CALIFORNIA JUVENILE WARRIORS PREP

Flame Thrower (Saint Ballado) and Street Cry (Ire) (Machiavellian), first and second respectively in the GII Del Mar Futurity and GII Norfolk S. in their last two meetings, were out for work yesterday morn-

ing over a fast Santa Anita main track as they prepare for their third head-to-head confrontation in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile. Trained by Bob Baffert, undefeated Flame Thrower cruised through a bullet half mile in :46 2/5 with exercise rider Dana Barnes in the irons. Godolphin's Street Cry covered five furlongs in a cofastest :58 2/5 for trainer Eoin Harty. California-bred Arabian Light (Fly So Free), third for Baffert in the Del Mar Futurity and winner of Keeneland's GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity, breezed four panels in :47 2/5 and is expected to supplement for the Juvenile.

TIZNOW ON TO LOUISVILLE?

Wearing a Breeders' Cup hat, trainer Jay Robbins of GII Goodwood Breeders' Cup H. winner Tiznow (Cee's Tizzy) suggested that the full brother to last year's Breeders' Cup Classic runner up Budroyale will make his next start in the Classic. "As of right now, we're going," Robbins said yesterday, but cautioned, "unless he doesn't train well over the next four of five days." If he starts, his owners will need to be supplemented for \$360,000.

COLSTAR WILL BE SUPPLEMENTED

Colstar (Opening Verse), who ran down Snow Polina to register an upset in the GI Flower Bowl at Belmont Park Oct. 7, will be supplemented to run in the Filly & Mare Turf. Owner Beverly Steinman will pay the \$90,000 supplement for her four-year-old filly, who is trained by Paul Fout. Four-for-six on the year, the bay won her first three starts of the season, before back-to-back losses to divisional leader Perfect Sting. Fout indicated that Perfect Sting's loss in last Friday's GIII WinStar Galaxy S. was a contibuting factor in his decision to send Colstar.

All Time High gave her sire his first Group 1 winner with this victory. The game filly settled last among 15 as 2-1 favourite So Gorgeous (Aus) (Brief Truce) rallied to take the lead before folding to finish last. Patiently ridden by jockey Steven Arnold, she produced a stunning burst of speed to win by two lengths from Ponton Flyer, a winner of the G3 Blue Diamond Prelude as a two-year-old, with Tanith a short head away third. "I was always going to ride her guietly and luckily they went quickly," said Arnold. Trainer Russell Cameron will send the a A\$110,000 Inglis Easter Yearling Sale graduate to the Crown Oaks at Flemington Nov. 9 after she contests the Wakeful S. five days earlier. Having raced nine times for two wins and three placings, she resumed on Aug. 26 to finish runner-up to So Gorgeous in the Listed Quezette S. before filling third place behind that same rival in the G3 Tranquil Star S. on Sept. 23 and 2 1/2 lengths fourth, again to the same filly, in the G2 Manifold S. Oct. 7.



RIVER KEEN RETIRED River Keen (Ire) (Keen {GB}-Immediate Impact {Ire}, by Caerleon), a four-time graded stakes winner, has been retired from racing, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The eight-year-old chestnut, claimed by trainer Bob Baffert and owner Hugo Reynolds for \$100,000 in 1998, won last year's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, GI Woodward S. and GII Bel Air H., as well as the 1997 GII California S. Winless in five starts this year, River Keen was an uninspired sixth in Sunday's GII Goodwood Breeders Cup H. "He just doesn't want to do it anymore," Baffert told the *Form*, adding the veteran runner had bled in the Goodwood. River Keen retires with 11 wins in 42 starts and earnings of \$1,642,272.

TABASCO CAT TO JAPAN Overbrook stallion Tabasco Cat (Storm Cat--Barbicue Sauce, by Sauce Boat) has been sold to Japanese interests for \$7 million, according to the Japanese newspaper Sankei Sports. The nine-year-old was purchased by the Japanese Bloodstock Breeders' Association for the Shizunai Stallion Station and has sired four stakes winners from his first two crops to race, including Paterson S. winner Cat's At Home, who is scheduled to make his next start in the \$250,000 GII Pegasus H. at The Meadowlands Oct. 27. Overbrook Farm's farm manager Ric Waldman would not confirm the transaction, indicating there are details remaining which need to be hammered out.

IMPEACHMENT TO FLORIDA Impeachment (Deputy Minister--Misconduct, by Stick to Beauty), third in the 2000 Kentucky Derby and Preakness, is being syndciated and will stand the 2001 breeding season at Meadowbrook Farm in Ocala, Florida for a \$5,000 stud fee. Dogwood Stable Inc. will act as co-syndicate manager along with Robert Candow. Impeachment's syndicated share price will be \$18,000 per share. "Impeachment is a horse who danced every dance, faced the best horses in training all spring and summer and never flinched," said Dogwood president Cot Campbell. "Fusaichi Pegasus beat him only a head in the Preakness and that speaks volulmes. We're excited about his future at stud."

LADY LUCK TOPS OBS SESSION Thirteen-year-old Lucky Lady Lauren (Carnivalay) topped yesterday's third and final consignor preferred session of the OBS Fall Mixed Sale. Consigned to the sale by Lakland Farm LLC, the mare, in foal to 1999 GI Blue Grass and GI Haskell winner Menifee (Harlan), the graded-stakes winning mare was knocked down for a session-topping \$67,000 to Hickstead Farm. The third day saw 134 horses sold for gross receipts of \$1,985,400 and an average of \$14,816. Bidding continues this morning at 10:30 a.m with the first of two open sessions.
