A ROSY DEAUVILLE OPENER

The market was very selective on day one of the Agence Française December Mixed Sale at Deauville yesterday, with the choice pedigrees commanding much enthusiasm and competition. The top lot, Lot 154, the exceptionally-bred Green Rosy (Green Dancer), was bought by Horse France for FF5,000,000. Sold in foal to Faslivey and the dam of Group winners Majorien (GB) and America (Ire), she was one of six lots to make FF1,000,000 or over on a very lively first day. Lot 114, Zaizafonic Davis (Ire) (Law Society), in foal to Darshaan (GB), went to Peter Doyle Bloodstock on behalf of Swordlestown Stud for FF2,200,000, which also purchased lot 30, Reve Realite (GB) (Anabaa) for FF1,000,000. Caerless (Ire) (Caerleon), whose granddam is the amazing Trillion, sold in foal to Theatrical (Ire) for FF2,100,000 to 6C Racing. Caerless was one of two successful representatives of Darley Stud, who also put forward lot 120, White Quartz (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). The filly went for FF1,350,000 to Intercontinental Bloodstock. She is in foal to Mark Of Esteem (Ire), A total of FF30,262,000 changed hands, with an average of FF277,633.

ON THE MONEY

Follow The Money (Pine Bluff) circled three wide around pacesetting Smooth Player (Bertrando) into the stretch and dug in gamely late to annex a 1/2-length triumph in yesterday's GII Dahlia H. at Hollywood Park. The homebred filly came to hand for trainer David Hofmans during the Del Mar meeting where she followed up a second-place finish Aug. 3 with a 2 1/4length victory Aug. 28. Shipped east, the dark bay was made the 19-10 favorite in the Sept. 15 GIII Violet H. at The Meadowlands and got her neck in front at the wire for her first stakes success. She returned to the races with a last-place finish in Santa Anita's GII Las Palmas H., but found trouble in the stretch and gave way. Rated in midpack by jockey Victor Espinoza as Smooth Player slugged it out on the front end, she advanced on the far turn, was shifted out for run and finished gamely. "She relaxed very nicely today and sat right behind the two leaders," Espinoza commented. "When it was time to go, she took off and I didn't think there was anybody who could catch me then. She was very strong at the end."

Radical Riley seized the lead in midstretch and held off the charge of favored Outofthebox to become the first stakes winner for his second-crop sire Wheaton, an Alvdar half brother to Storm Cat. The gray colt had been second in both the Affirmed division of the Florida Stallion S. and the Foolish Pleasure S., but displayed fondness for a wet surface Nov. 25, when he splashed home by 9 3/4 lengths in a Calder allowance. Breaking from post three, he saved ground just behind the leaders in the run down the backstretch, but angled out four wide and loomed boldly as they raced around the far turn. He held a narrow advantage at the eighth pole and gamely held on to deny the late-charging Outofthebox. "When I saw the rain come down I started praying--I knew I had a better chance," said winning jockey Eduardo Nunez. "My horse is much better in the slop. They tried to get him, but it was too late." Radical Riley will likely make his next start at Calder. "We know he loves a wet-fast track under him," said trainer Jim Hatchett. "We'll look at the Tropical Park Derby [GIII, 1-1, \$100K, 9fT] and see whether it goes on the turf and make a decision."

Wild Heart Dancing and Megan's Bluff raced one-two every step of the nine furlongs of the GIII My Charmer H. The former, winner in her most recent trip to the post of the GIII Athenia H. at Aqueduct Oct. 29, set the pace tracked by GII Mrs. Revere S. champion Megan's Bluff, the betting favorite. The latter ranged up on the outside of her rival nearing the sixteenth pole, exchanged bumps and ultimately crossed the line narrowly the best, but was subsequently disqualified for causing interference and was placed second. "She's been a nice filly since mid-summer," said winning conditioner Eugene Brajczewski. "We were going to take her to California for the (GI) Matriarch, but she came up with a little bit of mucus in her lungs." The trainer will point the four-year-old to winter stakes races at Gulfstream Park.

A steady rain falling over South Florida rendered the Calder turf course yielding for the GIII Tropical Turf H., but Stokosky found the underfoot conditions to his liking in registering his first stakes success. The half to local favorite Winfama returned from a four-month hiatus without Lasix, but easily wired a local turf allowance bunch at nine furlongs Nov. 3. The chestnut followed that effort with a crack at the 11-furlong Flag Down H., yielding late to finish second by a length. Returning to a more comfortable distance for this effort, Stokosky took up a cozy position along the inside as Special Coach led from favored Band Is Passing. The colt split those two rivals once into the stretch, took over a sixteenth out and inched clear late. Special Coach and Band Is Passing finished in a dead heat for the place spot.
