Owned by Sabine Plattner, Laisserfaire, who is out of the Jade Hunter (USA) mare Procrastinate (Aus), cost A\$575,000 at the Inglis Easter Yearling Sale in 1997. She has now won five of her seven starts in South Africa and for earnings of R263,300.

CAL-BREDS SWEEP BAYAKOA

Feverish (Pirate's Bounty) finally made the step up from state-fair sweetheart to graded-stakes winner with a tough-as-nails victory in the GII Bayakoa H., leading home a top-three sweep for California-breds on the penultimate day of racing at Hollywood Park yesterday. The winner of the Alameda City H. at Pleasanton July 8, the homebred mare shipped to Santa Rosa to annex the L Burbank H. before some time off. She returned to easily win the E.B. Johnston S. at the L.A. County Fair at Fairplex Sept. 17, but developed a case of seconditis for her following three outings, most recently filling that spot in the 7 1/2-furlong Cat's Cradle H. for state-breds Nov.23. Stretching back to two turns, the dark bay was the narrow second choice behind Gourmet Girl (Cee's Tizzy). Sent immediately for the lead, Feverish was joined at the half-mile pole by Gourmet Girl. The cadence quickened at the top of the stretch as the two continued to race side by side, but Feverish proved just the better at the line to improve on her fourth-place finish a year ago. "It's nice to be on the right end of the photo," said winning trainer Dan Hendricks. "She's just been tremendous. In a few days, they all turn another year older and she'll be back."

The seven-furlong event is the beginning of the Strub Series, which continues with the GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup Jan. 13 and concludes with the GII Strub S. Feb. 3. Dixie Union (Dixieland Band) makes a much-anticipated return to competitive racing for trainer Richard Mandella. One of the top juveniles in 1999, the dark bay was second by a neck to Tiznow in the GII Affirmed H. before shipping East to annex the GI Haskell Invitational.
