ALL ROADS LEAD TO ROMA

The final Group 1 stakes on the European calendar. the Premio Roma, will be held in Rome this afternoon. British representatives have an admirable record in the race, having taken seven renewals in the 1990s, but last year it was the German contingent who stepped forward onto this stage as Elle Danzig (Ger) (Roi Danzig) took her stakes total to an astounding eight. This season she put a disappointing unplaced effort in the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. at Sandown May 30 behind her to recover her form, winning the G3 Preis der Badischen Sparkassen at Baden-Baden Aug. 25 and the G2 Frankfurt Trophy Sept. 17, in the process signaling her well-being by handing the smart Aboard (Fr) a four-length defeat. Her biggest danger may be Dane Friendly (GB) (Danehill), who finally reached the level of form necessary to be a contender by impressively taking the G2 Premio Ribot here last time Nov. 12. Previously he had finished fourth to Faberger (Ger) in the G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua at Milan Oct. 8, where Sumitas (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}) was second. Sumitas was also runner-up to Greek Dance (Ire) in the G1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis at Munich July 30, where Elle Danzig was fourth. In fact, Peter Schiergen's colt has chased some illustrious tails this season, most notably that of Dubai Millennium (GB), albeit at a distance, when second in the G1 Prince Of Wales' S. at Royal Ascot June 21.

RED-LETTER DAY FOR DICKINSON

A master at getting horses ready off the layoff, trainer Michael Dickinson has done it again, saddling Cetewayo (His Majesty) to win yesterday's GII Red Smith H. at Aqueduct in his first start since July and his second since May of 1999. The bay, who broke his maiden for a \$20,000 tag and raced vs. \$13,000 claimers in his first try for Dickinson, dropped his rider in his turf debut at Keeneland in April of 1997, but blossomed when returned to the grass that fall. His 1998 campaign included consecutive wins in the Sir Ivor S. at Laurel, GII Bowling Green H. at Belmont and GI Sword Dancer Invitational at Saratoga, but the streak was broken when he stumbled and fell at the quarter pole in the GI Man o'War S. He bounced back to be second to champion Buck's Boy in the GI Turf Classic a month later, but failed to fire in that year's GI Breeders' Cup Turf and finished sixth. In his two starts since, the John Chandler homebred captured the Riggs H. at Pimlico May 22, 1999, then disappeared for more than 13 months before resurfacing to be sixth in the GI United Nations H. at Monmouth Park this July. "He wasn't quite right going into the United Nations," Dickinson admitted. "He had little aches and pains and I made the wrong decision to run him. We gave him six weeks off after that race." Returning here as an 8-1 outsider, Cetewayo was reserved at the tail end of the field through a mile in 1:39 2/5, but kicked it into gear around the far turn and finished with determination to catch Understood (Pistolet Bleu {Ire}) for a neck victory. "He had a little trouble handling the course for the first mile or so, but he really picked it up in the second half of the race," winning jockey Richie Migliore said. "He just exploded in the lane." As for the future, Dickinson said, "He'll probably run in the W.L. McKnight at Calder [GII, Dec. 30] and keep going through the Gulfstream meet." The 5-2 favorite, Drama Critic (Theatrical {Ire}), was caught in traffic on the first turn, rated near the back of the pack down the backstretch, then made up some ground in the stretch to be fifth. "When I angled him out, he didn't have any kick," jockey John Velazquez said. "I think he needs a break." Trainer Mark Hennig concurred. "We tried to stretch his season out one more race," he said. "We'll give him some rest now and bring him back toward the end of Gulfstream." (Red Smith chart. p2)

Megan's Bluff had started on the grass just once before, taking an allowance race at Churchill in June. Since that effort, she had run second in the Cleveland Oaks and captured the GIII Arlington Oaks by an impressive eight lengths, then took on older fillies and bested GISW On a Soapbox by a neck in the GIII Arlington Matron. The even-money favorite in the Oct. 6 Indiana Breeders' Cup Oaks at Hoosier last time out, she rallied to second, beaten a half length, and was let go at 6-1 this time. Sent right to the front, she cut out all the fractions and had enough left to hold off Uncharted Haven for the narrow score. "We'll giver her some time off now and come back next year," trainer John Hennig said.

Never off the board, Swept Away had won three of her last four starts, including a 5 3/4-length victory in the Stormy Blue Breeders' Cup H. over this track Oct. 18. Odds-on to add another in the win column, the dark bay filly was never far from the front, commandeered the lead after a half and pulled away to win as she pleased. "She's in love with this racing surface," jockey Jeremy Beasley said. "I asked her to go around the three-eighths pole and she dragged me to the lead and just opened up. I'd like to take credit for riding her, but all you really do with her is hang on. She does the rest." The consistent miss is expected to return to Maryland for the GII Barbara Fritchie H. in February.

RECORD AVERAGE AT NOVEMBER SALE The marathon that is the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale ended yesterday with the highest average and the second-highest aggregate in the sale's history. When all was said and done, 3,266 horses sold for \$301,994,800, a gross second only to the mark of \$317,666,000 set a year ago. The average of \$92,466, however, surpassed the mark of \$91,784 set last year. Buyers also set a single-session record on the second day of the 14-day auction, spending \$102,450,000. A total of 39 horses brought \$1 million or more, 10 more than in 1999. Champion Jewel Princess (Key to the Mint), in foal to Storm Cat, topped the sale at \$4.9 million, while a filly by Storm Cat was the highest-priced weanling at \$1.2 million. Yesterday's finale saw the four-year-old broodmare Magic Melody (Gulch--Minstress, by The Minstrel) take the highest bid, selling for \$90,000 to Munster Bloodstock. Consigned by Mrs. and Mrs. William Wofford, Agent IX, she is in foal to MGSW Concerto (Chief's Crown), who stood his first season in 1999.

KELLY KIP RETIRED Top-class sprinter Kelly Kip (Kipper Kelly--Marianne Theresa, by John's Gold), who set four track records during his career, has been retired due to a leg injury, The Blood-Horse online reports. The six-year-old won graded stakes in each of his first four seasons but, compromised by injury, managed only a Gulfstream allowance victory this year, winning at the Florida track in February. He was third in the GII Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup Sprint Championship in March and missed winning the GIII Bold Ruler H. for the third straight time when second by a head in that April test, but started only once more, running sixth in the GII Forest Hills H. Oct. 14. In addition to his two Bold Ruler wins, the dark bay captured the GIII Sanford S. and GIII Tremont S. at two: the Forest Hills at three; and the GII Frank J. DeFrancis Memorial Dash, GII A Phenomenon H. and GIII Finger Lakes Breeders' Cup S. at four. Leaving his mark in the record books, he went five furlongs in :55 3/5 at Belmont, six furlongs in 1:08 1/5 at Finger Lakes and, bettering his own time, six furlongs in 1:07 2/5 at Aqueduct. Overall, he won 15 of 31 starts for earnings of \$1,157,141. Trainer Allen Jerkens told The Blood-Horse that Kelly Kip was "the fastest I've ever been around."

Iwinski Lives Up to His Name:

Trainer Allen Iwinski yesterday set a record for most wins during a Delaware Park meet when he saddled Bag Woman to capture the first race on the card. The winner was the 38-year-old Michigan native's 75th of the season, breaking the mark set by Sam Cronk in 1991.

Lu Ravi to Race in 2001:

Lu Ravi (A.P. Indy), a winner of five grades stakes, including three this season, will race again next year, trainer Carl Bowman said yesterday. The five-year-old mare is currently getting a break after finishing fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff last time out. "She's sounder this year than she has ever been in her life," Bowman said. "[Owner Yoshio Fujita] loves to race these horses and he said he might not have one this good again for a while. So at least we're going to race her through next spring and, if she does well, we'll see where we go from there." The bay, who was troubled by quarter cracks earlier in her career, has earned more than \$1.5 million to date. She will head to Fair Grounds after the Churchill meet ends. Her main goal for the spring will be the GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn; she was second to Heritage of Gold in this year's edition of the race.

Solar Bound Retired:

Stakes winner **Solar Bound** (Boundary--Solar Star, by Lea Fan), who bled badly and was eased in a Churchill Downs allowance race Nov. 15, has been retired and will be bred to Seeking the Gold in the spring. The winner of the Edgewood S. at Churchill last year, the four-year-old was also second in the 1999 GIII Regret S. and third in the GIII Noble Damsel S. this season. She goes to the breeding shed with four wins, two seconds and two thirds from 11 starts for earnings of \$226,469.

Compton Bolter, described as a 'blue-collar worker' by his trainer Gerard Butler, has been campaigned vigorously this year, and it was fitting that he should take his first stakes success in mid-November after starting his racing at Nad al Sheba in Dubai in February. This was his 10th start of the year, in fact, but he has maintained a high level of form throughout the months of 2000. A fast-finishing fifth in the G1 2000 Guineas behind King's Best (USA) at Newmarket May 6, he also finished seventh in the G1 Dubai Champion S. at the same course Oct. 14 behind Kalanisi (Ire). Here he was kept to the inside by Frankie Dettori where he enjoyed cover and a trouble-free trip in fourth behind the leader Velvet Lady (GB) (Nashwan {USA}), as Crimson Tide was settled on the outer. Dettori was able to ease him out to prepare his challenge to Crimson Tide, who had committed before the turn into the straight. Any fears that the odds-on favourite would not catch the leader were short-lived, as he powered past that horse with a furlong and a half remaining, before going clear for an impressive success. "This guy is a blue-collar worker, and is a fantastic character--he's been in hard training since December last year," said trainer Gerard Butler. "He's been to Dubai twice, ran in the Guineas, been to Royal Ascot, Arlington, and the Champion Stakes." Dettori added, "Full credit to Gerry, who's kept him going throughout the season--it was a good performance."

DETTORI KEEN ON LIGHT

Frankie Dettori was yesterday looking forward to next Sunday's ride on Godolphin's Fantastic Light (USA) (Rahy {USA} in the G1 Japan Cup. He was fifth in the Breeders' Cup Turf at Churchill Downs Nov. 4 last time, but Dettori is hopeful that he may get things more his own way in Tokyo. "He was stuck on the inside a little bit and we couldn't get out," Dettori commented. "This will suit him a lot better than the Breeders' Cup as there will be a faster pace and a longer straight and that's what he needs. Hopefully we've saved a little bit for Japan, but every Breeders' Cup race is tough and I hope he's not just gone over the top."

Life Is Life (Fr) (Mansonnien {Fr}) scored at her first attempt at hurdles yesterday when accounting for six rivals in the Sodexho Novices' Hurdle that closed the Ascot card. She raced prominently throughout, before surging clear after the second-last hurdle, to land the odds at 11-8 on.
