### STRONACH CASHES AGAIN

A year ago, all eyes were focused on Stronach Stable's Perfect Sting in Keeneland's GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup and she made good on a promise of 8-5 to win by two lengths. Collect The Cash (Dynaformer) came into yesterday's renewal a much less heralded commodity. Her most important success to date came in a 1 1/2-length victory in the Rockingham Park Oaks July 1, which she followed with back-to-back allowance triumphs at Saratoga. Gaviola (Cozzene) had been the unstoppable force of her division on the East Coast this season, including a victory in the GI Garden City Breeders' Cup in her last effort and was the 4-5 favorite among the Keeneland faithful. The gray filly was away in stride and cut out reasonable fractions while jockey Shane Sellers kept Collect The Cash within easy striking distance in second. Gaviola still held the call with a furlong and a half to run, but Collect The Cash turned up the heat at the eighth pole, got clear and withstood late runs from Blue Moon (Fr) (Lomitas {GB}) and Theoretically (Theatrical {Ire}) for her first Grade I victory. Gaviola tailed off to finish sixth, beaten four lengths. "I really didn't want to go out and try to track down the leader early in the race," Sellers commented. "I could tell that when we swung out and started to make our move, that [jockey] Robbie [Davis]'s horse wasn't finishing too well. We just ran on with it and finished up strong and were in the right place at the right time."

### A MASHING PERFORMANCE

Mash One (Chi) (Mashkour) hadn't been seen since earning his first North American victory in the GI Oak Tree Turf Championship last October. The race's name changed this year, but the result was the same as the Chilean bred came through in the stretch to win yesterday's GI Clement L. Hirsch Turf Championship at Santa Anita by 1 1/4 lengths. Mash One, returning from foot problems and ankle surgery, stalked the pace of favored Asidero (Arg) (Fadeyev), gained the lead with a twowide move turning for home and finished under a hand ride. Boatman (Irish River {Fr}) rallied from last to outfinish Asidero for the runner-up spot. "I'll tell you, we couldn't get a better trip than that," said winning rider David Flores. "I just placed him in a spot where I got him relaxed and than, at the half-mile pole, I felt a couple of the other horses coming up to put some pressure on us. But still, I didn't push him at all; I just kind of let the horse do it all by himself. He just gave me a beautiful run. You have to give [trainer] Bobby Frankel some credit. He's a great trainer and he had this horse very sharp after a year off." Winning owner John Amerman said that Mash One could be pointed towards the Japan Cup. The six-year-old was shipped to Japan last year to prepare for the Cup, but was forced to miss the race with a quarter crack. He is not Breeders' Cup eligible.

Notable Career, a 12-length maiden winner in May, captured the GIII Landaluce in her third outing before running second against state-bred company in the CTBA S. and again in the Sept. 2 GI Del Mar Debutante last time out. The filly took the lead from the start and was never seriously threatened, finishing under a hand ride. "She has so much speed that she went up to the front easily and I just stayed quiet on her," commented winning jockey David Flores. "I just stayed guiet and waited until the guarter pole and then I picked her up a little bit, and boy, she just moved on with it." Trainer Bob Baffert has saddled the last four winners of the Oak Leaf. "Another day at the office," Baffert said. "We got her here, I worked her a mile the other day--she worked an awesome mile, then came back and followed up with another strong work so I felt real confident." Baffert added Notable Career will move on to the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies.

Okawango lived up to the promise of his previous showings to keep this prize at home and place his name to the fore of the ever-changing ante-post lists for next year's Classics. Although the perception is that foreign raiders have dominated the French juvenile Group One races in recent years, the statistics show another story; Okawango was the 14th French winner of the last 29 such races run on these shores. He looks a bit special too, following up his highly impressive success in the G3 Prix la Rochette at Chantilly Sept. 20 and maintaining his unbeaten three-for-three record. He was ridden confidently by jockey Olivier Doleuze here, settled at the rear early as the field was taken along by French Tune (Fr) (Green Tune). As they entered the straight, jockey Mick Kinane on Honours List kicked on and looked temporarily to have left his stablemate King's County and jockey Olivier Peslier standing. However, as Peslier brought King's County through to challenge with one and a half furlongs remaining, there was a greater threat on the outside. Doleuze unleashed his horse's run, having cruised up on the bridle, and the colt stretched out under hands and heels riding to deny the spirited challenge of the runner-up. At the line he had registered a comfortable success without ever having been truly extended. "Okawango is a very nice colt, but still very tender and who has a lot more to learn," said winning trainer Criquette Head. "He needs to put on some more strength and he should improve a lot in the months to come. We will now put him away for the season and he will return next year in the Spring with the Classics in mind, starting with the Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) in May.

Faberger is used to causing shocks in Group company. He arrived on the scene at Deauville July 8 with a win in the G3 Prix Messidor at odds of over 60-1. He was a somewhat more conservative price at around 10-1 here. When he tried Group 1 company in August at Deauville, he was eight of 11 in the Prix Jacques le Marois. Last time he failed to land a blow on Bernardon (Ger) when sixth in the G3 Darley-Oettingen-Rennen at Baden-Baden Aug. 29, but he was produced here to take the spoils and fulfill the promise he had shown in France earlier. Sotabrascet (Ire) (Danehill) led them along early at a moderate pace, with Sumitas and Makeup A Mystery (Mystery Storm) close up, while jockey Craig Williams had Barathea Guest settled in last place, around seven lengths off the pace. When Sumitas quickened in the straight, he looked the winner, until Faberger was delivered with his customary late rattle on the outer to pass him with 150 yards remaining. From there he left a stunned jockey Terence Hellier reeling on the runner-up, while Barathea Guest could never make the improvement to figure.

Arabian Light made the first two starts of his career against fellow California breds, breaking his maiden by two lengths at Hollywood June 11 before returning Aug. 2 to annex the Graduation S. for Cal-breds at Del Mar by an impressive five lengths. Given a test for class, the chestnut was an excellent third to West Coast juvenile stars Flame Thrower and Street Cry in the GII Del Mar Futurity Sept. 13. The \$700,000 twoyear-old purchase had been running a hole in the wind during morning trials of late, including six furlongs in 1:10 3/5 Oct. 2 before heading east. Bumped at the start, jockey Shane Sellers took the colt towards the back of the pack for the opening five eighths of a mile. Sellers pushed the button with three furlongs to run and Arabian Light began an eye-popping, five-wide sweep towards the front. The Bob Baffert pupil took command entering the short stretch and was ridden out to the wire. "When I called upon him, he really collared those horses pretty easy," Sellers commented. "I really never did have to hit him, but I did a couple of times to get his attention." GI Futurity winner Burning Roma (Rubiano), blocked for a good portion of the race, finished well for fourth.

Turf specialist North East Bound came into this event with three wins from his last four trips to the post, including a 3 1/4-length success in the off-the-turf Oceanport H. in the Monmouth slop July 15. The 1 1/2-length winner of the Battlefield S. over the Monmouth lawn Aug. 6, the gelding was fourth in the GII Fourstardave at Saratoga, but rebounded to account for the GIII Cliff Hanger H. on the local sod Sept. 22. The second highweight on the return to the main, North East Bound stalked a fast early pace, loomed into contention outside the quarter pole, took over in upper stretch and pulled clear to his fifth victory of the season. The 8-5 favorite Vision and Verse (Storm Cat) never reached contention and finished eighth.

In his fifth start back from an 11-month layoff, Forbidden Apple scored by 1 1/4 lengths in the Sept. 16 GII Belmont Breeders' Cup H. Looking to make it two graded wins in a row, the dark bay closely attended the pace of Affirmed Success and battled down the lane to get a neck in front of the second favorite who held off 30-1 outsider Johnny Dollar by a nose. The victory capped a big weekend for veteran rider Jean-Luc Samyn who swept all three graded New York preps for Breeders' Cup turf races. "I love this job," Samyn said after this latest win. "He was really on the muscle today and I let him tell me when he wanted to move. The trip was perfect and I was glad that Affirmed Success was on the inside of me and not on the outside. This horse has really improved over the last month." Favored Hap (Theatrical {Ire}) had a four-race win streak snapped with his fifth-place finish here. The colt was forced to steady in traffic down the backstretch, bid three wide nearing the stretch and couldn't close on the leaders. "I've got no big excuses," trainer Bill Mott said. "He got into some traffic trouble and that was pretty much it. We'll wait and see about the Breeders' Cup."

Downgraded in Group status, this mile event has not been won by the favourite since 1994, when the champion filly Risen Raven ran away with the race and the upsets continued yesterday. Peppercorn, sixth in the Sept. 23 G2 Grosse Europcar-Meile at Cologne, reversed the form of that race to defeat Bernardon (Ger) (Suave Dancer), Banyumanik, and Catoki (Storm Cat). Here Lymond took up the early running, with Banyumanik shadowing him on the outside, while the favourite Bernardon lay in midfield. As that horse came under pressure, Banuyumanik was still travelling strongly and in the straight Lymond was finding it hard to shrug off his attentions. It was only with 200 yards remaining that Peppercorn loomed into the picture, swiftly passing the leaders on the rail, before going away to win impressively.

Last year she was runner-up to Alborada (GB) after a lay-off throughout the summer months. Although their participation depends on the prevalence of cut in the ground, Cecil said, "At the moment they are both in and provided the ground is all right they will both run. We will sort out jockey plans later."

### **COCO TAKES METRO**

Trainer Gai Waterhouse captured her fifth G1 Metropolitan H. win when Coco Cobanna (NZ) (Casual Lies {USA}) ground down Pasta Express (Aus) (Rigoletto {Aus}) by 3/4 lengths yesterday. Waterhouse is now within sight of her father, Tommy Smith's, record seven Metropolitan wins. Four-year-old Coco Cobanna, purchased as a \$200,000 tried horse, won the AJC Oaks in autumn and placed in the South Australian Oaks. Sent off the 2-1 favourite, Coco Cobanna settled at the rear, gradually made up ground to sit in fifth behind 4-1 Pasta Express and moved around that rival at the 800m for the win. "If she continues to please we will go to Melbourne for the (G1) Caulfield Cup, but the (G1) Melbourne Cup has always been on the cards," Waterhouse said.

### **FAIRWAY UPSETS SUNLINE**

In Melbourne, the AJC Australian Derby winner Fairway (Aus) (Danzero (Aus)) caused an upset when he beat Sunline (NZ) (Desert Sun {GB}) in a mighty duel down the straight in the A\$251,000 G2 Turnbull S. at Flemington vesterday, Jockey Darren Beadman sent the four-year-old gelding straight to the front in a move that immediately put the front-running Sunline under pressure and placed her in the second spot, where she remained to go down by a half-head. "Sunline is a great horse, but they all get beaten," said Fairway's trainer Allan Denham. Beadman added, "She'll bounce back. She had him beaten three times in the straight, but he has a heart as big as a lion's and any other horse would have laid down." Sunline's trainer, Trevor McKee, said that he was "not too worried" about yesterday's outcome as the main focus is on winning back-to-back A\$2 million (G1) Cox Plates with the five-year-old mare. "She got beaten last year at this stage," he said.

One Won One (USA) (Naevus {USA}) ran in the rear of the nine-horse field in the GII Kelso H. at Belmont Park yesterday, before moving inside and getting caught up in traffic to finish fourth to Forbidden Apple (USA) (Pleasant Colony {USA}). In behind horses the entire distance, Leave Us Leap (USA) (Summer Squall {USA}) split rivals in the stretch, but tired and ran seventh. Never closer than sixth place, G2 Budweiser International S. winner Alrassaam (GB) (Zafonic {USA}) chased the leaders from an outside position, which caught up with him after three quarters, fading to last place in the final leg of the mile.
