## DEAUVILLE GETS UNDERWAY TODAY

The Agence Francaise's December Mixed Sale, which begins today at 2 p.m. at Deauville, has firmly established itself as a top sale on the international market. Silic (Fr), Reve d'Oscar (Fr) and Beckett (Ire), all G1 winners this year, had their dams sold at Deauville for respectively FF400,000, FF150,000 and FF65,000. There will be two different catalogues, with the first numbering 552 lots of broodmares, fillies in and out of training and foals. Beside all major French farms like Bernesq, Cadran, Chartreux, Capucines, Etreham, Fresnay Le Buffard, Logis, Louvière, Mezeray, Ommeel, Reboursière, and Val Henry, the sale features the return to the Deauville market of such consignors as His Highness The Aga Khan and Darley Stud. Among potential stars in this catalogue are Hip 14, a filly foal by Anabaa out of a full sister to GISW Silver Ending; Hip 83, the Group-placed Learycal (Lear Fan), a half sister to G1SW Oczy Czarnie in foal to Croco Rouge (Ire); Hip 88, **Happy Diamond (Ger)** (Master Willie {GB}), a full sister to MG1SW Hollywood Dream (Ire) in foal to Lando (Ger); Hip 94, **La Consaca (Ger)** (Kongsstuhl {Ger}), a half sister to MG1SW Lomitas (G1) in foal to Trempolino; Hip 120, **White Quartz (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), a half sister to G1SW Queen Maud (Ire) in foal to Mark of Esteem (Ire); Hip 130, **Nazeera (Fr)** (Lashkari {Ire}), a half sister to G1SW Natroun (Fr) in foal to Monsun (Ger); Hip 154, **Green Rosy (Green Dancer)**, the dam of Group winners Majorien (GB) and America (Ire) in foal to Fasliyev; Hip 201, **Tiyana (Ire)** (Zayyani {Ire}), a half sister to champion Timarida (Ire) in foal to Alhaarth (Ire); Hip 204, **Sunningwell (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), a daughter of G1 Yorkshire Oaks heroine Untold (GB) in foal to Indian Ridge (Ire). There will be broodmares in foal to and foals by all major international sires, as well as foals by first-crop sires including Among Men, Desert Story (Ire), King of Kings (Ire), Medaaly (GB) and Starborough (GB). The second catalogue will feature 130 yearlings and 65 horses in training to be sold on Mon., Dec. 11. After starting today at 2 p.m., the sale will continue on Sunday and Monday with sessions beginning at 10 a.m.

## BEHRENS RETIRES

Top handicap horse **Behrens** (Pleasant Colony--Hot Novel, by Mari's Book) has been retired from racing and will enter stud at Darby Dan Farm in Lexington, Kentucky for the 2001 breeding season. He will stand for a fee of \$20,000, live foal, as the property of his owners William L. Clifton, Jr. and Rudlein Stable. Out of graded stakes winner Hot Novel, Behrens was a \$225,000 Keeneland July purchase. He won the GII Buick Pegasus and the GII Dwyer at three, as well as finishing second by a head in the GI Travers. He went on to secure two runnings of the GI Gulfstream Park H. as well as the GI Oaklawn H., and finished second to Dubai Millennium (GB) in the 2000 G1 Dubai World Cup. In all, Behrens concluded his four-year career with a record of 25-9-7-3, for earnings of \$4,563,500. The six-year-old bay is a grandson of His Majesty, who stook his entire career at Darby Dan until his death in 1995. Behrens is available for inspection at Darby Dan.

## GREEN DANCER DIES

A week after he was pensioned from stud duties, **Green Dancer** (Nijinsky II-Green Valley {Fr}, by \*Val de Loir) died from the infirmities of old age, Gainesway Farm announced yesterday. "Green Dancer's condition deteriorated rapidly this past week and he was humanely destroyed," said Gainesway's Michael Herson. The sire of seven champions, Green Dancer became an excellent broodmare sire. His daughters have produced over 100 stakes winners to date, including champions Halling, Peaks and Valleys and Sandpit (Brz) as well as this year's GI Breeders' Cup Turf hero Kalanisi (Ire) and G1 Epsom Derby winner Quest for Fame (GB).

Smooth Player has announced herself as a force to be reckoned with on the southern California circuit, winning the GII Lady's Secret H. on the main track before switching to the turf for a victory in the GII Las Palmas H. at Santa Anita Nov. 5. In the latter, she opened up a lengthy lead and held off Beautiful Noise and Happyannuit in the stretch; she cuts back a sixteenth in distance here. The dark bay four-year-old should be able to secure a forward position from the two hole. Defending champ Lady at Peace found Grade I company too deep in her last two outings, finishing fifth in the GI E.P. Taylor and ninth in the GI Matriarch over this course Nov. 26. Previously, she was unbeaten in three starts on the Hollywood turf.

**KEENELAND, BORISLOW SETTLE** Keeneland and Daniel Borislow have settled out of court in regards to the \$1.7 million lawsuit filed by the sales company Nov. 16, the *Blood Horse* reported. Keeneland had not received payment for eight horses which Borislow purchased at the September sale for \$1,654,000. A \$50,000 check submitted by Borislow could not be cashed by Keeneland due to a bank error. Borislow sold Beautiful Bid for \$2.6 million at Fasig-Tipton in November and will use the proceeds from that sale to cover his Keeneland purchases. Fasig-Tipton releases funds 30 to 45 days after the date of the sale. "He's working with us and he's cooperated fully," Harvie Wilkinson, Keeneland's director of finance, told the *Blood Horse*.

CONFLAGASION** (c, 2, Pine Bluff--Lady's Truth, by Riverman) finished strongly in a third-place effort Nov. 7 but regressed to seventh last time out Nov. 25. Making his two-turn debut, the colt trailed the field in the early going, rallied widest of all into the stretch and forged to the lead late to win by a half length over Progencis (Rubiano). The average daily attendance was 1,206, 3.2 percent down from 1,246 in 1999. The live handle averaged \$105,233 this year, a \$3,098 dip from 1999's \$108,331. The simulcast signal rose significantly following Hoosier's inclusion under the Churchill Downs umbrella. The average daily signal sale was \$1,012,329, a 22 percent increase over the \$829,657 registered in 1999.
