MAGICAL ALLURE CARRIES KEENELAND

The race was close, but at the end of the night, the five-year-old mare Magical Allure (General Meeting), in foal to leading sire Storm Cat, topped yesterday's third session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington with a stratospheric price tag of \$4.2 million. The mare, consigned by Eaton Sales as agent for Mr. and Mrs. John Mabee, was purchased by Sheikh Hamdan al Maktoum and his Shadwell Estate Company after a spirited bidding duel with Rich Decker and WinStar Farm's Kenny Troutt. Shadwell farm manager Rick Nichols signed the sale's slip for the multiple graded stakes winner. "She was a Grade I winner, she is in foal to Storm Cat and she was very very tough on the racetrack," Nichols said after the purchase. "We thought that she might be the best. She'll go to Shadwell and we'll see who the boss wants to breed her to." Magical Allure counted the GI La Brea S. and GII Lady's Secret Breeders' Cup H. among her victories on the track and she was never off the board in 12 outings. John Magnier made only one bid on hip number 789, the four-year-old mare Blissful (Mr. Prospector), but it was the winning \$4-million bid that brought the full sister to Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus, in foal to Deputy Minister, to Coolmore. "We've got two choices, I think," Magnier said when asked about Blissful's future. "One is to keep her here and breed to Storm Cat, and the second is to take her back [to Ireland] and breed to Giant's Causeway (Storm Cat). We'll probably take her to Storm Cat." At this sale in 1996, Robert and Beverly Lewis purchased Blissful as a weanling for \$1 million. Also among the 10 mares bringing seven figures yesterday was Oyster Catcher (Ire) (Bluebird). Britton House Stud purchased the four-year-old mare, in foal to Seeking the Gold, for \$2.15 million from the consignment of Eaton Sales, agent. "It is a wonderful family and fits perfectly into our plans," said Dick Fawlston, bloodstock advisor for Roger Baines and his Britton House Stud. "The fact that she was an outstanding runner, that she comes from a great family and she is in foal to Seeking the Gold made her quite an attraction." Britton House also purchased the Leonila (Ire) (Caerleon), in foal to Rahy, for \$2 million from the consignment of FitzGerald/Keogh, agent. *Cont. p. 2*

A filly by super sire Storm Cat brought \$1.05 million to become the top-priced weanling at yesterday's Keeneland November sale. The youngster, out of Jetapat (Tri Jet), was consigned by Brereton Jones and his Airdrie Stud and was purchased by Bradley & Bowden LLC, as agent. "It's an easy game sometimes," said Jones. "I bought the mare at Fasig-Tipton for \$72,000. It works out sometimes and you just smile when it does. But she is a very, very nice filly. I wish them the best of luck."

Tuesday Overview...

On Tuesday, Keeneland sold 11 horses for \$1 million or more. That brings the sale total to 35 million-dollar horses. Through three days, the average is up 21.9 percent from last year and the median is up 7.1 percent. The sale continues today at 10 a.m.

FUSAICHI PEGASUS'S STUD FEE SET Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector--Angel Fever, by Danzig) arrived safely at Ashford Stud in Kentucky and his stud fee has been set at \$150,000, live foal. "We have already had a tremendous number of applications," explained Ashford's director of sales Aisling Cross. "Breeders are naturally keen to use a colt whose pedigree and conformation were good enough for him to top the world's most competitive yearling sale and who was talented enough to win one of the world's most competitive races." Fusaichi Pegasus enters stud with six wins in nine starts and earnings of \$1,994,400. In addition to the Derby, the three-year-old won the GII Wood Memorial, GII San Felipe S. and GII Jerome H.

DOWN THE AISLE RETIRED Down the Aisle (Run-away Groom--That's My Hon, by L'Enjoleur) has been retired and will enter stud next year at Dixiana Farm near Lexington, Kentucky, according to *The Blood-Horse*. Charles Deters, owner and breeder of the seven-year-old, retained a 25-percent interest in the stallion, and sold the majority interest to Albert Coppola. Down the Aisle captured this year's GI United Nations H. and GIII Bougainvillea H. He retires with nine wins and 10 placings in 21 starts for earnings of \$1,007,989. Down the Aisle, 12th in Saturday's Breeders' Cup Turf, will stand for \$5,000.

Regally bred Brew drew into the Melbourne Cup field with a victory in Saturday's SAAB Quality, but drew the outside barrier and was sacked by senior rider Chris Munce. Despite the turmoil, the six-year-old lived up to his pedigree when he sprinted to a two-length victory before a record Flemington crowd of 121,000. Jockey Kerrin McEvoy settled Brew midfield, one off the fence, and waited patiently before sprinting from the 300-meter mark when the race turned into a four-horse affair. From there he caught and passed stablemate Second Coming and withstood a charge from late-running Yippyio to secure the win. "To win the Melbourne Cup in my first ride in the race is just unbelievable," said McEvoy. "I got across nice and quietly with a whole bunch in front of me. They all went forward early and there was no use going with them, so I came back one off the fence near Yippyio, got cover and he relaxed really well. I bided my time coming into the straight as Mike said not to get there too soon."

Lager returned to the site of his last win--the GIII Excelsior H. over course and distance Apr. 29--and recorded a last-stride victory. Runner-up to Fire King in an Oct. 20 Belmont allowance last time out, the chestnut gelding dropped back to last in the early going. He bumped with pacesetter Top Official at the quarter pole, but forged to the front late for a narrow score. "When I called on him in the lane, he gave me all he had," said winning rider Heberto Castillo, Jr. "It seems like he wants even more distance. He loves this track and Jimmy [Jerkens] has done a great job training him." Jerkens added that Lager would continue racing at the Big A through the winter.

WEEKEND PEDIGREE PERSPECTIVES

Cometh the hour, cometh the sire line. For some time now it has looked as if breeding in North America (and perhaps most of the world as well) could expect the choice of sires lines to begin to boil down to little more than Mr. Prospector and Northern Dancer, Hail to Reason through Roberto and Halo, and possibly Bold Ruler through Seattle Slew.

However, as we recollected in a recent copy of *Owner-Breeder International*, at the moment there is still considerable variety available to breeders, and that point was underlined at the Breeders' Cup. Remarkably, the eight Breeders' Cup races were taken by representatives of seven different sire lines. The surprise was that the one line doubly represented was that of In Reality, who scored through Tiznow (c, 3, Cee's Tizzy--Cee's Song, by Seattle Song) and Caressing (f, 2, Honour and Glory--Lovin Touch, by Majestic Prince), the sires of this pair both being sons of Relaunch, a stallion free of Northern Dancer, Raise a Native, Hail to Reason, Bold Ruler and even *Nasrullah and *Royal Charger. In Reality is out of a mare by the father of Florida breeding, Rough 'n Tumble, and, coincidentally, there was also a stakes winner for the Rough 'n Tumble male line in the shape of the hugely promising Macho Uno (c, 2, Holy Bull--Primal Force, by Blushing Groom {Fr}).

Other sire lines with one winner apiece were Mr. Prospector (Spain, f, 3, Thunder Gulch--Drina, by Regal and Royal); Northern Dancer (War Chant, c, 3, Danzig--Hollywood Wildcat, by Kris S.); Ribot (Kona Gold, g, 6, Java Gold--Double Sunrise, by Slew o' Gold); Hail to Reason (Perfect Sting, f, 4, Red Ransom--Valid Victress, by Valid Appeal) and Never Bend/Mill Reef (Kalanisi {Ire}, c, 4, by Doyoun {Ire}--Kalamba {Ire}, by Green Dancer).

We have considered the pedigrees of several of these in depth in previous pedigree perspectives, but let's honor their achievement at the "World Championships of Racing" with a brief overview.

First winner of the day was Spain in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. She is a member of the first crop of Thunder Gulch, who came desperately close to having a second winner with Point Given in the juvenile colt's race, and is obviously an extremely promising young sire. Spain, who traces to the great filly-pro The GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies event went to Caressing, the longest shot on the board. Her sire Honour and Glory has been the runaway leader of the Freshman Sires by individual winners since very early in the season, and now he has thoroughly proven his ability to get class as well as numbers. Caressing is out of Lovin Touch, a stakes-winning mare who has the sister and brother Your Hostess and Your Host 3x3 in her pedigree. This pair is out of the Mahmoud mare Boudoir II, and Honour and Glory has Mahmoud's son, The Axe II. Lovin Touch also has the three-quarters brothers Royal Charger and Nasrullah 3x3 (Royal Charger also appearing in Honour and Glory). Mahmoud's three-quarters sister Mumtaz Begum is the granddam of Royal Charger and dam of Nasrullah, so this family is pretty strongly represented in Caressing's pedigree.

When the blood (or at least gene pool) is as rich as that possessed by GI Breeders' Cup Mile victor War Chant, it doesn't need pedigree pattern to explain why the mating worked. A son of Danzig, War Chant is out of champion and GI Breeders' Cup Distaff winner, Hollywood Wildcat (herself by Kris S. out of a Mr. Prospector mare). For the record, we will note that Danzig has a strong affinity for both Roberto (the sire of Kris S.) and Mr. Prospector.

Java Gold was a major disappointment as a sire, but prior to his export to Germany, he left one really good horse in the shape of Kona Gold, who set a new track record when taking the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. Surprisingly swift for a horse with a pedigree chock full of stamina (his dam is by Slew o' Gold out of a Majestic Light mare), Kona Gold is the result of a very deliberately planned mating (again showing how a clever pattern can upgrade a less than commercial pedigree). *Cont. p. 5*

Java Gold is by Key to the Mint, a son of Graustark. Bringing together Graustark and Majestic Light (the sire of the second dam of Kona Gold) is a clever move. Graustark is by Ribot out of Flower Bowl. Majestic Light is by Majestic Prince (granddam, Your Hostess, a three-quarters sister to Flower Bowl) out of a mare by Ribot. Kona Gold has a second clever pattern. Java Gold's granddam, Dusky Evening is by a son of Tom Fool out of a mare by Hill Prince, exactly the same cross which produced Alluvial, dam of Kona Gold's broodmare sire, Slew o' Gold.

In the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf, Perfect Sting completed a near perfect season. By Roberto's son, Red Ransom out of a Valid Appeal mare, she is another example of the affinity between Roberto and In Reality. Her dam, stakes winner Valid Victress, has Rough 'n Tumble 3x4 in her pedigree through My Dear Girl (dam of In Reality) and Dr. Fager.

Rough 'n Tumble is also prominent in the pedigree of Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner Macho Uno, who descends from Rough 'n Tumble, not through Dr. Fager, but through Dr. Fager's contemporary, Minnesota Mac, via Great Above (out of Dr. Fager's half sister, Ta Wee) and Holy Bull. There are some shades of the Juvenile Filly winner Caressing here, as Holy Bull is out of a mare inbred to Mahmoud, and Macho Uno's dam--who also produced GI Breeders' Cup Classic winner Awesome Again--has a double of Nasrullah. The second dam is by Mr. Prospector out of a mare by Olden Times (grandson of War Relic) and it's not surprising that this works with Holy Bull, as he is half brother to a stakes winner by Crafty Prospector (Mr. Prospector/War Relic cross). As a footnote, we have to say it is highly encouraging to see competitively priced young horses like Holy Bull, Thunder Gulch and Honour and Glory quickly establishing themselves.

Kalanisi, who took the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, is yet another product of the extremely successful Aga Khan breeding operation. The Aga Khan frequently succeeds with home stallions which have been shunned by other breeders, and such is the case with Kalanisi's sire, Doyoun (a talented son of Mill Reef) who also sired last year's GI Breeder's Cup Turf victor Daylami (Ire). Kalanisi is the product of what is becoming a favorite Aga Khan pattern, that of inbreeding to Never Bend via Mill Reef and Riverman (sire of Kalanisi's second dam). This pair are close genetic relatives, as Mill Reef's dam Milan Mill, is three-parts related to Riverman's broodmare sire, Prince John.

The victory of Tiznow in the Breeders' Cup Classic made amends for the narrow defeat of his brother Budroyale in last year's renewal of the same event. Tiznow and Budroyale are sons of the California-based Cee's Tizzy, also sire of GISW Gourmet Girl, and of this year's graded-stakes winning filly Theresa's Tizzy from very limited opportunities. A talented, but lightly raced son of Relaunch, Cee's Tizzy is out of a mare by Lyphard, and so bred on the same cross as Honour and Glory. Tiznow is out of a mare by a son of Seattle Slew, and is an example of what seems to be a growing affinity, that of Relaunch and Seattle Slew. This may have something of a La Troienne connection as Seattle Slew's dam is inbred to Busher and Striking (sisters from the La Troienne family) and Relaunch carries The Axe II who is out of Big Event, also from the La Troienne family and with a similar background to Busher and Striking. Kentucky Racing Gets Source-Market Fees:

NTRA Services, a subsidiary of the National Thoroughbred Racing Association, is distributing \$1.5 million in TVG-generated fees to Kentucky racing interests. The fees were generated from wagering by TVG subscribers in Kentucky from September 1999 through September 2000. The fee distribution will be made to tracks and horsemen in the state based on a previously agreed upon formula, with half of the money allocated to purses. "One of the reasons that NTRA Services agreed to operate a wagering hub was to insure the equitable distribution of source-market fees to racing interests in participating states," said NTRA commissioner Tim Smith. "These are the fees generated to support live racing in a state when residents of the state engage in account wagering. As this form of off-track wagering matures, we look forward to other states sharing in this revenue source." Based on a blended 20-percent take-out rate, NTRA Services pays 10.5 cents of every dollar wagered to tracks and their horsemen in the market where the wagering account-holder resides.

MIXED RESULTS IN MELBOURNE European shippers tasted only moderate success during Tuesday's G1 Melbourne Cup Tuesday. Trainer James Fanshawe's **Arctic Owl (GB)** (Most Welcome {GB}), who raced in the rear with second and third-place finishers Second Coming and Yippyio, was best of the internationals, filling fifth place with jockey David Harrison saying that interference probably cost the G1 Irish St Leger winner a place. Topweighted **Enzeli (GB)** (Kahyasi {Ire}), winner of this year's G3 Doncaster Cup, settled fourth from the rear, but could do no better than 15th in a disappointing performance. "At the 800 metres a big funnel opened in front of me, but I didn't have any horse to go in there," reported jockey Greg Hall. Added trainer John Oxx, "It was the worst performance of his career," adding that the five-year-old was not suited by the fast track. Godolphin's **Lightning Arrow (USA)** (Silver Hawk {USA})'s rider Frankie Dettori said, "He was in a beautiful position in sixth, but when I tried to get closer at the 800m I knew straight away I didn't have enough horse to be in contention." The four-year-old was 17th of 22. **Far Cry (Ire)** (Pharly {Fr}), trained by Martin Pipe, was fourth, three off the fence in the early stages before beating only one home. "It just didn't happen for him. He lost concentration with a barrier attendant in the gates with him and he missed the start," analyzed jockey Kevin Darley. "For the first 600 metres he had to chase them in to the race and at the seven furlongs he was cooked."

WEATHER CONTINUES TO PLAGUE RACING

Folkestone and Kelso are the latest casualties as the adverse weather conditions continue to disrupt the British racing programme. Folkestone had originally scheduled an afternoon inspection, but had to call the meeting off after a morning inspection. There is approximately one foot of water running across the track near the entrance to the home straight and, with further heavy rain forecast, clerk of the course Fergus Cameron was left with no option but to cancel. Kelso had two inches of rain in the previous 24 hours and the track is waterlogged. Newbury looks set to go ahead as planned with no inspection scheduled at present. Ireland continues to have similar problems with tomorrow's Clonmel card already lost and the weekend's big meeting Down Royal under threat. There is a precautionary on Thursday morning, but course officials are hopeful the meeting, which features the James Nicholson Wine Merchant Champion Chase on Saturday, will go ahead.
