NEW RECORDS AT TATTERSALLS

The foal section of the Tattersalls December Sales finished vesterday evening with new records for average and median, beating the previous bests set three years ago by 7.4 percent and 6.9 percent respectively. First-crop Irish National Stud stallion Desert Prince (Ire) has enjoyed an incredible week, and the icing on the cake came when his well-connected daughter from Haras de Montaigu was bought by Charlie Gordon-Watson for 230,000gns, having seen off Brian Grassick. She will race for Northern Ireland businessman Tom Wilson, who recently sold his engineering business. Wilson said, "I have owned horses for many years, but this is the first time I have been buying foals. She will go to Watership Down Stud now before eventually going into training with John Oxx, and we hope to breed from her when the time comes." The filly is a half sister to the Group 2 winners America (Ire) (Arazi) and Majorien (GB) (Machiavellian). The 230,000gns price was reached again later on when agent Anthony Stroud saw off Seamus Burns of Lodge Park Stud for the only Gone West catalogued, a half brother to the G1 Prix de Diane runner-up Mousse Glacee (Fr) (Mtoto (GB)), who herself realised \$1.8 million at Keeneland last month. "He's a nice horse by a very solid stallion from a classic family," said Stroud. "He is for a new client who will send him back to stud outside Britain before deciding whether to re-sell." The colt was consigned from Liam McAteer's Woodtown House Stud for Martyn Burke. Shortly before, Coolmore's Tammy Twomey saw off John Ferguson for a Machiavellian half sister to the Chilean Group 1 winner Fontanella Borghese (Chi) (Roy) at 215,000gns. Fillies were in strong demand, with another daughter of Machiavellian having been sold earlier for 195,000gns to Brendan Morrin, acting for Cathal Ryan's Swordlestown Stud, who is likely to re-sell her next year. The Tattersalls December Sales will continue Monday with mares, getting underway at 9:30 a.m.

LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON

Bienamado (Bien Bien) emulated his sire in winning the GI Hollywood Turf Cup with a sparkling three-length triumph yesterday at the southern California track. The blaze-faced chestnut, a Group winner in France at two, came to trainer Paco Gonzalez's barn for this season and started off in fine style, winning the restricted Jim Murray H. by seven lengths, then adding a front-running victory in the GII Sunset H. over this course July 23, an effort which punched his ticket for the GI Arlington Million. Sent off as the favorite in that Aug. 19 outing, he had a wide trip en route to a fourth-place finish and was given some time to regroup. The layoff was no concern to the betting public, which sent him off as the even-money chalk. As Vergennes (Dynaformer) bowled along with a four-length lead, Bienamado settled into an easy rhythm, but edged closer as they made their way down the backstretch. He drew even on the far turn, then accelerated smartly once in the straight to maintain his perfect record over the Hollywood turf course. "He got to Vergennes very comfortably," said winning jockey Chris McCarron, who also rode Bien Bien. "I let him pick up the pace leaving the 3/8-pole, and the race was on. From that point on, he simply was best."

Boston Party rallied late to get up in time for his first career stakes success. The four-year-old bay had worked his way steadily through his conditions earlier this year, winning a 10-furlong money allowance at Belmont in May before heading to the sidelines. He returned to action with a third at Belmont going a mile Oct. 8 and followed that up with a second in a conditions allowance over this surface Nov. 2. Making his first foray into stakes company, he was sent off as the second choice. He broke well from his outside post and settled into stride about five lengths from the front as Turnofthecentury disputed the lead with Talk's Cheap through soft early fractions. Asked to pick it up by jockey Norberto Arroyo, Boston Party advanced along the inside through the far turn and swung wide in the stretch, finishing strongly in the final strides. "We've just babied him along and taken it easy with him," said winning trainer Lenny Imperio. "He ran so many times earlier this year, we figured we would freshen him up for the winter. I thought he was going to win at the top of the stretch. He [jockey Arroyo] timed his ride perfectly." As for Boston Party's next start, "We'll see how he comes back," Imperio continued. "He might go to Saudi Arabia for his next race."

TATTERSALLS FOALS WRAP-UP The rising average and median were all the more extraordinary in light of the fact that the top price of 230,000gns--reached twice yesterday--was the lowest at this fixture since 1994 and was less than a tenth of the record individual price of 2,500,000gns. Tattersalls chairman Edmond Mahony commented, "The 29-percent rise (on 1999) in average price is the sign of a very successful sale, but it is the record median figure, up a massive 49 percent, which really tells the story of the week's trade. From the word go we have seen extremely strong demand which has reflected the strength of the yearling sales here at Park Paddocks this autumn. In overall terms this was perhaps not a vintage catalogue, and the number of withdrawals was exceptionally high, but competition has been intense at all levels of the market from start to finish."

From there she turned the race into a procession and was eased near the line to record a comfortable victory.

Caroline Lee, one of the leading apprentices in France in the mid-eighties, passed away on Wednesday at Coye-La-Forêt where she lived after retiring from the saddle. Born in Ireland in 1963, she started riding in her native country for trainer Liam Browne before joining the stable of Maurice Zilber in France. The leading trainer gave her a chance to ride at a time when it was still very difficult for women to make it as jockeys. She became very popular among racing fans with many successes in big handicaps, supporting the national "Quinté" bet. She was also the first of her sex to ride in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby), guiding the Zilbertrained Face Nord (Fr) to sixth place in the 1988 edition of the race.

BACK IN BUSINESS: A REVIEW OF THE 2000 ITALIAN SEASON by Giorgio Barsotti

Just like 1999, the focus of Italy's 2000 season was firmly centred upon the names of trainer Bruno Grizzetti and jockey Mirco Demuro. Their relentless success, coupled with the bouyant results of Italian-trained horses in the championship races both in their native country and abroad, made it a year to remember.

The established dominance of the brothers Alduino and Giuseppe Botti is under threat. For the first time in 27 years, the pair are looking vulnerable as Grizzetti heads them by five wins with 169 on the board. The Italian trainers' championship is decided by the number of winners, but Grizzetti has no equal in terms of prizemoney after sending out the winners of purses totaling L5,770,522,000. The Varese-based horseman took the first Classic of the season, the G2 Premio Regina Elena (Italian 1000 Guineas, Rome Apr. 30) with Xua (Ire) (Fairy King {USA}) and went close to adding the G1 Oaks d'Italia with Polar Charge (GB) (Polar Falcon {USA}), who was denied by a neck by Timi (GB).

Grizzetti also took the G2 Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte July 29 with Rolly Polly (Ire) (Mukaddamah {USA}) and the G3 Prix du Palais Royal at Longchamp May 25 with Blu Air Force (Ire) (Sri Pekan {USA}). These successes highlighted the benefit of a more aggressive international policy for the trainer. Boosted by the involvement of Daniel Wildenstein, who bought Blu Air Force, Xua and Rolly Polly, and with over 150 horses in his stables spread between Milan and Varese, Grizzetti established himself as the most powerful trainer in Italy--so much so that he is now considering setting up a satellite base in France, where he will send an elite set of horses, attracting the investment of international owners. A trainer of such dimensions deserves a jockey to match and, in Demuro, he has the best. Demuro's highly successful Japanese foray last winter spoke for itself, and the 2000 Italian season saw him finish clear of his rivals with 153 winners and he was successful in the highest company on Timboroa (GB) (Salse {USA}) in the G1 Presidente Della Repubblica (named the Premio Del Giubileo), which was richer than ever before. There the Roberto Brogi-owned and trained horse handed a beating to German raiders Sumitas (Ger) and Caitano (GB).

Demuro, who also partnered Timi (GB) (Alzao {USA}) to her Classic victory, has now signed to Grizzetti and that should see him dominate the local scene in 2001 after what could be a beneficial time in California in February of next year.

The 2000 season saw a resurgence in the native fortunes, as the first three Classics fell to Italian-trained horses. In addition to Xua taking the Italian 1000 Guineas, homebred Davide Umbro (Ity) (In The Wings {GB}) captured the colts' version, the G2 Premio Parioli. The run was maintained by Timi, but despite this upturn, the G1 Derby Italiano continued to escape the home team, as the very smart German challenger Kallisto (Ger) (Sternkonig {Ire}) stormed to an impressive six-length victory.

Kallisto renewed the usual plundering by foreign raiders. Along with that success, Germany also celebrated the win of Faberger (Ger) (Dashing Blade {GB}) in the G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua at Milan Oct. 8. The Luca Cumani-trained Endless Hall (GB) (Saddler's Hall {Ire}) was impressive winning the G1 Gran Premio di Milano June 17, while the John Dunlop-trained Golden Snake (USA) (Danzig {USA}) added another success for Britain in the G1 Gran Premio Del Jockey Club at Milan Oct. 22. On the same afternoon, William Haggas' Count Dubois (GB) (Zafonic {USA}) had too many guns for local hope Sopran Glaumix (Ity) (Linamix {Fr}), who could finish only fourth in the G1 Gran Criterium.

Of the two-year-olds, Low Pivot (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) achieved arguably the most success when he claimed the G3 Premio Chiusura at Milan Nov. 1, becoming the first juvenile to beat the older horses, including Xua, in 19 years.

Overseas, alongside the efforts of Blu Air Force and Rolly Polly, the Aidan O'Brien-trained Glyndebourne (Ire) was a boost for Italian breeders, as the colt, who was a product of Azienda Agricola Razza del Sole, finished second to Sinndar (Ire) in the G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh July 2.

The billions of lira invested to help Italian breeders sell yearlings to European and American buyers certainly has started to pay off, with the breeders' associations which are members of the Italian racing authority UNIRE receiving up to 40 percent extra to buy quality mares and to spend on nominations.

Among the owners, Luciano Gaucci, who campaigned Tony Bin (GB) and White Muzzle (GB), was back with greater investments and he was rewarded with the success of Richard Hannon's Bram Stoker (Ire), Paul Cole's Overspect (GB) and Spettro (Ire). At home, he had Dane Friendly (GB) (Danehill {USA}) to fly the flag, who scored in the G2 Premio Ribot at Rome Nov. 12.

While the results showed the new strength of the Italians, the racecourses suffered in attendance, as Milan achieved only 129,000 all season, showing a downturn from the 138,000 in 1999. Betting turnover, however, improved slightly, reaching L171,044 billion, an increase on last year's total of L161,400 billion. Rome, which will be open throughout the winter with jumping fixtures mixed with all-weather flat racing, lost out again as attendance fell.

Racecourse politics dominated again, as the courses called for better facilities for owners and racegoers. UNIRE has promised to look into this situation. Plans to relaunch racecourses are in the offing, as the three Racecourse Associations are demanding urgent investment to maintain their fixtures and help the status of Italian racing worldwide.

JOCKEYS JOURNEY TO JOBS ABROAD

Milan-based jockey, Marco Latorre, has gone to South Africa where he will spend the winter in the employment of their local Jockey Club. He follows the move overseas by jockey Mirco Demuro, who jets off to Japan to ride for trainer Teruya Yoshida for two months, and Fernando Jovine, who is already riding in Singapore, is employed by the local Jockey Club until March. Demuro, who took the jockeys' championship again with 153 wins, was chased hard by the Rome-based jockey Dario Vargiu, who closed on 115 wins. Vargiu has left the Rome stable of trainer Fabio Brogi to sign a contract with Scuderia Rencati, one of the most powerful stables based in Milan and with whom Demuro made his name. Luciano Salice of Scuderia Rencati spreads his horses among trainers Luciano D'Auria, Giuseppe Botti and Emilio Borromeo in Italy, and Luca Cumani in Britain. Jockey Gabriele Bietolini, who was third in the classification, will remain with Scuderia Blueberry, the breeders of Irish Derby runner-up Glyndebourne (Ire). He will also ride for Bruno Grizzetti when Demuro is unavailable, but he is not committed. Jockey Max Tellini has left trainer Roberto Feligioni and Scuderia Zaro to sign with Milan-based trainer Antonio Marcialis and Spanish-born jockey Manuel Diaz will move from Pisa to replace Tellini at Scuderia Zaro. The Spanish jockey Oscar Urbina arrived in Pisa recently where he will spend the winter riding for Scudera Azzurra at the local track while looking for other rides. Based in Newmarket this year, he built up an association with trainer James Fanshawe.

ITALIAN SCENE SWITCHES

Flat racing at Milan and Rome has ended for the year, but Napoli starts today while Pisa, Varese, Corridonia, Siracusa and Livorno are kept busy until the spring. The last Listed races of the Italian season, the Premio FIA European Breeders Fund and the Premio FIA Breeders' Cup, will take place at the Pisa track on Saturday Dec. 16. All the races will be sponsored by FIA, the Italian EBF Associations. Entries are due to close Monday at 11a.m. Italian time.
