### Ribolletta Supplemented to Cup

Ribolletta (Brz) (Roi Normand) will be supplemented to the Breeders' Cup Distaff, according to *Daily Racing Form*. Owners Aaron and Marie Jones will have to pay \$400,000 to give their

Brazilian-bred mare the chance to run in the Breeders' Cup. Ribolletta already leads her division after dominating wins in the GI Vanity, GI Ruffian and Saturday's GI Beldame. Also expected to be supplemented to the Cup are **Tiznow** (Cee's Tizzy), **Gander** (Cormorant) and **Captain Steve** (Fly So Free), who are all likely for the Classic.

### Heritage of Gold Gets Clean Bill of Health

Jack Garey's **Heritage of Gold** (Gold Legend), a disappointing fourth at odds-on in Saturday's GI Three Chimneys Spinster at Keeneland, has been pronounced in good health following her physical examination at Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital Tuesday. "She's fine. Everything checked out great," said trainer Tom Amoss. "Everything came out clean. Now we just have to try to get her back on her game." The five-year-old, winner of this year's GI Apple Blossom H. and GI Go For Wand, could still make the Breeders' Cup Distaff.

### JAPAN CUP FRONTS 87 FOREIGN NOMINEES

The Japan Racing Association has announced the foreign nominees for the \$4,533,333 G1 Japan Cup (Nov. 26) and the inaugural running of the \$2,361,904 G1 Japan Cup Dirt (Nov. 25). Included in the 58 overseas-nominated horses are Group 1 winners: Australia's **Freemason (Aus)** (Grand Lodge); England's **Kalanisi (Ire)** (Doyoun {Ire}); France's **Montjeu (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells); and the United States' **Mash One (Chi)** (Mashkour) and **Val's Prince** (Eternal Prince). Among the 29 horses up to contest the debut of the Japan Cup Dirt is Australia-New Zealand Horse of the Year **Sunline (NZ)** (Desert Sun {GB}); Ireland's Iron Horse **Giant's Causeway** (Storm Cat); and the States' Grade I winners **Albert The Great** (Go For Gin) and **Tiznow** (Cee's Tizzy).

**MALEK TO CALIFORNIA** Malek (Chi) (Mocito Guapo {Arg}--Condegnita {Chi}, by Chairman Walker) will stand the 2001 Northern Hemisphere breeding season at Ron and Fran Stolich's Blooming Hills Farm near Clements, California, according to *The Blood Horse*. The winner of the 1998 GI Santa Anita H., Malek began his stallion career this year at Haras Mocito Guapo in Chile. He will stand in the U.S. as the property of Great Falls S A for \$6,000 live foal. During his racing career, the seven-year-old stallion was named champion two-year-old in Chile and was runner-up in the 1999 Dubai World Cup. He retired earlier this year with 10 wins in 23 starts and earnings of \$2,382,623.

Unhurried early on, the Neil Drysdale-trained filly settled in midpack, broke through traffic with half the stretch left to run and quickened under jockey Pat Day's urging to make the late, winning sprint. "That was a great performance," said Day. "She didn't get away from there real, real quick, but after the first few jumps, she put herself right in the race. We were looking for a seam [in the stretch] and when it finally opened up, she responded very, very well. She ran right through the opening and once she was in the clear, she really turned it on." Freefouracing may have earned herself a Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies start with this effort.

**DELEGATION SEEKS SAFETY FIRST**

While it is currently normal practice for onlookers to visit racehorse training grounds in Britain, particularly in Newmarket, that could change due to the efforts of a delegation from racing in prompting a change to existing legislation. The delegation, made up of several interested parties, met with government minister Lord Whitty yesterday to express concerns about safety for walkers, work-riders and racehorses within the context of the Countryside and Rights Of Way Bill which aims to increase public access to open country. Lord Carnarvon, who sat on the delegation, said, "Lord Whitty has been tremendously helpful. He has recognised our genuine and legitimate concerns and has agreed to bring forward a Government amendment to the Bill at the House of Lords' Report stage in around two weeks' time. The intention is to restrict public access to racehorse training grounds. Racehorses are volatile creatures and we want to avoid people venturing into these areas when their safety may be at risk." Lord Donoghue, also on the delegation, added, "Lord Whitty and his officials evidently appreciate that racehorse training grounds are a working environment; that they are, in fact, racing's factory floor."
