-Mou's stamina normally dominated his mates, as he showed by siring stayers of the calibre of Double Trigger, Snurge, Almaarad, Eurobird and Sumayr, but he didn't come close to dominating River Dancer. Their daughter, Ballet Shoes, raced exclusively over sprint distances, winning twice over five furlongs at three. Spectrum, a half-brother to Ballet Shoes, established himself as one of Rainbow Quest's fastest sons by winning the Irish 2000 Guineas, but he stayed well enough to become a Group 1 winner over 1 1/4 miles, so Ballet Shoes was a bit of a freak.

Petrushka has the Breeders' Cup as her immediate objective, but the Arc could be part of her 2001 schedule. Her family nearly provided a winner of this great race in 1983, when Sun Princess--a classic-winning half-sister to Petrushka's third dam, Dancing Shadow--finished second of 26. Dancing Shadow's half-brother Saddlers' Hall contested the 1992 Arc. This is an exceptional family and Petrushka must now be worth many times the IR110,000gns she cost as a yearling.

ARLINGTON POSTS SIGNIFICANT GAINS

Arlington International Racecourse wrapped up its first race meeting since 1997 Saturday with large increases in both attendance and handle compared to the Illinois totals during the same period in 1999. Wagering on Illinois racing from all sources rose by 62 percent to an average of over \$3.2 million per day, a figure which also represents a 22-percent gain on the corresponding figure from the live meet at Arlington in 1997. Daily on-track handle was \$637,664, a 133-percent improvement on the Illinois average from 1999. Attendance averaged 6,709 for the 103-day meet, better than two-and-a-half times the figure for the same period a year ago. Mark Guidry was the leading rider of the meet with 132 wins, while trainer Wayne Catalano topped the trainer standings, saddling 37 winners for his first-ever Arlington title.

UNBRIDLED JET TO COUNTRY LIFE

Unbridled Jet (Unbridled--Easy Summer, by Easy Goer), perhaps best remembered for his unlucky fourth-place finish in the 1999 GI Haskell H., will stand the 2001 breeding season at Country Life Farm in Bel Air, Maryland for a fee of \$7,500. The four-year-old broke his maiden at second asking at two and was the five-length winner of a Keeneland allowance in his first start at three. Second by a head in Monmouth's Long Branch Breeders' Cup S. prior to the Haskell, the dark bay was second by a nose in the GI Pegasus H. to close his sophomore season. He took a Gulfstream allowance this past January by 12 1/4 lengths, but injured a suspensory while preparing for the GI Donn H. Put back into training by Bill Mott over the summer, he suffered a recurrence of his injury and was retired with three wins and two seconds from 13 starts and earnings of \$255,363.

SMOKE GLACKEN COLT TOPS MIDLANTIC OPENER

A bay colt from the first crop by champion sprinter Smoke Glacken (Two Punch) out of Swingin' Sister (Dixieland Band) brought a final bid of \$200,000 to top the opening session of the 2000 Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Eastern Fall Yearling Sale, held in Timonium, Maryland yesterday. From the consignment of Muirfield Ventures and William Roberts, the half brother to graded stakes-placed Swingin Verse (Opening Verse) was purchased by Jan, Mace and Samantha Siegel. The top-selling filly, a daughter of Cozzene out of stakes winner Space Warning (Caveat) named Lujien Lujien, attracted a final bid of \$170,000 from William Clifton. She was consigned by Ryehill Farm, with Litz Bloodstock Services as agent. The three-day sale continues today, with bidding beginning at 10 a.m.

Gov. Davis Vetoes Bill:

California Gov. Gray Davis has vetoed the bill which would have legalized Internet and telephone account wagering in the state. The legislation also included provisions which would improve the working and living conditions of California's backstretch workers. Davis said, "If this bill contained only the backstretch provisions, I would sign it. However, I cannot support the provisions lifting the state ban on Internet and telephone wagering. It would expand the scope of gambling by allowing Internet and telephone betting on out-of-state and out-of-country horse races, and it would allow continual betting through commercial betting systems without being limited by the racing season." Davis also cited concerns that the bill would give children access to placing bets.
