ST AVERIL COMES MARCHING IN

Stan Fulton's St Averil (Saint Ballado) came home with a professional victory in the GII Santa Catalina S. at Santa Anita Saturday afternoon and stamped himself as one of the West Coast's top contenders for the Triple Crown trail. The dark bay had posted a 96 Beyer Speed Figure in securing his Nov. 9 debut over this surface, then found himself with the thankless task of chasing home the unbeaten Lion Heart when second in the GI Hollywood Futurity Dec. 20. That effort marked his first try at two turns, but the bettors turned to Master David (Grand Slam), making his first start for trainer Bobby Frankel, as their 7-5 favorite. Perfect Moon (Malibu Moon) went up to set the pace accompanied by Lucky Pulpit (Pulpit), and the pair put up fractions of :45.61 and 1:09.81 as St Averil sat a stalking trip. Jockey Tyler Baze sent him up to challenge on the far turn as Lucky Pulpit went on with it. Lucky Pulpit battled back gamely, but St Averil overhauled him in midstretch and went on to secure his first stakes victory. Cont. p2

SPRINGTIME BECKONS A June 2 birthdate hasn't stopped Second of June (Louis Quatorze) from coming to hand quickly; since a 3/4-length second in the Foolish Pleasure S. Sept. 20, he has won three straight starts, all by open lengths. Following a 4 3/4-length allowance win at Calder Nov. 3, he defeated Silver Wagon in the Dec. 13 What a Pleasure S. crosstown, and made his three-year-old bow as the 5-2 second choice here. "We're just glad to have this win," said trainer Bill Cesare, who trains the colt for his mother Barbara. "He can win here, in Kentucky or anywhere. The money is all green. He can win on the right Saturday...any Saturday is a good day to win." As for 8-5 favorite Silver Wagon, jockey Jerry Bailey said, "He ran like a first-time starter. He was in, out, back in again. He wouldn't even stay in the pocket on the backside."

CATALINA HERO TAKING CALIFORNIA

ROUTE St Averil (Saint Ballado) could meet up with Lion Heart again in Santa Anita's prep races for the Kentucky Derby. "Right now, we'll sit down the next couple of days and decide what's next," said trainer Rafael Becerra. "I'm pretty sure we'll stay here [in California]." That could mean the Mar. 14 GII San Felipe S. at a mile and a sixteenth, which is currently the intended target for unbeaten Lion Heart. St Averil has pleased young rider Tyler Baze. "He's just a real good horse," said Baze. "Around the far turn he took a nice, deep breath and when I asked him, he really dug in."



Austin's Mom turned in a ninth-place finish in the GIII Singapore Plate at Arlington Aug. 9, but has turned it around since. In her next three starts at Delaware, she ran second in an allowance Sept. 20, then won an allowance Oct. 6 and a \$50,000 optional claimer last out Nov. 2. Making her inner track debut here, she raced towards the back of the field, swung wide for the stretch drive and closed strongly to notch her first stakes victory. "She is a nice filly to ride," winning jockey Pablo Fragoso said. "I did what the trainer told me to do. He said, 'She likes to be off the pace and she comes running at the end.' She really kicked in throught the stretch." Message Red (Cryptoclearance), the crowd's 2-1 choice, was at the back of the pack early, raced wide around both turns and showed little in the stretch, finishing sixth.



Seattle Fitz won a pair of stakes preps while racing in UAE at the beginning of his career and capped off his stint in the desert with a sixth in the 2003 G2 UAE Derby. Sent to the U.S. after that effort, he picked up his first stateside score with a 10-1/2 length allowance romp at Belmont Sept. 27. Stepping up in class in his next three starts, he ran third in the GIII Fayette S. Oct. 25, fourth in the GII Clark H. Nov. 28 and third over this track in the GIII Queens County H. last time Dec. 13. Made the second-choice here, he rated early, moved while racing on the outside down the back-stretch, took the lead in the stretch and gamely held off the game Evening Attire. "He is a really, really nice horse," winning trainer Kiaran McLaughlin said. "He's real professional."

Island Fashion was overlooked by the Eclipse voters, but she can't be overlooked in this field. Looking to follow in the hoofsteps of Got Koko, who swept the La Canada series in 2002-03, the four-year-old comes off a rousing six-length score in the Dec. 27 GI La Brea S. "She's the sort of filly that can make a jockey famous," Kent Desormeaux, who was aboard the gray for the first time in the El Encino, told Daily Racing Form. Island Fashion looked like she might be any kind after daylight wins in the GIII Delaware Oaks and GI Alabama S., but went off form in her next two. Fourth in the GI Gazelle H. and sixth in the GI Beldame S., she was given a short break before trying the turf for the first time in the Nov. 30 GI Matriarch S. The Everest Stable homebred was far back early and swung five wide into the stretch, but finished full of run to be fourth, just 3/4 of a length behind Eclipse finalist Heat Haze (GB). "We were glowing for days afterward," owner Jeff Nielsen told DRF. "If she wins that race, she's a lock for the Eclipse Award." Nielsen believes she is the one to beat for year-end honors this season. "It will take some awesome fillies to knock her out," he said. Looking to deliver a knockout punch today are Victory Encounter, who capped a three-race winning streak in the Torrey Pines S. at Del Mar, but has not been out since that Sept. 7 test; and Hope Rises, who captured her first two career starts before finishing fourth in the La Brea. The El Encino will be her introduction to a route.



A well-related A\$24,000 purchase from the 2003 Classic Sale, Commands Nothin' highlights the rise and rise of her sire, who has just completed his third season at Woodlands Stud in the NSW Hunter Valley. Unlike his multiple Group 1-winning full brother Danewin, who is enjoying a bumper season in Hong Kong as the sire of G1 Hong Kong Cup third Elegant Fashion (Aus) among others, Commands did not win at the highest level. The runner-up in the G1 Galaxy S. and third to Iuminaries Redoute's Choice (Aus) and Testa Rossa (Aus) in the G1 VATC Caulfield Guineas, Commands has sired such consistently classy types that horses from his first crop fetched up to A\$240,000 last year and his 11 yearlings averaged A\$116,364 at Magic Millions last week. He has 16 yearlings catalogued for this sale, which kicks off at 10:30 a.m. Sunday and continues Monday. In recent years, the Classic catalogue has yielded horses of the ilk of Choisir (Aus), a A\$55,000 purchase; top Hong Kong sprinter Silent Witness (Aus), a A\$55,000 acquisition; and G1 Caulfield Guineas victor In Top Swing (Aus), a A\$50,000 son of emerging sire Beautiful Crown. Coming hot on the heels of a strong Magic Millions sale, it is hard to imagine that Classic will not record a similar increase this year, with domestic purchasers who found bidding too fierce at Magic Millions keen to fill orders, while several international purchasers, such as Grant Pritchard-Gordon, have chosen to attend Classic.
