#### **OUITE A CATCH AT DEAUVILLE DAY 2**

Sharp Catch (Ire) (Common Grounds {GB}), a Groupplaced winner in foal to Barathea (Ire), brought a final bid of FF3,200,000 to top yesterday's second session of the Deauville December Mixed Sale, presented by L'Agence Française. Consigned by Haras de Bernesg and sold to dissolve a partnership, the five-year-old was purchased by Peter Doyle Bloodstock as agent for Swordlestown Stud. The bay, who won two of her 14 starts and finished third in the G3 Ballyogan S., was bred for the first time this year. A half-sister to twotime Irish champion Catch The Blues (Ire) (Bluebird), she is also from the family of Group 1 winners Caracolero, Epsom Derby hero Secreto and Close Conflict. Another broodmare carrying her first foal, the three-year-old Mona Em (Ire) (Catrail), attracted the second-highest price yesterday. Part of the same consignment which produced the session topper, the Listed stakes winner, in foal to Hector Protector, was bought for FF670,000 by Agence Fips. A weanling from the third crop by G1 Irish 2000 Guineas and G1 Dubai Champion S. winner Spectrum (Ire) (Rainbow Quest) rounded out the top three on Deauville December's second day. Out of twice Group-placed Kruguy (Ire) (Try My Best), the colt was purchased for FF480,000 by Peter Doyle Bloodstock. The Deauville Sale concludes today, with bidding for the final session beginning at 10 a.m.

#### WINNING THE UNDERWOOD...AT LAST

Men's Exclusive (Exclusive Ribot) made his stakes debut in the 1996 edition of the GIII Vernon O. Underwood S. and finished second, beaten just three-quarters of a length. The veteran gelding has started just 21 times in the four seasons since, and missed the last three runnings of the event, but he was back in the field at Hollywood Park yesterday afternoon and made the most of his second chance, rallying to win the 2000 Underwood by three lengths over 2-1 favorite Love All the Way (Majesterian). Winning jockey Laffit Pincay Jr., who had guided the seven-year-old to four of his previous seven victories, said, "What a great feeling. I thought I was in tough today. I was a little bit disappointed in the way he ran last time." The California-bred, who was winless in eight tries last year while finishing second five times, returned from a 9 1/2-month layoff to be third in an optional claimer at Del Mar in August, then finished second in the GIII Bay Meadows Breeders' Cup Sprint H. in September before romping to a 7 1/4-length score in the restricted Bull Dog S. at Fresno Oct. 15. But, trying turf for only the second time in his career in the Nov. 6 GIII Morvich H. last time out, the dark bay finished fifth after pressing a very fast pace. "This horse has run his best races for me when he has come from behind," Pincay said, "Last time, we wanted to take him back, but he broke so sharp I couldn't take him as far back as I wanted. Today it worked out perfect because he didn't break that sharp. I was able to put him behind horses and I think that probably made the difference." Added trainer Wesley Ward, "I made a mistake and put him on the grass course...it's too late in the game to change a horse's racing surface. But he really came through today, and Laffit rode him like the champion he is." Love All the Way, claimed out of five consecutive races from May through October, most recently was haltered for \$62,500 after a victory at Santa Anita Oct. 29 and captured an optional claimer vs. \$80,000 horses Nov. 16. The five-year-old suffered from a tardy start as well, but fought his way through traffic to get up for the place. "He ran into some traffic problems around the far turn which kind of cost him his momentum," his iockey, Corey Nakatani, said. (Underwood chart, p2)

**DALIAPOUR TO REMAIN IN HONG KONG G1SW** 

Daliapour (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), who will make his next start in Sunday's G1 Hong Kong International Vase at Sha Tin, has been sold to Robert Ng, one of Hong Kong's leading property dealers and hoteliers. Currently trained by Sir Michael Stoute, the four-year-old will carry Ng's colors in the Vase, then will join the stable of one of Hong Kong's top conditioners, Ivan Allan. The bay has won five of his 14 career starts, including this year's G1 Coronation Cup; he was also the runner-up in the G1 Epsom Derby and G1 Irish Derby last season, and finished third in both the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. and GI Canadian International S. during his 2000 campaign. His earnings stand at more than \$1.2 million. Ng, who owns 70 horses in Singapore which race under the banner of Lucky Stable, said, "Daliapour is the highest-rated horse I have owned, and the first one I will have with Ivan." Allan added, "He is a nice horse and I am looking forward to having him, but it will be difficult to improve a horse from Sir Michael Stoute." As for the future, he said, "The sort of races he will be aimed at are the Audemars Piaget Queen Elizabeth II Cup and the Aetna Hong Kong Champions and Chater Cup. I shall give him a rest after Sunday and aim him for the Dubai Sheema Classic next March."

Odds-on trying two turns for the first time in this restricted test, the \$4,500 yearling bargain went right to the front and was allowed to set a leisurely pace, then kicked away from the well-bred Indy Glory to keep her perfect record intact. "She just keeps on going," trainer Bob Klesaris said. "I don't think it was a spectacular or flashy race, but she did what she had to do. We're going to give her four or five weeks off now, bring her back in training down south and have her ready for a race in March."
