## DILSHAAN SHINES IN RACING POST TROPHY

Dilshaan (GB) (Darshaan {GB}) showed a big race temperament and a large amount of ability to take yesterday's G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster, but it was jockey J. P. Murtagh who stole the show to once again grab Group 1 glory. Now successful at the top level 10 times in 2000, thanks to the likes of Sinn dar (Ire) and Petrushka (Ire), the Irishman displayed his skill once more to guide the maiden Dilshaan to success. Second at Sandown on his only prior start, the colt was staying on at the finish that day despite running greenly. That could not be taken as a hint that he might take this mighty step up in class in his stride, but that is just what he did at 14-1. Murtagh rated his mount in last early as Darwin (Ire) (Danehill) and jockey Paul Scallan set the pace up front, keeping the inexperienced runner wide as the field scrimmaged in front of him. Tracking 11-4 Tamburlaine (Ire) (Royal Academy) and Freud (Storm Cat), the winner was still trailing, but sitting in a comfortable position entering the straight. Tamburlaine put what looked like his seal on the race with 2 1/2 furlongs remaining, quickening clear in a few strides, and only Dilshaan could follow. Although he took a while to get down to work, he gave Murtagh what he needed to pass Tamburlaine with 150 yards remaining before powering away for a convincing success.

Bonnard (Ire) (Nureyev), who was keen early, came through the pack to gain an honourable third. Winning trainer Sir Michael Stoute said, "I wasn't confident we'd win it, but I felt he was entitled to run, and win well, as he's progressed a lot since his first race. He has a lot of scope, and he's still got to get more powerful. He handles the ground alright, but the main thing is he stays well--he needs to go a little bit further than a mile next year." A delighted Murtagh added, "It's fantastic--it's just picked up and kept going all through the year. I can't believe it really. Mr. Stoute said this colt's not fully furnished yet, so just give him a chance to find his feet. He did that beautifully and down the straight he was staying well--when he got to the front he just pricked his ears a little bit, but fair dues to the horse, he did it well and as its only his second race he can only improve." Dilshaan is now quoted at 20-1 with Ladbrokes and Victor Chandler for next year's G1 Epsom Derby, the second part of a three-race bonus, including the G1 St. Leger at Doncaster, which could earn his connections £1 million. ## ONE FOR HOME TEAM IN GRAN CRITERIUM?

The hopes of a nation will rest on the shoulders of Sopran Glaumix (Ire) (Linamix {Fr}) in today's G1 Gran Criterium at Milan. The colt, bidding to become the first home-trained winner of this contest since Glory Of Dancer (GB) in 1995, is unbeaten in four starts and his win in the Listed Premio del Dado here Oct. 1, a four-length victory over Lagudin (Ire), looks better after the runner-up won in Britain this week. Previously, he had won the Listed Premio Giuseppe de Montel at this course July 6, where Barking Mad was a half length away in second. The usual strong overseas challenge is fronted by trainer Aidan O'Brien's King's County (Ire) (Fairy King), who ranks with the best juveniles in Europe after his length second to Okawango in the G1 Grand Criterium at Longchamp Oct. 8. The Ballydoyle runner was also second, three lengths behind Beckett (Ire), in the G1 National S. Sept. 17. Trainer William Haggas is enjoying a fruitful year with his two-year-olds and his Count Dubois (GB) (Zafonic) was just over a length third to Mozart (Ire) in the Tattersalls Houghton Sales S. at Newmarket Sept. 26. Last time out, he finished third to current G1 English 2000 Guineas ante-post favourite Nayef in the Listed Autumn S. at Ascot Oct. 7, so it will be interesting to see how he fares here.

Sign Of Hope started the year with handicap wins at  
 Windsor in March and Pontefract in May, then missed  
 by a neck when second to El Gran Papa in a June 22  
 handicap at Royal Ascot. Shipped to the U.S. after that  
 effort, the chestnut made his American bow in the Gill  
 La Jolla H. at Del Mar Aug. 19 and finished fourth. In  
 his latest attempt, the British-bred trailed early before  
 making up some ground to finish fifth in the Gill Del Mar  
 Derby Sept. 10. Able to sit closer this time behind a  
 softer pace, he saved ground while fourth, switched to  
 the outside for the stretch drive and roared past front-  
 running David Copperfield in the final sixteenth to win  
 going away. "The turf course at Del Mar was beat up  
 and he stumbled all the way around in his races there,"  
 jockey Alex Solis said. "He just never got a hold of the  
 course at all down there. This course is in great shape  
 and he handled it very well." Even-money chalk  
 Jokerman (Septieme Ciel) stalked the pace, but came up  
 empty when it counted and finished last.

Good Game stepped out of Gaviola's shadow and bounded clear for her first graded success. After rallying to win the Christiana S. at Delaware in July for trainer Tony Dutrow, the filly was purchased by her current connections and took on Gaviola in her next two starts. Second to her in the GII Lake Placid H. at Saratoga, she tired to finish sixth in the GI Garden City Breeders' Cup H. at Belmont Sept. 10. Forwardly placed on the outside here, the gray rated just outside of Trip down the backstretch and came very wide off the far turn. Taking command in midstretch, she held off the late bid of Impending Bear under a hand ride. "In the last race, she got caught in a speed duel and really didn't have much left at the end," said winning trainer Neil Howard. "The Mrs. Revere [GII, CD, Nov. 18] is an obvious place to point to, but I will talk it over with [owners] Mr. Farish and Mr. Hudson and we will have a plan."

Wellbeing has taken all the tests that have been put forward this season, showing an impressive attitude in the process. Twice successful at Newmarket earlier in the year, he came down with the lung infection that ravaged trainer Henry Cecil's Warren Place yard in May and so went to the G1 Epsom Derby without a crucial final prep, yet ran a highly creditable fifth to Sinndar (Ire), then was rested to allow a return to full strength. That looked to be the case back at Newmarket last time as he lengthened away up rising ground to beat Pawn Broker (GB) by five lengths in the Listed Godolphin S. Sept. 29. Here he established the case that he will be a four-year-old to look forward to, collecting his second stakes success in the very testing conditions. He was slow away, but the pace was not strong early and he was soon within shouting distance of Boreas and Jamie Spencer. He moved up the inside on the final turn as Boreas kept up the gallop in front and Marienbard continued to threaten on the other side. These three pulled away from the rest as they came up the centre of the straight. While Marienbard and jockey Frankie Dettori took the initiative to get in front with three furlongs remaining, Wellbeing floundered slightly in the mud, but he was able to pick up well, hitting the front with a furlong remaining. Despite drifting right, he had enough in hand to go away from his pursuers at the finish. "He hates that ground and I told Richard (Quinn) not to ask him until as late as he sensibly could," said winning trainer Henry Cecil. "I do think he'll make up into a really good horse next year and, of course, he'll be put in everything."

**Amilynx** was an impressive winner of this event last October, beating **Tajoun** by a length and a half and signing off a memorable season which had seen him take the **G2 Prix Hubert de Chaudenay** at this course earlier in the month. He returned this season with a highly creditable second to **Russian Hope (Ire)** over an inadequate 10 furlongs in the **G3 Prix Exbury** at **Saint-Cloud** Mar. 11 before finishing seventh to **Fantastic Light** in the **G3 Dubai Sheema Classic** at **Nad Al Sheba** Mar. 25 over a mile and a half. He showed his aptitude for that trip in the **G2 Prix Vicomtesse Vigier** here May 21, where he had the consistent performer **Yavana's Pace** five lengths back in third. Trainer **Andre Fabre** has also supplemented **Daring Miss** for this and she followed success in the **G3 Grand Prix de Chantilly** June 11 with a respectable five-lengths second to **Montjeu (Ire)** in the **G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud** July 1. The German-trained and highly consistent performer **Moonlady** has looked up to a task such as this with wins in the **G3 Deutscher Herold-Preis** at **Hamburg** June 24 and **G3 Preis der Stadtparkasse** at **Hannover** Sept. 10. **John Dunlop** has two representatives here, and while **San Sebastian** is a tough performer, **Orchestra Stall** has had a light campaign. Last time he took the **G3 Prix Gladiateur** here Sept. 5 and, on strict formlines, he does not have too much to find on **Amilynx**.

**Golden Snake** justified the decision to keep him in training as a four-year-old by collecting his second success at the highest level last time in the G1 Preis von Europa at Cologne Sept. 24. He beat the supremely tough and evergreen Yavana's Pace (Ire) by a nose there, with Catella (Ger) a further six lengths back in third. Previous to that he had looked unlucky when fifth behind Agol Lack in the G3 Coupe de Maisons-Laffitte Sept. 13, where he raced on the slower ground in the centre. Having finished a length-and-a-half second to Volvoretta (GB) in the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp Sept. 10, she was then denied by three-quarters of length by Petrushka (Ire) in the G1 Prix de l'Opera at the same course Oct. 1. The home defence looks weak, but **Poseidon** showed he retained some ability last time when winning the G3 Premio Federico Tesio here Oct. 1 from Jar.
