#### A HORSE FOR SOFT COURSES

It is often the condition of the course which determines the quality of performance given by Indian Lodge (Ire) (Grand Lodge). A class act on good going, the fouryear-old is simply top drawer when the going is on the soft side and he demonstrated that fact again yesterday with a decisive score over favored Dansili (GB) (Danehill) in the G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp. The colt added a second French Group 1 prize to his win in the G1 Prix du Moulin over this course Sept. 3, a victory secured in highly impressive fashion when there was cut in the ground. He put on another imperious performance here, bursting clear inside the final furlong for a facile win. The two blips on this season's record both occurred on Ascot's firmer going, in the G2 Queen Anne S. June 20 and the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. Sept. 23. Enjoying the footing in this test, Indian Lodge was always travelling well in second as Bold Edge (GB) (Beveled) set a good pace, with Sugarfoot (GB) (Thatching {Ire}) and Dansili reserved off the pace. The winner cruised into the lead at the quarter-mile marker and quickened clear approaching the final furlong. Pat Eddery needed only to shake the reins at his mount, and Indian Lodge ran on strongly for an unchallenged win. Trainer Amanda Perrett said, "Indian Lodge is a wonderful horse who has been on the go since April and incredibly consistent since, holding his form superbly. He will be retired at the end of the season and will stand at Rathbarry Stud. Of course the GI Breeders' Cup Mile [Churchill Downs, Nov. 4] is a possibility, but it is undecided yet and the ground rarely comes up soft enough in America, even at Churchill Downs." Dansili, who emerged from the pack as the closest pursuer, had no chance in reeling back the eventual winner, but could also try his luck in America the first Saturday in November. Sugarfoot kept on well inside the final furlong to secured third. G3 Prix de Sandringham winner Zarkiya (Ire) (Catrail), making her first start since finishing fourth in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot, ended up sixth; trainer Alain de Royer-Dupré is keen to run his filly again, but she may not be Breeders' Cup eligible. #### AN INTERNATIONAL AFFAIR

In what was truly an international event, European invader Mutafaweq (Silver Hawk), owned by Godolphin, trained by Saeed bin Suroor, ridden by Frankie Dettori and campaigned in Britain, Ireland and Germany this year, fought off the late charge of America's Williams News (Alleged) to take the GI Canadian International by a nose at Woodbine yesterday afternoon. The winner, a \$310,000 Saratoga yearling purchase, has been an accomplished runner across the Atlantic, winning the G2 King Edward VII S. and G1 Doncaster St. Leger S. last year and adding a victory in the G1 Deutschland Preis this season. Coming off a third-place finish in the G1 Irish St. Leger Sept. 16, the bay was sent off the 4-1 second choice and closed from fifth to grab a short lead in the stretch. The four-year-old showed his courage in the final furlong to withstand the determined bid of 12-1 Williams News. "I thought I'd lost," Dettori admitted. "But when the photo came out, for once it came out my way. I'm very sorry for the connections of the second, but obviously delighted with my fella." The 6-5 favorite, Daliapour (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) stalked the pace, was on even terms with the winner at the guarter pole, but weakened in the final drive to be third.

DANCINGINMYDREAMS HOLDING HER OWN Ogden Phipps' Dancinginmydreams (Seeking the Gold), who suffered a shattered right hind pastern in the GI Frizette S. at Belmont Park Saturday, made it through a long surgery at the New Bolton Center in Pennsylvania and was doing well yesterday. "They immobilized whatever that they had to immobilize," trainer Shug McGaughey said. "They worked all through the night. So far, so good. She still has a long way to go, but she's doing excellent right now."

PREVIEW WRAP-UP Trainer Nick Zito said yesterday that his Breeders' Cup Preview heroes, GI Jockey Club Gold Cup winner Albert The Great (Go for Gin) and Gl Champagne S. victor A P Valentine (A.P. Indy), came out of their respective races in good order and will point for the main event at Churchill Downs Nov. 4. "We got every break we needed yesterday," Zito said. "It was a tremendous day." Still touting A P Valentine as possibly the best horse he has trained, the Brooklyn native said, "This horse scares me, the way he does everything so easily. He showed me a lot of poise yesterday coming up the rail like that. Nothing fazes this guy. He'll only get better." Zito could also start Out Of Sync (Out of Place) and Western Justice (West by West), second and third in the GI Frizette S., in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. The Gold Cup favorite, Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo), who finished fifth at 4-5, was also feeling no ill effects from his effort yesterday morning, but trainer Scotty Schulhofer had harsh words for jockey Jerry Bailey, who was board Behrens (Pleasant Colony) in the race. "Mr. Bailey knew we had the horse to beat, so he tried to beat him," Schulhofer said. "After the break, he just kept coming over and (jockey Edgar Prado, on Lemon Drop Kid] had to snatch out of there. If [Bailey] keeps pulling stuff like this, the next thing you know, somebody's really going to get hurt." The fouryear-old will head to Churchill Oct. 23. Behrens, who ended up sixth, is not likely to go on to the Classic. "He got scraped up a bit at the start," trainer Jim Bond said. "He came in on Lemon Drop Kid at the break. He's OK, but it's doubtful that he would be going to the Breeders' Cup. He'll go back to Saratoga and we'll make some decisions after that."

We're hoping that she'll get a clean bill of health and we can get her back on the track and back on track." He added, "The Breeders' Cup is still a possibility, but we want to make sure there's nothing going on with her."

Fly For Avie hadn't won a race in four starts this year after a four-year-old season which saw her go two-for-10, including a win in Woodbine's Flaming Page S. She was an afterthought in the wagering here in a field which included some sharp shippers, including the winner of this year's July 1 G2 Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh, Lady Upstage (Ire); and favored Innuendo (Ire), a two-time stakes winner in Europe who was fourth in the July 15 GII New York H. at Belmont in her last start. But the local mare made good in the field of imports. Taken off the early pace while saving ground, she gained on the leaders while entering the stretch, found herself blocked through most of the drive and was forced to alter course to the outside with a sixteenth of a mile remaining, but got up in the final strides under a drive. "I was certainly worried," winning jockey Todd Kabel said. "I went for an opening turning for home and she wouldn't go through. Then I was hoping the horses would spread apart down the lane, which they didn't. So I had one choice, to jump heels. Thank God I got up in time. Otherwise I would have had a lot of explaining to do."

Just two weeks and a day after his track-record setting performance in the GI Super Derby at Louisiana Downs, Tiznow earned himself a trip to the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup Classic with a hard-fought win over Captain Steve here. Part-owner Michael Cooper had said before vesterday's Goodwood that Tiznow, who must be supplemented to the Classic for a fee of \$360,000, would guarantee himself a trip to Louisville with a win here, and the three-year-old colt helped his owners out by earning two-thirds of his supplemental fee with this score alone. The Goodwood proved to be a rematch with Captain Steve, who defeated him in the July 23 GI Swaps at Hollywood. The Bob Baffert trainee was sent off the second choice to the winner, with Tiznow setting the pace from the break. Captain Steve was content to sit second until turning for home, looked as if he may overtake his rival at the eighth pole, but could not catch a determined winner. "Today is exactly what I wanted to see to tell me to go to the Breeders' Cup. We wanted him in a real horse race to see how he would handle the pressure. I think he certainly showed us he could handle it. If he looks good, we'll probably go," Cooper said after the race, adding, "Fortunately, we have until the 23rd to make the first payment." Trainer Jay Robbins said, "Judging from the way they ran yesterday [in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup], I think Tiznow has a shot in the Breeders' Cup. And I think he's more comfortable going a mile and a quarter. I'm more inclined to go now."

Undefeated in three starts while sprinting at Arlington International, She's A Devil Due added Lasix for her two-turn and Kentucky debut and eked out a narrow victory to remain unbeaten. It was the second straight photo-finish win for the filly, who stepped into stakes company for the first time Sept. 9 and came away with a nose score in the Top Flight S. Allowed to settle just off the early pace here, the bay went after front-running Cash Deal as they came out of the turn, took over inside the eighth pole and pulled out all the stops to hold off a hard-charging Nasty Storm to the wire. Asked if the filly will go next in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, trainer Kenny McPeek said, "Absolutely. I think she deserves a chance. The filly has the will to win, like all great racehorses." Pacesetter Cash Deal, who was rank on the front end and ducked in for a stride at the three-sixteenths pole, held well for third. "I was trying to get her to relax cut there and she was fighting me," jockey Jorge Chavez said. "I probably should have just let her run. I made a mistake. After she started to pick it up, she saw the starting gate and she started to act a little funny. She saw the footprints and started to duck those--she lost her action there, too. It was just one of those days." Added trainer D. Wayne Lukas, "I wish Chavez would have just let her run. She would have been six in front at the top of the stretch and she could have coasted home. I don't know why he didn't let her run--I have absolutely no idea. But that won't happen again."

The odds-on favorite, the late-running King Cugat was compromised by a very slow pace, but still managed to get up in the final jump for a very narrow score. The bay, who picked up his fourth straight victory in the July 1 GII Arlington Classic, was 3-5 in the GI Secretariat S. at Arlington Aug. 19, but couldn't hold off the late run of Ciro and finished second. Last after a guarter this time, the crowd's choice moved into contention after a half in :51 4/5, came with a four-wide bid at the top of the lane and kept coming to catch the front-running Mandarin Marsh in the very last jump. "That son of a gun [Mandarin Marsh] kept digging in," trainer Bill Mott said. "It looked like we had him at the three-sixteenths pole, but at the sixteenth pole he kept digging in. It was a good race for my horse. There was a slow pace and it didn't set up ideally for him, but he was good enough to run the leader down." As for what's next, Mott said, "If we keep going, it looks like we might go in the Hollywood Derby [Nov. 26]."

In the battle of the unbeaten, longshot Xtra Heat outfinished even-money Gold Mover to run her pefect record to six-for-six. The bay, who started her career running for a \$25,000 tag, had reeled off four straight stakes wins coming into this test, most recently taking the Blue Hen S. at Delaware Sept. 16. Bumped at the break this time, the \$5,000 juvenile purchase came up the inside to put a head in front after a half in :44 2/5 and outgamed the favorite to the wire to take the photo. "At the eighth pole, I couldn't take it any more and had to look the other way," winning owner Ken Taylor said, but added, "She's never been beaten in the stretch." Jockey Mark Johnston said, "She just wouldn't let that other filly by. I thought I was in big trouble in midstretch, but she dug in." The runner-up, winner of the GIII Kentucky Breeders' Cup S. over colts May 29 and the GIII Debutante S. over fillies July 8, was making her first start since taking the July 26 GII Schuylerville S. by a neck. "I think she got a little tired at the end," trainer Mark Hennig said. "The Breeders' Cup is a possibility, but more than likely we'll try something else."

A consistent stakes performer all season, Crimson Quest's previous best effort was when second, albeit a distant one, to Arc hero Sinndar (Ire) in the G2 Prix Niel at Longchamp Sept. 10. He started this year with a win in the Listed Prix de Courcelles at this track Mar. 30 and added this, his first group win, with a decisive final-furlong burst to beat stablemate Slew The Red. Kind Regards (Ire) (Unfuwain) led at a good pace, with Crimson Quest close up in second and G1 Prix du Jockey Club winner Holding Court (GB) (Hernando {Fr}) in third. But the French Derby hero faded quickly before the straight as Crimson Quest made his bid for the lead. The winner took over in front inside the final quarter mile, then ran on strongly inside the final furlong to easily hold Slew The Red. Folie Danse kept on well from rear, but was eased close home when it became apparent she couldn't improve on her third place--according to her trainer Yves de Nicolay, she will now run in the Hong Kong Vase Dec. 17. Holding Court finished distressed when crossing the line last, 15 lengths off the fourth horse. Trainer Michael Jarvis was at pains to explain the situation. Interviewed by the stewards afterwards, he said the colt had worked nicely, was eating well and had travelled well to Longchamp. He added that he was slightly concerned before the race as Holding Court, usually on edge before a race, was too calm compared to his usual behaviour. He asked the stewards to order that the horse be tested.
