JOHN FRANKS DEAD

John Franks, who earned a record four Eclipse Awards as top owner, died Wednesday night at Willis-Knighton Pierremont Health Center in Shreveport, Louisiana. He was 78. The owner and chairman of the board of Franks Petroleum Inc., the Louisiana native served in the Air Force during World War II. After the war, he graduated from Louisiana State University before founding his oil and gas company in 1957. Franks bought his first Thoroughbred in 1979. He won his first race in July of 1980 at Louisiana Downs and picked up his first stakes victory at the Fair Grounds the following February. Just two years later, he was honored as champion owner after leading the nation in both races won and purses. Franks took a second Eclipse in 1984, and was champion again in 1993 and 1994. During his 24 years in racing, the oilman campaigned 11 millionaires. His lone Eclipse winner was Answer Lively, who was the champion two-year-old of 1998 after winning the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. Franks also bred MGISWs Sharp Cat and Royal Anthem and Grade I winner Lady Tak, and was the leading breeder in the nation by races won six times. He owned Franks Farm in Shreveport and the Southland division of the operation in Ocala, Florida. Franks is survived by his wife, Alta, two daughters, six grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren. Visitation will be held at Rose-Neath Marshall Street Chapel in Shreveport from 4-8 p.m. today. There will be a memorial service at Trinity Heights Baptist Church Saturday at 2 p.m.

was fifth in his debut at Saratoga in August, but just missed in his second try, running second by a head in an off-the-turf event going a mile at Belmont Park Sept. 24. Making his stakes debut as the 7-2 second choice, Kitten's Joy rated off moderate splits, kicked it into gear as they raced into the stretch and pulled away to win handily.
