NUMBERS UP AT GOFFS ORBY

The Goffs Orby Sale concluded yesterday in Co. Kildare, Ireland, with substantial increases in aggregate, average and median. Leading the way during yesterday's final session was lot 314, a full sister to champion **Desert King (Ire)**, bought by Chryss O'Reilly for Ir£650,000. The bay filly was produced from the Nureyev mare Sabaah, herself a half sister to champion Maroof. "She's a beautiful filly, and she'll go home to Castlemartin Stud, and we'll decide on a trainer for her in about a month's time," said Jim Kelly, O'Reilly's racing manager. The top price for a colt was Ir£550,000, realised by lot 217, a colt from the first crop of 2000 Guineas winner **Entrepreneur (GB)**. Out of the stakes-winning mare Marie d'Argonne (Fr) (Jefferson {GB}), the bay is a half brother to champion sprinter **Polar Falcon (Nureyev)** and was purchased by Dermot Forde. "I have bought this colt for Countess Rossi di Montelara and he'll be trained by Nicholas Clement," said Forde. "The dam has already produced a Group 1 winner, and he is one of the few in the catalogue who is a half brother to a Group 1 winner." Overall, the aggregate rose 36 percent from last year, while the average climbed 41 percent and the median went up by 29 percent. Donn McLean, general manager of Irish Thoroughbred Marketing, expressed great satisfaction with the amount of overseas buyers at the Goffs Orby Sales. "There are new buyers here this week, and one of the newest markets for us would be the Norwegian market; they bought a total of five lots to date and we hope they will be active again tomorrow at the Challenge Sales," McLean said.

MILLENNIUM TO COVER STELLAR BOOK

Recently retired G1 Dubai World Cup winner Dubai Millennium (GB) (Seeking the Gold) will cover a book of mares dotted with Grade/Group 1 winners from both sides of the Atlantic. Under an agreement with Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum, 35 selected mares from the U.S. will be brought to Dalham Hall Stud in Newmarket, England, to be bred to the four-year-old. The mares will be boarded and cared for at Sheikh Mohammed's expense, along with the foals they are currently carrying, before being returned to the States. A similar number of mares from Europe and Sheikh Mohammed's broodmare band will also be bred. North American mares scheduled to be sent to England include champion two-year-old of 1996 Storm Song (Summer Squall), GI Ashland S. winner Well Chosen (Deputy Minister), multiple Grade I winner November Snow (Storm Cat) and Fire the Groom (Blushing Groom {Fr})--a Grade I winner and dam of European champion sprinter Stravinsky. Most of the foals will be owned in partnership between the mare owners and Sheikh Mohammed. The partnerships will be subsequently dissolved when the foals are sold at auction as yearlings, Lexington bloodstock agent Reynolds Bell told *Blood-Horse* online. Dubai Millennium is set to stand his first season at Dalham Park next year for £100,000.

Senator Ken Maddy H. cont.

A Listed stakes winner in her native England in 1998, Evening Promise went winless in nine tries last season and closed the European portion of her career with a second-place finish in the rich Ayr Gold Cup Sept. 18. Shipped to the U.S., the four-year-old strung together three consecutive victories this past spring, culminating with a one-length success in the GIII Las Cienegas H. over course and distance Apr. 15, her last victory to date. The bay was most recently sixth in the GIII Palomar H. at Del Mar going two turns Aug. 16, but was returning to Arcadia, where she sported a three-for-four career mark and two-for-three at the distance. Strawberry Way, the longest shot on the board, took the early initiative and established realistic fractions down the hill as Evening Promise raced unhurriedly. Jockey Kent Desormeaux aboard the latter bided his time into the stretch, asked his filly to pick it up with a furlong and a half to run and she rallied down the middle of the stretch to snatch victory from Strawberry Way. Southern House, making her U.S. debut, finished well for third. "She really likes this course," winning trainer Kathy Walsh commented. "She's going to be in the November Racing and Breeding Sale at Keeneland. She's got another great year of racing ahead of her."

GOFFS DAY TWO

Really about the only difference between yesterday and Monday was the Ir£2-million yearling. There were 176 sold yesterday--175 on Monday--and the gross was Ir£16,372,000--about Ir£1.65-million below Monday's gross. The number of Ir£500,000-Ir£1 million yearlings was the same--three each day--and even the number of Ir£ 200,000-Ir£ 499,000 yearlings was exactly the same--17 each day.

So the overall sale grossed Ir£34,383,000, an increase of 36 percent, and the average just missed the Ir£100,000 barrier, still averaging Ir£97,957, a huge 41-percent jump from last year. The median rose more yesterday, finishing at Ir£58,000, a 29-percent increase over last year. All in all, a blockbuster sale.

Lots of fireworks. Augurs well for the October sale, back at Newmarket, next week, too. Sire statistics (unofficial, compiled by the correspondent), Goffs Orby only:

Potaro provided another stakes French success for the combination of Brian Meehan and Gerald Mosse here. Although he had not shown anything like the class of his stablemate, G1 Prix Morny winner Bad As I Wanna Be (Ire), he is nevertheless a useful individual, having taken five runs to win, despite showing up well in maidens and nurseries in Britain. Here he was ridden from the front to pulverise his rivals and take his first stakes race. Although he was drawn wide, the lack of early pace allowed Mosse the chance to get him across to the rail and to the front. He led them along until the turn into the straight, where he was asked to go on, and he responded to stretch the field, galloping on under a far-from-forceful ride to win comfortably.

The session topper Wednesday was hip number 607, a son of Crafty Prospector out of the Topperside mare Just Tops. The yearling, consigned by Lochlow Farm with Welker Sales Agency as agent, was purchased for \$110,000 by Marathon Farms. At the session, the average declined 10 percent over the third session of 1999. Overall at the three-day sale, the average rose 4.1 percent compared to last year. A total of 159 horses were reported as not sold this year, while 164 did not sell last year.

Ciro To Pass Turf Classic:

Ciro (Woodman), winner in his most recent start of the GIII Lawrence Realization H. at Belmont Park Sept. 24, will pass on this weekend's GI Turf Classic and will instead wait for the Breeders' Cup Turf Nov. 4. The winner of the GI Secretariat in his American debut Aug. 19 worked four furlongs around the dogs on the inner turf course in :50 4/5 yesterday morning. "He went easily and I was pleased with the work," said trainer Christophe Clement. "But I think the Turf Classic is a little too close to his last race. He's earned his trip to Churchill Downs."

Hennig Juveniles Gearing Up:

Undefeated **Gold Mover** (Gold Fever), unraced since a neck victory in the GII Schuylerville at Saratoga July 26, breezed five furlongs in 1:00 breezing as she prepares for her return to the races in the GII Astarita Oct. 15. The chestnut was sidelined with inflamed shins for most of the summer, but has returned to regular training with no ill effects. "Her shins are perfectly fine," trainer Mark Hennig said. "She's doing super. The Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies is still a possibility with her." The conditioner also confirmed that his other undefeated filly, **Raging Fever** (Storm Cat), will make her next appearance in the GI Frizette Oct. 14. GOFFS CHALLENGE SALE PREVIEW With 260 yearlings catalogued, Goffs will hold its Challenge Sale at the Kildare Paddocks this afternoon. Graduates of the sale will be eligible for the Goffs Ir£100,000 Challenge Race in 2001. Last year saw 223 yearlings sell for an aggregate of Ir£3,615,000 at an average price of Ir£16,211. Proven sires represented include Alzao (USA), Cadeaux Genereux (GB), Danehill (USA), Desert Style (Ire), Grand Lodge (USA), Indian Ridge (Ire), Kris (GB) and Unfuwain (USA), while some of this year's leading freshman sires also have youngsters on offer, including Ashkalani (Ire), Charnwood Forest (Ire), General Monash (USA), Pennekamp (USA), Spectrum (Ire) and Tagula (Ire). Among this year's first-year sires are Alhaarth (Ire), Ali-Royal (Ire), Benny the Dip (USA), Danehill Dancer (Ire), Desert King (Ire), Entrepreneur (GB), Louis Quatorze (USA), Octagonal (NZ), Revoque (Ire) and Zamindar (USA).

VOLVORETA TO JAPAN CUP Trainer Carlos Lerner reported yesterday that his star three-year-old filly **Volvoreta (GB)** (Suave Dancer {USA}) has come out of Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp in great shape. Having filled third place behind Sinndar (Ire) and Egyptband (USA) there, she is now due to go to the G1 Japan Cup at Tokyo Nov. 26. Lerner stated that, providing the filly remains in good form until then and her preparation satisfies, she will take part in the great international event.

LEND A HAND RETIRED Godolphin's **Lend a Hand (GB)** (Great Commotion {USA}--Janaat {GB}, by Kris {GB}) has been retired and will enter stud at Darley's Kildangan Stud in Ireland. He will stand for Ir£5,000, Oct. 1 terms. A champion at two in Italy following his victory in the G1 Gran Criterium in 1997, he finished second to King of Kings (Ire) in the 2000 Guineas at three and was third later that year in the G1 Sussex S. At four, Lend a Hand captured the Nad al Sheba Mile from Muhtathir (GB) and Cape Cross (Ire) as well as the G3 Hungerford S., and closed out 1999 with a fourth in the G1 Breeders' Cup Mile. The five-year-old started 2000 in good style, defeating Pipalong (GB) and Bold Edge (GB) in the G3 Duke of York S. in May and concluded his career with a second to Bold Edge in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest in August at Deauville. He retires with a record of 18-7-5-2 and \$563,245 in earnings. "Lend a Hand is a wonderful physical specimen, and he showed outstanding Group 1 from every season from two to five," said Joe Osborne, managing director of Kildangan Stud.

WEEKEND OUTLOOK Trainer Aidan O'Brien again dominates the 17 entries for Sunday's G1 Grand Criterium at Longchamp. He has G1 National S. (The Curragh, Sept. 17) first and second **Beckett (Ire)** (Fairy King {Ire}) and **King's County (Ire)** (Fairy King {USA}), and **Honours List (Ire)** (Danehill {USA}), runner-up in the G1 Prix de la Salamandre here Sept. 16, among the nine Ballydoyle horses left in yesterday. The home defence is made up almost entirely of representatives of Criquelette Head, who has four entered, including impressive G3 Prix de la Rochette (Chantilly Sept. 20) winner **Okawango (USA)** (Kingmambo {USA}), and **Mizzen Mast (USA)** (Cozzene {USA}), a nose runner-up here Sept. 10 in the G3 Prix des Chenes. **CD Europe (Ire)** (Royal Academy {USA}), runner-up to Noverre (USA) in the G2 Champagne S. at Doncaster Sept. 7, is also entered, forming part of trainer Mick Channon's overseas raid this weekend. He also has **Golden Silca (GB)** (Inchior {GB}) and **Barathea Guest (GB)** (Barathea {Ire}) entered in the G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua at Milan on Sunday, in which the German-trained **Sumitas (Ger)** (Lomitas {GB}) is a likely contender. **Innit (Ire)** (Distinctly North {USA}), impressive winner of the Listed Prix Herod at Chantilly Sept. 13, and Listed Premio Novella at Milan Sept. 23, is also in the G3 Premio Dormello on the same card.

INDIAN LODGE TO RATHBARRY Indian Lodge (Ire) (Grand Lodge {USA}--Repetitious {Ire}, by Northfields {USA}) has been purchased by Rathbarry Stud's Liam Cashman and will retire to the Irish farm for the 2001 breeding season. The four-year-old captured the G1 Prix du Moulin at Longchamp Sept. 3 and was seventh in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot in his last outing, and will make his next appearance in the G1 Dubai Champion S. at Newmarket Saturday week. Out of the stakes-winning mare Repetitious, the bay colt is a half brother to G2 winner Sarhoob (USA) (Alydar {USA}) and G3 winner Sifting Gold (USA) (Slew O'Gold {USA}). His 2001 stud fee will be announced shortly.
