UP TO THE TEST

Testa Rossa (Aus) (Perugino) took his earnings to A\$2,940,240 recording his sixth Group 1 win in G1 Emirates S., the final Group 1 feature of the Victorian carnival. The four-year-old, whose stud future at Victorian Stud Yallambee was officially launched this week, settled well back in the 16-horse field after starting from the widest barrier. Rounding the turn, jockey Patrick Payne wound the speedster up to romp through to a convincing win, his first G1 victory over a trip further than seven furlongs. Testa Rossa started at 15-1 after failing to place in the Cox Plate and the G1 Yalumba S. at his past two starts. Connections will now consider a tilt at either the Hong Kong Mile or Cup at Sha Tin in December as well as a possible campaign in Europe, targeting the G1 July Cup at Newmarket. "To win the July Cup would double his stud value and make him viable as a dual-hemisphere stallion," said trainer Dean Lawson. "From barrier 16 we knew he had to go back. I really didn't expect him to win today, there was too much against him and we thought he needed a bit of luck. But to win like that was just great." Testa Rossa's Group 1 tally includes the Sires Produce S., the Vic Health Cup, the Lightning S., the Futurity S. and the Eat Well Live Well Cup.

'MOON' SHINES ON LONG ISLAND

Moonlady (Ger) (Platini {Ger}) had proven herself adept on heavy and yielding going in her native Germany, and handled a muddy track with alacrity in winning the GIII Long Island H. at Aqueduct yesterday. The bay filly had won five of her seven starts in Germany, including the G3 Deutscher Stutenpreis Sept. 10 and the G2 Deutsches St Leger Oct. 10 at Dortmund, but was no threat when seventh in the G1 Prix Royal-Oak at Longchamp Oct. 22, her first foreign foray. Racing with Lasix here, she broke alertly and tracked Free Vacation (Fly So Free) in the early stages, moving up to put a head in front with a half mile to go. With a clear advantage turning for home, she widened her advantage through the stretch and remained well clear of fellow Euro shipper Playact (Ire) (Hernando {Fr}). "They told me that she was pretty much onepaced," said winning jockey Chris DeCarlo. "She was moving comfortably down the backstretch, and at the 3/8 pole I asked her to run and she took off."

Illiquidity held sway in the final strides to come away with her first graded victory. Winner of the Dade Turf Classic at Ellis Park three back, the bay filly stretched out to 12 furlongs in taking the Dowager S. at Keeneland Oct. 28. The Stonerside colorbearer, never more than four lengths from the front, loomed boldly on the turn for home and opened up by 1 1/2 lengths in midstretch. Responding to the urgings of jockey Jon Court, she staved off the challenges of even-money License Fee from the inside and Miss of Wales from the outside. "I was a little concerned that we had made the lead too early," Court remarked. "I knew there were some powerful closers in there, and I knew they would be coming at us. The speed had backed up to us and she naturally inherited the lead. Taking the lead like we did was just the way it shaped up." Winning trainer Pat Byrne noted his charge's tendency to wait on horses. "If she gets to the lead too soon, she begins to loaf," he said. "You get a bit nervous when you run back in two weeks like we did today. Everything worked out, though."

Successful at this track in the 12-furlong Listed Prix Panacee Oct. 23, Aiglonne doubled her stakes tally and recorded her first group race win over this shorter trip with a well-timed run to secure victory. Jockey Goulven Toupel tried restraining tactics, but Aiglonne raced keenly in sixth as Limelighting led from Kantia (Ire) (Seattle Dancer), Nadira and Caerau (GB) (Nashwan), and made progress to challenge on the outside at the quarter-mile marker. One of two choices from John Gosden's stable, Limelighting proved game from the front and showed no signs of faltering as the field swept into the final eighth. Toupel's persistence aboard Aiglonne proved decisive in the closing stages as his mount responded well to pressure and grabbed the lead inside the final fifty yards for a tactically astute score. Limelighting proved to be a model of tenacity and held on grimly from Nadira in the dying strides, getting the judge's verdict in a three-way photo for second.

JIG TOPS KEENELAND SATURDAY Selling as a racing/broodmare prospect, Jig (Ire) (Catrail) topped all prices at yesterday's session of the Keeneland November Sale when she brought a bid of \$360,000 from Bluegrass Thoroughbred Services, Inc. Offered by Newgate Stud Farm, Inc., the bay filly is a half sister to multiple Group-winning Dance Parade and to GSW Ocean Queen. Out of the stakes-winning Irish River (Fr) mare River Jig, Jig is a winner in both England and the U.S. First-year sires continued to be popular among weanling buyers, with a colt by GI Florida Derby winner Cape Town (Seeking the Gold) drawing a bid of \$160,000 from Buzz Chace, agent, to top all foals. From the consignment of Claiborne Farm, agent, he is out of a half sister to stakes winners Hitch and Thread. Tale of the Cat maintained his strong showing at this sale, with his filly out of Basking (Alydar) going for \$150,000 to Dromoland Farm. Numbers were down slightly across the board from 1999, with the gross dipping from \$12.8 million to \$10.1 million. The average of \$39,257 was down from last year's figure of \$44,194. The bay filly, a half sister to stakes-placed Dehere of the Dog, was consigned by Bluegrass Thoroughbred Services, Inc. The November Sale continues through Saturday, Nov. 18. Bidding begins at 10 a.m. dailv.

Nine-time Derbywinning jockey Lester Piggott took third on Bay Scenery (Aus) (Scenic {Ire}) in the four-furlong event.

The dark bay rebounded from an eighth in the Da Hoss S. at Colonial Downs in September to win the Bald Eagle Breeders' Cup H. over this course Oct. 22. Breaking alertly, he shadowed Maria's Tiara (Magic Prospect) through pedestrian fractions of :50 4/5 and 1:15 4/5. Called on for his run in the stretch, he grabbed the lead and stayed on bravely as the field closed in on him, getting home a neck the better of Adcat. "We were closer today because this horse was coming out of a race with a real fast pace," said winning jockey Mark Johnston. "At a mile and a half they [the riders] tend to slow the pace down, and a lot of time horses racing up close [are able to] finish and the closers can't catch them. That's exactly what happened today."

Zillah the Hun maintained his unbeaten record in winning his first graded stakes. After breaking his maiden by seven lengths at Fairplex, the bay colt tried the grass and responded with a front-running score in the Pinjara S. at Oak Tree Oct. 19. Back on dirt here, he chased pacesetter I'madrifter to the stretch and began to make up ground in the final furlong, but appeared to be heading for second at that time. I'madrifter veered suddenly into the rail, unseating jockey Miguel Perez. Zillah the Hun maintained his course and crossed the line clear of Jumron Won. "That was pretty wild," said winning jockey Corey Nakatani. "My colt is still a little green. Coming into the stretch, he was getting dirt kicked in his face and was kind of playing. He leveled out when I hit him left-handed and started to close the gap. I think it [the finish] was going to be pretty close at the wire." I'madrifter emerged with a few scratches, but no serious injuries. Perez was taken to San Mateo County Hospital for precautionary X-rays.
