STAR OF THE FLOWER BOWL

New York horseplayers have chanted the mantra "Samyn on the Green" to themselves for many years now, and yesterday the world was let in on the secret as 43-year-old Jean-Luc Samyn piloted a pair of outsiders in the co-featured events. First up was the consistent **Colstar** (Opening Verse), who showed a scintillating burst of speed to nip second choice **Snow Polina** (Tremolino) at the wire of the GI \$750,000 Flower Bowl Invitational H. The bay filly had won four straight, including the GIII Gallorette H. at Laurel and the GIII Locust Grove H. at Churchill in June, before trying her hand against the New York division. Her early campaign took its toll as she could do no better than fifth in the GII New York H. July 15, running against such names as Perfect Sting, Snow Polina and **Pico Teneriffe** (Red Ransom). Freshened up, she had a wide trip when fourth behind Perfect Sting in the GII Diana H. at Saratoga Sept. 4. Rating patiently along the inside as **Lisieux Rose (Ire)** (Generous {Ire}) led from Snow Polina, Colstar switched to the outside turning for home to commence her run. Snow Polina held a 4 1/2-length lead at the stretch call, but could not hold off the surging Colstar in the shadow of the wire. "I wanted her to tell me when she was ready," commented Samyn, winning his fourth Flower Bowl. "She really took off on the outside, and I thought I was going to win for fun. Jerry's filly [Snow Polina, with jockey Bailey] dug in, but we got in just in time." Winning trainer Paul Fout took the blame for his charge's defeats this summer. "I think I ran her back too quick in the New York H. after the race at Churchill," he said. "At Saratoga, in the Diana, we just got outpiloted." This may have been the season's swan song for Colstar. "She's not Breeders' Cup nominated, so this is probably it for the season," Fout continued. "We'll probably run her next year." Snow Polina will likely head to Churchill Nov. 4. "My mare put in a good run," said trainer Bill Mott. "I would have to consider the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf." Happyanunoi (NZ) (Yachtie {Aus}), the 4-5 favorite, never posed a serious threat and wound up fourth. "She just didn't have it at the end," said jockey Edgar Prado. "I don't think she handled the going because she just didn't finish." *Chart p2*

ITS'S ALL THE CALL

One race after piloting Colstar from the back of the pack, jockey Jean-Luc Samyn sent John's Call (Lord At War {Arg}) to the front at the start of the \$750,000 GI Turf Classic Invitational at Belmont yesterday and sat chilly as the nine-year-old gelding made all the running. A former steeplechaser, John's Call proved himself as a force on the flat when he stormed home a 9 1/4-length winner of the GI Sword Dancer H. at Saratoga Aug. 12. In his next out, he was outfinished by **Fantastic Light** (Rahy), **Ela Athena (GB)** (Ezzoud {Ire}) and **Drama Critic** (Theatrical {Ire}) in the GI Man O' War over this course Sept. 9 and wound up fourth. Breaking sharply here, John's Call quickly opened a clear lead, setting soft fractions of :50 2/5 and 1:15 4/5, and had enough left to hold **Craigsteel (GB)** (Suave Dancer) at bay in the final furlong. "This is the ultimate thrill," Samyn said. "It's funny how I won the other race coming from way off the pace and John's Call goes wire to wire." Winning trainer Tom Voss wasn't sure where the chestnut would head next. "We might be tempted to supplement him to the Breeders' Cup Turf, but the risk-and-reward factor, well, that's a lot of money." 7-5 favorite Fantastic Light's late punch was rendered ineffective by the slow pace, but he stayed on for fourth.

Tranquility Lake lulled the field to sleep in the early stages, then unleashed a sub :23 final quarter to fend off defending champion Spanish Fern. Lightly raced this season with an eye on the Eclipse, the bay mare opened 2000 with a pair of victories, including a 2 1/2-length score in the Gill Palomar H. Aug 16 at Del Mar. Forced to miss nearly two weeks of training after being bitten by a spider, she was clearly fit for these 10 furlongs off the seven-week hiatus. Unchallenged through dawdling splits of :25 3/5 and :51 1/5, Tranquility Lake quickened smartly in the stretch to remain unbeaten this year. "I don't think Eddie [jockey Delahoussaye] got into her at all--I don't think he even cocked the whip," said winning trainer Julio Canani. "She's a good mare. What I like is she can be on the lead; you can leave her alone, whether it's slow or fast, and she can cope with that." Next up is the Breeders' Cup. "I'm going to train here," Canani said. "I will go up there maybe four days before the race. I do my homework at home and that's what I did last year [the Canani-trained Silic took the Breeders' Cup Mile in 1999]."

Shadwell's Altibr caught Strategic Mission in midstretch and outfinished that horse in winning his first North American stakes, setting a new course record in the process. A winner of the G3 Dubai Duty Free over the sand at Nad al Sheba in 1999, the flashy chestnut failed to make much of an impact in his first two U.S. starts on dirt, but improved vastly when switched to the grass. After taking a Saratoga allowance July 30, he just missed to Hap in the GII Fourstardave Aug. 26 and followed that up with a third in the GIII Belmont Breeders' Cup H. Sept. 16 over a soft Belmont course. Getting firmer going here, he saved ground in the early stages, but angled out five wide approaching the stretch and put in a sustained rally for the score. "Can you believe it?" asked jubilant trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "To win the stake that you sponsor, that is great." Altibr will most likely make his next start Nov. 4 at Churchill Downs. "We'll go on to the Breeders' Cup Mile now and hope for the best," said McLaughlin.

In a virtual replay of their epic GII Del Mar Futurity duel Sept. 13, Flame Thrower once again stared down Street Cry to remain unbeaten. Breaking in stride from the rail, the flaxen-maned chestnut was pressed as he carved out fractions of :23 and :46 3/5 and turned the corner into the stretch with a narrow advantage. As Street Cry ranged up on the outside with his challenge, the battle was joined, with Flame Thrower tenaciously digging in to deny the Godolphin youngster. "He never lets anyone get ahead of him," said winning jockey Victor Espinoza. "There was no way that other horse was going to beat us. But this horse, you do have to keep busy on him. He's like riding a bicycle: you just have to keep going, keep pedaling all the way to the wire." Flame Thrower will board a plane bound for Kentucky in the next few weeks. "We're just getting ready for the Breeders' Cup," said winning trainer Bob Baffert. "We're just having fun with him, he's the kind of horse that you buy him to run."

Jostle displayed a new dimension in running her stakes skein to three. Having winged along on the front end in the GI CCA Oaks and stalked the pace in her GI Alabama victory Aug. 19, the dark bay filly loped along at the back of the pack as the field made their way down the backstretch. Revving her engines entering the far turn, the prohibitive favorite grabbed the lead at the top of the stretch and extended her advantage under a hand ride. "This is her home territory and I actually found her loafing a bit up the backside," commented winning jockey Mike Smith. "But when I finally asked her to go...she went!" The Breeders' Cup Distaff (Churchill Downs, Nov. 4) is on tap next for the nation's leading three-year-old filly. "She is absolutely at the top of her game right now," said winning trainer John Servis. "If we are going to beat the best, now is the time. She's heading into the Breeders' Cup in perfect shape."

Golden Missile had finished second in this event last year prior to his third in the Breeders' Cup Classic.

GIANT TO SKIP GOLD CUP Giant's Causeway (Storm Cat), being readied for a tilt at the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Churchill Downs, will not make his next start in the Oct. 14 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park. Trainer Aidan O'Brien told *The Blood-Horse*, "The Classic is what we've been working toward. We decided the best way to get there is either run in the [G1 Dubai Champion S. at Newmarket, Oct. 14] or go to the Classic off works. But the horse is doing so well, and he looks like he wants another race." A decision on the Champion S. is expected to be made in the middle of the week. Also possible for Newmarket is **Montjeu (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who is now being touted for one more start before he retires to stud. The four-year-old was fourth as the favorite in the Oct. 1 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. "[Trainer] John Hammond will take a view of the future once the horse has had a chance to recover," John Warren, racing manager for co-owner Tsega Ltd., told *Racing Post*. As the two colts are owned wholly or in part by the Coolmore partnership, it is not expected that both would run.

THIS WEEK IN HISTORY...

Oct. 6, 1979...Affirmed became the first Thoroughbred to earn more than \$1 million in a single season with a three-quarter length victory over **Spectacular Bid** in the Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park. Affirmed was later named Horse of the Year, while Spectacular Bid earned the Eclipse Award as top three-year-old; it was the only time the two met.

Oct. 7, 1956...In the final start of his career, four-year-old **Ribot** won the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe for the second consecutive year and retired a perfect 16-for-16.

Oct. 8, 1973...Secretariat made his grass debut in the Man o'War S. at Belmont Park, winning by five lengths and going the mile and a half in 2:24 4/5. He overran the finish line by another furlong, running 1 5/8 miles in a world record-equaling 2:37 4/5.

October 10, 1974...Lincoln Downs staged a \$5,000 "Battle of the Sexes" match race between jockeys **Denise Boudrot** and **Mike Lapensee**. The race was won by Boudrot. In a rematch held one week later in which the riders switched mounts, Boudrot won again.

October 12, 1920...In the final race of his career, three-year-old **Man o'War** defeated 1919 Triple Crown winner Sir Barton in a match race at Kenilworth Park. Sent off at odds of 1-20, Man o'War won by seven lengths for his 14th consecutive victory.

October 13, 1927...Arlington Park opened. The track, built by H. D. Brown, had a steeplechase course and a polo field and was adjacent to tennis courts, a golf course and a one-mile training track.

October 13, 1956...At age four, 1955 Horse of the Year **Nashua** won his last race, the Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park.

October 13, 1984...At age nine, odds-on favorite **John Henry** won his last race, the Ballantine's Scotch Classic at the Meadowlands. He earned a \$500,000 bonus for winning both the Scotch Classic and the Turf Classic at Belmont Park September 22. He retired with then-record earnings of \$6,597,947.

BOMB THREAT FORCES CANCELLATION AT ASCOT Yesterday's program at Ascot was called off after just one race because of a bomb threat, *PA Sport* reports. As the horses headed to the starting gate for the second race, the G3 Willmott Dixon Cornwallis S., police contacted course officials with the information that a coded message had been received. The runners were returned to the stables while racegoers were moved from the stands onto the course for half an hour before being asked to leave. Ascot Clerk of the Course Nick Cheyne told the BBC, "The grandstand has been evacuated and a search will take place and it will take some time to go through the whole of the grandstand." The meeting, Ascot's last of the season, had already been threatened by heavy rains. "We've had a very good Flat season and to finish on a note like this when we had such a strong card is very disappointing," added Cheyne. This is not the first time a race meet has been abandoned due to a security alert. Aintree was evacuated before the '97 Grand National, as was Kempton before the King George VI Chase card last December.

We did the same thing exactly with **Nashwan**, and he would never have been asked a big question at home, but he's always worked well." **Nayef** beat **Tamburlaine (Ire)**, impressive in a subsequent Newmarket maiden win, in the **Haynes, Hanson and Clark S.** at **Newbury** last month, a race that **Unfuwain** took in his two-year-old year. Here he stepped up to stakes company to follow in the footsteps of **Nashwan**, who won this in 1988. Always travelling easily, he tracked stablemate **Istihsaan (Ire)** (**Baratheas {Ire}**) in fourth place early. As soon as they entered the straight, he picked up to lead with a furlong and a half remaining before going quickly clear in the heavy ground under hands and heels riding. **Tregoning** said: "Credit must go to **Richard Perham**, who rides him in all his work--he told me to fear nothing about the ground, and he has just rung me up to say 'I told you so!' He is a very exciting prospect and a lovely horse to have anything to do with. He'll go into the winter unbeaten--I very much doubt he'll run again--and he is the sort of horse who keeps you going through the winter months. The days of **Nashwan** and **Unfuwain** were wonderful, and hopefully this is rekindling some of that feeling."
