DANZIG COLT TOPS GOFFS OPENER

A colt by Danzig out of Canadian champion Alywow brought a final bid of Ir£2 million from John Magnier to top yesterday's opening session of the Goffs Orby Sale in County Kildare, Ireland. "We have been very lucky with the sire and he is one of the most important stallions in the world," said Magnier. "He'll go to Ballydoyle." The underbidder was Sheikh Hamdan al Maktoum who dropped out of the bidding at £1.8 million. The yearling was consigned by Kilcarn Stud. Lot 102, a son of Spectrum (Ire) out of the Caerleon mare Danse Royale (Ire) realized the session's second highest price. The bay colt, also consigned by Kilcarn Stud, was purchased by Shadwell Estates with a final bid of £900,000. "He has a wonderful pedigree and is from a super family and by a stallion that has had a very good first season," Hubie De Burgh, speaking for Shadwell, commented. No trainer has been picked out for the yearling. Top price for a filly at the session was the £300,000 paid for lot 10, a daughter of Darshaan (GB)--Whispered Melody (GB), by Primo Dominie (GB). Consigned by Camas Park Stud, the filly was purchased by Anthony Stroud Bloodstock. "I liked the pedigree and I liked the filly," Stroud commented. "We were knocking heads a bit at Newmarket last week, so we decided to get in early today." During the opening session, the average sale price rose 48 percent over the 1999 figure and the median rose 22 percent. Although 10 fewer horses sold at yesterday's session, the aggregate still rose by 40 percent. The sale's final session begins today at 11 a.m.

PETRUSHKA KENTUCKY BOUND *Petrushka (Ire)* (Unfuwain) is still on target for an attempt at the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Churchill Downs, it was revealed yesterday. British bookmaking firm Corals have already issued ante-post prices for the race and have *Petrushka* as 2-1 favourite ahead of 4-1 second choice **Perfect Sting** (*Red Ransom*). Tim Jones, of owners Highclere Thoroughbred Racing Ltd said, "She has come out of her last race nicely and has returned home. Hopefully we will be all systems go now to the Breeders' Cup in November. Obviously we have got a month on tenterhooks while we hope to keep her right in preparation for it, but so far so good, she's done everything we could have expected." The Airlie Stud-bred filly won her third Group 1 race of the year in Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp. Having finished fourth in the G1 Vodafone Oaks at Epsom June 9, she went on to win the G1 Kildangan Stud Irish Oaks at The Curragh July 16 and secured the middle leg of her hat-trick in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks at York Aug. 23.

 Having tasted success when winning the Listed Grand Prix de Compiègne July 5, Aboard has not entered the winner's circle in three subsequent starts. Out of his depth when unplaced behind *Greek Dance (Ire)* in the G1 Bayerisches-Zuchtrennen at Munich July 30, he then finished in the money on his next two starts, when he was fourth to *Elle Danzig (Ger)* in the G3 Spreiti-Rennen at Baden-Baden Aug. 25 and runner-up to the same rival in the G2 Arthur Andersen Euro Cup at Frankfurt Sept. 17. Performing at somewhere near his best the five-year-old entire doubled his group race tally here with a comfortable win. Racing prominently, Aboard was positioned third or fourth as *Feenkönig (Ger)* (*Le Glorieux {GB}*) and *Karakal (Ger)* (*Dashing Blade {GB}*) disputed the early running. *Feenkönig* had the slight measure of *Karakal* approaching the final quarter mile, but began to fade quickly as Aboard seized the lead. With jockey Piotr Piatkowski keeping Aboard perfectly balanced, the pair ran on relentlessly to the wire for a comfortable score. *Rosolaw* finished best of the remainder to claim second in the closing stages with *Sambakonig* gaining the judge's verdict in a photo for third.

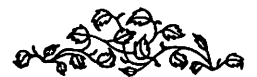
West Coast favorite Budroyale didn't win a stakes of any kind until he was five, and reached his peak last year at the age of six, when he captured three graded events and finished a close second in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. Such continued improvement speaks volumes for the potential of Budroyale's three-year-old brother Tiznow. Last weekend, on only his seventh start, three-year-old Tiznow powered home six lengths clear of GI Belmont S. victor Commendable to take the GI Super Derby in a new track record time. Since capturing his maiden at the end of May, Tiznow has spent the rest of his short career running against the best. The results have been extremely impressive with his Super Derby triumph being preceded by a victory over Dixie Union in the GIII Affirmed H., a second to Captain Steve in the GI Swaps S. and a second to Skimming in the GI Pacific Classic.

Tiznow is a son of Cee's Tizzy, a California-based son of Relaunch, who is proving himself a very useful sire. Cee's Tizzy only started six times, but he clearly had ability as he broke his maiden at Hollywood Park by six lengths, and won a pair of allowance contests at Del Mar. Cee's Tizzy's maiden and allowance wins were at six furlongs to a mile, but he also demonstrated that he owned stamina as well as speed, with a third to Home At Last and Unbridled over ten furlongs in the GI Super Derby.

Retired to Harris Farms in Coalinga, California, Cee's Tizzy began his stud career covering relatively small books of mostly modest mares. He has made the most of his opportunities, however, and from just over 202 foals from his first six crops (his sixth crop being three-year-olds of 2000) has sired six stakes winners and 16 stakes placed horses. In addition to Cee's Tizzy and Budroyale, these also include Gourmet Girl, who captured last year's GI Milady Breeders' Cup H. and Theresa's Tizzy, winner this year of the GIII Rancho Bernardo H. *Cont. p. 5*

GOFFS ORBY DAY ONE

Since Goffs took their flagship Orby yearling sale back to a two-day format in 1996, the results had been relatively stable. Going back and converting previous years into Irish punts rather than guineas (Goffs began reporting sales in punts in 1999), the average ranged from Ir£ 64,678 in 1996, hit its high of Ir£ 72,670 in 1997, and settled at Ir£ 69,415 last year. Those days are gone.

Never in their wildest dreams would the Goffs team have imagined their opening session yesterday would break the Ir£100,000 average mark, yet that is exactly what it did--175 yearlings grossed Ir£ 18,011,000 (82 percent of the whole sale's gross in 1996, in one night), averaging a blockbuster Ir£102,920. The gross was up 40 percent from last year's opening session, the average up 48 percent. The champagne corks were poppin'.

There were some very impressive numbers rung up on the scoreboard. John Magnier outbid Sheikh Hamdan for the session-topper, a Danzig colt out of dual Canadian champion Alywow, at Ir£2,000,000. Sheikh Hamdan came back to take home the Ir£900,000 Spectrum colt, also from Miss O'Kelly's Kilcarn Stud consignment. There were also two colts who brought Ir£550,000 (a Grand Lodge colt, to Peter Doyle), and Ir£ 540,000 (a Spinning World colt, to The Thoroughbred Corp.). So four colts brought more than Ir£500,000. In all, 21 yearlings brought Ir 200,000 or more. I'll venture it's been a few years since that happened.

It was fitting that Danzig had an Ir£ 2-million yearling, because he had a huge day in Paris on Sunday--well, at least his branch of the incomparable Northern Dancer sire line did. Not only did Sinndar (by Grand Lodge, by Chief's Crown, by Danzig) score an impressive win in the Arc, but also Danzig's first-crop son Anabaa, the champion European sprinter of 1996, had the winner of the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac (1m, 2yo fillies) in the de Moussac family's Amonita. That was after Danehill became the top 2yo sire in GB/Ire last week.

Our reports from the field suggested the most important factor yesterday was the Ir£200,000+ individual. It wasn't so much a question of which sire it was--the ones who had the right individuals, the complete package, got the 200,000+, pretty much regardless of who the sires were. So a look at first-day sire averages, to some extent, just tells us which sires had those 21 yearlings. It also created some weird anomalies in comparing averages and medians (the session median was up 22 percent, just half the percentage increase in average, from Ir£45,000 to Ir£55,000). Spectrum, for example, had eight yearlings sell yesterday. One made Ir£ 900,000, one made Ir£78,000, and the other six all brought Ir£ 40,000 or under. So Spectrum averaged Ir£143,250--but his median was just Ir£33,000.

There were seven European-based first-year sires which had two or more sell yesterday. Surprisingly, Coolmore's two lead first-year sires, Desert King and Entrepreneur, ranked just fourth and fifth on yesterday's table. It was Danehill Dancer, a resident of Coolmore's satellite farm Kilsheelan, who actually took opening day honors, with two colts bringing Ir£200,000 and Ir£85,000 respectively. With his Ir£540,000 colt, Coolmore Kentucky first-year stallion Spinning World had three average Ir£263,333. But you'd have to say the top six European first-year sires represented on this table turned in impressive commercial performances.

Tiznow and Budroyale are out of Cee's Song, a daughter of the up-and-coming broodmare sire, Seattle Song. Of course, Seattle Song is by Seattle Slew, and we think we may have detected the beginnings of an affinity between Relaunch and Seattle Slew. Relaunch himself sired the fast two-year-old Slew Gin Fizz--now a leading sire in South America--out of a Seattle Slew mare. With the cross reversed, there are two graded stakes winners by Seattle Slew's otherwise unheralded son, Breeders Bonus out of a Relaunch mare, and another by Metfield out of a Relaunch mare.

There is one obvious reason that Seattle Slew and Relaunch should work well together. Seattle Slew is out of a mare inbred to the sisters Striking and Busher, both out of La Troienne's daughter, Baby League. The Axe II's granddam is La Troienne's daughter, Big Event. To make the connection even closer, Baby League is by Bubbling Over, a horse who appears as the broodmare sire of Blue Larkspur, the sire of Big Event (making Baby League and Big Event five-eighths sisters). It is worth noting that there are several other good Seattle Slew's with The Axe II in their pedigree, including Grade I winners Thirty Slews and American Gipsy and English champion two-year-old Digression. Relaunch is an up-and-coming broodmare sire, so it will obviously pay to consider sending his daughters to sires carrying Seattle Slew, and also to try Relaunch's highly promising son, Honour and Glory with Seattle Slew-line mares.

There is a second important connection involving The Axe II in the pedigrees of Cee's Tizzy and Budroyale. The Axe II is a product of the Whitney patented Mahmoud/Equipoise (or Equipoise family) combination. He's actually by Mahmoud out of a mare by Equipoise's son, Shut Out. The third dam of Cee's Tizzy and Budroyale is by Pia Star, who was out of the mare, Inquisitive. She was by Mahmoud, and her granddam was a sister to Equipoise.

PEDIGREE SHORTS

He's called Walkslikeaduck, but he seems to run like the wind lately. In his last two starts, **Walkslikeaduck (c, 3, Blushing John--Nabla, by Theatrical {Ire})** has captured the GII Del Mar Derby and GIII Bay Meadows Breeders' Cup Derby. Walkslikeaduck's sire, Blushing John, was by Blush-

ing Groom (Fr), a grandson of *Nasrullah, out of a mare by Prince John. Tucked away at the bottom of Walkslikeaduck's pedigree, as sire of the third dam, we find Torsion, who was a grandson of Nasrullah out of a Prince John mare, and so bred on a very similar cross to Blushing John.

The G1 Prix Marcel Boussac Royal Barriere winner **Amonita (GB) (f, 2, Anabaa--Spectacular Joke, by Spectacular Bid)** has an unusual linebreeding to the Somethingroyal family. She is a member of the first crop of Anabaa, a horse who has Sir Gaylord (out of Somethingroyal) in the center of his pedigree. Amonita's fourth dam, Imperial Hill, is by Hill Prince (by Princequillo) out of Imperatrice, and is, therefore, a three-quarters sister to Somethingroyal.

Sudden Storm (h, 5, Storm Bird--Secret Imperatrice, by Secretariat), winner of the \$100,000 Louisiana Downs H., has a pedigree which combines the obvious and the not so obvious. He's bred on the same Storm Bird/Secretariat cross as Storm Cat and Summer Squall. In addition, however, his third dam, Time For Art, is by Nearctic out of a Native Dancer mare, making her a three-parts genetic relative to Storm Bird's sire, Northern Dancer.

THIS DATE IN HISTORY...

Oct. 4, 1970...Nijinsky II's 11-race winning streak came to an end when he finished second to Sassafras (Fr) in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp.

Oct. 4, 1980...Less than an hour before post time, **Spectacular Bid** was scratched from the Jockey Club Gold Cup, which was to be the final race of his career. The colt was retired after going nine-for-nine on the season; he was named 1980's Horse of the Year.

Oct. 4, 1989...Secretariat was euthanized at Claiborne Farm in Paris, Kentucky due to complications from laminitis. He was 19.

UCANDOITTOO breaks her maiden by 5 lengths on Saturday

STAR DE NASRKA DEAD Star de Naskra (Naskra) was put down at Darby Dan Farm in Lexington, Kentucky yesterday due to the infirmities of old age. The champion sprinter of 1979, he was 25. Star de Naskra sired graded stakes winners Sewickley, Dance Floor, Carr de Naskra, Storm and Sunshine, Staraway, Pampered Star, Dumdedumdedum, Star de Lady Ann, Tenacious Tiffany, Chart the Stars and Ask de Naskra. "He was a superb racehorse and an excellent stallion," said John Phillips, managing partner of Darby Dan. "We were privileged to be associated with Bill DuPont and the many fine shareholders. It was a long and good run." Star de Naskra was pensioned earlier this year.

RICE TO DISPERSE Clyde Rice has announced that he will disperse his Indian Prairie farm over the next several months, beginning Nov. 5 at Fasig-Tipton's Selected Mixed Sale in Kentucky. Rice will sell the graded stakes winning mares **Prairie Princess** (Rocky Mountain) and **Rapid Selection** (Sabona), in foal to Awesome Again, in November, as well as weanlings by Favorite Trick, End Sweep and Storm Creek. "We want to travel, visit the kids more often," explained Rice. "It's tough to find time to do that if you have a farm to run and a lot of horses to care for. By next summer we will have sold all our Thoroughbreds. Indian Prairie will go on the market and we'll look for a smaller home in the Ocala area," explained Rice. Indian Prairie will offer the balance of its mares between Fasig-Tipton Kentucky's December Mixed Sale and OBS January Sale.

GO FOR GIN COLT TOPS FASIG-TIPTON A colt by Kentucky Derby winner Go For Gin brought \$315,000 to top yesterday's second session of the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Eastern Fall Yearling Sale in Timonium, Maryland. The yearling, out of the unraced mare Crone's Nest (Topsider), was consigned by Walnut Green, agent and was purchased by John Terranova II. The average price of the session rose 22 percent compared to last year's corresponding figure. Through two days of the three-day auction, the average price has increased 10.9 percent over 1999. The sale continues today at 10 a.m.

DERBY WAGERING INTERESTS EXPANDED?

Churchill Downs is considering expanding the individual wagering interests in the Kentucky Derby from 14 to 20--the maximum number of horses allowed in the Classic. The change would eliminate entries in the Derby since currently the only possible multi-horse interest in the race is the mutuel field. The Kentucky Racing Commission earlier eliminated the possibility of a coupled entry when it voted to allow horses with common ownership to run as separate wagering interests in Kentucky stakes races with purses of \$1 million or more. That change became effective at mid-year and will be in place for the Breeders' Cup Championship at Churchill Downs on Nov. 4. The expansion of Kentucky Derby wagering interests would require regulatory approval by the Kentucky Racing Commission, which is expected to consider the issue at its Oct. 30 meeting. "We think that making each horse in the Kentucky Derby an individual wagering interest will make this classic race more exciting for Derby fans at every level," said Alex Waldrop, Churchill Downs president. "It will allow skilled handicappers to receive good value on attractive Derby longshots that, in the past, have seen their odds diminished by their placement in an entry of the mutuel field. The proposal should also make the prospect of placing a wager on the Derby less confusing for casual fans and newcomers to our sport." Churchill Downs last expanded the number of wagering interests in the Kentucky Derby and its other major stakes races in 1998, when the maximum number of wagering interests grew from 12 to 14--the maximum number of starters allowed in Breeders' Cup races.
