HOLY BULL COLT TOPS KEENELAND SUNDAY

A colt by Horse of the Year Holy Bull, sire of GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile hero Macho Uno, brought a final bid of \$175,000 as the top-selling weanling at yesterday's session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington. The chestnut, whose second dam is GSW Blush (Sir Gaylord), was consigned by John Williams LLC, agent, and purchased by Buzz Chace, agent. The highest price commanded by a broodmare during yesterday's session was also \$175,000, as six-year-old Fordyce (Cox's Ridge), carrying a foal from the first crop by champion Victory Gallop (Cryptoclearance), sold to Grade II Bloodstock, agent. The mare is out of MGSW Foresta (Alydar), who set a course record at Belmont Park. The Keeneland November Sale continues through Nov. 18.

Having suffered a fractured pelvis as a juvenile when trained in England by Peter Chapple-Hyam, Dane Friendly's career was seriously threatened. The extent of the injury was such that he missed his entire threeyear-old season, but he came back to show good form this year, notably when second to Muhtathir (GB) in the G2 Premio Meilio Turati at Milan May 25 and fourth to Faberger (Ger) in the G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua at Milan Oct. 8. Showing he was in fine fettle here, the colt was positioned in third as Banyumanik (Ire) (Perugino) dictated matters from the front. Mirco Demuro asked his mount to make his challenge approaching the final quarter mile and Dane Friendly quickened in good style to win going away. Slaney Squire kept on for second place, but was subsequently demoted to third for causing interference to original third place-getter Blu For Life. The winner will run back in the G1 Premio Roma at Rome Nov. 19.

"He was having fun running in the back of the pack and, thankfully, the rail opened up for us," said winning jockey Jean-Luc Samyn. "He didn't have a tough time beating these."

"I usually don't like to stretch them out and turn them back again, but this looked like a pretty good spot for her," said winning trainer Michael Nevin. "I'll give her a little break. You're going to hear more from her."

Ruby Friday broke her maiden in her sixth lifetime start one year ago at Aqueduct and ran in 11 consecutive non-winners-of-one-lifetime events in New York before finding the winner's circle once more Sept. 12 at Belmont. She is now on a streak of a different kind, having won her last three straight, including this, her first stakes victory. The filly was unhurried early, made an inside move on the turn to head for home with just one to catch, switched to the outside and drove home for the victory. "She was doing so well that we were going to take a shot on the turf," said trainer Carlos Martin. "I was tickled to see the race come off the grass. There is moisture in the track and she loves that. We were thinking about giving her the rest of the year off, but it is hard to stop when she is doing so good." The 8-5 favorite Terreavigne (Belong to Me), who had not raced on the dirt since August of '98, was fourth.

QUIET (f, 2, Roar--Sly Maid {SP}, by Desert Wine) was sixth in his only start to date, back at Belmont June 17, and added Lasix for his second start off a five-month layoff. The \$120,000 '99 KEESEP yearling become the sixth winner for his freshman sire (by Forty Niner) with a pacesetting trip under Mike Smith, coming home first by 2 1/4 lengths at 7-1. Lifetime Record: 2-1-0-0, \$24,600.
