FIFTEEN MILLION REASONS TO

PLAY A total of \$15.2 million is up for grabs Saturday when a record 105 horses will face the starter for Breeders' Cup XVII at Churchill Downs. The fields include no fewer than 16 supplementary

nominations, including the afternoon's heaviest morningline favorite, Riboletta (Brz) (Roi Normand), who will depart from post nine as the 4-5 choice in the Distaff. "The post doesn't make any difference," commented trainer Eduardo Inda. "I like the outside. (Jockey) Chris (McCarron) said at Hollywood Park that she preferred to be on the outside." The five-year-old mare is one of a handful of candidates for Horse-of-the-Year honors who will race beneath the Twin Spires. Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector) is the 8-5 favorite in the \$4.7 million Classic, as he squares off against fellow Horse of the Year candidate Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo), the 5-1 co-second choice. A \$4 million yearling purchase, Fusaichi Pegasus will be making his final career start in the Classic. "When he was purchased, the two races we wanted to win with him were the Kentucky Derby and the Breeders' Cup Classic,' said trainer Neil Drysdale, who will also saddle 4-1 Mile favorite War Chant (Danzig). "He's won the Derby and is a fresh horse for the Classic. He is right where he is supposed to be." FuPeg sets sail from the nine hole. A last-minute entrant, Montjeu (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) has been made the 5-2 choice in the afternoon's penultimate event, the Turf. The Michael Tabor colorbearer, fourth in the G1 Arc de Triomphe and second to Kalanisi (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}) in the G1 Dubai Champion S. Oct. 14, will break from post position number four in what will be his final trip postward. Kona Gold (Java Gold), third in the 1998 Sprint at Churchill, was second in last year's renewal at Gulfstream Park and is the deserving favorite this time around at 5-2 from the 10 hole. The Todd Pletcher tandem of More Than Ready (Southern Halo) and Trippi (End Sweep) drew posts one and two respectively. "If I was picking posts for this race," Pletcher said, "No. 1 would be my 14th pick and No. 2 would have been my 13th pick." The other favorites include Petrushka (Ire) (Unfuwain) in the Filly & Mare Turf at 5-2: Flame Thrower (Saint Ballado) is favored at 3-1 in the Juvenile; and undefeated Raging Fever (Storm Cat) is the 7-2 morning line choice in the Juvenile Fillies.

In fact, it had looked as if that filly had made a decisive winning move with a furlong and a half remaining, when she passed Low Pivot, but he fought back spiritedly to claim his first stakes success on the line.



LEVY SCHEME AGREEMENT

The Horserace Betting Levy Board and the Bookmakers' Committee yesterday reached agreement on the terms of the 40th Levy Scheme, avoiding government involvement in the process. The decisive factor, a push for a reduction in General Betting Duty, helped the representatives from racing and bookmaking to unite and come together. The rates marked out offer the chance to raise £60 million, a figure which can only aid in the growth of the horseracing industry in Britain. Robert Hughes, the Levy Board Chairman, said today: "I would like to congratulate everyone involved in securing an agreement. The result is that the racing and bookmaking industries have presented a united front in sending a message to the Chancellor that a cut in GBD is needed urgently. If he responds at an adequate level, the British bookmaking industry will be stabilised and racing's funding will be strengthened."

GO RACING STEP UP MEDIA RIGHTS ISSUE

Go Racing have now upped the stakes for the best deal for media coverage of racing in Britain by offering a deal worth £750 million, the previous best was £400 million from Carlton before yesterday. The Go Racing consortium, comprising of Arena Leisure, BSkyB, and Channel 4, offer a deal covering all 59 racecourses over 10 years on both a terrestrial and interactive level. Ian Penrose of Arena Leisure said: "We are delighted that Go Racing is in a position to go ahead with its plan. We believe this is the best solution."
