#### INOUIRY INTO MELBOURNE CUP ALSO-RAN

Jockey Jim Cassidy, who was aboard Diatribe (Aus) (Brief Truce) for his 11th-place finish in the Nov. 7 G1 Melbourne Cup, will face stewards on Thursday morning to answer a complaint lodged by the horse's owner, John Thompson, and trainer George Hanlon over his ride in the race. Diatribe won the G1 Caulfield Cup with Cassidy sneaking through along the fence, but the four-year-old was trapped wide in the Melbourne Cup. Off at 7-1, he made a run from the 1000-meter mark to join the leaders on the home turn, but weakened in the straight. Hanlon told *Australian Associated Press*, "Compared to the Caulfield Cup, the horse was ridden altogether differently in the Melbourne Cup."

#### CAPE TOWN FILLY TOPS KEENELAND MONDAY

A weanling filly from the first crop by GISW Cape Town (Seeking the Gold) out of Elizabeth Clare (Lord Durham) brought a bid of \$140,000 to top yesterday's session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington. A half to stakes winners Slick Groom (Runaway Groom) and Tarazu (Zilzal), she was consigned by Denali Stud, Agent XXIX, and purchased by Bon Air Stables. The six-year-old mare Miss Moonwaki (Miswaki--Hard Freeze, by It's Freezing), in foal to Storm Boot, also sold for \$140,000. Out of a half-sister to stakes winner Bang Bang (El Baba), she was consigned by David and Ginger Mullins, Agent XVII, and bought by WinStar Farm, LLC. A son of first-crop sire Indian Charlie (In Excess (Ire)) out of stakes winner Inlaw (Gold Seam) was the top-selling weanling colt, going for \$100,000 to Holiday Stables. The bay was consigned by Welker Sales Agency LLC, Agent II.

Broad Appeal, winner of the G3 Silkroad S. in February, rolled to her second graded-stakes success here. The six-year-old mare had been winless in four tries since taking the Ritto S. May 14, and was most recently fourth in the G2 Swan S. Oct. 28. Breaking from the outside post position in the 15-horse field, she was settled near the back of the pack by jockey Koshiro Take. After Take switched her to the outside in midstretch, she responded and, with two furlongs left to run, gained command and drew away for an impressive victory. Take said, "I pushed her hard in the stretch, and she showed her tremendous turn of foot. It was a very impressive performance."

You have to feel sorry for owners and trainers when they send horses from Europe to challenge for a graded stakes on turf, only to see the race switched to the main track. Should they run or not, when their horses have raced only on turf?

Although four horses came out of the Long Island H. after heavy rain, they were all trained by American. The three European raiders stood their ground, perhaps remembering that Dermot Weld once found himself in a similar position prior to the 1989 Laurel Futurity. Weld's Go And Go took his chance, even though he had never set foot on dirt, and he won, in the process gaining experience which was to stand him in very good stead in the following year's Belmont S.

This pioneering spirit also paid off handsomely for trainers Harro Remmert and Nicolas Clement at Aqueduct, when their fillies Moonlady and Playact took first and second. There are enough good dirt horses in Playact's pedigree for her performance to come as no great surprise, but the same cannot be said of Moonlady.

Her pedigree is largely German, and all of Germany's best racing takes place on turf. Her sire Platini managed only fourth place when favorite for the German Derby in 1992, but that was one of the few setbacks he suffered during a distinguished career which ended with a splendid effort in the 1993 Japan Cup. In finishing fourth behind the Japanese winner Legacy World, Platini was only half a length behind Kotashaan and he had more than a length to spare over another American challenger, Star of Cozzene.

Platini's sire Surumu has been arguably the most dominant force in German breeding over the last 20 years, taking the title of champion sire on six occasions in addition to siring three German Derby winners: Acatenango, Mondrian and Temporal. Acatenango has proved similarly effective as a stallion, with his Deutsches Derby winners Lando and Borgia both proving themselves to be of top international standard.

Moonlady's sire Platini, with four crops of racing age, has also shown distinct ability as a stallion, with plenty of black-type performers to his credit. Among them are El Divino, a Group 2 winner over a mile; Wins Fiction, a Group 3 scorer over twice that distance; and Dangerous Mind, a Listed winner over 1 1/2 miles in France.

Moonlady is potentially his best effort so far, as she has now won a Group 2 and two Group 3s in the space of two months. Interestingly, The Irish Field's report on her win in the German St. Leger recorded that she demonstrated "high-class finishing speed and stamina," so winning rider Chris deCarlo's remark that "they told me she was pretty much one-paced" was unexpected.

Gary Tanaka's filly clearly has some speed to go with the stamina which has enabled her to win at up to 1 3/4 miles. For this she can probably thank her broodmare sire Sure Blade, a leading juvenile who went on to win two of Britain's top mile events. Moonlady's second dam Majoritat possessed enough speed to win the German 1000 Guineas over a mile, plus enough stamina to take the German Oaks over 1 3/8 miles.

Majoritat's versatile sire, Konigsstuhl, won the German Triple Crown and his class was also very evident during his stallion career. He became champion sire and is responsible for the very promising Monsun, one of several stallions whose reputations are quickly spreading outside their native Germany. Interestingly, Majoritat is bred along similar lines to Monsun, as they share the same sire and Majoritat's second dam Monacensia is the third dam of Monsun.

With these bloodlines, Moonlady is virtually guaranteed a very successful future as a broodmare, but Tanaka must be wondering what to do with her now. Does her future lie on Europe's turf courses or in the U.S., where there is such a richly endowed dirt programme for older fillies?



SMULLEN REIGNS IN IRELAND Jockey Pat Smullen became Ireland's champion jockey for the first time on Sunday as the Irish Flat season bowed out at Leopardstown. His 80 wins meant he was 14 clear of Mick Kinane and Johnny Murtagh, who have enjoyed considerable international success this year. Smullen, the dual Irish champion apprentice, was described by trainer Dermot Weld in October, 1998 as "the best young rider in Europe," as he prepared to replace Kinane with the then 22-year-old. Smullen's success on Vinnie Roe (Ire) (Definite Article (Ire)) in Sunday's Listed Eyrefield S. was the perfect curtain call to a memorable season as first jockey to Weld, the winningmost Irish trainer of 2000 with 84 wins. Weld said of Smullen's ride on Vinnie Roe: "He rode that horse with all the confidence of a champion jockey." The trainer added: "Pat has had an outstanding year, and he improved as a rider as the year progressed. He rides a very intelligent race and gets horses nicely balanced. He's also a good judge of pace and has a great ability to listen. He's a young man with a big future. I was very keen to try to make Pat champion this year, as I plan to have a reduced team of horses next season and it will be harder for him to win the title." Smullen said: "It's been a marvellous year. I have a lot to thank Mr Weld for, and being champion means a lot to me." HANDSOME RIDGE TO NATIONAL STUD Threetime Group winner Handsome Ridge (GB) (Indian Ridge {Ire}--Red Rose Garden {GB}, by Electric {GB}) has been retired and will stand the 2001 breeding season at The National Stud in Newmarket. The six-year-old captured the G3 Prix Daphnis at three; the G3 GNER Park S. and G3 Prix Perth at four; and the G2 Chrysalis Sandown Mile at five. Overall, he earned seven wins, five seconds and three thirds from 26 career starts for a bankroll of more than £252,000. Amond his six Group placings was a second-place finish behind Elle Danzig (Ger) in the 1999 G1 Premio Roma. Raced by former England football captain and current Nottingham Forest Manager David Platt and his wife, Rachel, the chestnut will stand for the Platts for a fee of £2,500, live foal. John Gosden, who trained Handsome Ridge throughout his career, said, "He has a great temperament and was an extrememely consistent and genuine race horse." The National Stud Stallion Parade is set for Dec. 2-3.

#### WINSTON GETS HEFTY BAN

Jockey Robert Winston was suspended for 28 days, of which eight were deferred until May 12, 2001, following an appearance before the Disciplinary Committee at the Jockey Club's offices in Portman Square, London yesterday morning. Winston, who had already been banned for 15 days this season, was handed his latest ban--under the Jockey Club's totting-up procedure--when found guilty of a whip offence at Southwell Nov. 6. His suspension will run Nov. 20-Dec. 16, when Flat racing is scheduled to be staged. He will also attend a mandatory course of intruction on use of the whip at the British Racing School on a date yet to be arranged. The 20-year-old jockey commented: "I expected a long ban and I have just got to learn from my mistakes as I have a good job with Mrs [Lynda] Ramsden next season. I have been trying too hard, so I'll just have to settle down." The jockey recently escaped a further ban when disqualified from second place aboard David Nicholls' Further Outlook (USA) (Zilzal {USA}) in the Listed Prix Contessina at Maisons-Laffitte Nov. 10.

The bay is an own sister to Elsie Plunkett (GB), who won three races and was third in a pair of Listed races as a juvenile of 2000.
