DISPERSALS CENTER STAGE AT KEENELAND

The massive 14-day Keeneland November Sale of Racing and Breeding Stock kicked off yesterday in Lexington with the dispersal of horses from Morven Stud, the Allen Paulson trust, Marshall Naify's 505 Farms and Robert and Bea Roberts. Nine-year-old mare Electric Society (Ire) (Law Society) was the subject of lively bidding and sold for a session-topping price of \$1.35 million to Alex Scrope acting as agent for Gerald Leigh's Eydon Hall Stud in England. The brown mare, winner in the United States of the GII Diana H. and GII New York H., was consigned to the sale by Walnut Green, the agent for the complete dispersal of Morven Stud Ltd and is in foal to Deputy Minister. "After the bidding is over, I always say that I would have gone farther, but I was happy," Leigh commented after his purchase. The mare is to join Leigh's growing broodmare band in Europe. "We have a very small, but select group of broodmares. I try to keep somewhere around 15 to 17." Mr. Leigh also raced Coretta (Ire) (Caerleon), who was second in last year's Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf. Solar Slew (Seattle Slew), the dam of multiple horse of the year Cigar, accounted for the afternoon's second highest price when Fred Seitz of Brookdale Farm outlasted Katsumi Yoshida at \$1.3 million. "I bought her for a yet-to-be determined group of breeders," Seitz said. "I am included, but we haven't put the names together yet." The 18-year-old is in foal to Brookdale stallion Deputy Minister and was led over to the sale by Narvick International, agent for the Allen E. Paulson Living Trust. The sale continues this morning at 10 a.m.

A.P. Indy Colt Best Among Weanlings

A colt by horse of the year and Classic winner A.P. Indy brought a final bid of \$800,000, best on the day for a weanling. The bay, consigned by Walnut Green for the Morven Stud dispersal, is a half brother to Stormy Temper (Conquistador Cielo), a multiple stakes winner of over \$249,000 and is from the family of Flanders, the dam of Breeders' Cup Distaff runner up Surfside. The colt was purchased by Russell Drake, the farm manager for West Coast-based horseman Marty Wygod. The ticket was signed in the name of Kentucky Properties LLC. The weanling Danzig colt from session-topping broodmare Electric Society (Ire) (Law Society) was knocked down for a final bid of \$425,000 from the Curragh Bloodstock Agency.

Stallion Seasons for a Charitable Cause

The session concluded with the sale of 10 no-guarantee stallion seasons to some established and exciting new stallions. A portion of the proceeds, including Keeneland's five-percent commission, is to be donated to the Grayson Jockey Club Foundation. Agent Buzz Chace was most active, taking home no fewer than four seasons, including the half-million dollar Storm Cat season. He also purchased a \$270,000 season to Dubai World Cup winner Dubai Millennium. Arthur B. Hancock's Stone Farm and Robert and Janice McNair's Stonerside Stable shared in a \$225,000 season to Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus. Hancock was responsible for selling Fusaichi Pegasus as a yearling at the 1998 July Sale. All told, the 10 seasons grossed a total of \$2.5 million.

BEAUTIFUL BID BRINGS BIG BID Beautiful Bid (Baldski), the dam of 1999 Champion older mare and Breeders' Cup Distaff winner Beautiful Pleasure (Maudlin) as well as her multi-millionaire full brother Mecke, sold for \$2.6 million to top last night's Fasig-Tipton Fall Mixed Sale at Newtown Paddocks just north of Lexington. Consigned to the sale by FitzGerald/Keogh, the 16-year-old mare was sold in foal to Storm Cat to Gaines-Gentry Thoroughbreds. Interestingly, an unraced half sister to the aforementioned runners, The Franchise, was bought back for \$1.975 million. The evening's second highest-priced lot was hip number 35, Alizea (Premiership). She was taken for \$850,000 by Summer Wind Farm from the consignment of Taylor Made Sales Agency and is the dam of multiple stakes winner Lifeisawhirl (Island Whirl) and promising juvenile Songandapraver (Unbridled's Song). Fasig-Tipton reported gross receipts of \$7,625,000, down 23.7 percent against last year. The average of \$133,772 represented a 15.7-percent decrease from last year.

Grand Lodge has an excellent opportunity to add a Melbourne Cup winner to his already impressive list of classic winners with Freemason (Aus), an excellent fourth in Saturday's 2000m Mackinnon S., carrying 57.5kg compared with the 53kg he has for the Cup. Throughout the four-year-old's entire spring campaign, trainer John Hawkes said he wasn't certain Freemason would get 3200m, but has revisited that idea. "He's been trained for two miles. He's got the miles in his legs and if he's good enough he'll win it," he said. "He is my best ever chance and the barrier draw is ideal." The winner of this year's G1 Queensland Derby on the same day Grand Lodge's star Sinndar (Ire) landed the Vodafone Derby, he has had six starts this campaign culminating with his Caulfield Cup fourth and Mackinnon fourth. Diatribe (Aus), runner-up in the Cox Plate last Saturday, has eased to 8-1 after drawing awkwardly in 15. "I know he has a big job in front of him, but he's had a good preparation and is in great shape," said trainer George Hanlon, who is seeking a fourth Cup. Yippyio (Aus), G2 Moonee Valley Cup winner at his last appearance, is poised to make his presence felt with jockey Darren Beadman aboard.

Smooth Player was coming off a three-length triumph in the Oct. 9 GII Lady's Secret H. over the main Santa Anita track. The Cal-bred filly set an uncontested early pace, opening up as much as five lengths on the field through fractions of :23.34, :47.01 and 1:10.62. She was passed briefly in the stretch by favored Happyanunoit, but battled both the New Zealand-bred miss and the late-closing Beautiful Noise into submission in a hard-fought finish. "When I saw the 23 and change, I felt real good," admitted winning trainer Dan Hendricks. "When you've got [jockey] Eddie D., you've always got something left; you're not going to have one running out of gas at the quarter pole. She's a tough mare, when she's right and carrying weight into races like she is right now, she's tough."

During a successful juvenile campaign in England, Brahms ran second in the G1 Dewhurst and third in the G1 Middle Park S. He ended 1999 with a seventh-place outing on the Gulfstream dirt in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile. Brahms, who didn't draw into Saturday's Breeder's Cup Mile, resurfaced 10 months later to win a Saratoga allowance on the turf and added the Oct. 14 Seattle Slew S. at Keeneland last time out. Second choice in the field of nine, the colt settled inside early, moved up leaving the backstretch and overtook longtime pacesetter Vergennes in a driving finish. "We were back in the pack early but he was comfortable," commented winning rider Pat Day. "He dropped down along the inside at the top of the stretch and he went after the lead with a vengeance. We're really looking forward to his future. He just keeps improving." Winning trainer Elliott Walden added, "We were disappointed that we didn't get in the Breeders' Cup and Pat was set to ride him. So we just went to plan B and it worked today. Our goal now is the [Nov. 26 GI] Hollywood Derby and we used this as a prep for that race."

BREEDERS' CUP WRAP-UP

Juddmonte Farms' Spanish Fern (El Gran Senor) died Saturday night after fracturing her pelvis just after the start of the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf. "When she got to the clinic (Rood & Riddle in

Lexington), they thought she was going to be all right," trainer Bobby Frankel said yesterday. "At one point, they thought it was a problem with her femur, but they called later and told me she fractured her pelvis. It's a shame. She was a nice, nice mare." The five-year-old counted the GI Yellow Ribbon in 1999 among her six victories from 20 starts. Classic winner Tiznow (Cee's Tizzy) was due to return to California yesterday following his neck success over European star Giant's Causeway (Storm Cat). The flashy dark bay is due some time off, but will likely contest the final two legs of Santa Anita's Strub series for four-year-olds with the ultimate goal the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 3. Stronach Stables' two Breeders' Cup winners Macho Uno (Holy Bull) and Perfect Sting (Red Ransom) were returned to their New York base yesterday. Trainer Joe Orseno knows he has a work-in-progress with his gray juvenile. "The horse learns by doing, but he still has a long way to go," Orseno said. "The horses he beat yesterday are way ahead of him. He will grow and he will develop and he will overcome his stupidity." The Filly/Mare Turf heroine was originally scheduled to be bred, but Orseno said it was likely that she would race again next year. Also likely to defend his Breeders' Cup title is Sprint champion Kona Gold (Java Gold). "I'll just rest him for a while and then start him in the winter at Santa Anita," commented trainer Bruce Headley. "We'll have probably six starts for him again next year." The Neil Drysdaletrained team of Mile winner War Chant (Danzig) and beaten Classic favorite Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector) emerged from their respective efforts in good shape, according to the trainer. War Chant will return to Drysdale's Southern California stable, while the Derby winner retires to Ashford Stud in Versailles, Kentucky. Juvenile Fillies upsetter Caressing (Honour and Glory) was a surprise to most, but not trainer David Vance. "She trained super coming into this race," Vance said. "I worked her in company right before the race to make her competitive. It worked out good for her." The filly will be let down and give 45-60 days off before commencing a sophomore campaign, which would hopefully encompass the GI Kentucky Oaks on her home track the first Friday in May, according to the trainer.

Irish-bred Kalanisi (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}), who secured the Turf with an exciting stretch run, is to return to the Newmarket yard of trainer Sir Michael Stoute. There are no firm plans for a 2001 campaign for the colt, owned and bred by the Aga Khan. Finally, Distaff winner Spain (Thunder Gulch) will get some time off before returning to California. Of the winner, trainer D. Wayne Lukas said, "She has come a long way from seventh in the Kentucky Oaks to this. She really flourished in the program and improved alot." Lukas took over the training of the filly this past summer.

SUNLINE LEANS TOWARD HONG KONG MILE

Sunline (NZ) (Desert Sun {GB}) is more likely to target the Hong Kong Mile, her initial goal, rather than the World Series finale, the Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin on Dec. 17. Trainers Trevor and Steve McKee originally preferred the Mile, but paid the A\$12,500 late acceptance fee for the Cup last week and watched Giant's Causeway's (USA) second in the Breeders' Cup Classic lift him to outright lead. "We have a week or so to make up our minds, but my leaning is towards the mile," Steve McKee told the Age newspaper. "We'll sit down and have a look at the points in the next few days and work out whether it's a good gamble to try to win the series." Five-year-old Sunline equaled Dulcify's (Aus) 1979 record margin of seven lengths, pulverizing her Cox Plate opponents on Oct. 28. The mare took her stake earnings to A\$6,334,692, well past Australasia's previous highest earner Octagonal (NZ) who earned A\$5,829,231. She may target the Dubai World Cup in March and the McKees haven't ruled out a tilt at a third successive Cox Plate.
