HOLLYWOOD MEET ENDS Hollywood Park concluded its 2000 Autumn Meet Sunday with business down from the 1999 season. The 2000 average ontrack handle was \$1,688,360--down 11 percent from last year. The average total handle was \$9,649,413, down 5.8 percent from the 1999 figure of \$10,247,815. Total attendance at the 35-day meeting was 583,094. The average attendance of 6,880 was down 9.5 percent from the 7,603 average attendance of last year. Victor Espinoza was the top jockey at the Autumn meet and Bobby Frankel was the top trainer.

Irish Conquest & Gray Raider to LoAnJo Farm:

Irish Conquest (Conquistador Cielo--Irish Colors, by Hoist the Flag) and Gray Raider (Rubiano--Miss Creeker, by Red Ryder) will enter stud next year at Don Jone's LoAnJo Farm in Chester, New York. The seven-year-old Irish Conquest won the 1998 Deputy Minister S. at Gulfstream and was three times graded stakes placed. He retires with seven wins in 41 starts and earnings of \$362,635. Irish Conquest will stand as the property of a syndicate for \$3,000, live foal. Gray Raider, second in the 1996 GII Saratoga Special, retires with five wins in 22 starts and earnings of \$219,746. The property of a partnership, he will stand for \$2,000, live foal.

Cutting back to one turn for this effort, Grey Memo was reserved in sixth early on as favored Unlimited Value (Present Value) cut out solid fractions. He advanced along the inside on the turn, shifted out in the stretch and outfinished Cliquot for the victory.

#### UNIONIZED MALIBU

Dixie Union (Dixieland Band) made a successful return to the races yesterday at Santa Anita, forging to the front in deep stretch to take the GI Malibu S. by one length over Caller One (Phone Trick). The Richard Mandella-trained colt captured the GI Haskell Invitational in August, but had been off since finishing fourth as the favorite in the Aug. 26 GI Travers S. From the start, 6-5 favorite Caller One and Explicit (Distant View) dueled on the front end as Dixie Union stalked the top two. He bid three deep on the turn, gained a short advantage inside the final furlong and prevailed over a game Caller One. "He stumbled a little bit out of the gate, but after that he recuperated really fast and I was in a great position all the way around there," commented winning rider Alex Solis. "I got to the fiveeighths pole and from then on, I just had to be patient." As for what is next for Dixie Union, Mandella said, "The next two races [in the Strub series, the Jan. 13 San Fernando and the Feb. 3 Strub] are possibilities, but I doubt if I'm going to dance every dance. We've got the Strub series to choose from, the Santa Anita H., the Dubai Cup. There's a lot of meals out there on the table."
