CHANNEL CROSSING TOPS AT KEENELAND

What goes up inevitably must come down and such was the case during Wednesday's fourth session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale, a session which was nonetheless characterized by steady, if not the spectacular results. For the day, the average was up against the corresponding 1999 session by a healthy 28.1 percent while the median jumped by 18.1 percent. Six-year-old mare Channel Crossing (Deputy Minister) realized the afternoon's highest price when representatives of Centennial Farm went to \$600,000 for the dark bay who is in foal to Saint Ballado. The mare was consigned to the sale by the session's leading consignor, Taylor Made Sales Agency. "I think that (the mare being in foal to Saint Ballado) certainly had to help," commented Duncan Taylor. "She's a nice mare, but I didn't expect the bidding to go like it did." Channel Crossing is a half sister to graded-stakes winner Fit to Lead (Fit to Fight) and is from the family of Grade 1 winner Aube Indienne (Fr). Sold as a racing or broodmare prospect, Sheer Bliss (Relaunch) brought a final bid of \$485,000 from Thoro Beam Farm and was led over to the sale by Three Chimneys Sales as agent. The four-year-old is a half sister to this year's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup winner Albert The Great (Go for Gin) and was the winner of this year's Aspidistra H. at Calder. "She's a nice mare and her page has really taken off this year," said Robert Clay, owner of Three Chimneys in Midway, Kentucky. The sale presses on this morning with a session beginning at 10 a.m. (Weanlings, Statistics p2)

STRONACH FÉTES HIS BROODMARES

Frank Stronach, owner of Adena Springs Farm, held his fourth annual broodmare sale last night at the Fasig-Tipton Sales Complex north of Lexington. A total of 64 mares, in foal to Adena stallions, were sold without reserve and included a 2001 breeding season to a different stallion. Buzz Chace signed the ticket on the most expensive purchase of the evening when he went to \$340,000 to secure hip number 212, the nine-year-old mare Questelavie (Conquistador Cielo), sold in foal to Stronach's 1997 Belmont S. winner Touch Gold. The stakes-winning mare is the dam of Roaring Twenties (Dixieland Band), winner at three of the GI Selene S. in Canada. The mare can be bred back to Wild Rush in 2001. Gross receipts for the evening totaled \$3,649,000, for an average of \$57,016. (Top Lots p3)

DISEASE DISCOVERED IN HONG KONG The possible presence of equine encephalitis in Hong Kong may have drastic consequences for the Hong Kong Jockey Club's International races on Dec. 17. Group Fortune (Aus) (Barathea {Ire}), a Hong Kong racehorse euthanized on Oct. 30, may have been exposed to a viral infection known as Japanese encephalitis. Per the Hong Kong Jockey Club's standard practice, a post mortem was performed, and samples taken from the horse were sent to local and three overseas laboratories for further analysis. Final results are expected in two to three weeks. "Horses are dead-end hosts; they are not known to be able to transmit the disease from one to another or to humans," said Dr. Keith Watkins, the HKJC's senior veterinary surgeon. "The last suspected clinical case in horses in Hong Kong occurred in 1981, and the horse in that case recovered to race again." As many as four horses may have been euthanized because of the virus. Since diagnostic testing is still underway, Japanese authorities will not permit Hong Kong runners to travel to Japan for races later this month, and Japanese horses will not be able to compete in the December international events in Hong Kong due to a 60-day ruling pending test results. It is as yet uncertain whether other international runners will be able to travel to Hong Kong, Hong Kong horses affected by this ruling include G1 Yasuda Kinen hero Fairy King Prawn (Aus) (Danehill {Aus}), scheduled to compete in the Japanese Racing Association's G1 Mile Championship Nov. 19; and Housemaster (Ire) (Rudimentary) and Indigenous (Ire) (Marju {Ire}), Hong Kong's scheduled representatives for the G1 Japan Cup Nov. 26.

PEINTRE CELEBRE FOR JAPANESE SOJOURN

Peintre Celebre (Nureyev--Peinture Bleue, by Alydar) will stand the 2001 breeding season at East Stud in Japan, according to Racing Post. Winner of the 1997 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, the chestnut entered stud in 1999 at Coolmore Stud in Ireland. "We received a very good offer for Peintre Celebre to stand at the East Stud in Japan next year," Coolmore's Richard Henry told the Racing Post. "It's for one season only." Several stallions under Coolmore's banner have been leased to Japan for one-year stints in the past, including Royal Academy, Spinning World and Thunder Gulch, as well as Hennessy for the coming season.

TIZNOW CO-OWNER PASSES AWAY Cecilia Straub-Rubens, who just this past Saturday celebrated the victory of Tiznow in the Breeders' Cup Classic, died Tuesday night in a Newport, California, hospital at the age of 83. She had been suffering from cancer and was admitted to the hospital Monday, after returning from Louisville the day before. She died from a heart attack suffered during a surgical procedure. A homebred, Tiznow did not win a race until May 31, but improved steadily to win the GIII Affirmed and ran second in the GI Pacific Classic. He was then shipped to Louisiana, where he defeated Belmont winner Commendable in the GI Super Derby before returning to California to annex the GII Goodwood Breeders' Cup H., prior to his Breeders' Cup triumph. "Those two minutes it took Tiznow to run that race were the best she had felt in a long time," business partner Michael Cooper told the Los Angeles Times. "I think it was Tiznow that kept her going. She went out in style, a true winner." She is survived by three children from a first marriage as well as four grandchildren.

MIXED RESULTS AT OAK TREE The 27-day Oak Tree meeting at Santa Anita concluded Monday with an increase in handle from all sources, but a decrease in on-track figures. The total daily average handle was \$9,760,972, a 2.7-percent increase against the 31-day meet from a year ago, while average on-track handle dipped by 1.2 percent to \$2,353,124. The increase in total handle was due in large part to an 8.9-percent hike in out-of-state wagering. On-track attendance at the Arcadia oval averaged 11,170, a 4.1-percent decline against the same figure from last year, a result which Oak Tree Executive Vice President Sherwood Chillingworth attributed to a public transportation strike in greater Los Angeles. The meet was highlighted by leading jockey Laffit Pincay Jr.'s 9000th career winner on California Cup Day Oct. 28. Pincay rode 31 winners, six more than Victor Espinoza, to garner his first Oak Tree title since 1982. The trainer's title went to Bill Spawr, who sent out 17 winners, one better than Bob Baffert's 16. Racing returns to the foot of the San Gabriel mountains for the Winter/Spring meeting Dec. 26.

Bomfim left trainer Patrick Kelly's barn late last fall and took an 11-month break before returning to the track and running fourth two races back Sept. 22. In his most recent outing, the gelding finished second best Oct. 21 in an allowance event at Keeneland, but earned his first win since last August here. In second from the gate to the straight, the seven-year-old headed Daylight Savings in midstretch and held that rival at a narrow margin for the success, giving jockey Pat Day his fourth win of the day.

TURNBERRY ISLE TO REMAIN IN U.S. Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier's Turnberry Isle (USA) (Deputy Minister {USA}) has been transferred to trainer D. Wayne Lukas, according to *Irish-Racing.com*. Winner of the G3 Juddmonte Beresford S. Oct. 15 at The Curragh, the two-year-old colt ran bravely in last weekend's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, finishing sixth in his dirt debut. "He ran a fine race first time out on dirt to be beaten just over 2 1/2 lengths, and he must have a big shot for the Kentucky Derby," Aidan O'Brien told *Irish-Racing.com*. Michael Tabor previously won the Kentucky Derby with Thunder Gulch in 1995, a colt trained by Lukas.

O'BRIEN CRITICAL OF CLASSIC RIDE Trainer Aidan O'Brien has laid the defeat of Giant's Causeway (USA) (Storm Cat {USA}) in Saturday's GI Breeders' Cup Classic at the hands of jockey Michael Kinane, according to Irish-Racing.com. "Obviously, the horse would have won if he [Kinane] hadn't lost the reins," O'Brien told Irish-racing.com. "There's no doubt about that. Michael will tell you that in time." Kinane apparently got his whip caught in the reins when switching hands. The "Iron Horse" looked on even terms with Tiznow (USA) (Cee's Tizzy {USA}), but was never able to get by the likely American champion three-year-old and Horse of the Year.

ROYAL MEETING FINALLY GIVES WAY

Down Royal's scheduled meeting for this Friday and Saturday has finally succumbed to the elements. The eagerly anticipated clash between last season's G1 Tote Cheltenham Gold Cup one-two of Looks Like Trouble and Florida Pearl has been postponed one week until Nov. 17 and 18, with the Ulster course in unraceable state. The local River Lagan has burst its banks and the three-mile steeplechase start is flooded. Last season's two star chasers were due to meet in the James Nicholson Wine Merchant Champion Chase. All original entries will stand for the meet's feature race.

'PLAIN' COLOURS TO BE AUCTIONED

The British Horseracing Board and Weatherbys have announced that it will sell the right to register distinctive racing colours in a closed-bid auction. Three sets of plain racing colours will be on offer: beige, black and white. This represents one of the last opportunities to acquire completely plain racing silks. White and black were among the first registered list of colours in 1762 by the Jockey Club. The colours are estimated to bring the following prices: black, £130,000-£150,000; white, £65,000-£70,000; and beige, £48,000-£50,000. The lots to be sold will appear in the Racing Calendar on Nov. 9, Nov. 16 and Nov. 23; the closing date for the sealed bids is Friday, Nov. 24.

SAMUM HOLDS HONG KONG NOMINATION

German three-year-old star Samum (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) has been nominated by his connections to the G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin Dec. 17, according to a release by the Hong Kong Jockey Club. His participation may be decided by a ruling on the Japanese encephalitic virus (see TDN International). With 12 points in the Emirates World Racing Series Championship, he could earn a bonus of US\$1 million with a victory in Hong Kong. The chestnut, winner of the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden, fourth leg of the World Series, lost his unbeaten record when sixth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 1.

EASY ROCKING AIMING FOR HONG KONG SPRINT

Top Australian sprinter Easy Rocking (Aus) (Barathea {Ire}) looks to be bound for the G3 Hong Kong Sprint at Sha Tin Dec. 17, according to a release from the Hong Kong Jockey Club. As with Samum, the possible presence of equine encephalitis may preclude the four-year-old colt from shipping north. The bay colt captured the G1 Salinger S. at Flemington Saturday during the Melbourne spring carnival.
