A STAR IS BORN

E A Ranches' **Star Cross (Arg)** (Southern Halo) rallied on the outside and was along in the waning strides to defeat **Nose the Trade (GB)** (Cyrano de Bergerac {GB}) by a half-length in yesterday's GII San Pasqual H. at Santa Anita. Favored **Olmodavor** (A.P. Indy), who bested the latter in the GIII Native Diver H. in their respective last starts Dec. 6, struggled home third. Twice placed in the Estrellas series in his native Argentina, Star Cross served notice in this country with a strong third-place finish to Pleasantly Perfect in the GII Goodwood Breeders' Cup H. Oct. 4. Tenth in the Seabiscuit H. on the Breeders' Cup undercard three weeks later, the chestnut most recently took Golden Gate's Forty Niner H. with blinkers added Nov. 28. Content to relax off the early pace, he began to take closer order leaving the backstretch, swung out three deep for the stretch drive and rallied to wear down Nose the Trade for the victory. THE BEAT GOES ON

His rivals came at him from all angles, but Breeders' Cup Sprint hero **Cajun Beat** (Grand Slam) proved more than equal to the task, winning yesterday's GIII Mr.

Prospector H. at Gulfstream Park by an eased-down length and a half. The dark bay was second in each of his first two starts for trainer Steve Margolis, including the GIII Carry Back S. at Calder July 12. The 3/4-length winner of the GIII Kentucky Cup Sprint Sept. 13, he shocked most of

the racing world, with the notable exception of Andy Beyer and a single Pick Six winner, with his tour-de-force in the Oct. 25 Sprint. Hustled up from his outside post, Cajun Beat set a strong pace from **Gygistar** (Prospector's Music), turned back a bid from **Deer Lake** (Meadowlake) at the quarter pole and edged clear. The winner is possible for the Feb. 7 GIII Deputy Minister H. followed by the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen Mar. 27. [Click for the brisnet.com chart](#).

Never worse than third in six previous appearances in Hallandale, Puzzlement swooped from last to land the spoils in the Hal's Hope. Third in the GI Donn H. and the GII Gulfstream Park H. last winter, the Shields homebred took a third-level allowance at Saratoga July 24 before finishing a close fourth in the GI Whitney H. just nine days later. The bay put in one of his patented late runs to win the GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. Aug. 16 and was making his first appearance since completing the triple behind Mineshaft in the GI Woodward S. at Belmont Sept. 6. Unhurried early, Puzzlement was given his cue by jockey Jorge Chavez and gained good ground on the turn. Stablemate Bowman's Band led the field into the stretch and looked home free, but Puzzlement was along in time for the win. "I had a beautiful trip. My horse was doing his own thing," the winning rider commented. "He relaxed and when I asked he responded." The win was the third on the afternoon for Hall of Fame trainer Allen Jerkens.

Ever-consistent Delmonico Cat, out of the top two just once in seven previous turf tries, rallied down the center of the track and held off Coney Kitty to record her first graded-stakes victory. A half-length winner of the Possibly Perfect S. at Arlington on Independence Day, the Wygod homebred was beaten by that same margin in the Aug. 15 Estrapade H. over a yielding Arlington turf, but bounced back with a neck success in the Flawlessly S. in Chicago Sept. 20. Second as the favorite in the Oct. 11 Indian Maid Breeders' Cup at Hawthorne, the dark bay was most recently sixth in the GIII Cardinal H. at Churchill Downs Nov. 22. Settled in midpack behind only moderate fractions, Delmonico Cat commenced a wide rally on the far turn and assumed command late en route to the win. "It took all day, but we got what we wanted," commented winning rider Jerry Bailey. "I figured to just let her race where she was comfortable. She took the worst of it on both turns. There's still more in the tank, but I'm not sure if there's any more in mine."

HARTHILL RETIRES Dr. Alex Harthill, who treated champions such as Citation, Northern Dancer, Affirmed, Spectacular Bid and Sunday Silence during his 50-plus years as a veterinarian, has retired. The 78-year-old decided to give up his practice because of the lingering effects of injuries suffered more than a year ago. Harthill broke both legs and his back when a horse with West Nile virus fell on him while getting off a van. "I haven't gotten any better," he told the *Daily Racing Form*. "Goes with getting old. A back injury is a tough thing for a veterinarian, because you've got to get down there where the problems are. It's got to where I can't keep it up." Harthill was also the vet for Dancer's Image, who was disqualified from his victory in the 1968 Kentucky Derby after testing positive for bute.

Sunshine Beckons for Tomahawk:

Tomahawk (Seattle Slew), one of Aidan O'Brien's top two-year-olds at Ballydoyle in 2002, will make his first start for trainer Todd Pletcher in today's 10th race, a seven-furlong allowance on the main track. A \$2.5 million KEEJUL acquisition, Tomahawk was the runner-up in both the G1 Middle Park S. and the G1 Dewhurst S. before concluding his juvenile season with an eighth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. The dark bay returned to Ireland to annex the Listed Loughbrown S. to kick off his three-year-old season, but was luckless thereafter, missing by a neck when fourth in the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau before three straight unplaced efforts in Group 1 races. Previously owned by Mrs. John Magnier, Tomahawk will race for D. Morgan Firestone in his four-year-old debut with John Velazquez in the irons. He is 4-1 on the morning line.

The Future is Now:

Today's eighth race, a six-furlong maiden for three-year-old fillies, features the debut of **Indy Future** (A.P. Indy), a homebred for William S. Farish and G. Watts Humphrey Jr. The bay was produced by the stakes winning Everhope (Danzig), a daughter of the blue hen mare Battle Creek Girl (His Majesty). Battle Creek Girl has also produced MGSW Tricky Creek (Clever Trick); champion Wavering Girl (Wavering Monarch), the dam of GISW Military; GSW Speed Dialer (Phone Trick); MSP Swiss Asset (Private Account); MGSW Parade Ground (Kingmambo); and GSW Parade Leader (Kingmambo). Listed at 10-1 on the morning-line, Indy Future will be ridden by Eibar Coa for trainer Rusty Arnold.

Smarty Jones added a route victory to his unbeaten resume while handling a class rise, and punched his ticket for the next stop on the Triple Crown trail. The liver chestnut romped by 7 3/4 lengths in his Nov. 9 debut at Philly Park, a precursor to his coming out party in the Pennsylvania Nursery S. 13 days later. He trounced state-bred foes by 15 lengths in that spot, covering seven-eighths in 1:21 4/5 and earning a

105 Beyer Speed Figure. That grabbed the attention of the Aqueduct faithful, who sent Smarty Jones postward as the prohibitive 2-5 chalk. He stumbled at the start, but recovered smoothly to stalk the pace while three wide. Stewart Elliott asked for more on the far turn and Smarty Jones moved up to engage pace-setter Risky Trick at the top of the stretch. Risky Trick kept on gamely, but Smarty Jones had more left and opened up in the final sixteenth. "The way the race set up was a good thing, because he settled off the pace," said winning trainer John Servis. "I would much rather see this than see him go wire to wire. It is just a matter of time before there is going to be a horse that looks him in the eye, especially the farther they go." So where exactly will Smarty Jones go next? "We're planning on taking him to Oaklawn," Servis added. "There's the Southwest [2-29], the Rebel [3-20] and the Arkansas Derby [GI, 4-10]. We're probably going to run in all three." The 5-1 second choice Distressed Debt (Smoke Glacken) was rank early before packing it in on the far turn, finishing last of seven.
