YOU CAN GO HOME AGAIN

Cal-bred **Excessivepleasure** (In Excess {Ire}) returns to his home state for the first time since May for today's

GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup S. at Santa Anita. The four-year-old gelding won his only previous start in Arcadia, taking the California Breeders' Championship S. in his juvenile finale.

The dark bay is also a perfect three-for-three at the San Fernando distance of a mile and a sixteenth, with wins in the WinStar Derby, Iowa Derby and the GIII Indiana Derby at Hoosier Park Oct. 4. Second in the Nov. 16 GIII Oklahoma Derby in his last outing of 2003, he makes his seasonal debut against an interesting group. **Anziyan Royalty** (Anziyan), also bred in the Golden State, is undefeated in four starts on the dirt. He comes off an eight-length romp in an entry-level allowance at Hollywood Park Dec. 20. **Touch the Wire** (Birdonthewire) was beaten just 3/4 of a length by fellow San Fernando hopeful **During** (Cherokee Run) in an optional claimer at Santa Anita last February. Off

from April until October, he followed a rallying third-place finish in his return with a four-length score in a NW1X allowance at Hollywood Nov. 29. During went on to win the July 13 GII Swaps S., Sept. 13 GII Jerome H. and Oct. 29 GIII Discovery H., but looks to get back on track after being eased in the Nov. 28 GII Clark H. over a sloppy Churchill strip.

Toccet (Awesome Again) is also looking to regain the form that carried him to victory in the GI Hollywood Futurity, GII Remsen S. and GIII Laurel Futurity at two. The bay started his sophomore season with a win in the Aug. 19 Widener S. at Philly Park, then was off the board in three straight before running second by a nose in the Nov. 15 Hail Emperor S. at Laurel Park. A distant third in the Nov. 29 GI Cigar Mile H., he comes off an 11th-place effort in the Dec. 26 seven-furlong GI Malibu S. "Seven-eighths of a mile is not Toccet's race," trainer John Scanlan said. "He...should do fine coming up to this race." **San Fernando field, p3**

DANEHILL CONTINUES TO DOMINATE AT MM

Magic Millions principal and retail giant Gerry Harvey made his first purchase at the 2004 edition of the

Conrad Jupiters Magic Millions Yearling Sale yesterday. Harvey went to a session-topping A\$800,000 to bring home a much sought-after son of Danehill out of the Group 1-placed mare Fitting (Aus) (Marscay {Aus}). The yearling is a full brother to Golden Slipper winner Catbird (Aus) and to group stakes winner Danbird (Aus). Harvey said he planned to retain 50 percent, selling four

shares at A\$100,000 apiece. He considers the cracking colt an outstanding sire prospect for his Baramul Stud. "In my opinion, he's the best horse in the catalogue," Harvey said. "He's a great stallion prospect, he's by a champion and closely related to some top gallopers." The session-topping colt was consigned by Vinery Stud, as agent. **MM Report cont. p2**

Hong Kong Strong Off the Bench...

Buoyed by a particularly active Hong Kong bench, Magic Millions continued on a powerful note Friday, with 210 yearlings sold at an average A\$112,454. "We are on track for a positive result with two sessions remaining," said Magic Millions' Managing Director David Chester. The Hong Kong Jockey Club secured six yearlings for a total of A\$1,525,000 and an average of A\$254,167, while Willie Leung's Magus Equine, purchasing for several prominent Hong Kong owners who are attending the sale for the first time, bought eight for A\$1 million. Agent Mark Pilkington purchased 12 yearlings for A\$1,142,500, with many of his purchases destined for the stable of David Hayes in Hong Kong. But Magic Millions' mainstay domestic bench has hardly been deterred by international activity. Trainer Graeme Rogerson, who saddles race favorite **Not A Single Doubt (Aus)** (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) for the Magic Millions two-year-old race today, has paid more than A\$4.3 million for 24 yearlings to date. Gai Waterhouse bought nine yearlings for A\$1.9 million. The auction's third session kicks off at 6 p.m. Saturday night following the Magic Millions race day at the Gold Coast Turf Club opposite the sale complex, with a final session of the select sale Sunday.

Danehills in Demand...

Danehill's final Southern Hemisphere crop is averaging A\$362,619 with 21 sold at Magic Millions. Purchases of many of his trademark bay youngsters are likely to look decidedly like bargains in future years. The global champion is easily leading sire on average with New Zealand-based Pins (Aus) (Snippets {Aus}) second with one sold for A\$260,000. Yearlings by Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector) are averaging A\$205,000, with eight sold from nine offered. The first crop of King's Best (Kingmambo) are the subject of competitive bidding, with seven sold from eight offered at an average A\$129,286. The first crop of Testa Rossa (Aus) (Perugino), a six-time Group 1 winner and champion sprinter, are averaging A\$105,833. Redoute's Choice (Aus) (Danehill) is the most popular stallion at the sale (20 sold for an average A\$164,000) with the slashing wins of boom two-year-old Not A Single Doubt (Aus) fresh in buyers' minds. If the powerful colt fulfils expectations in the Magic Millions race today, the rush for Redoute's Choice is likely to continue.

Megahertz, beaten just 3/4 of a length by stablemate **Tates Creek** in this race last year, came back to be third by that margin in the Mar. 22 GII Santa Ana H. before taking the Apr. 19 GII Santa Barbara H. by...3/4 of a length. Third against graded foes in her next two outings, the chestnut was an 8-1 outsider in the July 26 GI Mabee H. at Del Mar, but closed well to best dead-heating **Tates Creek** and **Dublino** by a half length. The British-bred was freshened after that start, returning to finish a rallying fifth in the Oct. 25 GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf in her most recent appearance. **Firth of Lorne**, the runner-up in the 2002 G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches, started just three times last year. Fourth in an optional claimer at Del Mar in August in her U.S. bow, the bay came back to win at that level at Bay Meadows Sept. 14 before closing out the campaign with a third in the Nov. 22 GIII Cardinal H. at Churchill Downs. It was her first try at a mile and an eighth. "Her last race was a good one and I think the distance will suit her," trainer **Eoin Harty** said.

AVANZADO INJURED Grade I winner **Avanzado (Arg)** (Luhuk--Avian Eden, by Storm Bird) has suffered a splint bone injury that will preclude a return engagement in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen and may force his retirement. "He might be done," Michael Cooper, racing manager for owner Cee's Stable partnership, told *Daily Racing Form*. "I was originally going to run him in Dubai, then retire him. I was going to start him at stud in South America, then shuttle him here, but he might go to Kentucky first now." A group stakes winner in his native Argentina in 2001, **Avanzado** won last season's GI Ancient Title Breeders' Cup H. and GII Palos Verdes H., as well as the 2002 GII Forest Hills H. He was second behind **State City** in last year's Golden Shaheen.

Daily Racing Form executive columnist Jay Hovdey, free-lance writer William Nack and photographer Frank Anderson are this year's recipients of Media Eclipse Awards, to be handed out at this year's Eclipse ceremonies in Hollywood, Florida Jan. 26. Hovdey was recognized for writing in the news/commentary category for his three-part series honoring the late Bill Shoemaker, which appeared last October shortly after the Hall of Fame rider's death. "I wanted these columns to be my personal tribute to Bill, as a racing fan and as a journalist," Hovdey commented. Nack, who received an honorable mention in the news/commentary category, is to be awarded a Media Eclipse Award in the feature/enterprise category for his article "Horse Racing: Why Everybody Hates Bob Baffert," which appeared in the May 2003 edition of *GQ (Gentlemen's Quarterly) Magazine*. Nack has won an unprecedented seven Eclipse Awards for his writings. Frank Anderson, a 40-year employee of the Lexington *Herald-Leader*, has won the Media Eclipse Award for photography. Abbey Bridge, a winner for a \$50,000 tag at Santa Anita in April, was second in two of her next three starts while racing against Southern California claiming foes, but stepped up in company in her latest.
