## LIVING UP TO HIS NAME

Hal J. Earnhardt's El Corredor (Mr. Greeley), whose name means 'the runner' in Spanish, made his second foray to New York a successful one in winning the GI Cigar Mile at Aqueduct yesterday. The speedy sophomore had made quick work of his conditions through a four-race skein which culminated in a victory against his elders in the GII Del Mar Breeders' Cup H. Sept. 3. That set up his first trip to New York, where he overcame traffic problems to be second behind Fusaichi Pegasus, beaten 3/4-length, in the GII Jerome H. at Belmont Sept. 23. Quarter cracks surfaced soon after, necessitating some time off, but the dark bay signaled his readiness with a sharp 1:12 1/5 breeze at Santa Anita Nov. 20. With jockey Jerry Bailey clad in Aqueduct's substitute silks, El Corredor raced close up while four wide as Left Bank (French Deputy) and Forty One Carats (Tactical Advantage) disputed the pace through a half in :45 4/5. He kicked into gear in the stretch and outfinished the surprising 46-1 Peeping Tom (Eagle Eyed), drawing off in the final 1/16-mile. "I figured the pace up front would be sufficient for him, and the outside draw really helped us," said Bailey. "He was really on the muscle today and turned in a super effort. This colt really finishes up with a strong run."

## THIS CUP FLOWETH OVER

An internationally flavored field graces Tokyo Racecourse for today's G1 Japan Cup. T. M. Opera-O (Opera House {GB}), the champion Japanese three-year-old of 1999, is undefeated in six starts this season and has amassed career earnings of nearly \$9 million. The likely favorite faces some tough foreign opponents including America's John's Call (Lord At War {Arg}). The nine-year-old ex-steeplechaser, a multiple Grade I winner in 2000, defeated Ela Athena (GB) (Ezzoud {Ire}) in the Oct. 7 GI Turf Classic at Belmont and ran third in his latest trip to the post the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Nov. 4. Four-year-old Fantastic Light (Rahy), winner of the GI Man O' War in the U.S., was the three-length winner of the Dubai Sheema Classic in March as well and makes his first trip to the Orient. He was most recently a close-up fifth in the Breeders' Cup Turf Nov. 4. Air Shakur (Sunday Silence) will also put up a fight, heading into this event with two Group 1s under his belt including his victory last out in the G1 Japanese St. Leger Oct. 22.

Wing Arrow, this year's G1 February S. winner, claimed the title of Japan's Champion Dirt Horse in 1998 and proved the best on that surface here. While Regular Member (Jpn) (Commander in Chief {GB}) rushed to the lead with Lord Sterling pressing the pace in second, the five-year-old was unhurried from the gate and entered the first turn in the rear of the 15-horse field. Gaining ground up the backstretch, he found room on the inside and began his attack before the second turn, took command at the top of the lane and drew clear of his rivals to win the inaugural running of this event convincingly. Sanford City closed well from midpack to take second, while the American contender Lord Sterling hung on for third. The Bobby Frankel trained Euchre (Personal Flag) saved ground and advanced into contention on the final turn, but flattened out to finish eighth as the second betting choice.

A juvenile of considerable importance in France with a victory in the G1 Prix Morny, Charge d'Affaires finished the European portion of his career with a second-place effort in the 1998 G1 Prix de la Foret. Shipped to the U.S. for his four-year-old campaign, the homebred took an Aqueduct allowance in his second American outing and was last of 14 in the GI Atto Mile last year, before winning the GII Knickerbocker H. at Aqueduct. A failed effort in January's GIII Canadian Turf H. at Gulfstream led to some time away from the races, but the five-year-old returned from nine months away from the races with a successful defense of his Knickerbocker title, defeating Devine Wind (American Chance) by 3/4 of a length. Beneath regular pilot Jose Santos, the bay was hustled up to be a forward factor as Devine Wind along the inside and Asidero (Fadeyev) to his outside raced as a team to the far turn. Charge d'Affaires found the necessary racing room turning into the stretch, and hit the front inside the final furlong to register the narrow decision from Ladies Din. "I saw a situation around the middle of the turn where Alex Solis' horse (Asidero) was a little bit uncomfortable and he was starting to drift out a bit," said Santos, whose last winning ride at Hollywood Park was aboard Chief Bearhart in the 1997 Breeders' Cup Turf. "I stayed in behind him and when he moved just one path to the outside, I sent my horse. He finished very strongly to the end." The winner is under consideration for the G1 Hong Kong Mile to be contested at Sha Tin Racecourse Dec. 17, according to assistant trainer Christophe Lorieul.

Miss Pickums broke her maiden at the third time of asking over this surface and followed that success with a one-length victory in her first attempt at two turns in the Sept. 16 Kentucky Cup Juvenile Fillies at Turfway. Stepped up in class, the bay was a creditable fourth, beaten just two lengths, in the GII Alcibiades at Keeneland Oct. 15, but was most recently fifth in Churchill's Pocahontas S. Nov. 3. Miss Pickums was bumped at the start by favored Cash Deal (Danzig) but was kept well within striking distance by jockey Justin Vitek, subbing for an injured Charlie Woods. Nasty Storm wrestled the lead away from the front-running favorite with a bold move into the stretch, as Miss Pickums was forced to steady, but the latter was shifted out to the middle of the track for the drive, caught Nasty Storm and won going away. "I felt she ran a big race at Keeneland and also in the Pocahontas," said winning trainer Paul McGee. "I thought that when we had to check there in the turn we were in trouble, but she just wore them down."

Consistent over the first three starts of his career, Dollar Bill defeated A P Valentine in his maiden victory at Saratoga Sept. 4 before finishing a solid second in the GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland Oct. 8, earning a trip to the Breeders' Cup Juvenile. The bay was a non-factor on Championship Day, reporting home a well-beaten 10th, but was well backed to rebound from the lackluster effort. Angled in to save ground by jockey Calvin Borel, the bay was switched out into the five path for the stretch drive, caught favored Holiday Thunder with just less than a furlong to run and prevailed in a stiff drive. "He's the type of horse that you have to ride the whole time," Borel said. "But I like him because he can get the distance." Added winning trainer Dallas Stewart, "We were concerned that he didn't like running on this track [in the Breeders' Cup], but you have to have faith. The big thing is that he stretched out. You don't have to worry about him going the distance." The colt will be part of Stewart's string at the Fair Grounds and will be pointed for that track's three-year-old series this winter.

Two Item Limit seized command in midstretch and strode home a convincing winner in collecting her second straight graded success. After finishing sixth in the GI Frizette at Belmont, she was equipped with blinkers for her next start and responded with a 2 3/4-length score in the GIII Tempted S. over this surface Nov. 5. The bay filly, breaking from the rail, secured a good spot as Sweep Dreams and Kingsland argued the pace through fractions of :48 3/5 and 1:13 4/5. Shifting to the outside for the drive, Two Item Limit collared the leaders and sputtered away impressively, opening up with each stride. "This filly has really come to hand, and the thing I really like about her is that she has a number of gears," said winning jockey Richard Migliore. "You can place her where you want and she'll get you out of trouble if she has to." She may have one more start this year. "There is an Illinois-bred race December 16 at Hawthorne [Illinois Breeders' Debutante S., 8.5f, \$100,000], but I might wait until Gulfstream," remarked trainer Stephen L. DiMauro.

"I had the horse sold last week, but the vet turned him down. There was a little ankle chip, not a big problem and it didn't amount to anything." Those were the comments of winning owner and trainer Frank Alexander in the winner's circle following yesterday's GII Remsen at Aqueduct. Second in the GIII Cowdin S. sprinting at Belmont Oct. 15, the bay stretched to a mile to finish runner up to Ommadon in the GIII Nashua S. at Aqueduct Nov. 5. Rated along while saving ground in the early stages in his two-turn bow, jockey Robbie Davis shifted Windsor Castle to the outside entering the stretch and he rallied stoutly to catch Ommadon to win going away. "He's a very handy colt," Davis commented. "He's really got an explosive kick and I just wanted to keep him out of trouble." Despite the success, Alexander says the 'for sale' sign is still out. "He's still for sale. I'll take him to Florida on Tuesday and bring him back at Gulfstream."

## ★ AUSTRALASIA ★

### OWNER FAN INVESTIGATED

New South Wales Thoroughbred Racing Board (TRB) stewards opened an inquiry into the circumstances surrounding the death of three horses on a Central NSW Coast spelling property and matters related to the treatments of horses owned by Double Bay jeweler George Fan. The death of three of Fan's near 60 horses--**Our Best (Aus)** (Our Horizon {Aus}), **Solano (Aus)** (Al Hareb {USA}) and **Mr. Forever (NZ)** (Star Way {GB})--at J T Thoroughbreds spelling property in the Dooralong Valley resulted in stewards inspecting the stables of Rosehill trainer Chris Waller. Two boxes of vials, plastic containers, syringes, powders and other various coloured substances were confiscated in the search. The inquiry revealed that the three horses who died were suffering from various, and undiagnosed, illnesses with symptoms including, lost hair, dehydration, diarrhoea, high temperatures and renal failure. Australian Associated Press reported one horse was drinking 100 litres of water a day and urinating excessively before being put down. Tests on products taken from Waller's stables revealed a range of registered and unregistered products, some of which contained the stimulant caffeine and anti-inflammatory Naproxen. Evidence also showed S4 drugs stored in sterile vials had been transferred into plastic bottles with Chinese markings that formerly contained eye solution. Chief Steward Ray Murrhiy asked Fan of the practice, "Are you sending Australian drugs disguised as eye solution to Taiwan where you have horses and dogs? Could it be possible you're killing your horses by unsafe practices?," Murrhiy asked Fan. Fan had used 11 trainers in Queensland before sending his horses to New South Wales, initially with Peter Homann. After Homann, David Lee, John Size, Neville Voigt, Smith, Karakatanis and Waller all had horses owned by Fan over a 13-month period. Trainer Gai Waterhouse also had horses for Fan in her stable for a short period, as well as Cindy Alderson and Brian Mayfield-Smith in Melbourne. One stable employee told the inquiry that while the trainer was away he saw Fan returning from a horse stall "with a syringe in his hand" and the trainer said the horse had been treated without his permission. "What concerns stewards in the long list of trainers you have been involved with, quite a number of them gave evidence you brought preparations into the stables and gave them to your horses," Murrhiy said.

"You seem to have a lot of sick horses and horses that die." Fan denied bringing drugs into stables where his horses were kept. The inquiry was adjourned to a date to be fixed so that products impounded can be sent for toxicological testing. Horses owned by Fan are banned from racing until satisfactory arrangements for their training can be made with TRB stewards.

### NSW BOOKIES MOVE TO DECIMALS

The New South Wales Bookmakers' Co-operative will introduce decimal odds from Nov. 30. The bookies' boards will display fixed dollar dividends with the stake to be included in the price as is the case with the tote and TAB; i.e. a 4-1 chance will be posted as \$5.00, 11-2 becomes \$6.50. The move is aimed at lifting the profile of bookmakers and introducing a new generation of punters to the bagmen. Bookmaker John Kennedy said one of the most common complaints about bookies was that people didn't understand the fractional odds and that they were out of touch with the younger generation. "The present system is confusing for a lot of younger people who have grown up with the tote. The figures tell us there are a lot of first-time racegoers out there at every meeting and we have to make it as attractive as we can," Kennedy said, adding not all were keen on the change. Decimal odds were introduced on Sept. 9 in Brisbane.
