#### WHO WILL HAVE A CIGAR?

A deep field of 11 will go postward in the GI Cigar Mile at Aqueduct today, the final Grade I race of the vear in New York. Defending champion Affirmed Success (Affirmed) has been plying his trade on the turf lately and comes off a fourth, beaten just a half-length, in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Churchill Nov. 4. "He's put in a lot of good efforts this year and deserves one last shot," said trainer Richard Schosberg. "From a numbers standpoint, I think he's faster on dirt than he is on turf." Trainer Bob Baffert has shipped in the speedy El Corredor (Mr. Greeley) from his southern California base. The three-year-old turned in his two best career efforts at a mile, defeating his elders in the GII Del Mar Breeders' Cup H. before finishing a narrow second to Fusaichi Pegasus in the GII Jerome H. at Belmont Sept. 23. Fellow sophomore More Than Ready (Southern Halo) will seek to enhance his stud credentials with a victory here. Winner of the GI King's Bishop over seven furlongs at Saratoga, he has yet to win beyond that distance, but finished third, beaten two necks, in his lone start over a flat mile at two. He was fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint in his most recent outing. Florida shipper Forty One Carats (Tactical Advantage) earned a 115 Beyer in winning the Smile Sprint H. at Calder Oct. 7 after adding blinkers. He set a new track record that day, getting six panels in 1:08 4/5 over the deep Calder surface.

#### SURF'S UP IN THE CLARK

Overbrook Farm's Surfside (Seattle Slew), sent off as the 8-5 second choice, showed her heels to a field of older males with a front-running victory in the GII Clark H. at Churchill Downs yesterday, placing her squarely into Eclipse Award contention. Despite tossing her head a bit in the gate, the bay filly broke smoothly and settled into stride, coasting along through fractions of :23 4/5 and :47 2/5. She turned for home with a clear lead and quickly turned back the challenge of Guided Tour (Hansel), drawing off in the final furlong to win by four lengths. "I was excited at the prospect of riding her in this race," said winning jockey Pat Day. "I knew she had a great chance of winning against the boys and she was much better today than in the Breeders' Cup." It was her first victory since returning from a layoff due to ankle chips. The homebred had rattled off three straight scores to start off the year, including the GI Las Virgenes and the GI Santa Anita Oaks, but was a lackluster fifth in the GI Santa Anita Derby in April and was removed from Kentucky Derby consideration. Off for six months, Surfside was a game second in the seven-furlong Raven Run S. at Keeneland Oct. 17 after a suicidal early pace, then just missed to stablemate Spain in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff over course and distance Nov. 4. #### DESERT PRINCE COLT TOPS GOFFS NOVEM-

**BER** A colt from the first crop of top miler Desert Prince (Ire) (Green Desert) brought a bid of Ir£190,000 Friday from Timmy Hyde to top all foals at the Goffs November Sale. "He is a lovely horse from a beautiful family," said Hyde. The bay colt, selling as Lot 816 from the consignment of Kilcarn Stud, is a half brother to Poliuto (Ire) (Last Tycoon {Ire}), winner of the G1 Premio Parioli (Italian 2000 Guineas). His dam, the Posse mare Ploy (Ire), is a half sister to champions Sun Princess (GB) and Saddler's Hall (Ire). One lot earlier, a grey colt by first-season sire King of Kings (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) brought the sale's second highest price with a bid of Ir£155,000 from Paul Shanahan. "We will show him again next year," said Shanahan. "He is by an exciting sire who has some smashing horses by him in the U.S." From the same consignment as the sale topper, he is out of the winning mare Sallanches (Gone West), a half sister to Mill Native and French Stress. Thursday's session was headed by a Ir£72,000 son from the second crop of Desert King (Ire). Purchased by Eddie O'Leary of Lynn Lodge Stud, the bay colt is out of Forever (Forty Niner), a daughter of Group winner Eternal Reve. "I don't have to tell you what's happening with him, he comes back here next year," remarked O'Leary. Led by Friday's strong trade, the overall average increased from Ir£10,847 to Ir£13,530 and the median price was up as well, from Ir£7,400 to Ir£8,000.

A winner of the GIII Eatontown H. over the Monmouth lawn in August, she lost by a head to Chilukki in the GII Churchill Downs Distaff H. in a track-record setting time of 1:33 1/5. She broke well from her outside post and was forwardly placed through fractions of :23 1/5 and :45 4/5. Reciclada put a head in front at the stretch call as Country Hideaway attempted to come through between horses, and found more in reserve, drawing away in the shadow of the wire. "I was happy with where she was sitting," said winning trainer Richard Mandella, who watched the race on television from California. Bordelaise, a Group 1 winner in her native Argentina, started her U.S. campaign with a victory in the Run for the Roses H. at Santa Anita on New Year's Day, 2000, but had been held winless since. The bay had shown promise, however, finishing second to probable champion Riboletta (Brz) in the Mar. 5 Gl Santa Margarita H., May 28 GI Milady Breeders' Cup H. and Aug. 12 GII Clement L. Hirsch H. In her most recent trip to the post, she was a troubled third in the GII Lady's Secret H. at Oak Tree Oct. 9. The second choice behind GI Breeders' Cup Distaff heroine Spain in her first visit to Kentucky, the South American mare pressed a moderate pace and took a short lead after six furlongs. Always prominent, the favorite got a head in front as they raced down the stretch, but Bordelaise battled back to take a very tight photo. "Spain was definitely the horse to beat," admitted winning rider Pay Day. "She went by me at the head of the stretch and I got into my mare with the left hand. It took her a while, and at first she didn't respond, but when she did she was aggressive. When she was finally in her momentum she got the job done."

El Cielo added another victory to his collection of southern California graded turf sprints under a welltimed ride by jockey Corey Nakatani. The six-year-old bay has been on a tear this season, going four for five with just a neck loss marring a perfect record. He earned his first graded stakes success in the GIII San Simeon H. Apr. 24 going 6 1/2 furlongs down the hill at Santa Anita and went to the sidelines, but returned victoriously Nov. 6 in the GIII Morvich H., run over identical conditions. Shortening up to 5 1/2 furlongs here, the crowd's choice was guided to the rail shortly after the break as East Coast shipper Texas Glitter set out in front through snappy fractions of :22 and :43 4/5. El Cielo skimmed the rail through the turn, angled out for room at the head of the lane and kicked into gear. He collared Texas Glitter with ground-eating strides and surged past that rival in the final strides. "What a horse, he's got a heart as big as the racetrack," exclaimed winning trainer Craig Dollase. "They let that horse [Texas Glitter] go; it kind of surprised me, I thought, 'they're never going to catch this guy.' I was a little concerned that the distance might be a little too short for him [El Cielo]."

The chestnut finished a solid third in the GIII Bold Ruler H. in April, but after running seventh in both the May 7 GI Carter H. and in his True North title defense June 10, he was sent to the sidelines. The New York-bred returned Nov. 9 and showed good speed before weakening to be fourth, beaten just 1 1/4 lengths by Brutally Frank (Groovy), in an overnight handicap over this track. Looking to turn the tables on that rival here, he trailed the field after a quarter and had just one horse beaten after a half, but rallied along the rail on the turn and split horses in the stretch to best Exciting Story in the final drive. "I knew he would run good today," commented winning trainer John Hertler. "The pace set up for him. He was inside and I was just hoping there would be a spot that opened up for him. He really jumps up and runs big races when the pace sets up for him."
