GOLD STANDARD

A field of seven, headed by leading older horse Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo), is set to go postward this afternoon in the \$1 million GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, Belmont's last major prep for the Breeders' Cup Classic three weeks hence. Riding a four-race skein, Lemon Drop Kid was tested to the max by Behrens (Pleasant Colony) in the GI Woodward H. over this track Sept. 16, prevailing by a head after a stretch-long duel. "The Woodward was a tough race, but the good ones always find a way to win," remarked trainer Scotty Schulhofer. "So far, he's been able to stay right on schedule." The lone sophomore in the field is Albert the Great (Go for Gin), whose GII Dwyer victory came at Belmont in July. A gut-wrenching second in the GI Travers at this distance, the bay colt held well to be third in the GII Jerome H. behind Fusaichi Pegasus after setting daunting :44 1/5 and 1:08 1/5 fractions. Training well since that Sept. 23 outing, he drilled a bullet :58 4/5 over Belmont's main track Monday. "I'd like to see him sitting right off Skimming (Nureyev)," said trainer Nick Zito. "There's some tough veterans in there, but Albert's doing great. He'll improve off the Jerome." Shipping in from Chantilly to make his first start on the dirt is Agol Lack (Gulch). The four-year-old chestnut has won his last two starts, both at today's distance in France, including the G3 La Coupe de Maisons-Laffitte Sept. 13. He hails from the barn of trainer Andre Fabre, who sent out Arcangues to an improbable Breeders' Cup Classic victory.

A CHAMPION'S FAREWELL?

Today's G1 Dubai Champion S. at Newmarket could be the last chance to see Montjeu (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) in action. He is set to retire to Coolmore in the new year, having added the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S., G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud, and G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup this season to his laurels. Fourth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe 13 days ago, he is back for more business here. Ardent admirers have been doing a collective raindance this week in Newmarket, and their prayers have been answered. The rain has also come in time for Shiva (Jpn) (Hector Protector). Henry Cecil's at times brilliant mare, who looked a force when winning the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. at Sandown May 30. She encountered faster ground thereafter, at Sandown behind Giant's Causeway in the G1 Eclipse S. July 8, and at Ascot behind Montjeu July 29. The underfoot conditions will undoubtedly swing in her favour this afternoon. Providing he handles the ground, as he did here last year when winning the G1 Dewhurst S., Distant Music (Distant View) should not be far away. Given a rest following two sub-par spring efforts, he advertised his well-being when beating Valentino (GB) in the G3 Park S. at Doncaster Sept. 7. Kalanisi (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}), winner of the G2 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot June 20, breathed a sigh of relief at the absence of Giant's Causeway, having gone down by a head to that rival in both the the G1 Eclipse S. and G1 International S. at York Aug. 22.

FILLY TOPS TATTERSALLS FRIDAY The

Tattersalls October Yearling Sales continued in great vein vesterday with average up 64 percent on last year, the median increased by 30 percent and turnover up by 55 percent. The top price came in the morning session when agent Jimmy Byrne, accompanied by former Tattersalls (Ireland) chairman Denis Mahony, went to 375,000gns to see off John McCormack for a wellconnected Barathea (Ire) filly offered from Roy and Belinda Strudwick's Ballygallon Stud. The half-sister to Beckett (Ire) (Fairy King), who won this season's Group 1 National Stakes after topping the 1999 Houghton Sale at 1.7 million guineas, was bought for a client of Mahony's. "She is heading to Ireland where she may go into training, but she was bought for somebody who liked her for her paddock potential," said Mahony. The top price at the evening session was the 310,000gns paid by Charlie Gordon-Watson, standing with John Magnier and Paul Shanahan, for a Spectrum (Ire) colt offered from Castletown Stud for whom John Gosden was underbidder. He was bought for the same connections as Thursday's 440,000gns Cadeaux Genereux colt."They were both be trained in England, but I don't know where," said Gordon-Watson. "We had planned to buy more horses but got two big ones instead." The Maktoum entities showed no sign of slowing down their spending, with Sheikh Hamdan's team paying 200,000gns for a Selkirk colt offered from New England Stud. Coolmore agent Demi O'Byrne paid 200,000gns in the morning session for a Danehill colt who continued an outstanding sale for Kingwood Stud.

ASHFORD'S 2001 STUD FEES Ashford Stud. Coolmore's American operation, yesterday announced stud fees for its 16-stallion roster in 2001. Though Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector) will enter stud next season, his fee will be determined following his final career start in the Breeders' Cup Classic. He will be joined by multiple Grade I winner High Yield (Storm Cat), who will stand his first season for \$35,000. Three stallions saw their fees rise, with leading freshman sire Honour and Glory (Relaunch) going from \$17,500 to \$30,000; Southern Halo (Halo). sire of Grade I winner More Than Ready, from \$30,000 to \$40,000; and Tale of the Cat (Storm Cat), whose first weanlings will be offered at Keeneland November, from \$25,000 to \$30,000. Six stallions remained at their previous fees: Bianconi (Danzig) holds level at \$10,000; Spinning World (Nureyev) returns from his Japanese sojourn at a fee of \$35,000; leading secondcrop sire Thunder Gulch (Gulch) maintains his \$25,000 fee: as does Grand Slam (Gone West) (\$30,000), Louis Quatorze (Sovereign Dancer) (\$10,000) and Stravinsky (Nureyev) (\$35,000). Five stallions had their fees lowered for the 2001 season, with King of Kings (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) going from \$30,000 to \$25,000; Lure (Danzig) from \$20,000 to \$15,000, Royal Academy (Nijinsky II) from \$35,000 to \$25,000, Victory Speech (Deputy Minister) from \$10,000 to \$7,500, and Woodman (Mr. Prospector) from \$60,000 to \$45,000. "We are really looking forward to the new season, and I feel there is some real value on offer again this season," said Ashford spokesman Stuart Fitzgibbon. "For breeders attending the November Sale, High Yield is now available for inspection at Ashford."

California shipper Tout Charmant had visited Keeneland once before, finishing second to Perfect Sting in last year's GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup, but turned the tables this time. Winner of the May 14 GIII Wilshire H. at Hollywood in her first start of the season. the bay was then third in the June 4 Gl Gamely Breeders' Cup H. before taking a 2 1/2-month break. She came back to be second in both the Aug. 16 GIII Palomar H. and Sept. 9 GI Ramona H. over the Del Mar lawn. The second choice in an attempt to hand the aptly named Perfect Sting her first loss of 2000, the Stonerside colorbearer pressed the pace for a half and took over after six furlongs. The crowd's choice came after her at the top of the lane, but Tout Charmant bid the favorite adieu, drawing off again for the victory. "As soon as she made the lead, she settled right in and pricked her ears," wining jockey Chris McCarron said. "She was going right along nice and easily, just like I wanted. In the stretch, I saw [Perfect Sting's] white bridle coming at me and I knew the race was on, but we bellied down and really ran a game race." Trainer Ron McAnally said the decision on whether to go on to the Breeders' Cup would be made by owners Robert and Janice McNair. Jockey Jerry Bailey, aboard the runnerup, said, "It was a great race to the sixteenth pole, but that other filly had too much left. I think I should have moved a little quicker, but you never know."

Sacred Song has obviously been crying out for this trip in her racing so far and she adapted to the longer trip here to claim her first stakes success. Last time she found only Courting (GB) too strong in the Listed John Musker Fillies' S. at Yarmouth Sept. 12, having won at Nottingham last year and this. She had finished strongly in her racing so far and here with a true pace and endto-end gallop, she thrived in the conditions to give trainer Henry Cecil a welcome upturn in fortunes after a relatively quiet few weeks. Held up early towards the rear, Littlepacepaddocks (Ire) was sent to the front where she controlled the pace as Inaaq (GB) was bustled up to join her by jockey Frankie Dettori. As jockey Darryl Holland asked the leader to apply the pressure in the straight, Inaaq was struggling to pass her, while the favourite Riyafa (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire}) was struggling to get into contention. As Sacred Song was finishing on the outside, she was devouring the ground and powered past Littlepacepaddocks with a furlong remaining, before going away to win impressively. Jockey Richard Quinn, reflecting on the start of a big weekend for the yard, as both Love Divine (GB) and Shiva (Jpn) run in the G1 Dubai Champion S., and Vacamonte (GB) runs in the G1 Darley Dewhurst S., said: "That was delightful. It's very important for a filly to win a Group race, for breeding purposes, and its an important weekend for us. Hopefully she's just a taste of things to come."

This much-anticipated showdown between divisional heavyweights Riboletta and Beautiful Pleasure will go a long way in determining the Eclipse Award. Beautiful Pleasure has not lost at Belmont since June 1999 and comes off a five-length score over Heritage of Gold in the GI Personal Ensign at Saratoga Aug. 25. The five-year-old mare will be winging it from her outside post. "I don't want to be on the outside of her [Beautiful Pleasure]," said Eduardo Inda, trainer of Riboletta. "She'll carry me into the seven or eight path. My mare can hug the fence and if we do that, can get a good jump on Beautiful Pleasure at the quarter pole."

The dead-heat winners of the GI Hopeful S. (Saratoga, Sept. 2), City Zip and Yonaguska, meet some up-andcoming youngsters in the 129th renewal of the Champagne. Since that Labor Day weekend outing, City Zip was DQ'd from a nose victory in the GI Futurity at Belmont Sept. 17. Point Given, winner of the GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile Sept. 16, and Trailthefox, frontrunning victor of the GII Arlington-Washington Futurity Sept. 23, ship in to test their mettle against the East Coast two-year-olds. Hopeful fourth Saint Verre came back to post a 7 1/2-length allowance triumph at this track Sept. 28. Two impressive maiden winners are also making their stakes debuts: A P Valentine romped by 4 1/2 lengths at Belmont Sept. 23, while Griffinite won an off-the-turf event by eight lengths and will attempt to duplicate his sire's 1995 victory in this race.

Edward P. Evans' Raging Fever saw her unbeaten record nearly thwarted by the strong rally of Dancinginmydreams in the GI Matron Sept. 17 at Belmont. Previously, the Storm Cat filly had taken her first three career starts by a total of 26 1/2 lengths. She will be at the mercy of Dancinginmydreams once again, as that filly gets another 1/16-mile to accomodate her closing kick. A full sister to champion and Frizette winner Heavenly Prize, she rallied from 12 lengths back when winning her career bow at Saratoga Aug. 31. Stormy Pick has been beaten just once, but has not raced since her victory in the GI Spinaway at Saratoga Sept. 1 and will try a route for the first time.

Heritage of Gold started the season with five straight graded-stakes wins, starting with the GIII Oaklawn Breeders Cup S. in March and accounting for the Apr. 9 GI Apple Blossom H. and July 30 GI Go for Wand H., where she beat Beautiful Pleasure, during the stretch. Stretched out to a mile and a quarter for the Aug. 25 GI Personal Ensign H. at Saratoga last time out, the bay saw her streak end as she tired in deep stretch to be third, 5 1/4 lengths behind the Go for Wand runner-up. "We think she has a chance to be the champion, but we have to take care of our business on the track," trainer Tom Amoss said. "She's doing really well and I think she's coming to the end of the season in great shape, but we'll have to see." The five-year-old has been working bullets for the Spinster, most recently going five furlongs in :59 over the Keeneland surface Oct. 10. "I think that set her up perfectly," Amoss said. Three-yearold Spain could provide the toughest competition for the favorite. Easy winner of the GII Monmouth Oaks July 29, the Team Lukas filly was a game third in the 1 1/4-mile GI Alabama S. Aug. 19, then returned to the winner's circle when shortening up for the GIII Turfway Park Breeders' Cup S. Sept. 16, besting Ruby Surprise by a length in front-running fashion.

It is hard to believe that Aidan O'Brien has yet to win this race, but this year he is making a concerted effort to get off the mark, with three entries following the scratch of Minardi. While Mozart is already a winner, Freud is a figure of unknown quantity, having raced only once at The Curragh in July. Mozart was a length too strong for Pretty Girl (Ire) in the £400,000 Tattersalls Houghton Sales S. here Sept. 26, having won his Curragh maiden the day after Freud, a full brother to Giant's Causeway, had finished runner-up to Blixen. "He's a lovely horse, and I've always felt that he could be anything," said trainer Craig Williams. "Hopefully this could be a stepping stone for him and me. He was very impressive in France--they went out very quick, and they never stopped, and he really thrived on that. He took a while to get to them, but when he did he really put paid to them and that's something I liked about the horse." An interesting outsider could be Richard Hannon's King's Ironbridge, who would also be providing his trainer with his first success in this. He beat Storming Home (GB) by a half length in the G3 Solario S. at Sandown Aug. 19, where Vacamonte was a well-beaten fifth. That form has since taken knocks, but he will arive here a fresh horse from a stable which is particularly strong its juvenile department. Dual Group 1 winner Minardi was an 11th hour defection from the Dewhurst. "Minardi just coughed on the way to the gallops this morning--that's why he's a non-runner," said a spokesman for O'Brien yesterday.
