BRUSHWOOD BUYS EXCELLENT MEETING

Betty Moran's Brushwood Stable has purchased multiple graded-stakes winner **Excellent Meeting** (General Meeting--Fitted Crown, by Chief's Crown) from John and Betty Mabee's Golden Eagle Farm, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The four-year-old will be bred to Storm Cat in February. Excellent Meeting captured four Grade I events: the 1998 Hollywood Starlet, 1999 Santa Anita Oaks, 1998 Oak Leaf S. and 1999 Las Virgenes. She finished second in the 1998 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and fifth in the 1999 Kentucky Derby. "It was a no-brainer to do this," Moran told the *Form*. "She was a very good racemare with a good pedigree." The purchase price was not disclosed.

Team Valor Buys Interest in Le Grande Danseur:

Team Valor has purchased a controlling interest in undefeated two-year-old **Le Grande Danseur** (Citidancer). The colt most recently captured the Oct. 1 Bertram Bongard S. at Belmont by 5 3/4 lengths. Team Valor will campaign Le Grande Danseur with Team Five Star Stable and he will continue to be trained by Dominic Galluscio. He is expected to start next in the Oct. 21 Maryland Million at Laurel or in the Sleepy Hollow at Belmont.

Breaking cleanly here at 8-5 odds, she took charge immediately and was pushed throughout, but had enough in reserve to win by a safe 1 3/4 lengths. She is a half sister to Flying Lauren (Storm Bird), MSP, \$171,516 and Omi (Wild Again), GSW, \$319,718. Lifetime Record: 7-3-3-0, \$108,065.

Surfside Works:

Surfside (Seattle Slew), winner of the GI Santa Anita Oaks earlier this year, worked five furlongs in 1:01 2/5 at Churchill Downs yesterday. The filly is expected to make her first start since the Santa Anita Derby in the Oct. 11 Raven Run S. at Keeneland.

Keeneland Works:

Burning Roma (Rubiano), winner of the GI Futurity at Belmont, worked five furlongs at Laurel Wednesday in 1:02 3/5. After the work, the two-year-old was shipped to Keeneland for Sunday's GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity. Of his Belmont win, trainer Tony Dutrow said, "We came from off the pace and we were really fresh and running in the stretch. That's really what you like to see. All the big races to come are a distance of ground and you need to have the ability to save a little and run at the end. I was glad to see that." Also aiming for the Breeders' Futurity, **Unbridled Time** (Unbridled's Song) went four furlongs in :47 2/5 at Churchill yesterday. The colt broke his maiden at Keeneland in the spring. "It never hurts to run back over a track that you have won on before," said Mike Maker, assistant to trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "He seemed to like it there in the spring and we hope that he runs back over it the same way." Unbridled Time is coming off a dull ninth in the Belmont Futurity.

Aly's Alley (Alwuhush), who will start next in Saturday's GII Shadwell Keeneland Turf Mile, breezed a half mile over the Keeneland turf yesterday in :49 3/5... **Perfect Sting** (Red Ransom) breezed five furlongs over the Keeneland turf in 1:01 yesterday.

Ecton Park Gets a Rest:

Ecton Park (Forty Niner), winner of last year's GI Super Derby, will take the rest of the year off. "He's run at a lot of tracks this year and needs a break," explained trainer Elliott Walden. "He's tired." The four-year-old will spend several weeks at Taylor Made Farm in Nicholasville, Kentucky before being prepared for a 2001 campaign.

Atlantic City Seeks Expanded Festival:

Atlantic City is seeking an expanded Turf festival for 2001. The track has applied to the New Jersey Racing Commission for an eight-day meet running from May 11 through May 14 and from May 18 through May 21. The Turf Festival was first introduced in 1999 and was expanded to six days in 2000. In 2001, Atlantic City is expected to offer over \$1.2 million in purses. "When the Turf Festival was first proposed in '99 as a short, five-day turf meeting with a country fair atmosphere, there were many skeptics. We appreciate the willingness of the New Jersey Racing Commission to work with us in restructuring the racing at Atlantic City that has turned out to be more popular with both the horsemen and the fans," said James Murphy, president of the Mays Landing track. "The success of the Turf Festival has exceeded all expectations. We look forward to another extraordinarily successful Turf Festival where the horsemen have the opportunity to run for serious money on our fabulous turf course and our local racing fans get to see eight days of sensational racing with full fields."

A yearling filly by superstar shuttle stallion Danehill (USA) topped the Goffs Challenge Sale yesterday at the Kildare Paddocks in Ireland. The first produce from multiple Listed stakes winner Flame Violet (Ire) (Fairy King {USA}) was knocked down for a final bid of Ir£175,000 to McKeever-St. Lawrence and was consigned to the one-day sale by Glenvale Stud, agent. "The filly will be trained in England," commented winning bidder John McKeever. "She has a lovely pedigree and she should have been in the Orby Sale and this was not a crazy price to pay for a Danehill." Second highest price on the afternoon was the Ir£160,000 paid for lot 585, a colt by Bluebird (USA) from the consignment of Croom House Stud. Hubie de Burgh signed the winning ticket for Hugo Lascelles Bloodstock for the colt out of No Quest (Ire) (Rainbow Quest {USA}). Gross receipts for the sale were up 30 percent against last year's figures while the average climbed by 24 percent and the median was ahead by 33 percent. Matt Mitchell, managing director at Goffs was naturally pleased with the results. "The quality of the catalogue has consistently been a major plus and the current exchange rate of the Irish punt means there is still value especially for overseas buyers," he said.
