ROMA BELONGS TO ELLE DANZIG

Elle Danzig (Ger) (Roi Danzig) is becoming something of German folklore, earning the third Group 1 success of her remarkable career yesterday in the Premio Roma in Rome, Italy. The champion three-year-old filly in Germany in 1998, she took the G2 Henkel-Rennen (German 1000 Guineas) and Preis der Diana (German Oaks), before adding the G2 Idee Hansa-Preis at Hamburg, and G1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis at Munich in August. At four, her season culminated in fine triumph here in this contest 12 months ago, in the heavy conditions that suit her so well. Despite her unplaced effort behind Shiva (Jpn) over that ground in the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. at Sandown May 30, connections persevered and brought her steadily back to the heights of last year. On the virtually bottomless ground yesterday, the mare was brought to the front where she had only Sumitas (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}) for company in the early stages. As they entered the straight, the five-year-old mare kicked on as Sumitas started to tread water, and she soon had the race at her mercy. She came home the very impressive winner, while her rivals simply floundered in the mud.

PROUD PREVUE

Making his graded stakes debut and facing open company for the first time, two-year-old Proud Tower (Proud Irish) looked right at home, taking yesterday's GIII Hollywood Prevue S. at Hollywood Park by a confident one length. The colt was coming off a dominant eight-length win in the 1 1/16-miles California Cup Juvenile on Oct. 28. The 3-1 third choice in the field of eight, Proud Tower moved up inside to vie for the early lead. He took a slim lead on the backstretch, edged further clear at the top of the stretch and held sway late over longshot Chinook Cat (Tabasco Cat). "At the half-mile pole, I looked to the outside to see who was up there and didn't see any of the good horses," explained winning rider Victor Espinoza. "So I was thinking, this is over. I made my move and just tried to keep riding hard because he can be a little bit of a lazy horse." Winning trainer Jose Silva said, "I think this horse can run long or short. I like it better short, but he ran good long, too. I think this is one of the nicest horses I'm going to have." Favored Yonaguska (Cherokee Run) rallied four wide into the stretch, but couldn't threaten the top two. Undefeated second choice Our Shining Hour (Gilded Time) stalked the pace five wide, but dropped back leaving the turn, finishing seventh.

We thought she would be okay today, but we thought that other times. Finally she was good. It was a thrill."
