TIZNOW ON WORK TAB Breeders' Cup Classic champ Tiznow (Cee's Tizzy) worked at Santa Anita Friday morning, going seven furlongs in 1:24.40 under regular rider Chris McCarron. "He worked very, very well," McCarron said. "He was a different horse today. He finished strong last week, but he didn't have the gusto in the stretch. Today he did. He finished very well and galloped out strong, like his usual self. He's right back on it."

MORE CANCELLATIONS The storm which dumped more than a foot of snow on some areas in the Northeast has also forced the cancellation of racing at tracks in the region. Aqueduct, Philadelphia Park and Suffolk Downs called off all weekend cards, but the three tracks are expected to be back in action Monday. Mountaineer Park raced Saturday, but has anounced it will cancel its programs for Monday and Tuesday.

The prohibitive favorite to make it three straight, he stalked King La Boo through honest fractions after bobbling at the break, drove past the front runner on the turn and pulled away down the lane. WHITE-OUT FOR RACING There was no racing in Britain or Ireland vesterday, but racing at Ireland's Gowran Park looks certain to go ahead today and officials at Leopardstown rate the chances of their program being held as 60-40. There was little surprise when the jump racing at Fontwell Park was called off vesterday because of severe frost, but there was embarrassment and anger when the eight-race card on the "all-weather" track at Lingfield Park was also abandoned. The races were cancelled after the horses for the day's first event had already arrived at the start; their jockeys described the surface as "hard all the way around, dangerous and unraceable." Track officials were unable to explain why the surface was unraceable and promised to contact the track surface consultants to find out what went wrong. There are claims that the track owners, Arena Leisure, have not invested in refurbishing the track surface and that the track is worn out and needs to be dug up and replaced. A Jockey Club investigation seems certain to follow.

COCHRANE AND DETTORI WIN AWARDS

Former jockey-turned-jockeys' agent Ray Cochrane claimed the Channel 4 TV Racing Personality Of The Year award for 2000 on the same day that his client Frankie Dettori was awarded an honorary MBE (Medal Of The British Empire) for "Services To Racing" in the New Year's Honours List in Britain. Irish jockey Johnny Murtagh, who rode 12 Group or Grade 1 winners this year, was runner-up in the TV poll, with champion jockey Kevin Darley third. Ulsterman Cochrane's heroism in rescuing Dettori from a tragic plane crash at Newmarket in June earned him 31 percent of the votes registered by Channel 4 TV viewers, while Murtagh earned 23 percent and Darley 11 percent. Cochrane retired from riding earlier this year after a 26-year career. "This is a great surprise and thrill and I'd like to thank all the viewers who voted for me," he said.

SPAIN REIGNS IN LA BREA

Sporting the nasal strip she wore to victory in the GIII Turfway Park Breeders' Cup S. in September and again in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, Spain (Thunder Gulch) closed from last to first to capture the GI La Brea S. by three-quarters of a length over Cover Gal (Falstaff) at Santa Anita vesterday. Racing without the strip last time, the Team Lukas filly missed by a nose in the GIII Falls City H. at Churchill Downs Nov. 23. But she rebounded in the La Brea despite dropping back to a sprint for the first time in 16 months. "This was not an ideal distance, but we had to start back after the Breeders' Cup and we thought we'd take a chance," trainer D. Wayne Lukas said. Looking to keep Spain and stablemate Surfside apart, Lukas added that he likely would run one against fellow four-year-olds in the Feb. 11 GII La Canada S. and the other vs. older fillies in the Mar. 10 GI Santa Margarita S. Eclipse winner Chilukki (Cherokee Run), sent off the 7-10 favorite after picking up her third consecutive score in the Nov. 4 GII Churchill Downs Distaff H., tracked the leaders while racing along the rail and had dead aim in the stretch, but had to settle for fourth. "She didn't do much running today," jockey Gary Stevens said. "She was very lethargic throughout the race. I had to start riding her early and we really had no excuse."

SECOND TIME LUCKY

A Little Luck (Pas Seul) finished 10th in last year's Gll W.L. McKnight H., but had a little better luck this time, finding a seam between horses at the quarter pole to post a rallying one-length victory over Stokosky (Stack) at Calder Race Course vesterday afternoon. Twice a stakes winner at two and victorious in the GIII Laurel Turf Cup at three, the veteran gelding was held winless in seven starts last year and was dropped in for a tag to start this season, winning for \$75,000 in his fourth outing of 2000 at Aqueduct in April and for the same price at Saratoga in August. Third in the GIII Athenia H. at Aqueduct in October of 1999, one-time European campaigner Prospectress ended the season with a close-up fourth in the GIII My Charmer H. over this course, then disappeared for nearly nine months. As for the future, Skiffington said, "We'll look at the The Very One [GIII, Feb. 11] and the Orchid [GII, Mar. 10] at Gulfstream and then the Black Helen at Hialeah. After that, she is booked to be bred to Theatrical (Ire)." The 9-5 choice, Illiquidity (Sky Classic) pressed the pace, but tired in the drive to be fourth.

The 7-10 favorite Sir Bear rallied on the turn and moved into second, but drifted in during the stretch drive and was outfinished for the place spot.
