HONG KONG IS JIM'S TONIC

Globetrotting **Jim And Tonic (Fr)** (Double Bed {Fr}) makes his fifth overall start in Hong Kong in this afternoon's featured G1 Hong Kong International Cup at Sha Tin Racecourse, as the six-year-old looks for a third consecutive victory in the International Races. The winner of the G2 Hong Kong International Bowl over 1400 meters in 1998, the chestnut returned last season to annex the International Cup, defeating Running Stag over today's trip. It has been a relatively quiet season for the Francois Doumen trainee, with just three starts to date, including a 1/2-length success over heavy going in the G3 Prix Perth at Saint-Cloud Nov. 4, his first start in seven months. Jim And Tonic will likely have to call on all of his reserves to defeat an excellent international field, including fellow frequent flyer **Fantastic Light (Rahy)** from Team Godolphin. The winner of this season's G1 Man o' War at Belmont Park in September, the four-year-old is winless in his last three trips to the post. He was beaten into fifth, just two lengths behind Kalanisi (Ire), in the Breeders' Cup Turf two back and was unlucky when a neck third in the G1 Japan Cup in Tokyo Nov. 26. "The horse seems in good form and appears to have come out of his race in the Japan Cup very well," said Brian Powell, trainer Saeed bin Suroor's travelling head lad. "With a little more pace in the race he might have won in Japan. He has done a lot of travelling this year, but he takes it well. He's got to come back to 10 furlongs in the Cup, but he won the Man o'War over 11 furlongs at Belmont off a slowish pace, so we'll see." A victory this afternoon gives the bay a shot at the Emirates World Series Championship. **Samum (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}) is also in the running for the World Series prize. The sophomore defeated 20 classmates to score a decisive victory in the G1 Deutsches Derby before registering a popular 2 1/2-length success in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden two back. Undefeated in six previous starts, he was made a 7-1 chance for the G1 Arc de Triomphe in his most recent start to date, but finished sixth over ground that may have been somewhat too firm. He retains the services of regular rider and International Jockey Challenge winner Andrasch Starke. *Field p3*

MAKING HIS POINT

The Thoroughbred Corp.'s **Point Given** (Thunder Gulch) confirmed himself as a top-notch Derby prospect with a one-length score over Charismatic's half-brother **Millennium Wind** (Cryptoclearance) in the G1 Hollywood Futurity yesterday. The rangy chestnut announced himself with a victory in the GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile at Turfway Park and followed that up with a strong second in the G1 Champagne at Belmont in October. Sent off at 8-1 in the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile, he was a hard-charging second, beaten a nose, to likely champion Macho Uno Nov. 4 at Churchill Downs. The Bob Baffert charge had trained forwardly since that effort and signaled his readiness with a bullet :59 drill at Santa Anita Dec. 11. The 1-5 chalk, off a step slowly, was widest of all as the four-horse field turned into the backstretch. As Millennium Wind was pressed by **Golden Ticket** (Deposit Ticket) through fractions of :23 and :46 4/5, Point Given dragged jockey Gary Stevens into contention, and they turned for home three abreast. Golden Ticket dropped out of it as they straightened away into the stretch, and Point Given hooked up with a game Millennium Wind. Despite lugging in near the eighth pole, the crowd's choice gradually edged away and crossed the line a length clear, giving Baffert his third Hollywood Futurity winner in four years. "As a trainer I wanted to run him here because he is a big horse and I can't let him get too heavy on me," Baffert commented. The colt's route to the Classics is up in the air. "Right now I've got to sit down with Richard [Mulhall] and we've got to figure out a game plan," Baffert continued. "I don't know, the Santa Anita Derby, do we go there? Do we go to Florida? Do we go to Louisiana? All these tracks putting up these bonuses." Stevens praised his mount in the winner's circle. "He reminds me a lot in temperament of his daddy," he said. "As long as he stays in one piece, the sky's the limit." Stevens rode Thunder Gulch to victory in the 1995 Kentucky Derby. Millennium Wind, a \$1.2 million yearling, debuted with a three-length score going seven furlongs and gave a good account of himself in his stakes and two-turn bow. "He was hooked every step, never had a breather, and Chris [jockey McCarron] said he ran all the way to the wire," said trainer David Hofmans. "Take care of him, and here we come, we hope." *Chart p2*

The three-year-old, making only his seventh start for trainer Lindsay Smith, mustered up a late sprint in the straight to catch and edge out that rival out by a narrow margin at the wire.

Strolling Belle ended her three-year-old campaign with a 1 3/4-length victory in this race, but did not make her first appearance of 2000 until Sept. 15, when she was second in a Belmont allowance event. The bay, third in the Gill Maple Leaf S. at Woodbine Oct. 29, was coming off an allowance winner over the Aqueduct main track Nov. 22. Defending her Ladies title, she raced off the flank of front-running Sazarac Jazz (Dixieland Band) through six furlongs in 1:15, drove to the front as they came out of the turn, then was forced to alter course while jostling with Pentatonic down the lane and had to settle for second. Pentatonic, winner of the restricted Montauk H. Dec. 3, was disqualified and placed second for bearing in. "My filly was lugging in a bit, but every time I'd straighten her out Strolling Belle would bump into us again," said Pentatonic's jockey, Robbie Davis. "I did my best to keep a straight path." Herbie Castillo Jr., aboard Strolling Belle, countered, saying, "My filly got discouraged every time they came in on us. Once I checked out of it and got my horse to the outside, she came on again." Strolling Belle will be pointed for the Gill Affectionately H. at Aqueduct Jan. 13.

Antipodean star **Sunline** will tackle the Mile in an attempt to avenge her defeat in last year's Hong Kong Cup. The bay mare defended her title in the G1 Cox Plate Oct. 28 and prepped for this outing with a sharp score in the G2 Auckland Thoroughbred Breeders' S. over 1400 meters at Pukehohe Nov. 25. Her biggest challenge will come in the form of local hero **Fairy King Prawn**, winner of the Hong Kong Sprint in 1999. The five-year-old captured the G1 Yasuda Kinen in Japan earlier this year and finished second in his last out, a 1000-meter event over this course Nov. 26. American representative **Charge d'Affaires** is seeking to end his career on a high note. The five-year-old bay won his second straight GIII Knickerbocker H. at Aqueduct, then shipped to California and earned a hard-fought decision in the GII Citation H. at Hollywood Nov. 25.

A pair of fillies loom as serious threats in this event. The peripatetic **Ela Athena**, winner of the G3 Lancashire Oaks at Haydock in July, has taken her show on the road in the latter part of 2000. Shipped to New York, she finished second in the GI Man o' War Sept. 9 and third in the GI Turf Classic Oct. 7. The four-year-old grey then flew to Tokyo, where she finished fourth in the G1 Japan Cup Nov. 26. Fellow four-year-old **Catella**, a Group 1 winner in her native Germany, had a rough trip when third in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf at Churchill Downs Nov. 4. The chestnut has shown an affinity for firm going. **Helene Vitality** plied his trade as Hades in New Zealand, where he captured the G1 New Zealand Derby. Transferred to Hong Kong, the four-year-old looked sharp in defeating **Industrialist** and **Indigenous** in the Pok Oi Cup going 2000 meters over this course Nov. 18. **Val's Prince** edged **Oriental Express** in the 1997 Hong Kong Cup, but is a step off that form this year. The eight-year-old chestnut finished third in the GII Red Smith H. at Aqueduct Nov. 18.

A specialist at this afternoon's distance of 1000 meters, **Nuclear Debate** rides the crest of a three-race winning streak for trainer John Hammond. The winner of the G2 Prix du Gros Chene at Chantilly June 3, the gelding returned 17 days later to add the G2 King's Stand S. at Ascot at odds of 16-1. The bay is unraced since a 1 1/4-length victory in the Aug. 24 G1 Nunthorpe S. at York, but Hammond seems unfazed by the layoff. "If he gets beat, it will not be a case of fitness," he said. More of a question mark at this abbreviated sprint distance is American hopeful **Big Jag**. Trained by Tim Pinfield, the veteran was third to reigning Hong Kong Horse of the Year Fairy King Prawn (Aus) in this event last year in what was his only trip to the infield to date and could improve off that effort. "I'm looking to win on Sunday," commented rider Kent Desormeaux. "I know this horse is ready." The hero of the Dubai Golden Shaheen over a straight 1200 meters at Nad al Sheba in March, Big Jag was fourth in the GI Met Mile and was last seen when seventh in the GIII Triple Bend Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood July 9.

BLACK BEAN LOSES SPOT IN SPRINT After testing positive for the banned substance Demborexine on three separate occasions since shipping in from Australia Monday night, **Black Bean (Aus)** (Raami {GB}) has been withdrawn from the Hong Kong International Sprint by the stewards. The horse underwent urine tests Tuesday, Friday and Saturday morning, and all three samples contained traces of Demborexine; the five-year-old had been treated for respiratory problems with medication, which is not illegal in Australia, but his connections insisted he had not been administered the drug since arriving in Hong Kong. Taking **Black Bean's** place in the Sprint is **Prime Witness (Aus)** (Euclase {Aus}), a four-year-old gelding who equaled the track record for 1200 meters at Sha Tin in October, but has yet to win in six tries down the track's 1000-meter chute. With four wins from 11 Hong Kong starts, he breaks from post 13 with jockey Shane Dye aboard.

The spill resulted in six others crashing; Dominance was subsequently destroyed. Harvey, who won the G1 Fruit 'N' Veg S. on Old Comrade (Aus) earlier in the day, has a suspected broken thigh. Kristian Hawkins, Mark Sestich, Paul King, Craig Staples, Daniel Staeck and Jason Miller all were taken to the hospital for precautionary examinations. This accident comes after Perth jockeys staged a protest by snubbing Harvey last Saturday, refusing to leave the mounting enclosure until he'd gone ahead. The jockeys believe he has abused the appeals process, taking two appeals against suspension to the Supreme Court and gaining injunctions which enabled him to ride over the Perth summer carnival.
