TITANS ON TURF

With several memorable performances already under its belt, Belmont's Fall Championship Meeting showcases turf stars today with a pair of \$750,000, Grade I events. Runners looking to solidify Eclipse/Breeders' Cup credentials can bolster their claims with a victory over Belmont's turf. The GI Flower Bowl H. features a rubber match between **Snow Polina** (Tremolino) and **Happyanunoit (NZ)** (Yachtie {Aus}), who finished in that order in the GI Beverly D. at Arlington Aug. 19. Happyanunoit, heroine of the GI Matriarch last November, opened 2000 with a pair of seconds before triumphing in the 10-furlong GI Beverly Hills H. at Hollywood in July. The dark mare failed to catch Snow Polina over yielding ground at Arlington, but with the ground at Belmont currently good, she should justify her morning-line favoritism. The consistent Snow Polina took the GII Black Helen H. at Gulfstream in April before running into Perfect Sting twice, going down to that rival by just a head in the GII New York H. July 15. The main threat to the top two looms in the form of **Lisieux Rose (Ire)** (Generous {Ire}). A Group 2 winner in her native land, the chestnut mare took the GII Orchid H. and the GII Sheepshead Bay H. in June in her first two U.S. starts, but finished third at Woodbine Sept. 3. One race later, the GI Turf Classic will have an international field of 12, with **Fantastic Light** (Rahy) looking to build on his GI Man O' War victory Sept. 9. The Godolphin colorbearer did not face the deepest field that day, but closed strongly in the stretch in gaining his first GI victory. In his previous start, the four-year-old bay finished second to Montjeu in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot July 29. Second in the Man O' War at 35-1, **Ela Athena (GB)** (Ezzoud {Ire}) opted for this event over the Flower Bowl and adds Lasix for her second American outing. Heroine of the G2 Lancashire Oaks in July, the grey filly closed out her European career with a fifth behind the powerhouse trio of Petrushka, Love Divine and Ramruma in the GI Yorkshire Oaks Aug. 23. **Val's Prince** (Eternal Prince) seeks to add a third Turf Classic title to his 1997 and 1998 victories. The eight-year-old chestnut finished second in the nine-furlong GII Belmont Breeders' Cup H. Sept. 16 in his last start. The laterunning **Northern Quest (Fr)** (Rainbow Quest) has captured two straight graded events, including the GII Del Mar H. Sept. 4. *Fields, more previews p2*

TIE A YELLOW RIBBON 'ROUND THE OAK TREE

With Happyanunoit safely 3,000 miles away, the remaining top female turfers on the West Coast will get a chance to sort out their pecking order in the \$500,000 GI Yellow Ribbon at Santa Anita this afternoon, the first Grade I event of the 27-day Oak Tree meeting. **Caffe Latte (Ire)** (Seattle Dancer) seems to be rounding into her best form with the return to her favorite turf course. Second in this race as a three-year-old last year to **Spanish Fern** (El Gran Senor), the bay started 2000 in fine style by winning her first two starts over this course, including the 10-furlong GII Santa Barbara H. in April. After failing to hit the board in her next two outings, the Stonerside colorbearer rallied past Tout Charmant and **Alexine (Arg)** (Runaway Groom) in the GI Ramona H. at Del Mar Sept. 9. The latter, a Group 1 winner in Argentina, won her stateside bow at Del Mar Aug. 17 before her third in the Ramona and figures to be a factor in the stretch. "She had a very good record in Argentina," said trainer Richard Mandella. "She's done pretty well here in two starts, so we're excited about the future." Five-year-old **Tranquility Lake** (Rahy) returned in force with victories in both 2000 starts, including a front-running triumph in the GIII Palomar H. at Del Mar Aug. 16, where her victims including Caffe Latte and Spanish Fern. She missed some training due to an apparent spider bite following that effort and may not be at the highest fitness level. "She might come up a little short, I don't know," remarked trainer Julio Canani. "She didn't go to the track for 12 days. I would like to get one more work in her, but there's no time."

Highweight **Leave It to Beezer** has been successful in the two graded stakes he has attempted, taking Pimlico's GIII Baltimore Breeders' Cup H. June 17 and the GIII Salvatore Mile H. at Monmouth July 22. He comes off a 3 3/4-length win over **With Anticipation** in Delaware's Owners' Day H. Sept. 9. With Anticipation, winner of the Charles Staats S. July 23, he is one for four at the distance. **Valhol** finished third in the GII Ohio Derby last year, then was sidelined for 13 months after surgery to remove a chip in his knee. The four-year-old, best remembered for his buzzworthy performance in the 1999 GII Arkansas Derby, came back Aug. 29 to capture a Delaware allowance event last time out. Winning his first graded stakes in impressive fashion, **Rize** took the GII Philip H Iselin H. by a frontrunning nine lengths Aug. 27 before ending up fifth in the GII Kentucky Cup Classic H. Sept. 16. Last year's GII Illinois Derby winner, **Vision and Verse**, was runner-up in the GI Belmont S. and GI Travers S., but has not run since a fourth in the June 3 GII MassCap.

The 15th running of this event features the eagerly anticipated return of **Super Quercus**, unraced since his eye-catching victory in the GI Hollywood Derby last November. Never off the board in eight career starts, the French-bred chestnut closed impressively that day, going from 10th to first in the final quarter mile, defeating top turfer **Manndar** in the process. **Altibr's** only stateside win came in an allowance race at Saratoga July 30, but he just missed in his most recent two starts, finishing second in the GII Fourstardave H. Aug. 26 and third in the GII Belmont Breeders' Cup H. Sept. 16. He likes to race on the front end, but **Quiet Resolve** will also be on the pace. Runner-up in last year's GI Atto Mile, the gelding is three for five at this distance. Two races back, he won the GII Hong Kong Jockey Club Trophy July 23 and returned Sept. 3 to run third in the GII Niagara Breeders' Cup H.

A win by either youngster would establish him as the West's top gun. Street Cry's stablemate **Dubai Breeze**, off the board in three dirt sprints, won by three lengths when stretched out to a mile on the Del Mar lawn Aug. 28 and switches back to the main track here. Third behind Street Cry in his Aug. 19 debut, **Sudden Glory** also found the distance to his liking when breaking his maiden going a mile at Del Mar Sept. 8.
